them, I am the LORD your God.

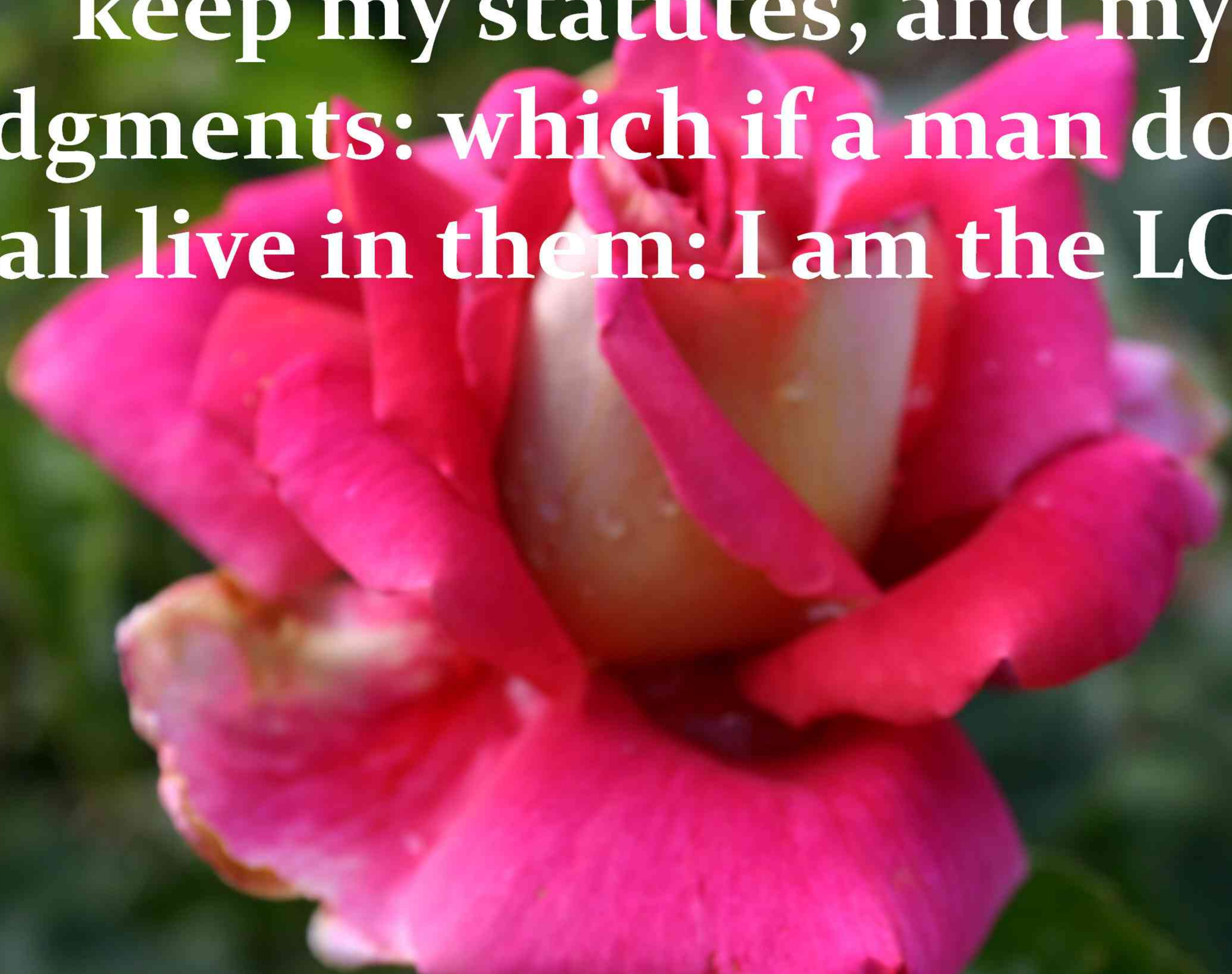


Leviticus 18:03 After the doings of
the land of Egypt, wherein ye
dwelt, shall ye not do: and after
the doings of the land of Canaan,
whither I bring you, shall ye not do:
neither shall ye walk in their
ordinances.

Leviticus 18:04 Ye shall do my
judgments, and keep mine
ordinances, to walk therein: I am
the LORD your God.



