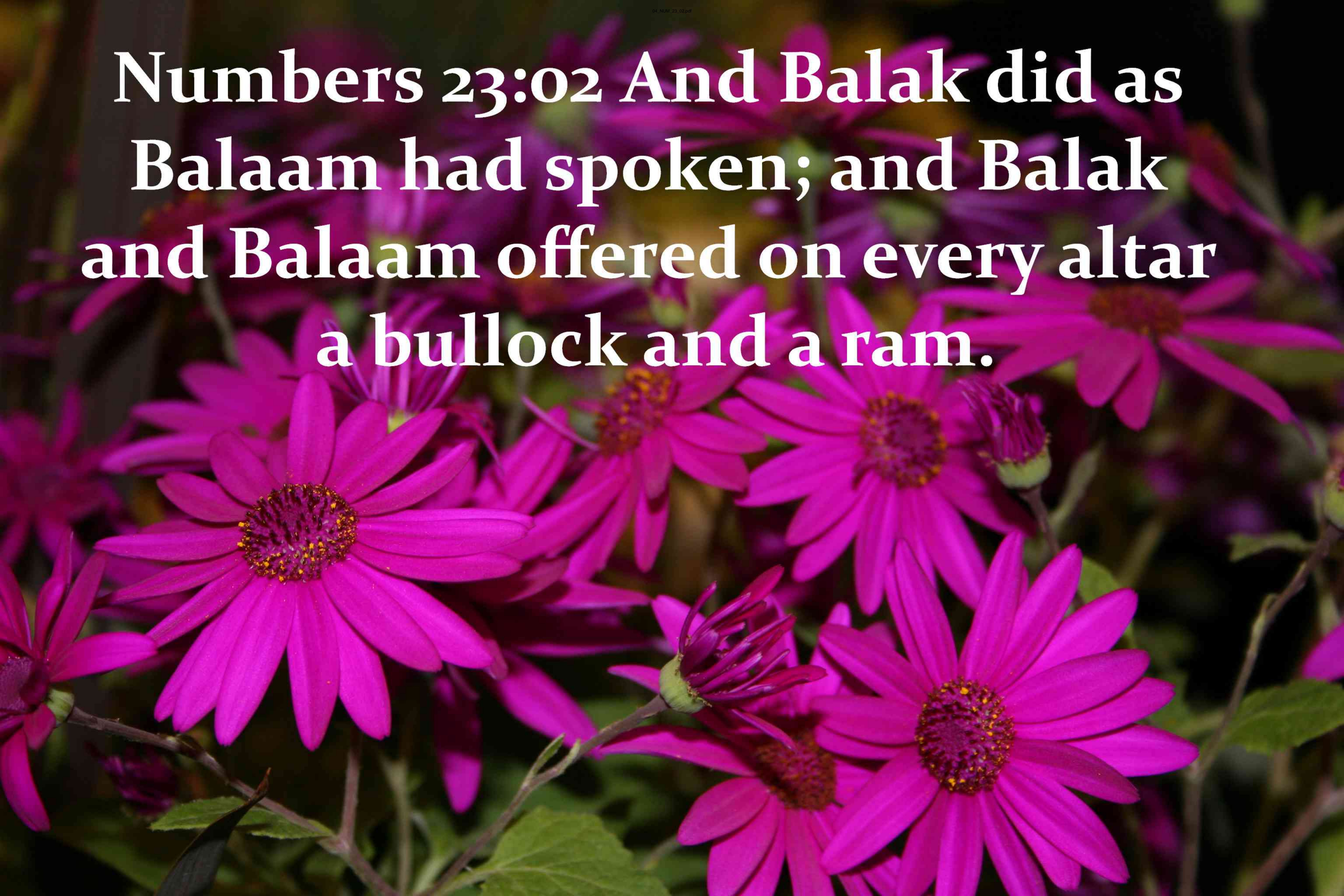



**Numbers 23:01 And Balaam said


Numbers 23:03 And Balaam said




Numbers 23:07 And he took up his

hath not defied?






