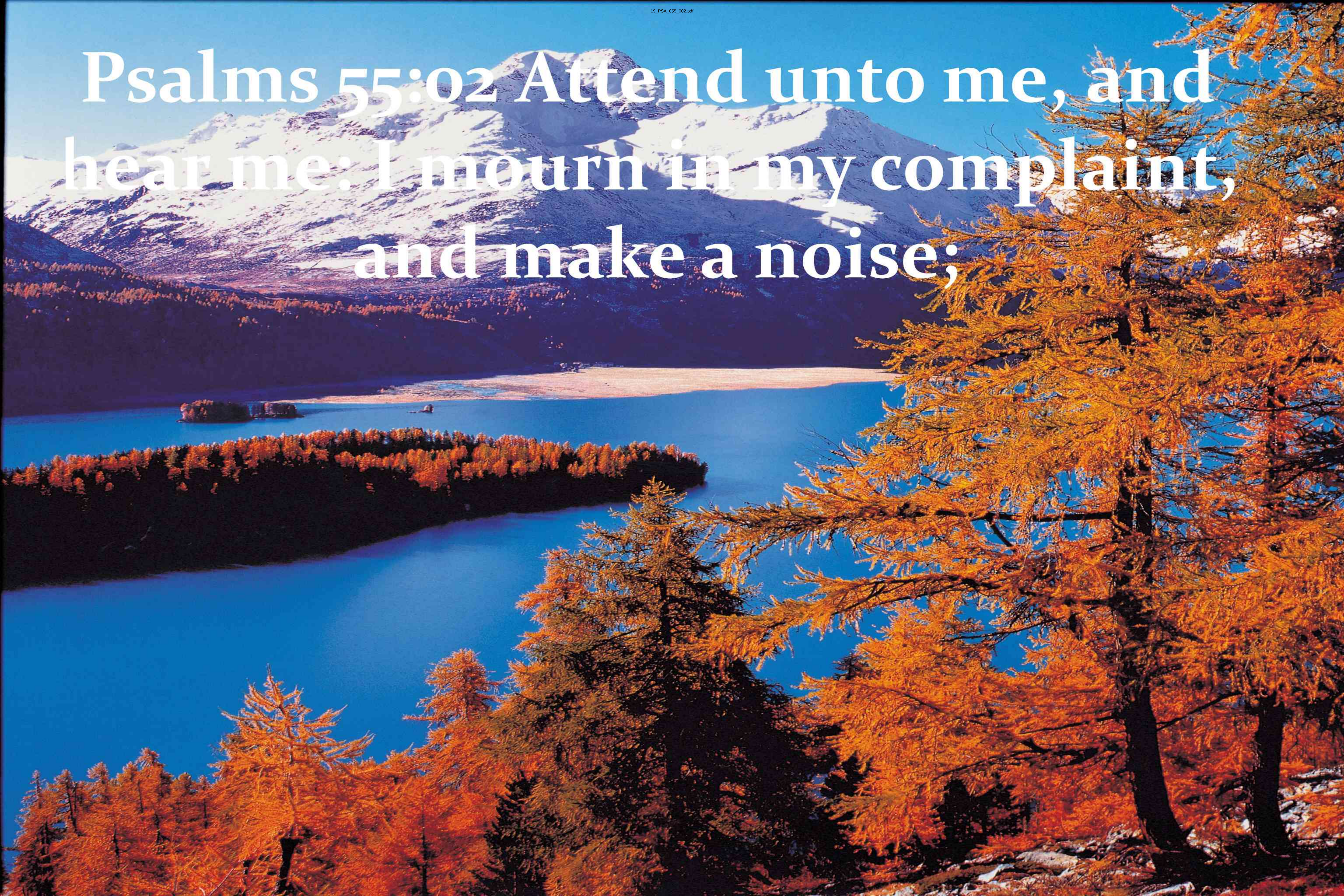
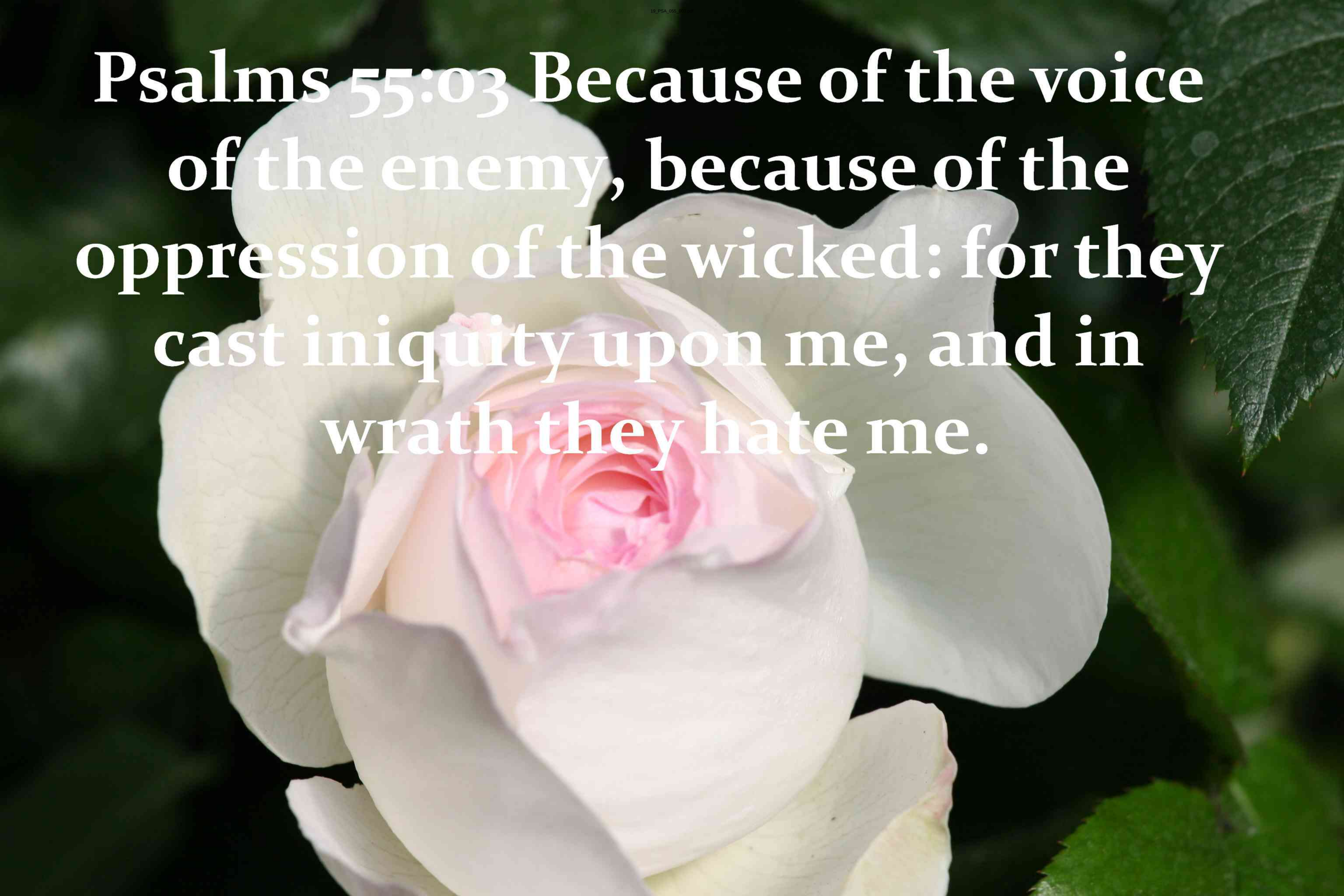