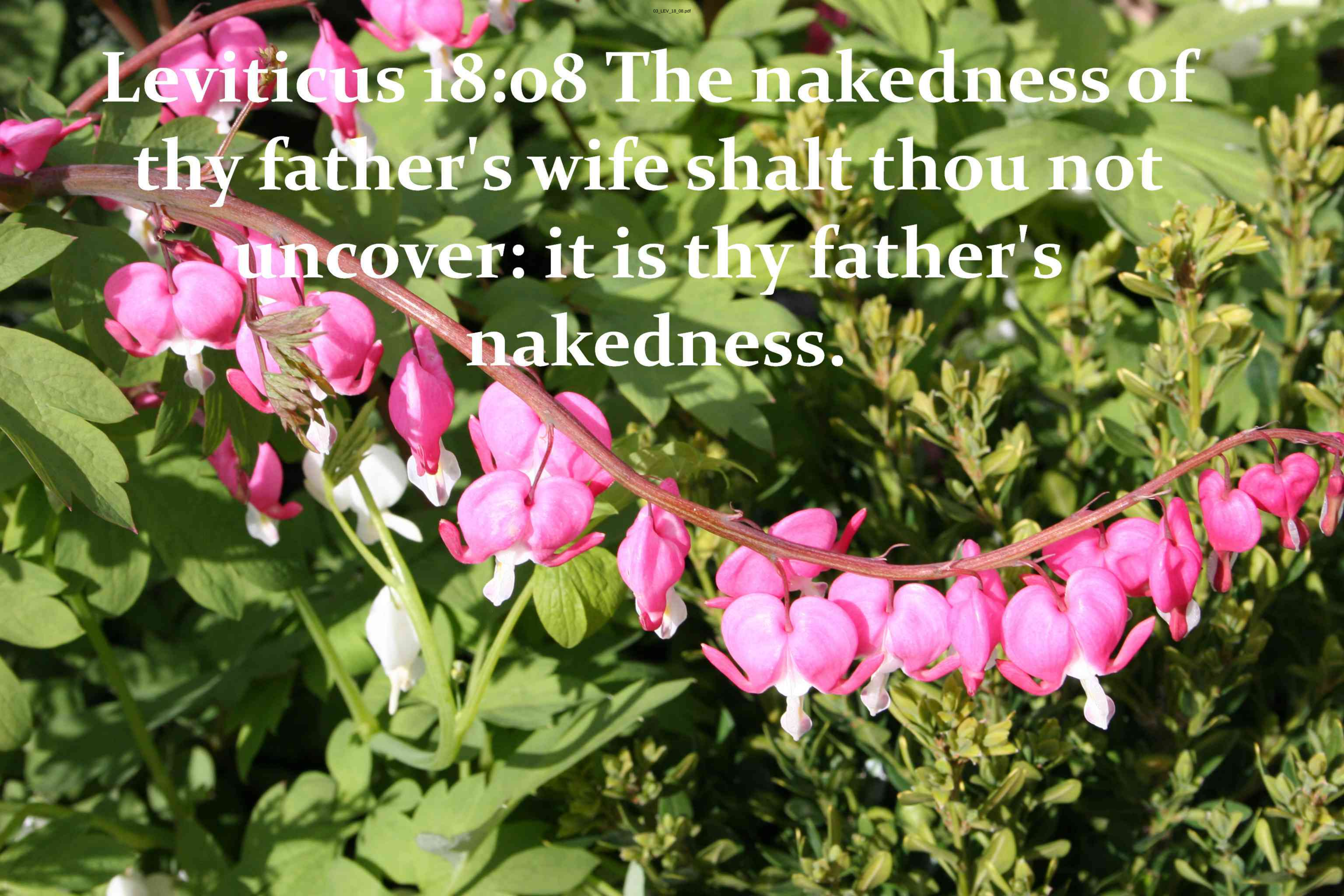
Leviticus 18:05 Ye shall therefore
keep my statutes, and my
judgments: which if a man do, he
shall live in them: I am the LORD.



**Leviticus 18:06 None of you shall
approach to any that is near of kin
to him, to uncover their nakedness:
I am the LORD.**

Leviticus 18:07 The nakedness of thy father, or the nakedness of thy mother, shalt thou not uncover: she is thy mother; thou shalt not uncover her nakedness.

Leviticus 18:08 The nakedness of
thy father's wife shalt thou not
uncover: it is thy father's
nakedness.



**Leviticus 18:09 The nakedness of
thy sister, the daughter of thy
father, or daughter of thy mother,
whether she be born at home, or
born abroad, even their nakedness
thou shalt not uncover.**

