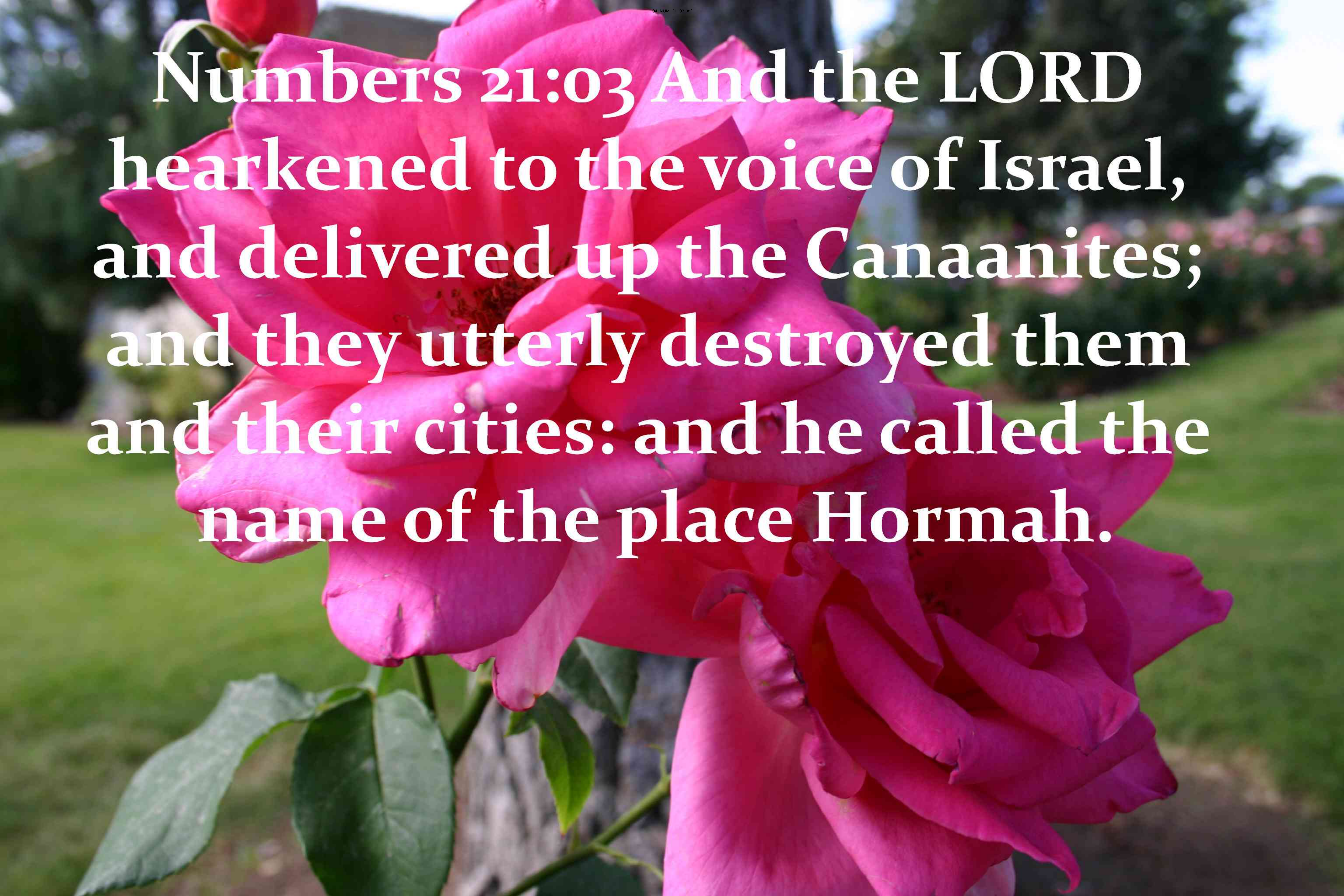


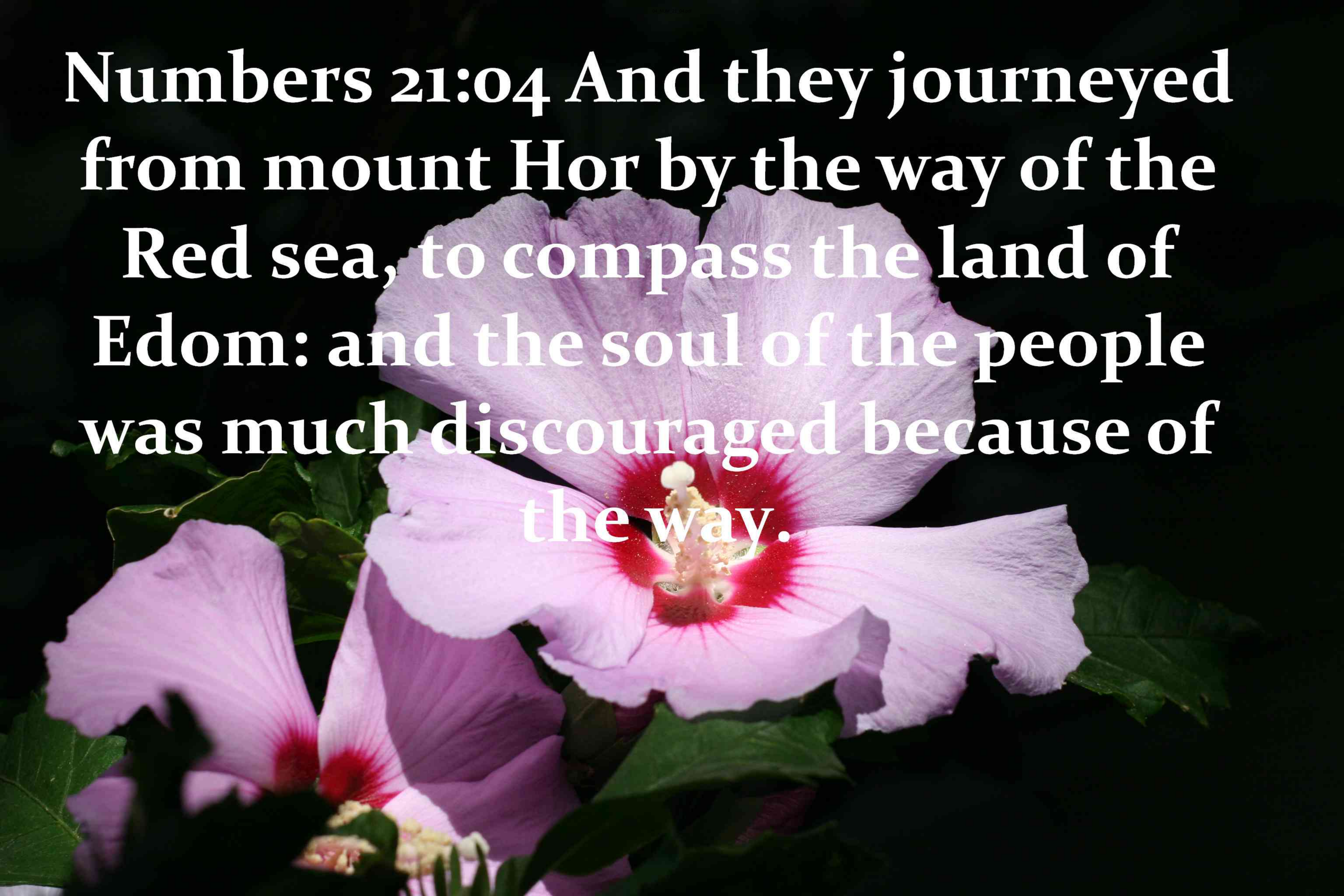
Numbers 21:01 And when king  
Arad the Canaanite, which dwelt  
in the south, heard tell that Israel  
came by the way of the spies; then  
he fought against Israel, and took  
some of them prisoners.

**Numbers 21:02 And Israel vowed a  
vow unto the LORD, and said, If  
thou wilt indeed deliver this  
people into my hand, then I will  