**Psalms 55:01 To the chief Musician

supplication.**

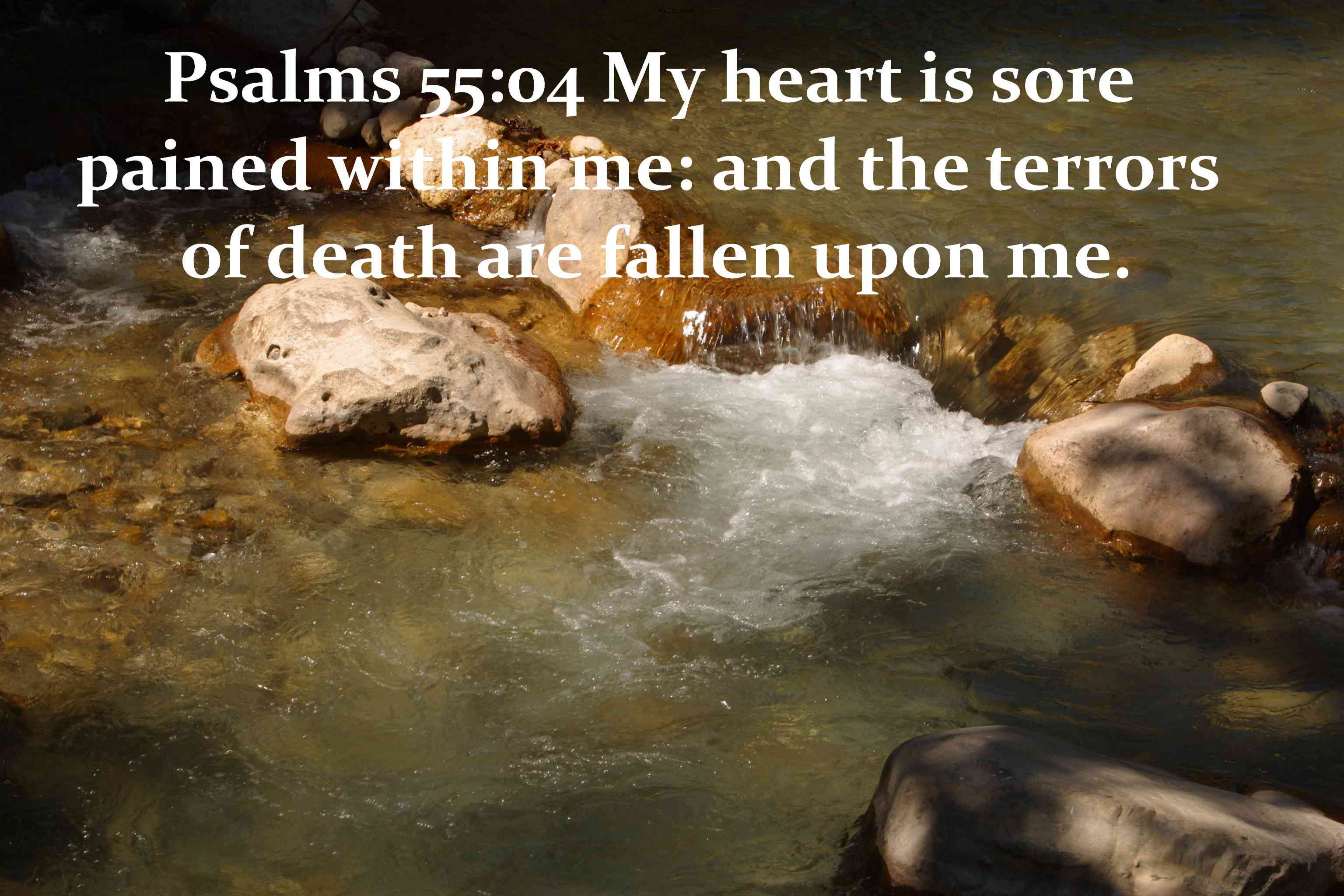


Psalms 55:02 Attend unto me, and