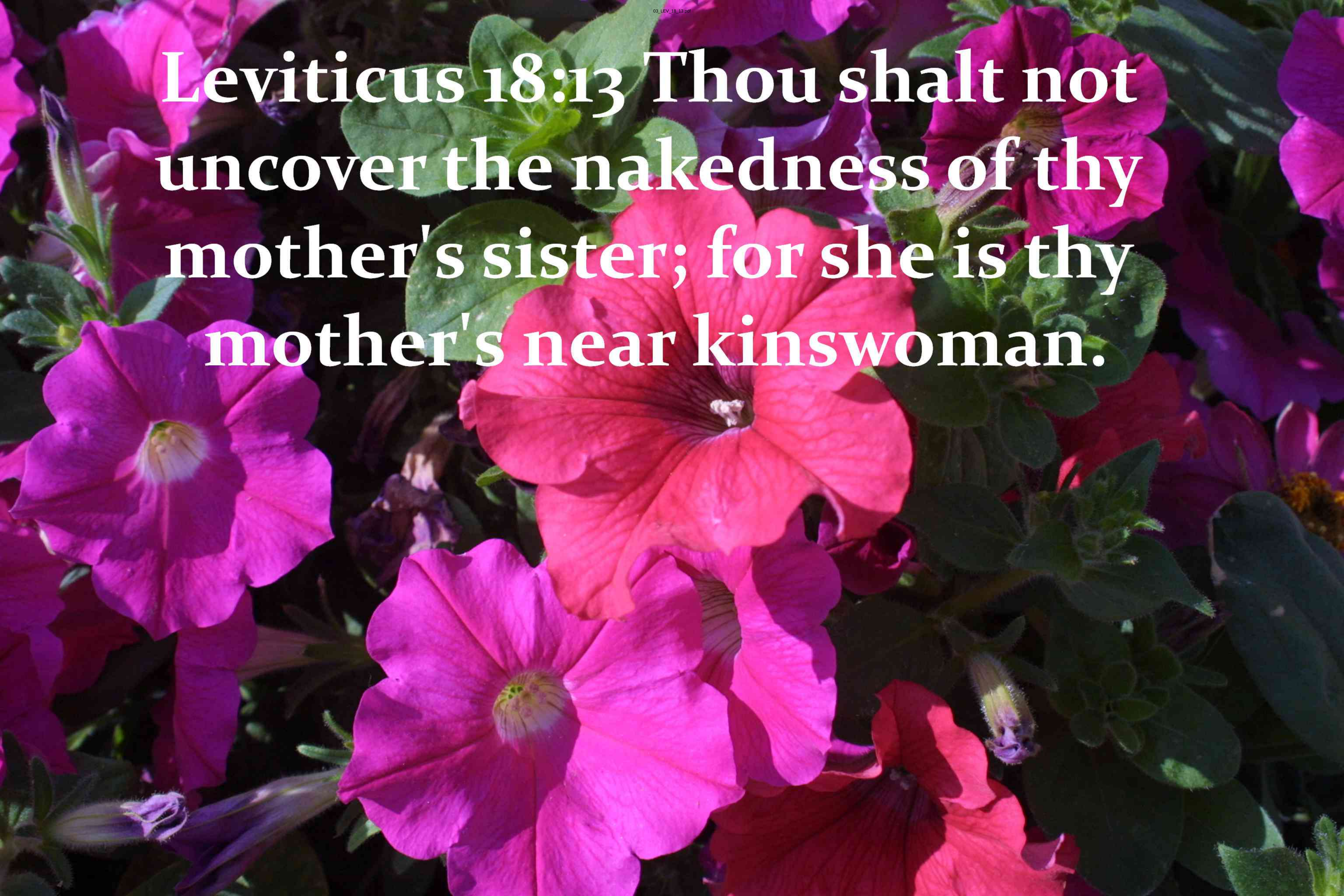


Leviticus 18:10 The nakedness of
thy son's daughter, or of thy
daughter's daughter, even their
nakedness thou shalt not uncover:
for theirs is thine own nakedness.

**Leviticus 18:11 The nakedness of
thy father's wife's daughter,
begotten of thy father, she is thy
sister, thou shalt not uncover her
nakedness.**

Leviticus 18:12 Thou shalt not
uncover the nakedness of thy
father's sister: she is thy father's
near kinswoman.