utterly destroy their cities.**



Numbers 21:03 And the LORD  
hearkened to the voice of Israel,  
and delivered up the Canaanites;  
and they utterly destroyed them  
and their cities: and he called the  
name of the place Hormah.

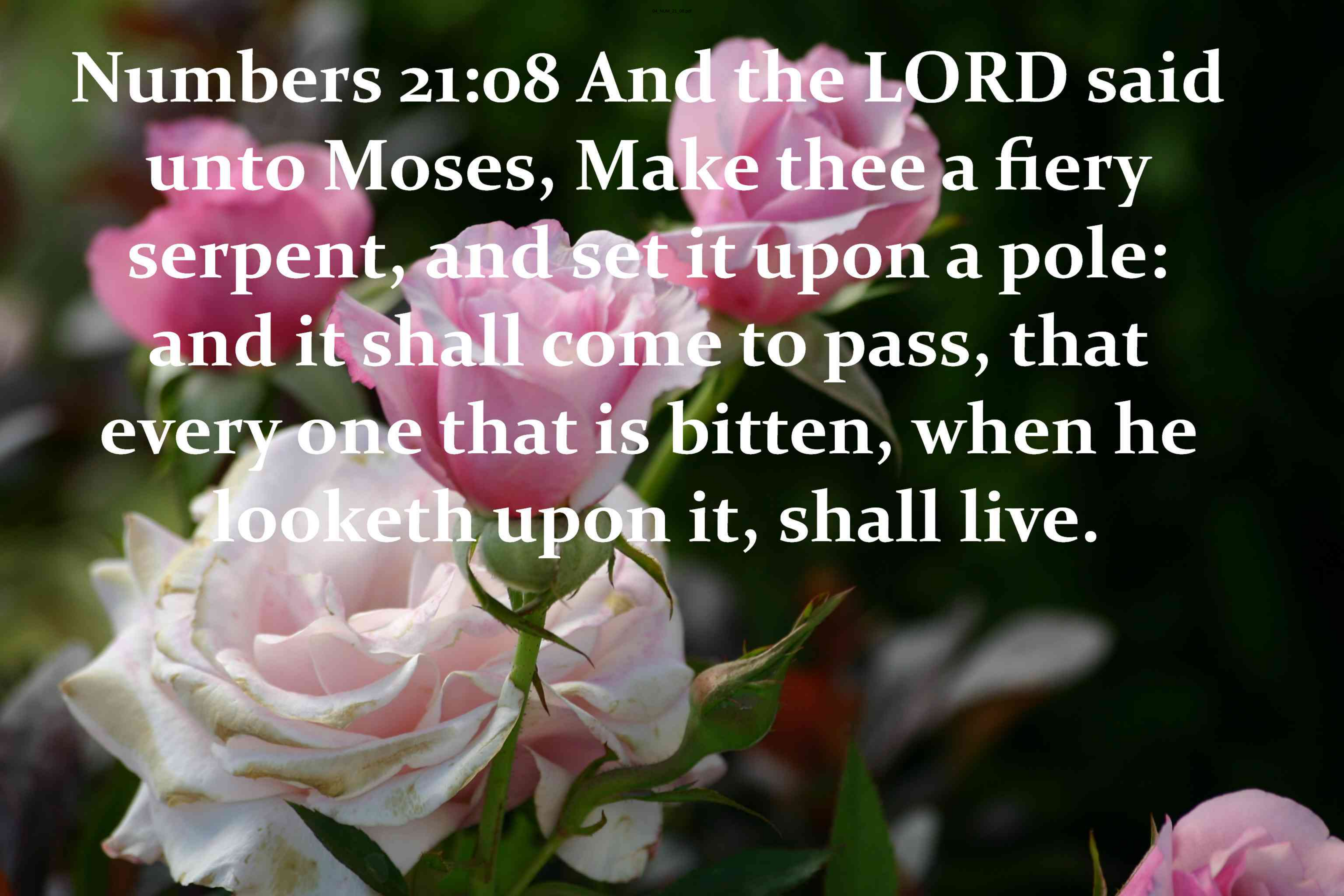
Numbers 21:04 And they journeyed  
from mount Hor by the way of the  
Red sea, to compass the land of  
Edom: and the soul of the people  
was much discouraged because of  
the way.