would I fly away, and be at rest.**

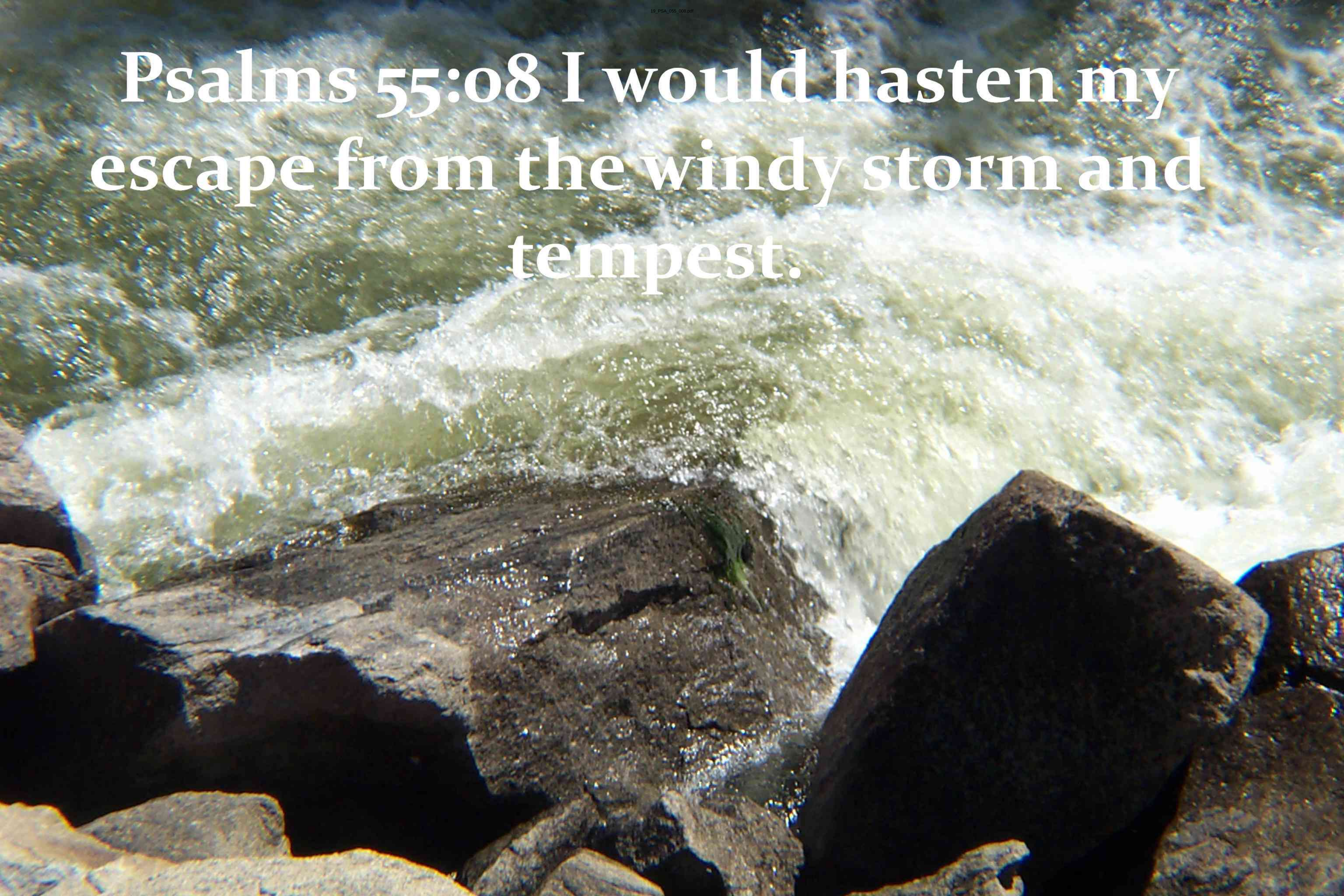


**Psalms 55:07 Lo, then would I

tempest.