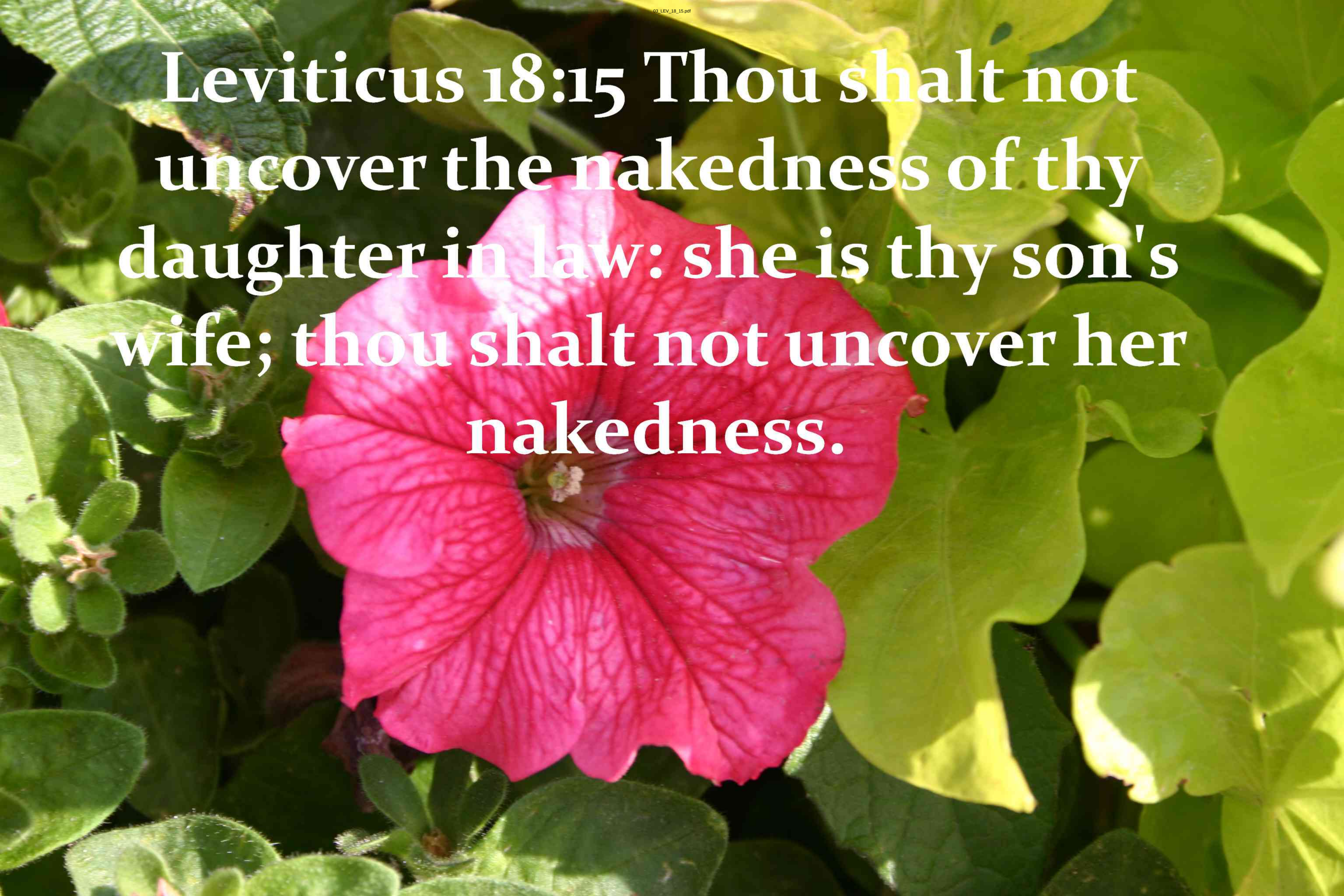




Leviticus 18:13 Thou shalt not
uncover the nakedness of thy
mother's sister; for she is thy
mother's near kinswoman.

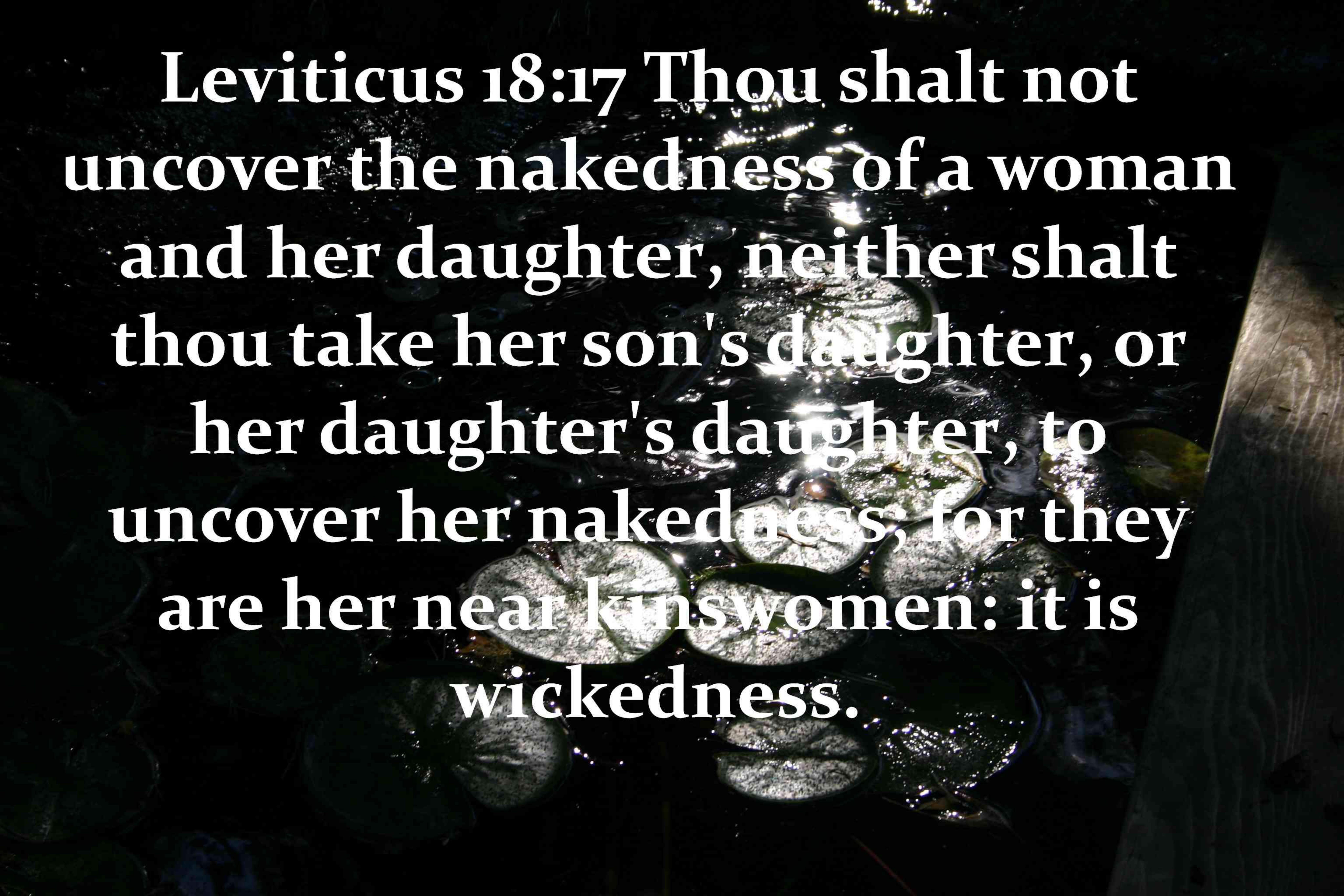
Leviticus 18:14 Thou shalt not uncover the nakedness of thy father's brother, thou shalt not approach to his wife: she is thine aunt.