**Numbers 21:07 Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD, and against thee; pray unto the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us. And Moses prayed for the people.**

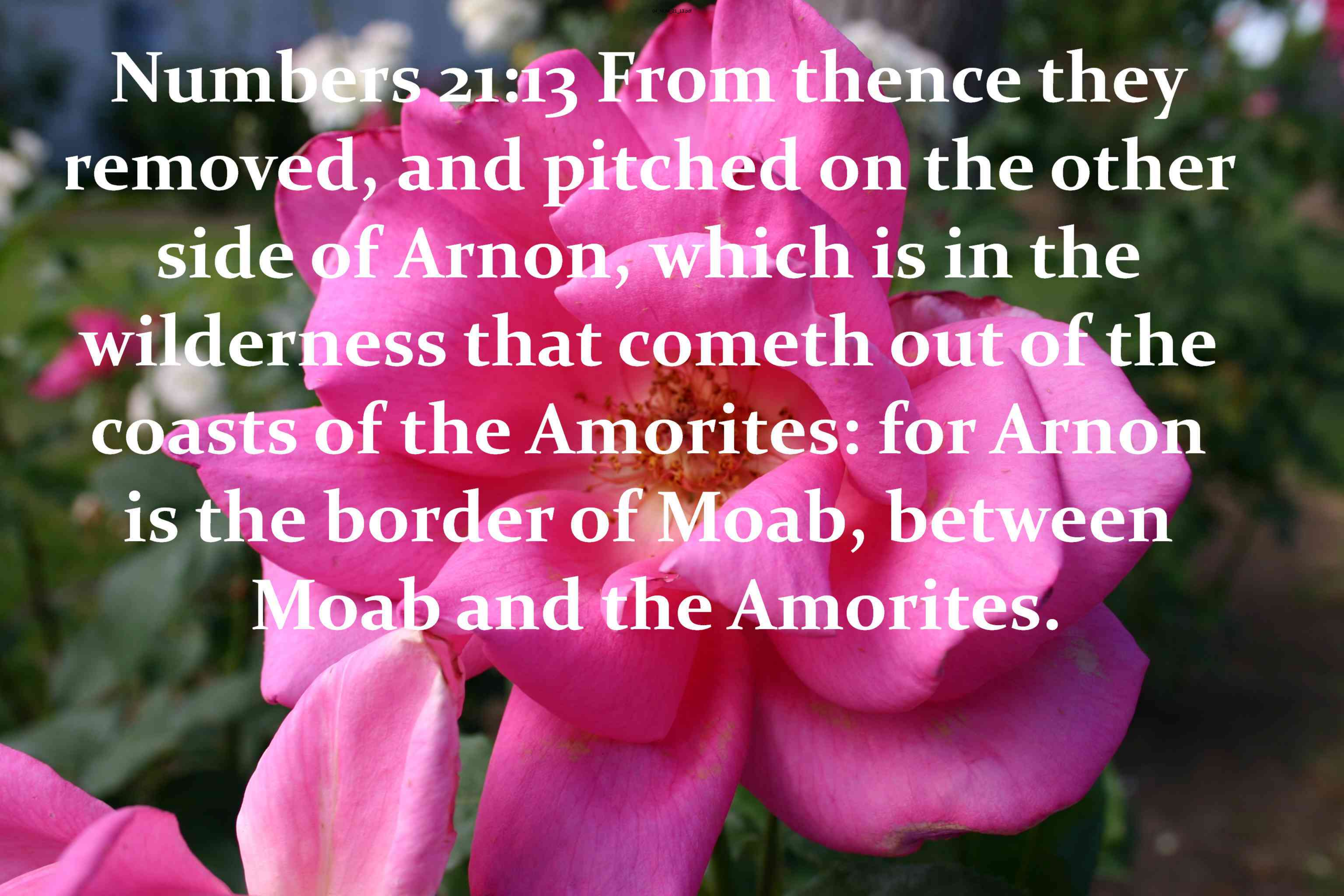
Numbers 21:10 And the children of

Ijeabbarim, in the wilderness which  
is before Moab, toward the  
sunrising.