Numbers 23:09 For from the top of



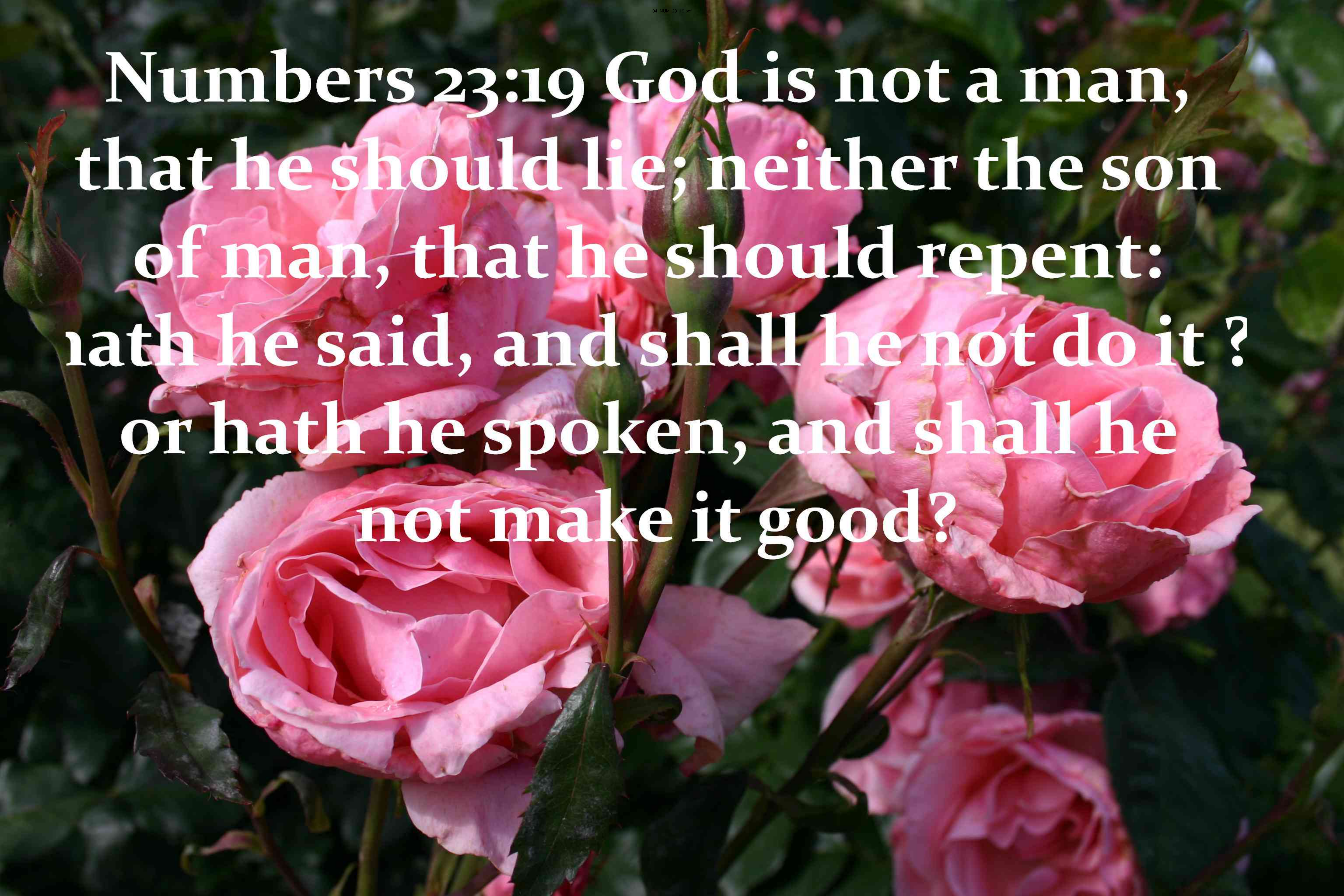

son of Zippor:



not make it good?