Leviticus 18:15 Thou shalt not uncover the nakedness of thy daughter in law: she is thy son's wife; thou shalt not uncover her nakedness.

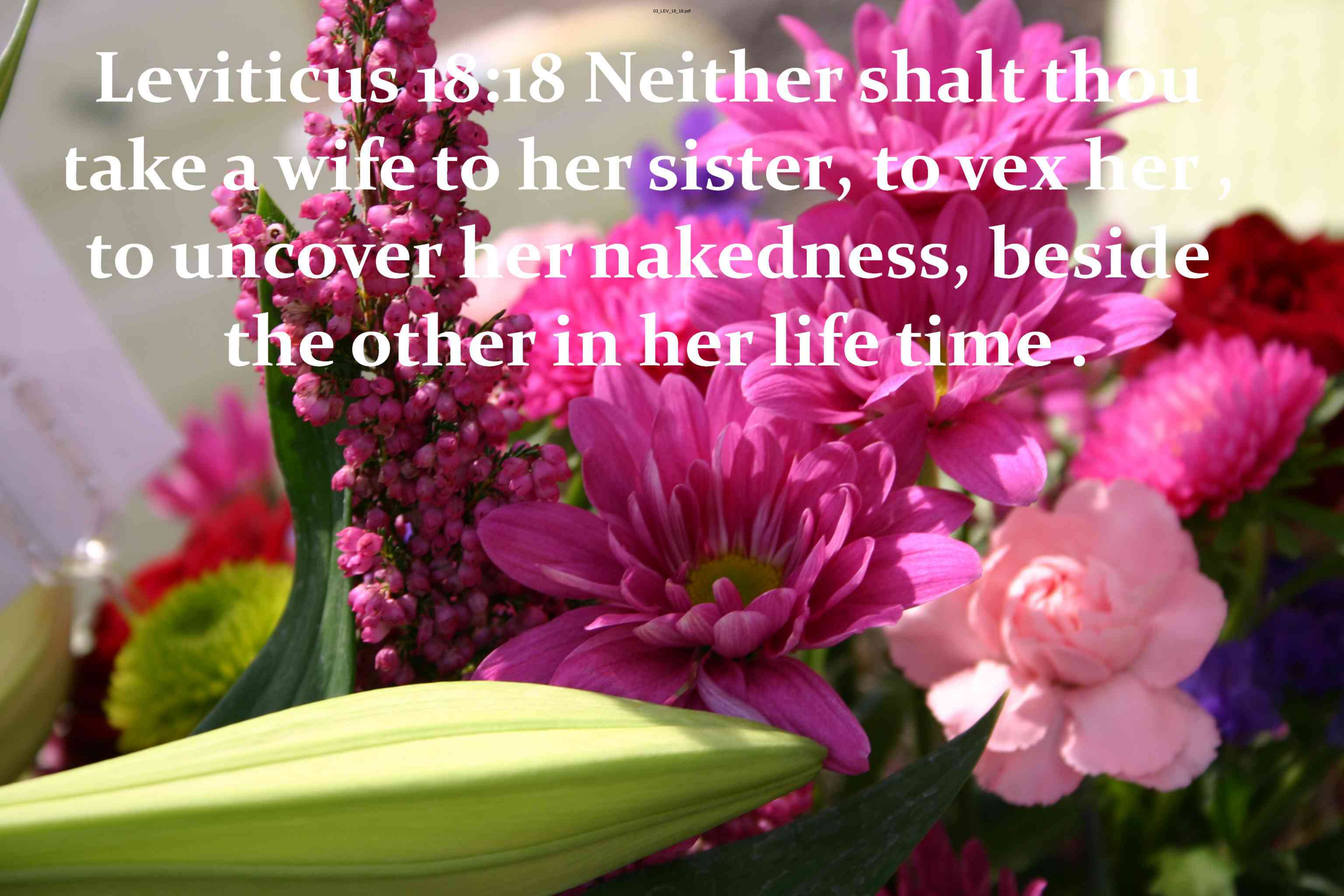
**Leviticus 18:16 Thou shalt not

nakedness.**

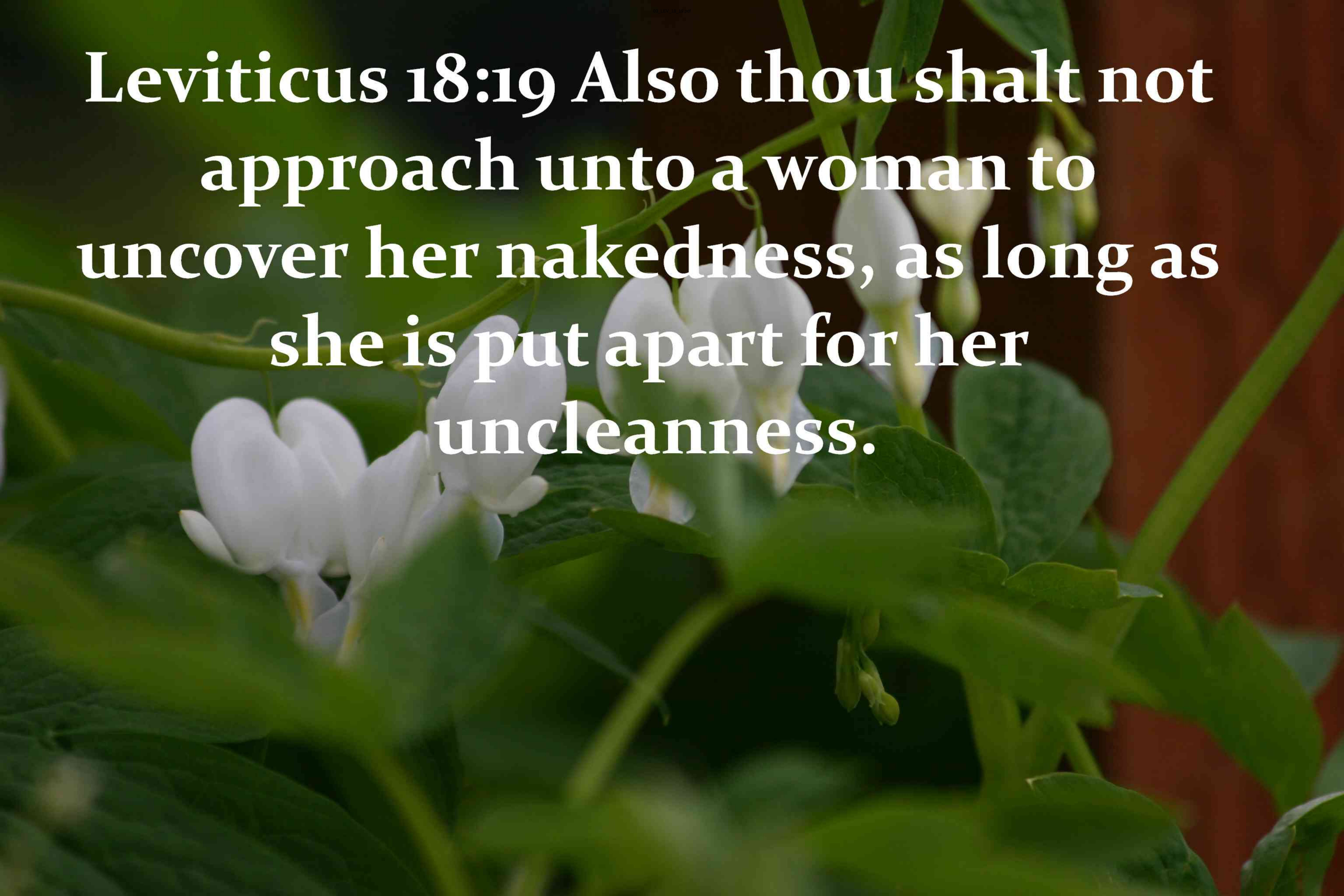

**Leviticus 18:19 Also thou shalt not
approach unto a woman to
uncover her nakedness, as long as
she is put apart for her