Numbers 21:12 From thence they  
removed, and pitched in the valley  
of Zared.

**Numbers 21:14 Wherefore it is said  
in the book of the wars of the  
LORD, What he did in the Red sea,  
and in the brooks of Arnon,**

**Numbers 21:15 And at the stream of  
the brooks that goeth down to the  
dwelling of Ar, and lieth upon the  
border of Moab.**

**Numbers 21:16 And from thence  
they went to Beer: that is the well  
whereof the LORD spake unto  
Moses, Gather the people together,  
and I will give them water.**

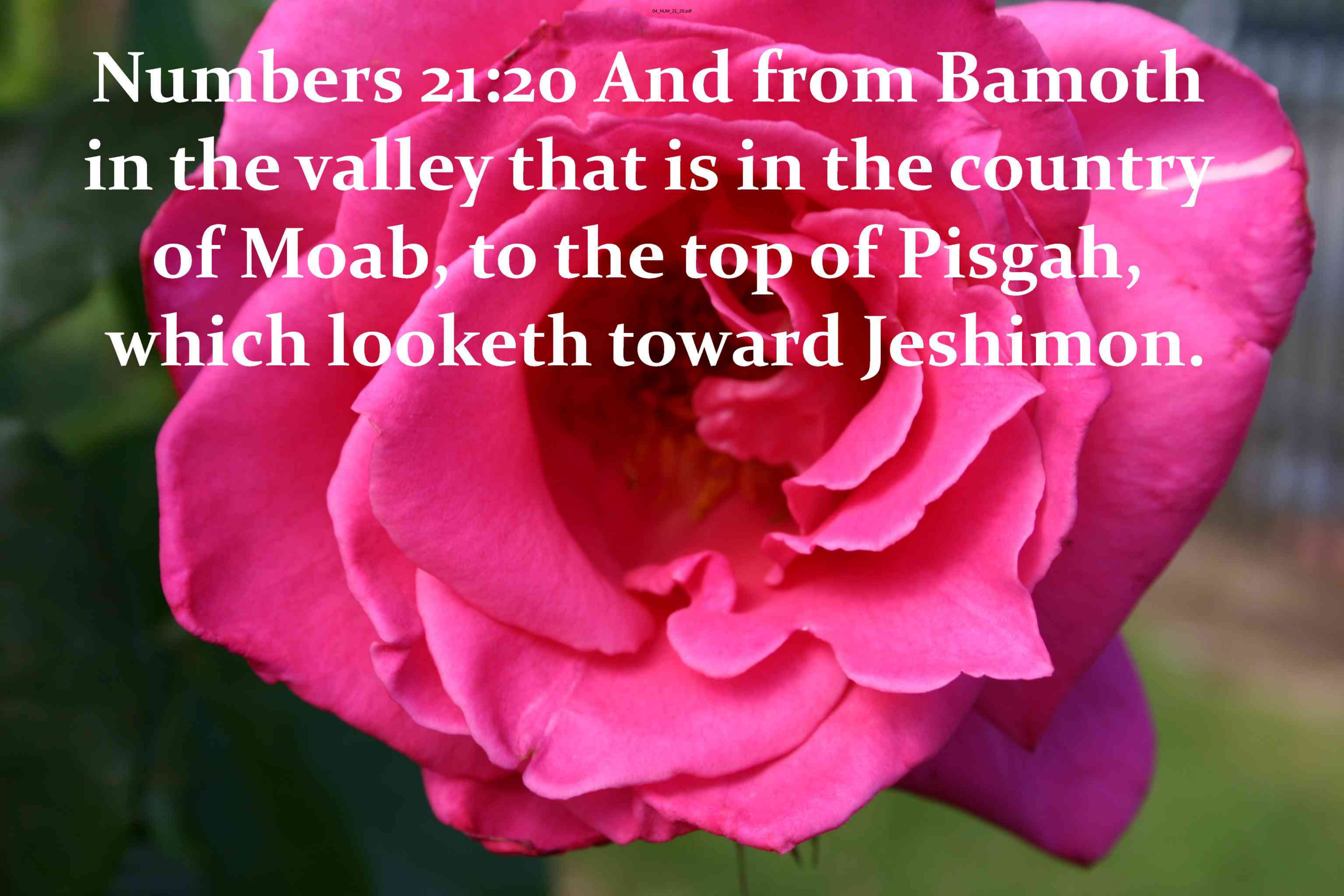
**Numbers 21:17 Then Israel sang  
this song, Spring up, O well; sing  
ye unto it:**

**Numbers 21:18 The princes digged  
the well, the nobles of the people  
digged it, by the direction of the  
lawgiver, with their staves. And  
from the wilderness they went to  
Mattanah:**