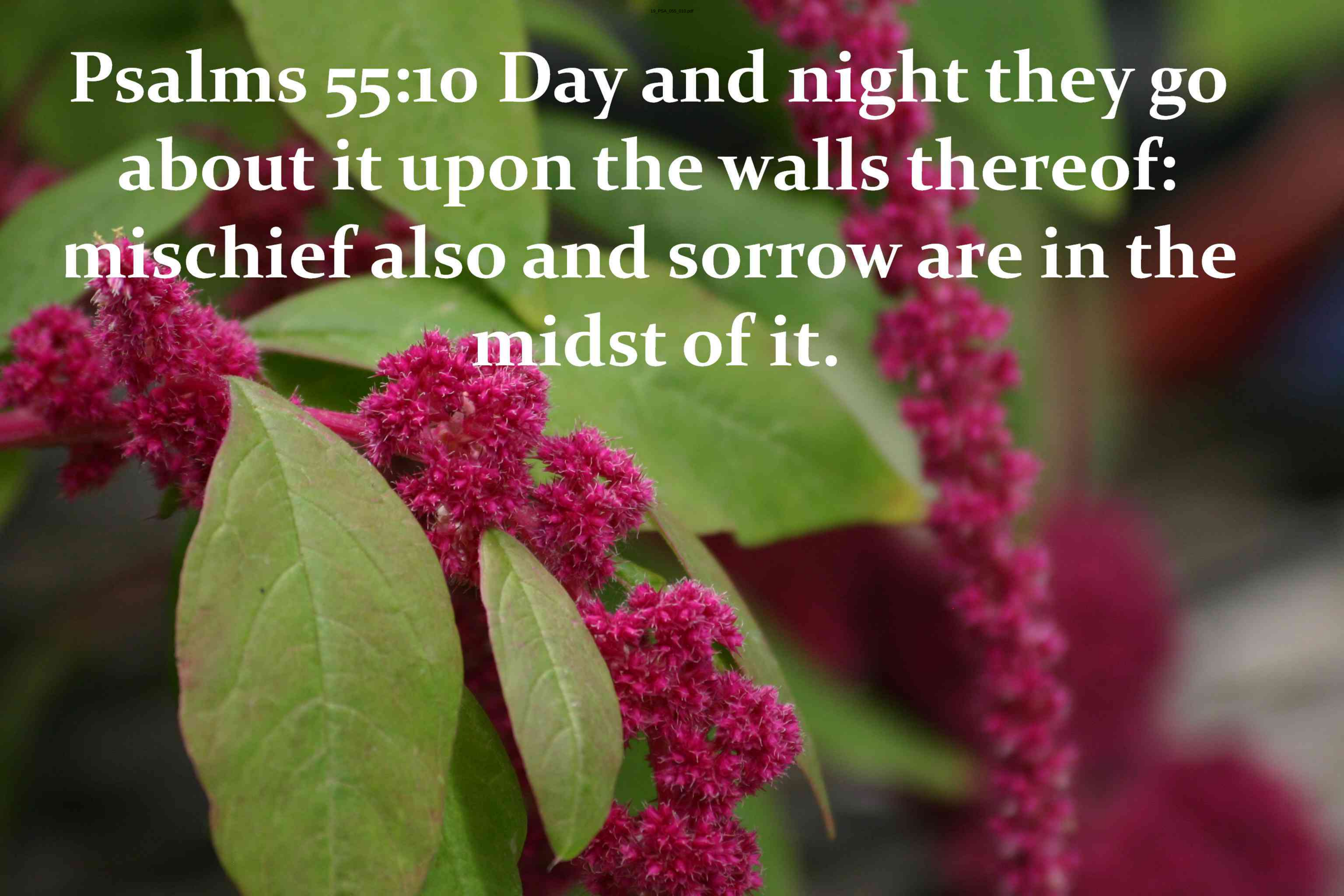


**Psalm 55:09 Destroy, O Lord, and

midst of it.**



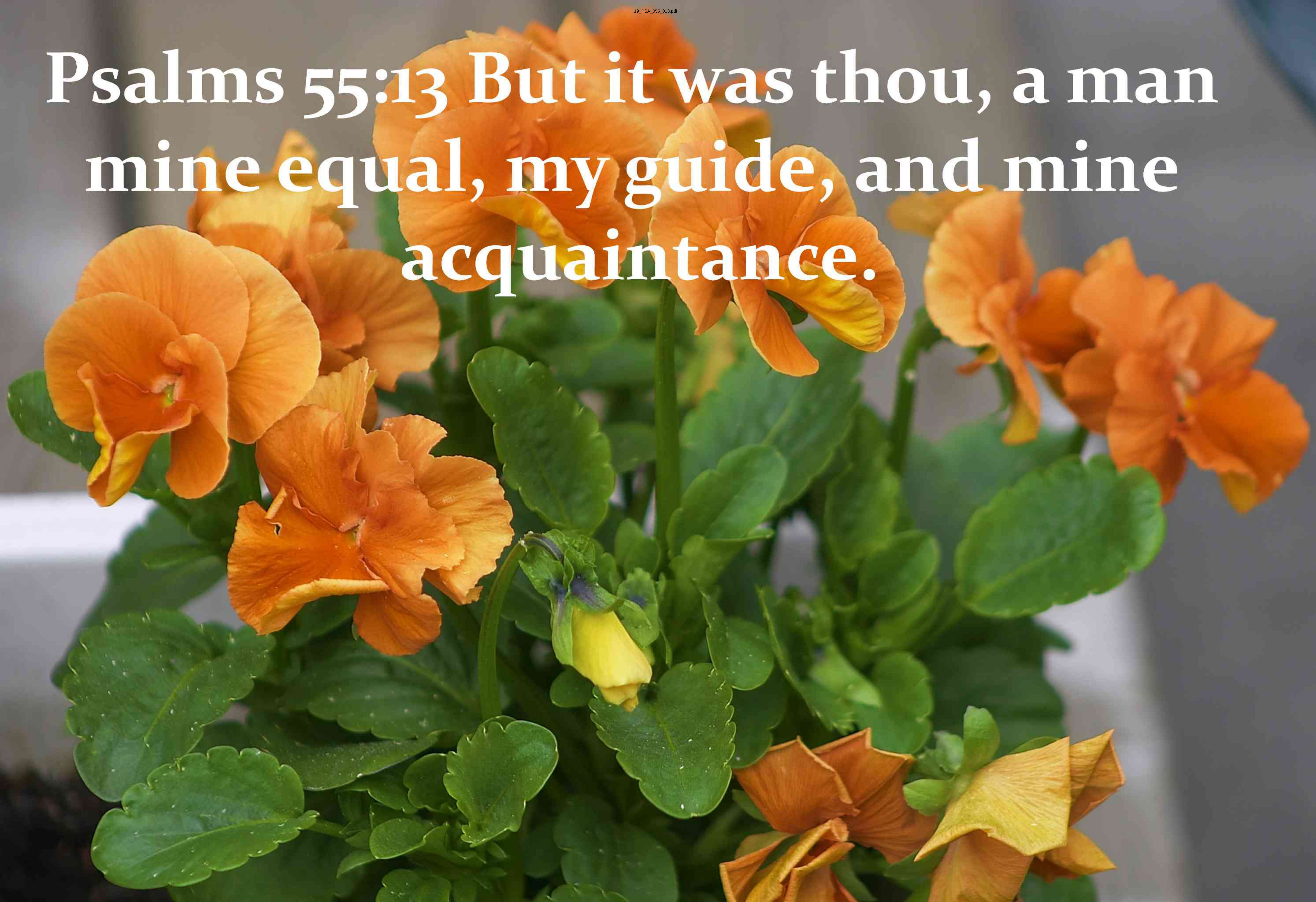