uncleanness.**

Leviticus 18:20 Moreover thou shalt not lie carnally with thy neighbour's wife, to defile thyself with her.

Leviticus 18:21 And thou shalt not
let any of thy seed pass through
the fire to Molech, neither shalt
thou profane the name of thy God:
I am the LORD.

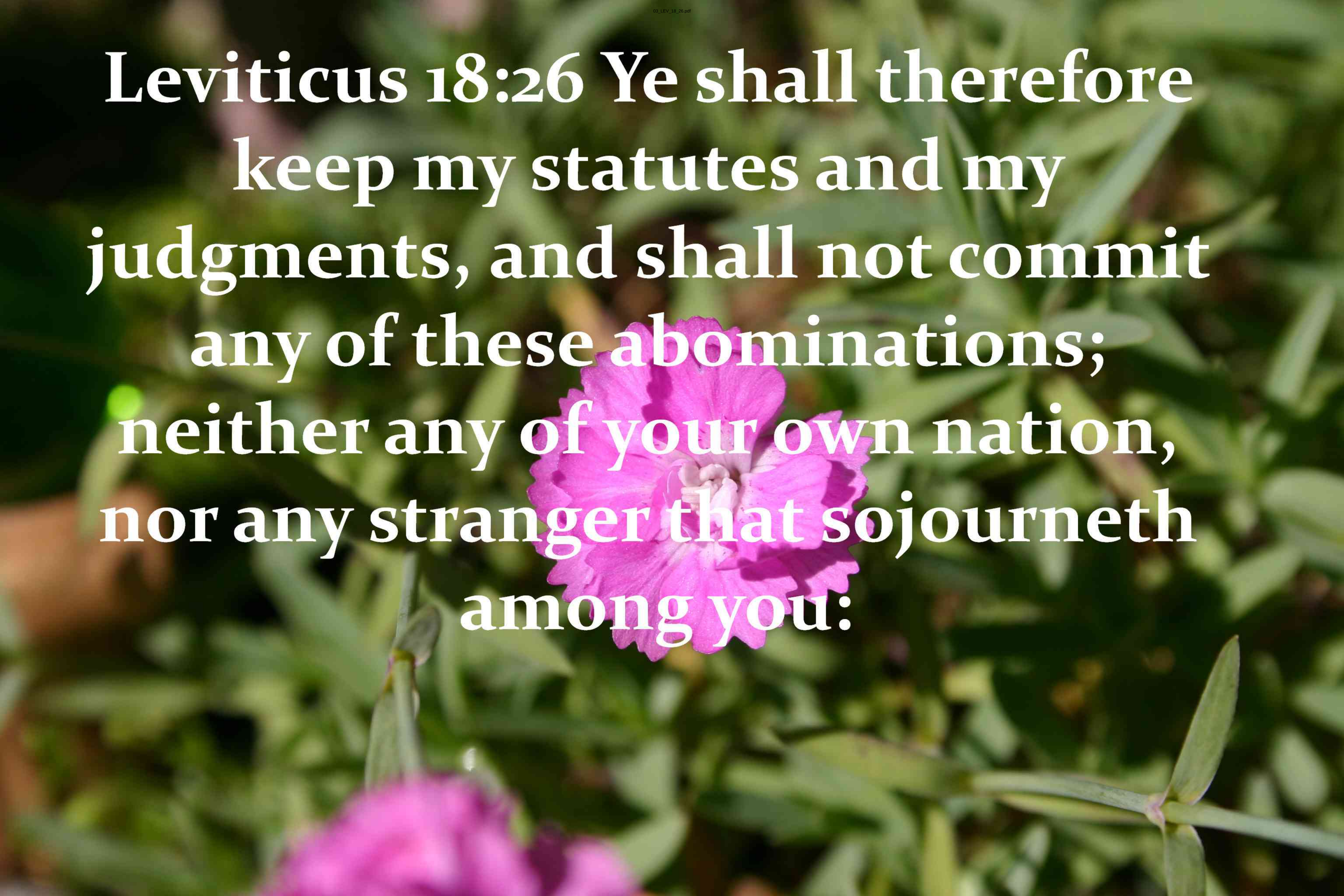
Leviticus 18:22 Thou shalt not lie
with mankind, as with womankind:
it is abomination.