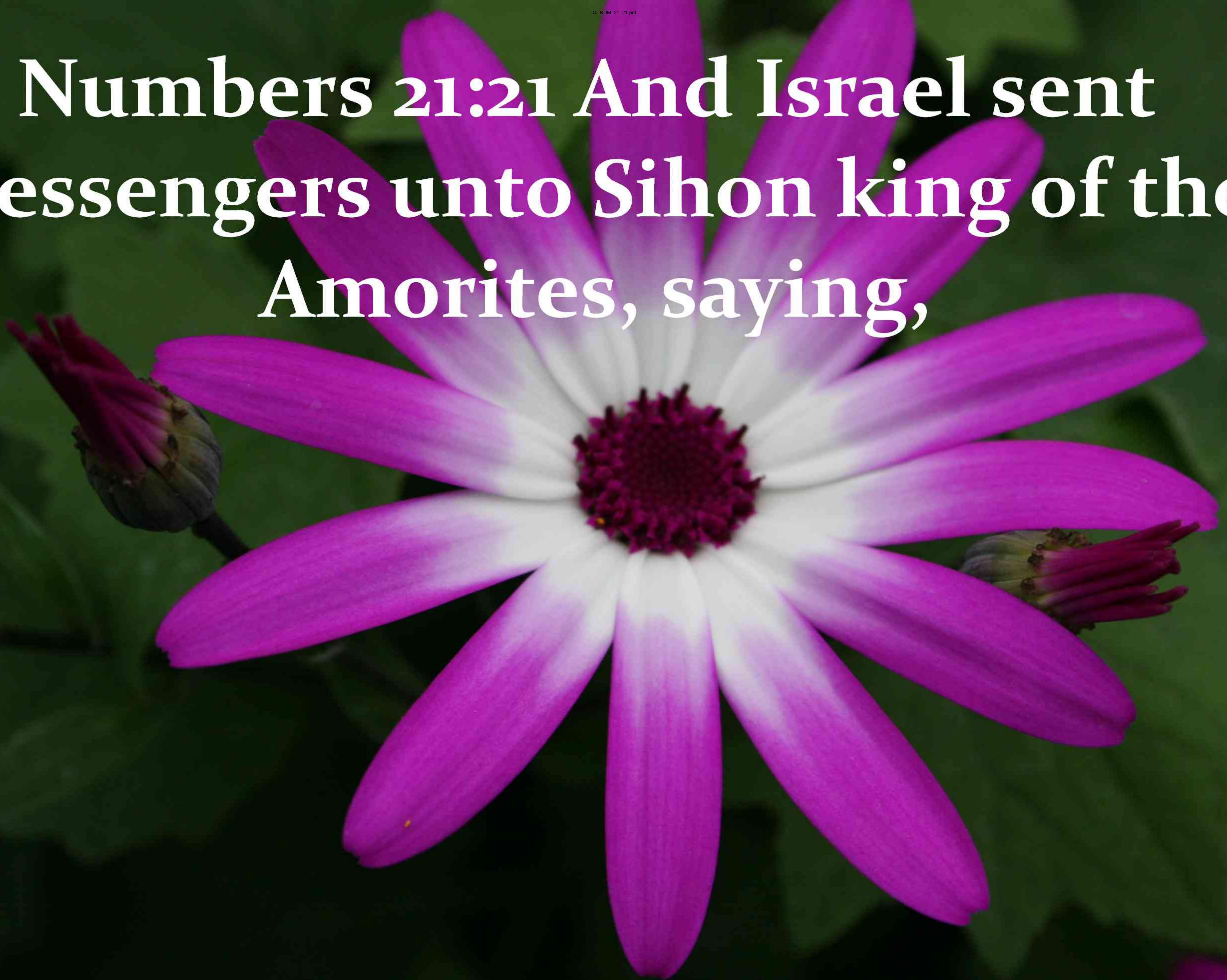
Numbers 21:19 And from Mattanah  
to Nahaliel: and from Nahaliel to  
Bamoth:



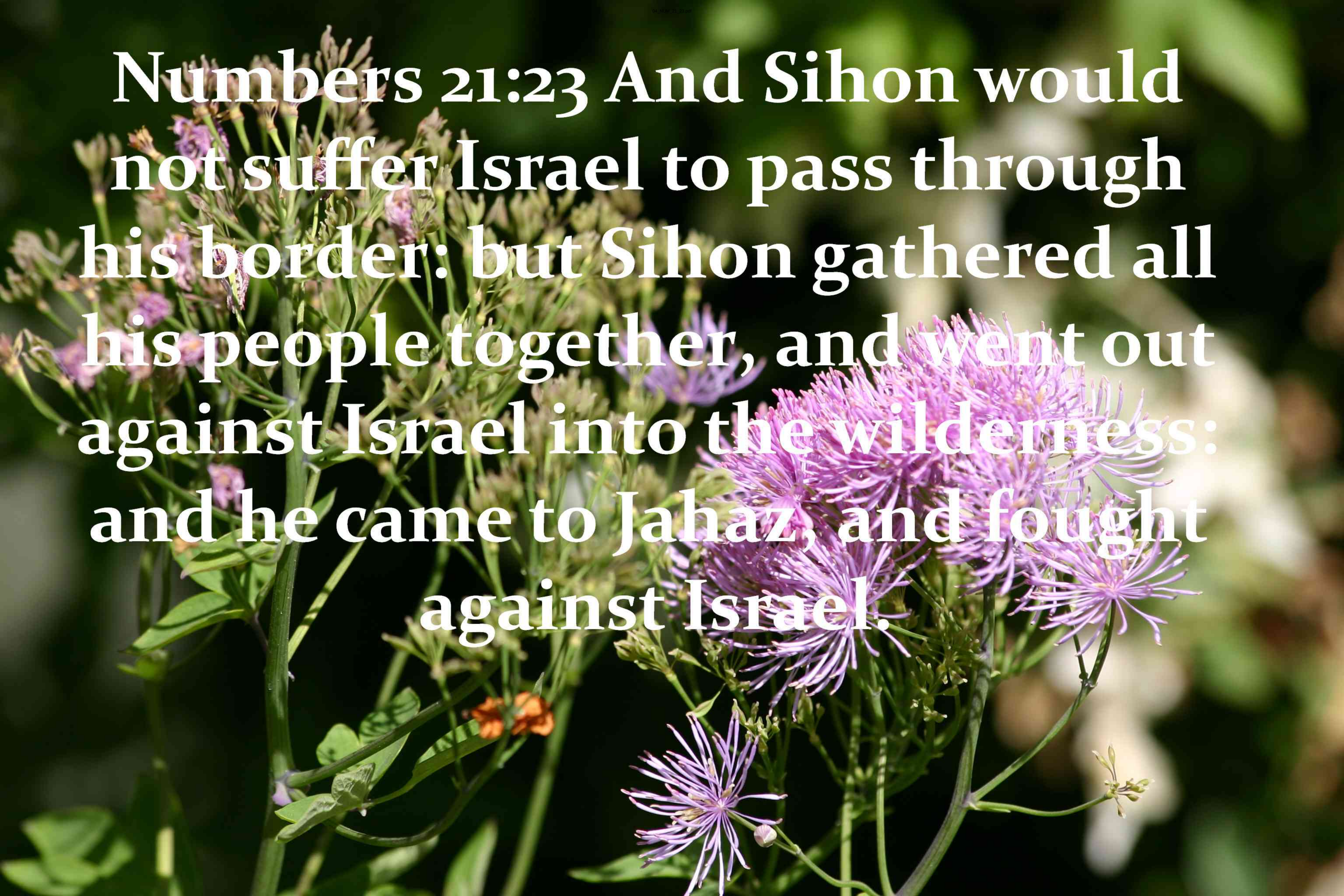
**Numbers 21:20 And from Bamoth  
in the valley that is in the country  
of Moab, to the top of Pisgah,  
which looketh toward Jeshimon.**



Numbers 21:21 And Israel sent  
messengers unto Sihon king of the  
Amorites, saying,



**Numbers 21:22 Let me pass  
through thy land: we will not turn  
into the fields, or into the  
vineyards; we will not drink of the  
waters of the well: but we will go  
along by the king's high way, until  
we be past thy borders.**

Numbers 21:25 And Israel took all these cities: and Israel dwelt in all the cities of the Amorites, in Heshbon, and in all the villages thereof.

speak in proverbs say, Come into  
Heshbon, let the city of Sihon be  
built and prepared:

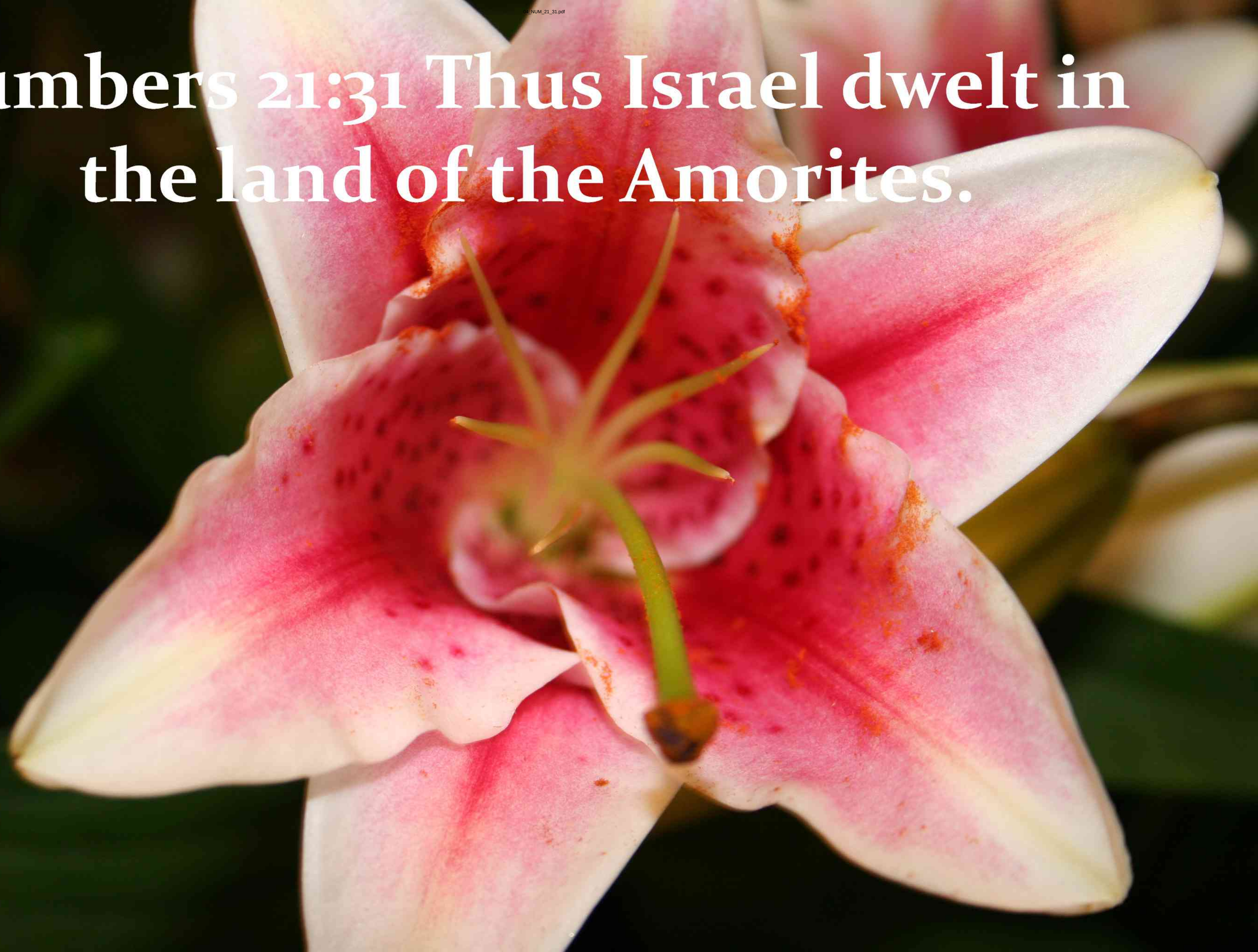
Numbers 21:28 For there is a fire  
gone out of Heshbon, a flame from  
the city of Sihon: it hath consumed  
Ar of Moab, and the lords of the  
high places of Arnon.