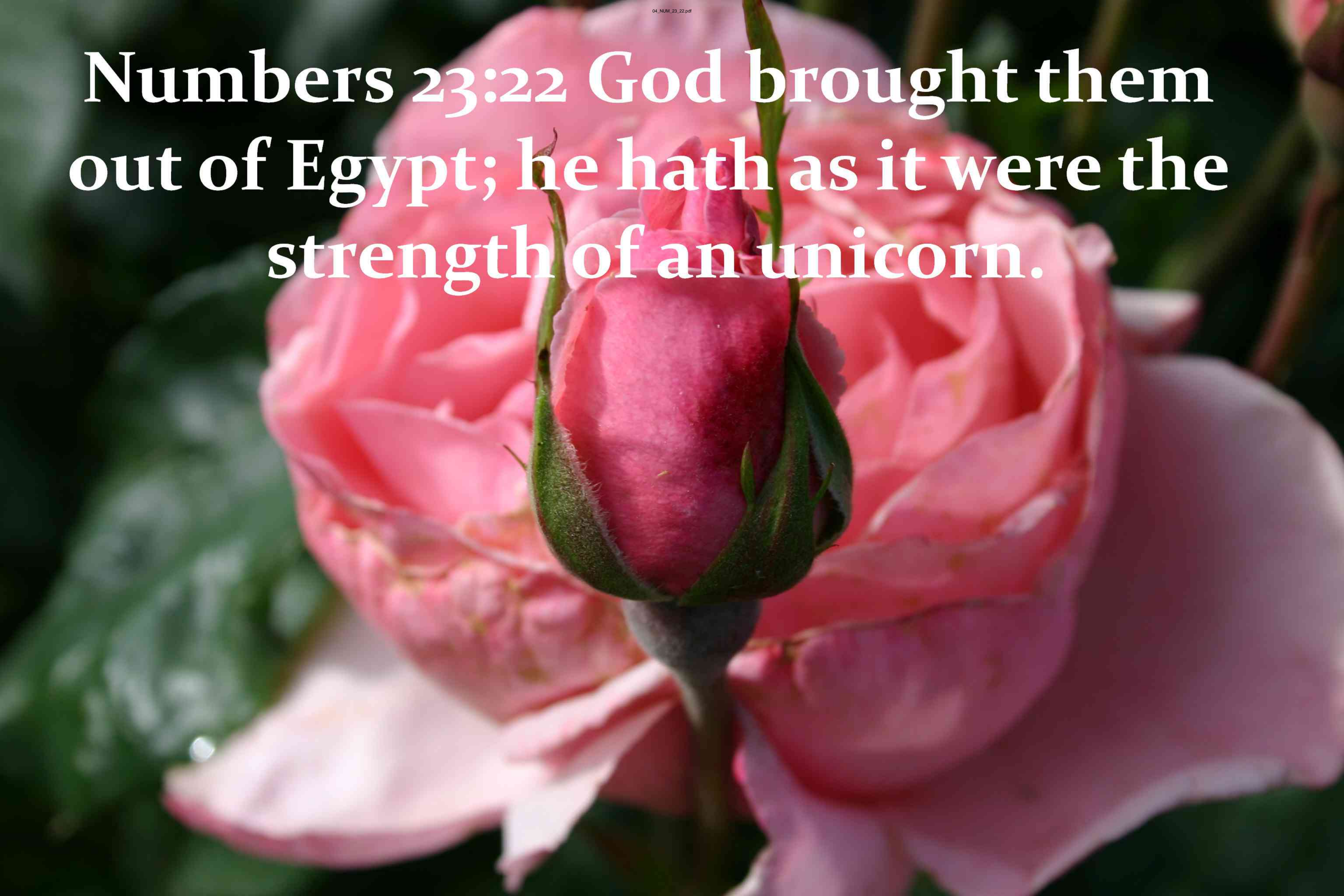
Numbers 23:20 Behold, I have