**Psalms 55:11 Wickedness is in the

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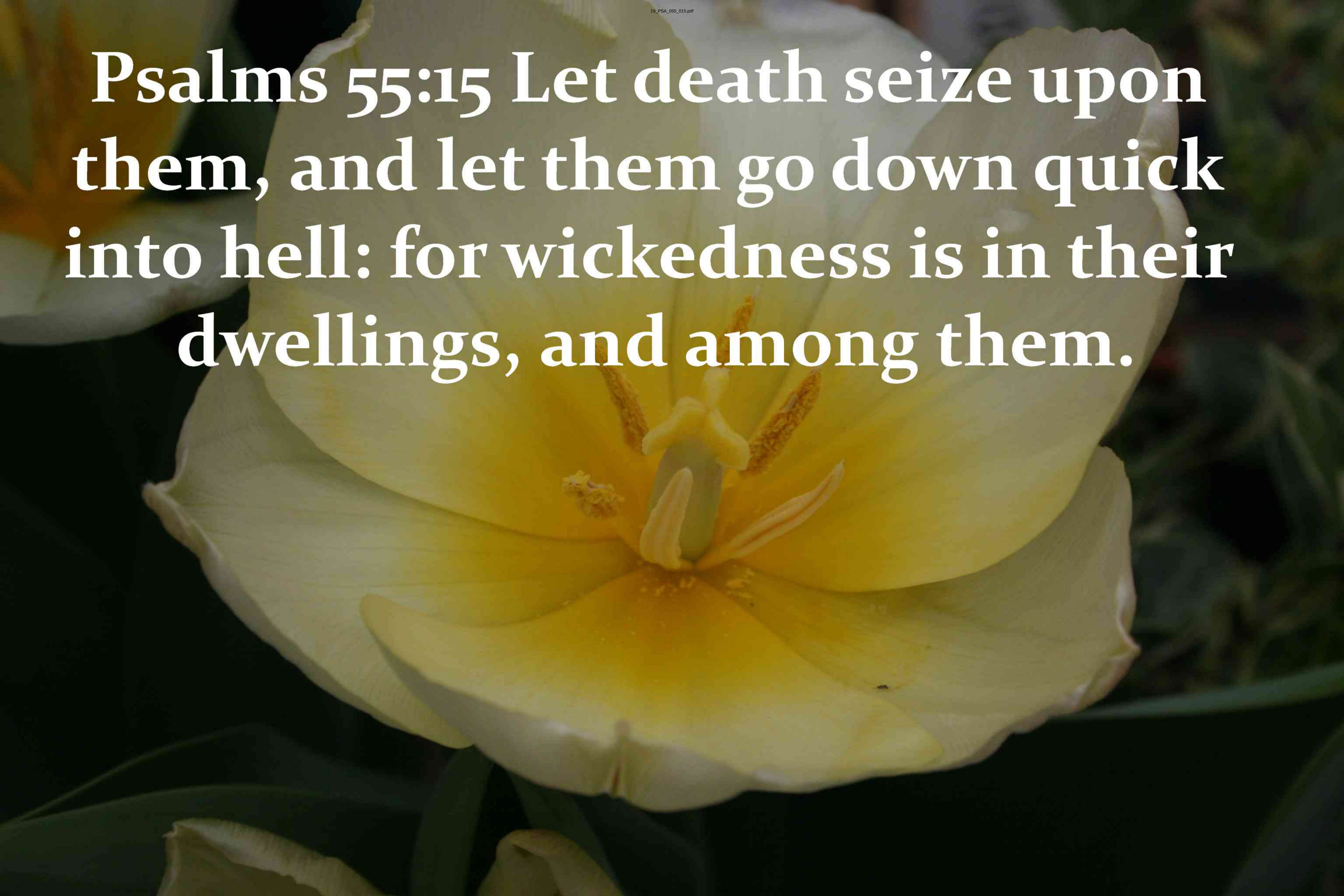
Psalms 55:13 But it was thou, a man