Leviticus 18:23 Neither shalt thou
lie with any beast to defile thyself
therewith: neither shall any
woman stand before a beast to lie
down thereto: it is confusion.

**Leviticus 18:24 Defile not ye
yourselves in any of these things:
for in all these the nations are
defiled which I cast out before you:**

Leviticus 18:25 And the land is
defiled: therefore I do visit the
iniquity thereof upon it, and the
land itself vomiteth out her
inhabitants.

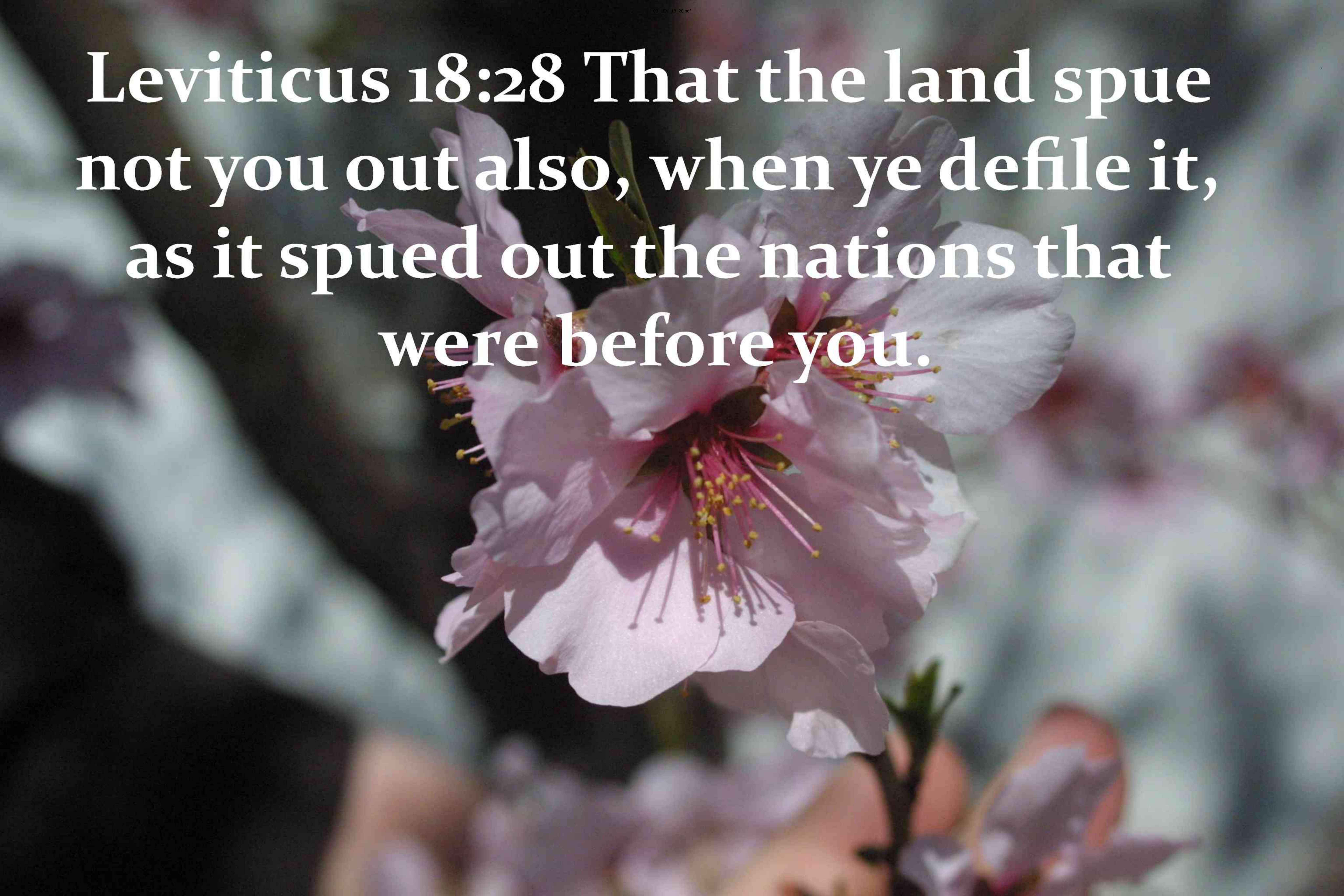
**Leviticus 18:26 Ye shall therefore
keep my statutes and my
judgments, and shall not commit
any of these abominations;
neither any of your own nation,
nor any stranger that sojourneth
among you:**