Numbers 23:21 He hath not beheld

strength of an unicorn.**



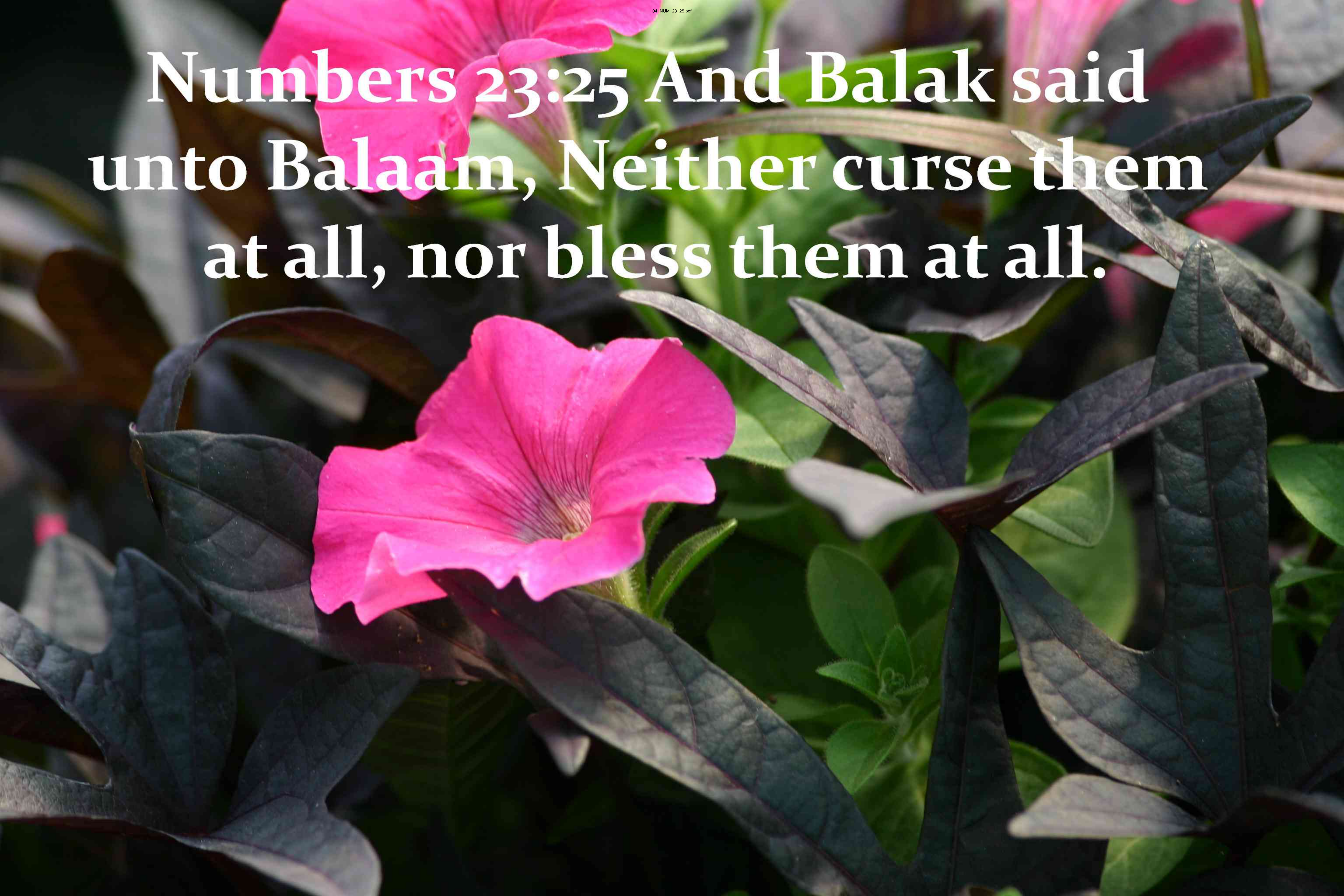
**Numbers 23:23 Surely there is no