dwellings, and among them.**

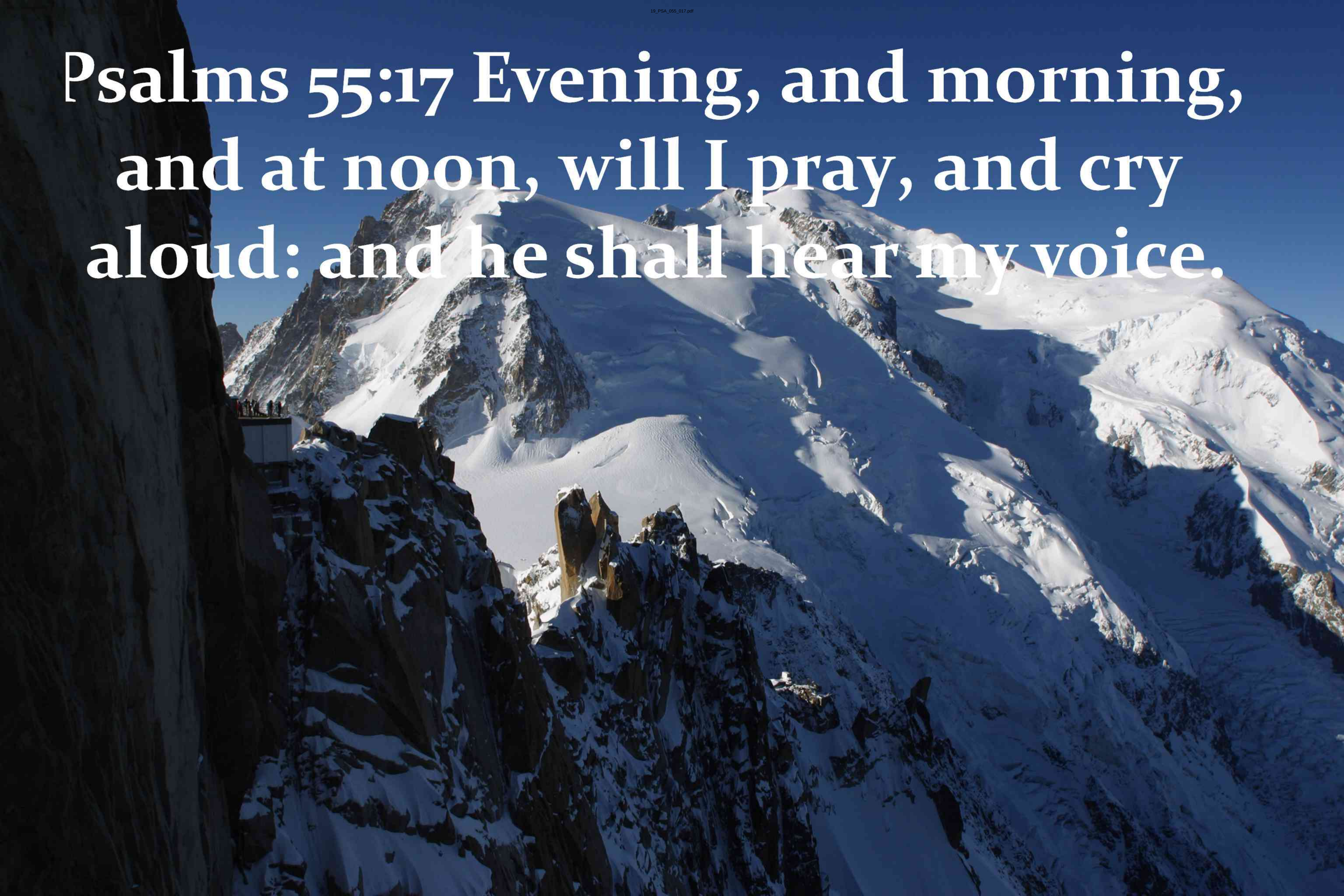


Psalm 55:16 As for me, I will call

save me.

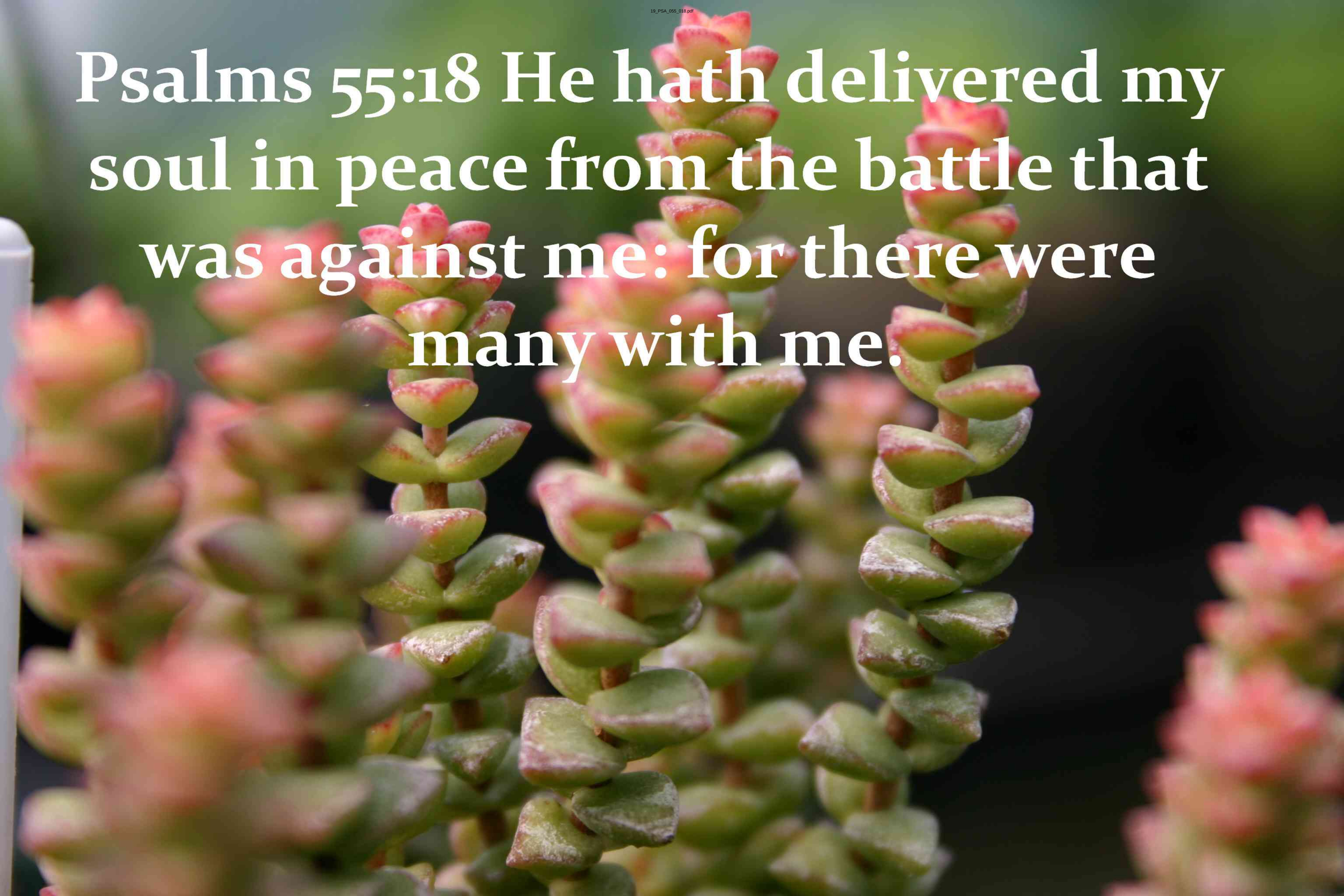


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Psalms 55:17 Evening, and morning,

aloud: and he shall hear my voice.