**Numbers 21:29 Woe to thee, Moab!  
thou art undone, O people of  
Chemosh: he hath given his sons  
that escaped, and his daughters,  
into captivity unto Sihon king of  
the Amorites.**

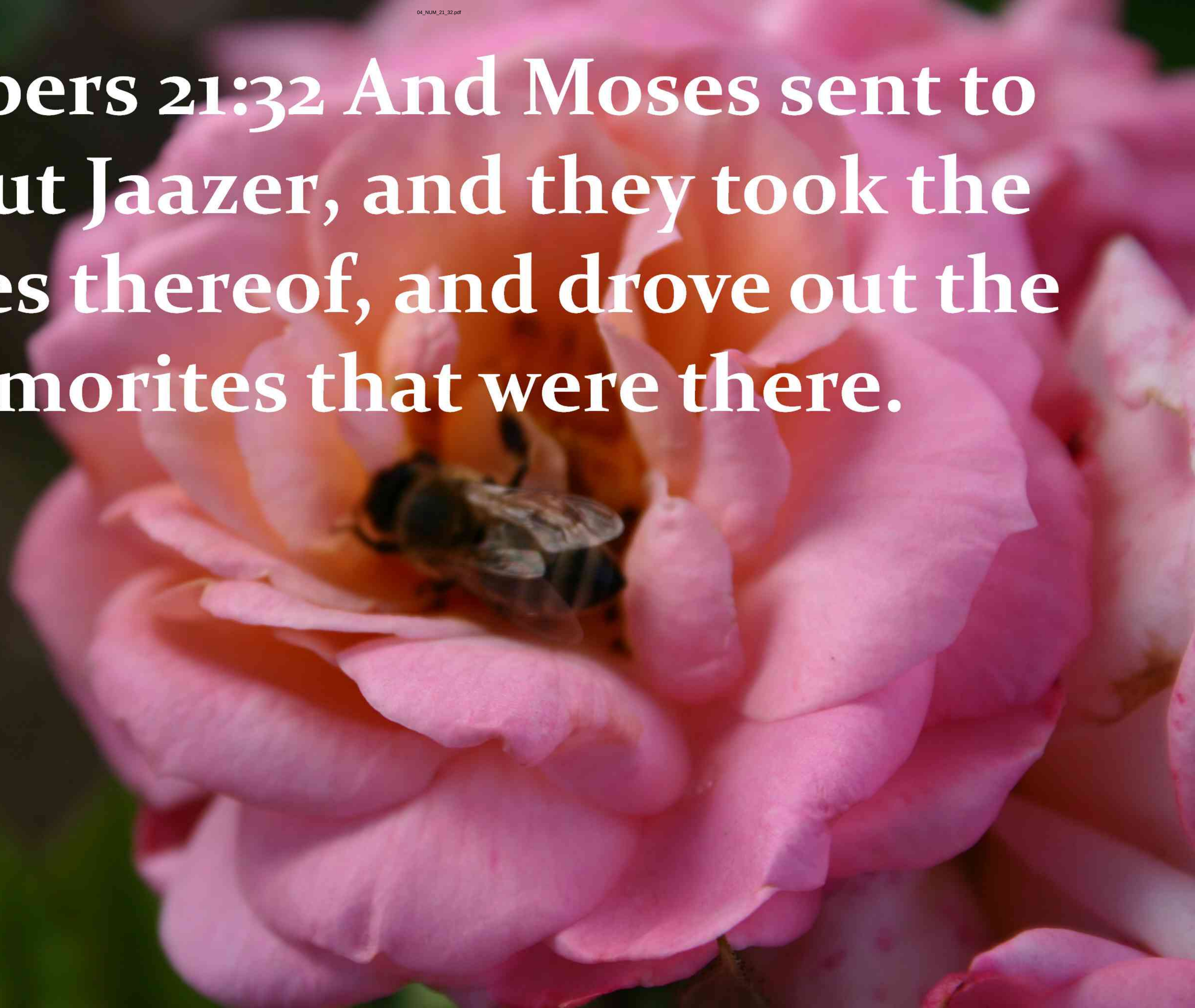
Numbers 21:30 We have shot at  
them; Heshbon is perished even  
unto Dibon, and we have laid them  
waste even unto Nophah, which  
reacheth unto Medeba.