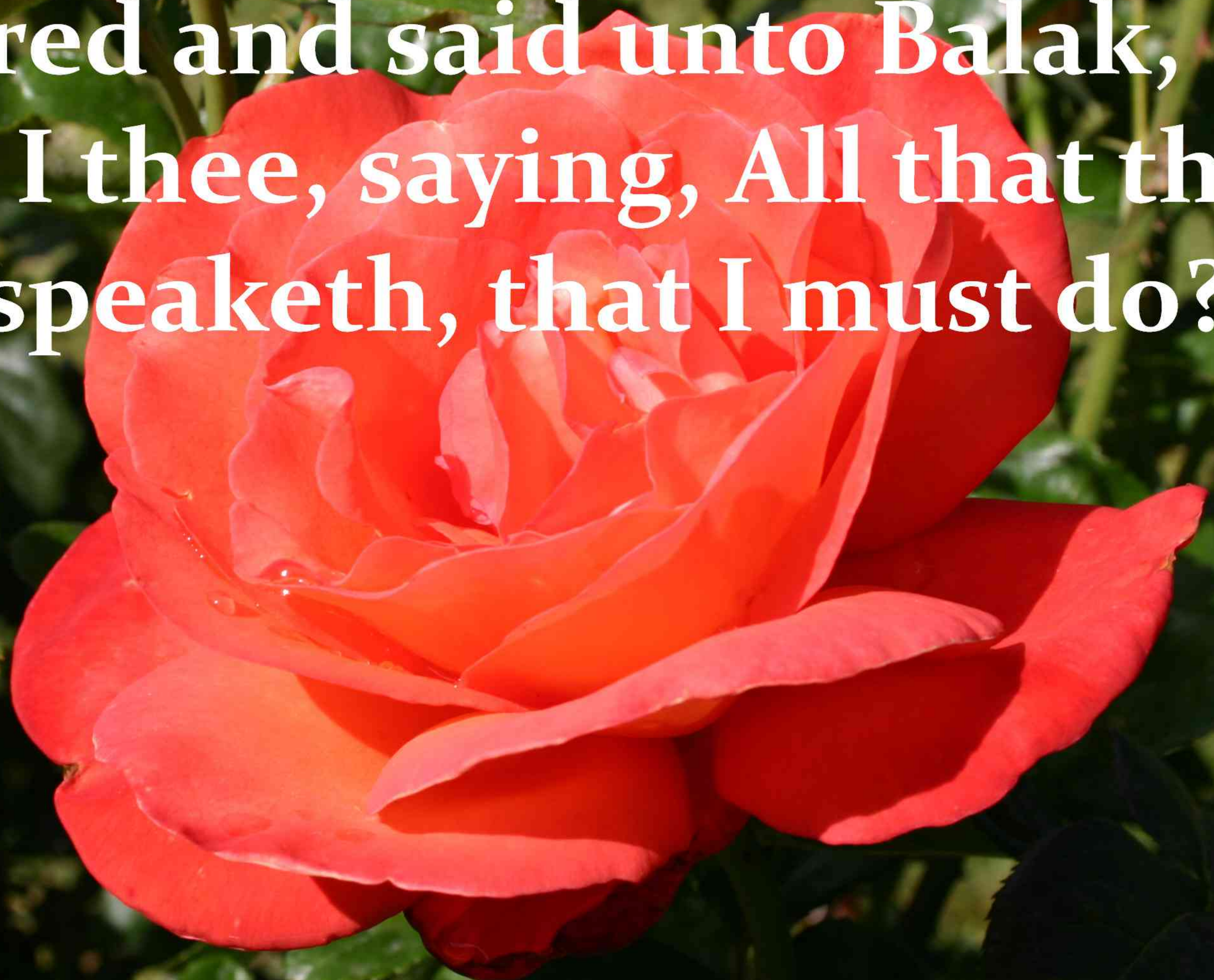

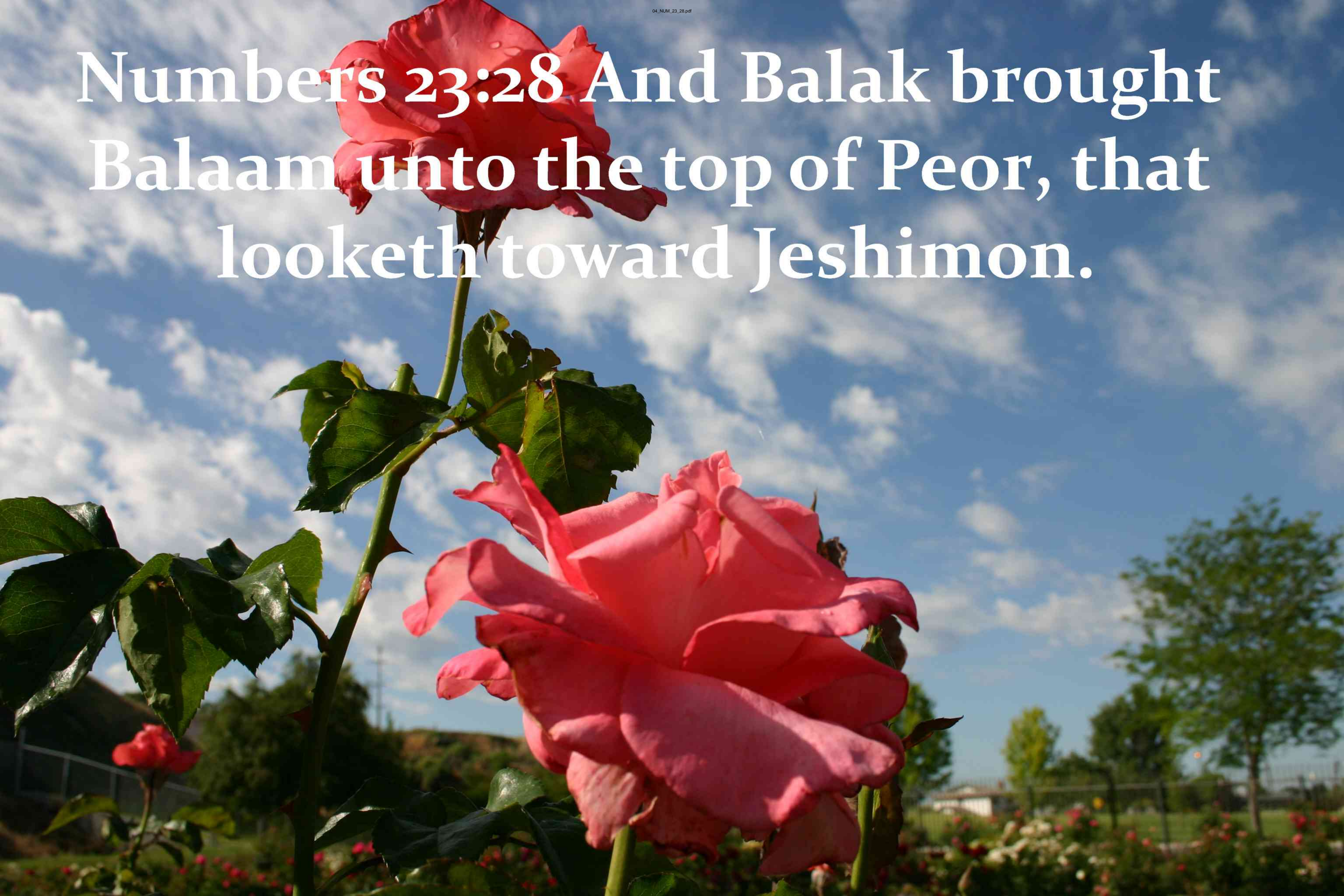