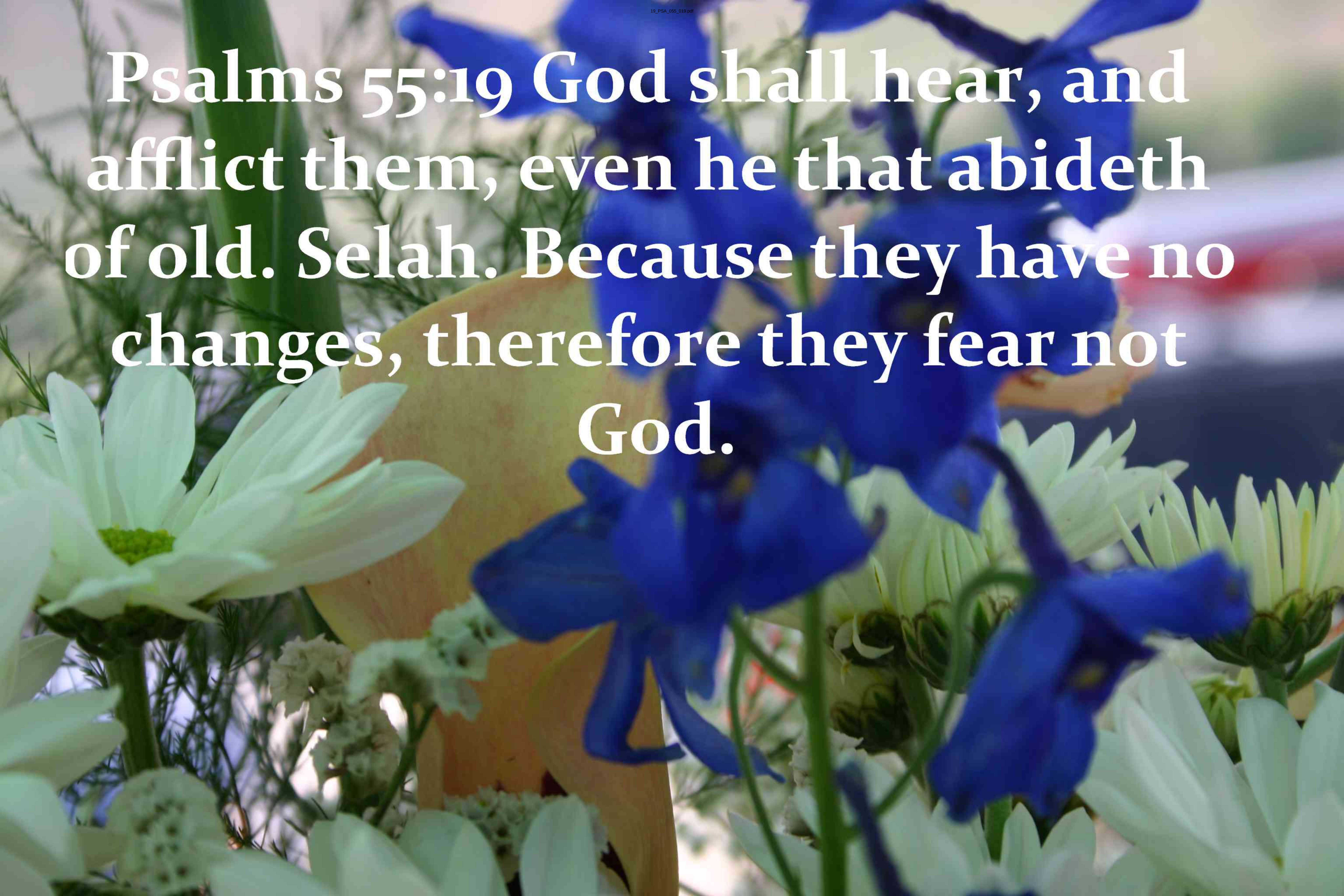


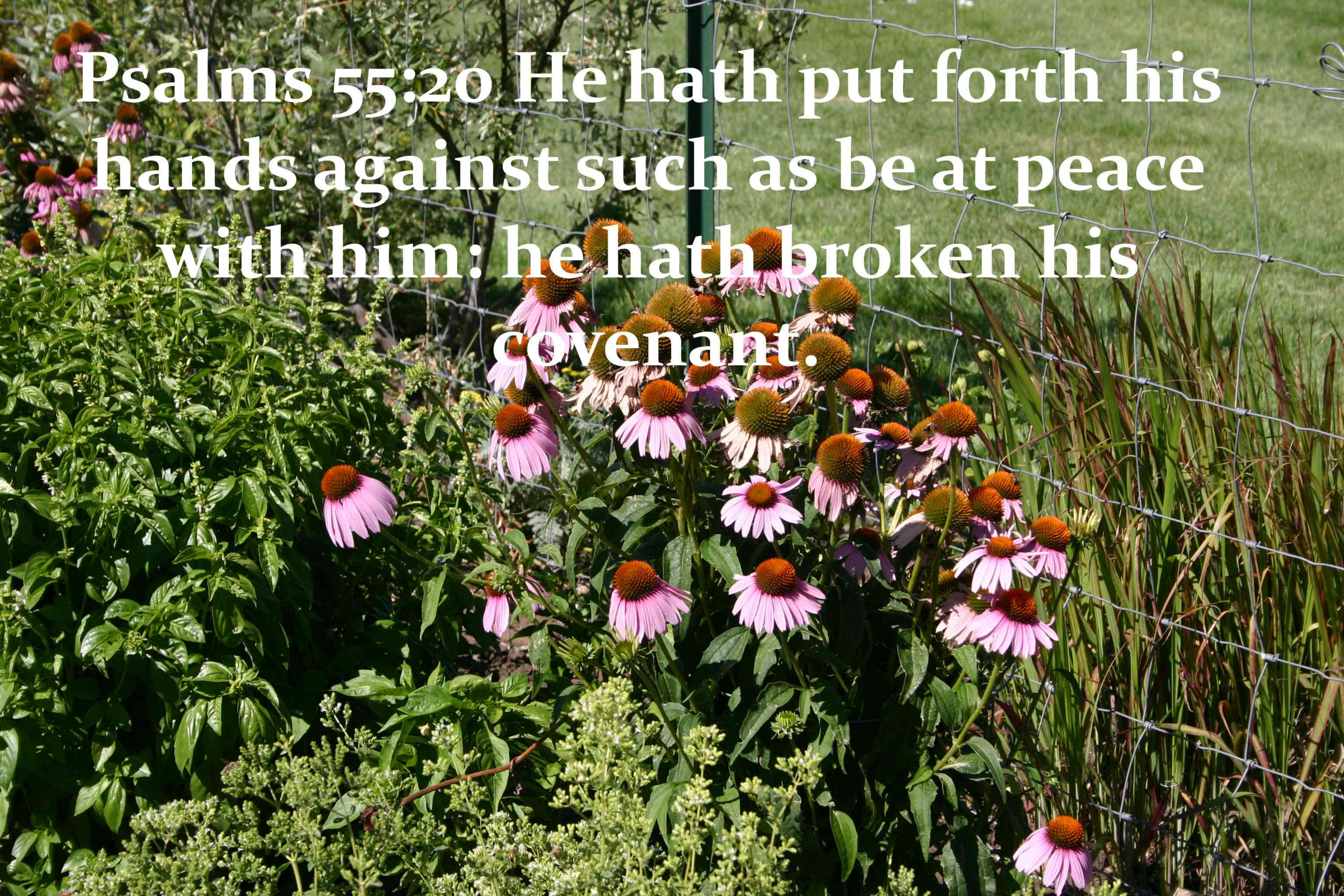