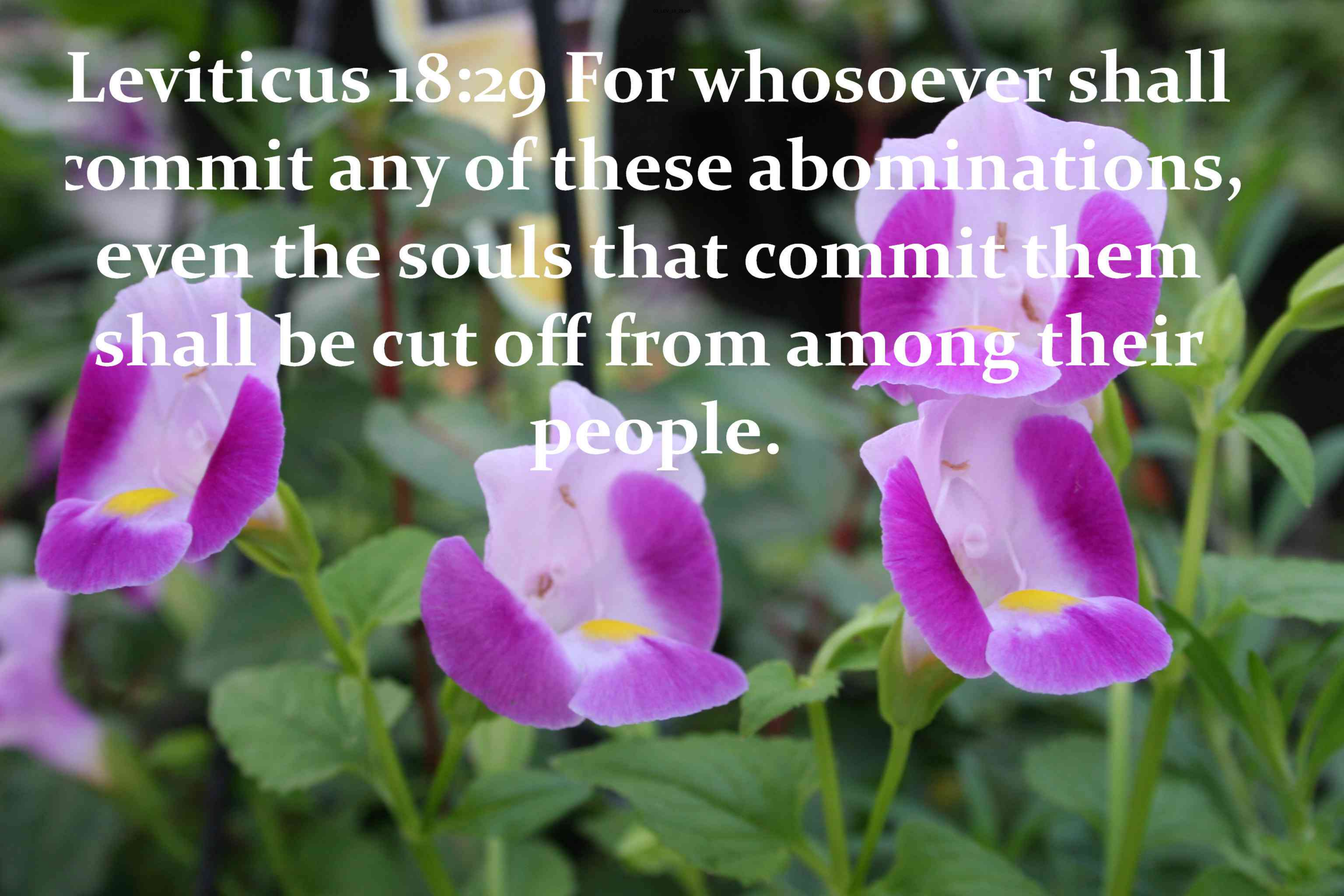


Leviticus 18:27 For all these
abominations have the men of the

and the land is defiled;



Leviticus 18:28 That the land spue
not you out also, when ye defile it,
as it spued out the nations that
were before you.