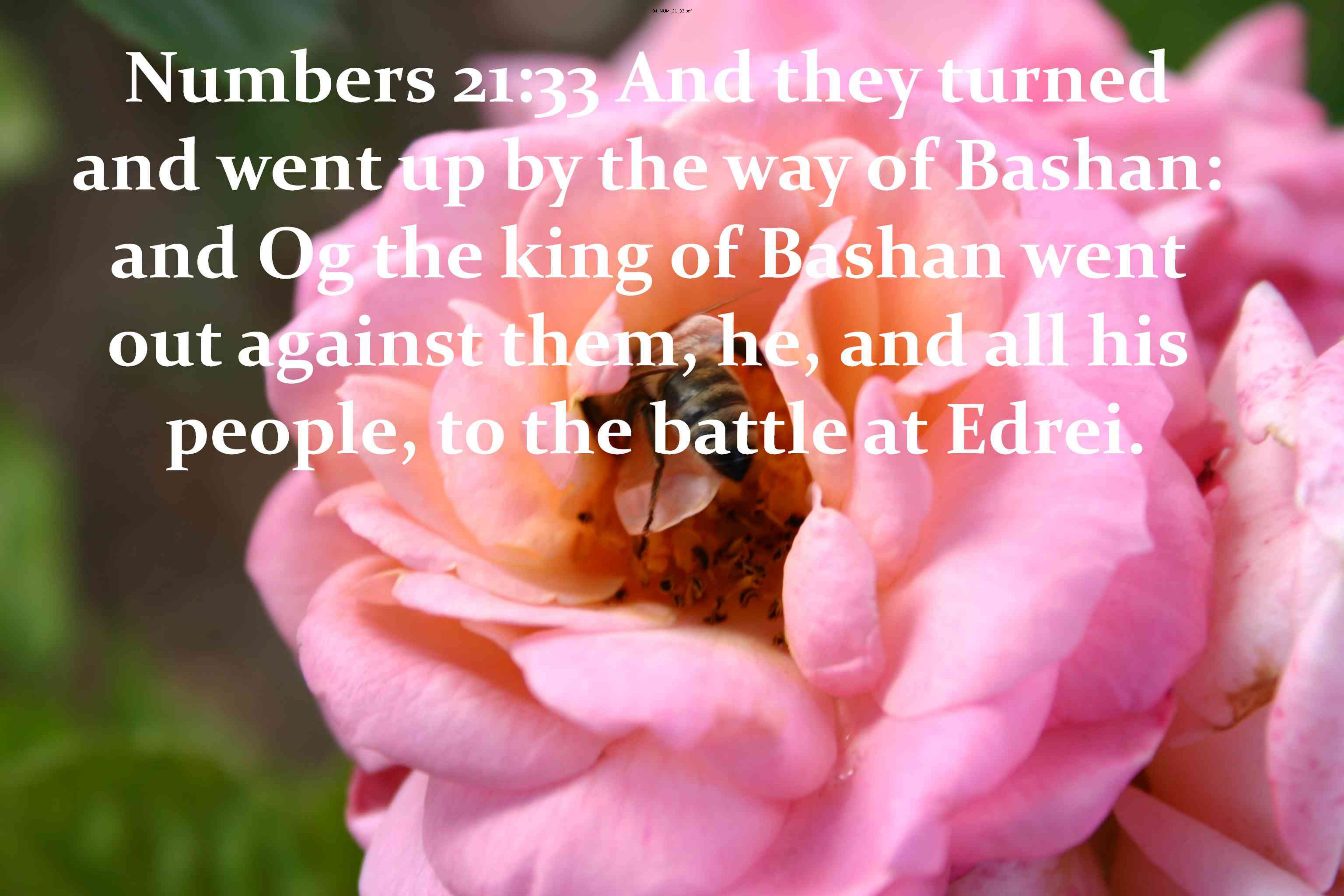
**Numbers 21:31 Thus Israel dwelt in  
the land of the Amorites.**



**Numbers 21:32 And Moses sent to  
spy out Jaazer, and they took the  
villages thereof, and drove out the  
Amorites that were there.**



**Numbers 21:33 And they turned  
and went up by the way of Bashan:  
and Og the king of Bashan went  
out against them, he, and all his  
people, to the battle at Edrei.**



**Numbers 21:34 And the LORD said  
unto Moses, Fear him not: for I  
have delivered him into thy hand,  
and all his people, and his land;  
and thou shalt do to him as thou  
didst unto Sihon king of the  
Amorites, which dwelt at Heshbon.**

Numbers 21:35 So they smote him,  
and his sons, and all his people,  
until there was none left him alive:  
and they possessed his land.