Psalms 55:18 He hath delivered my

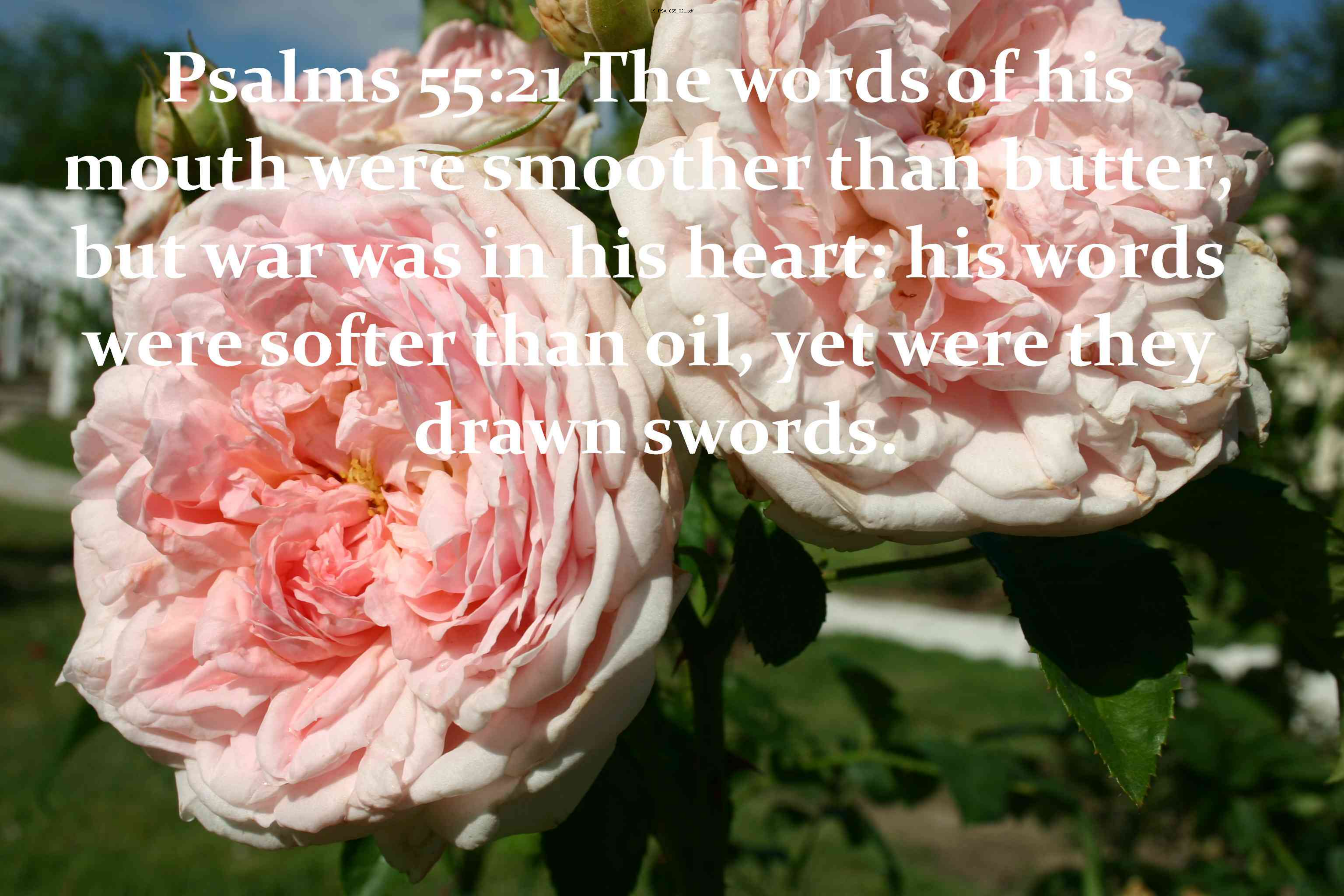
**Psalms 55:19 God shall hear, and
