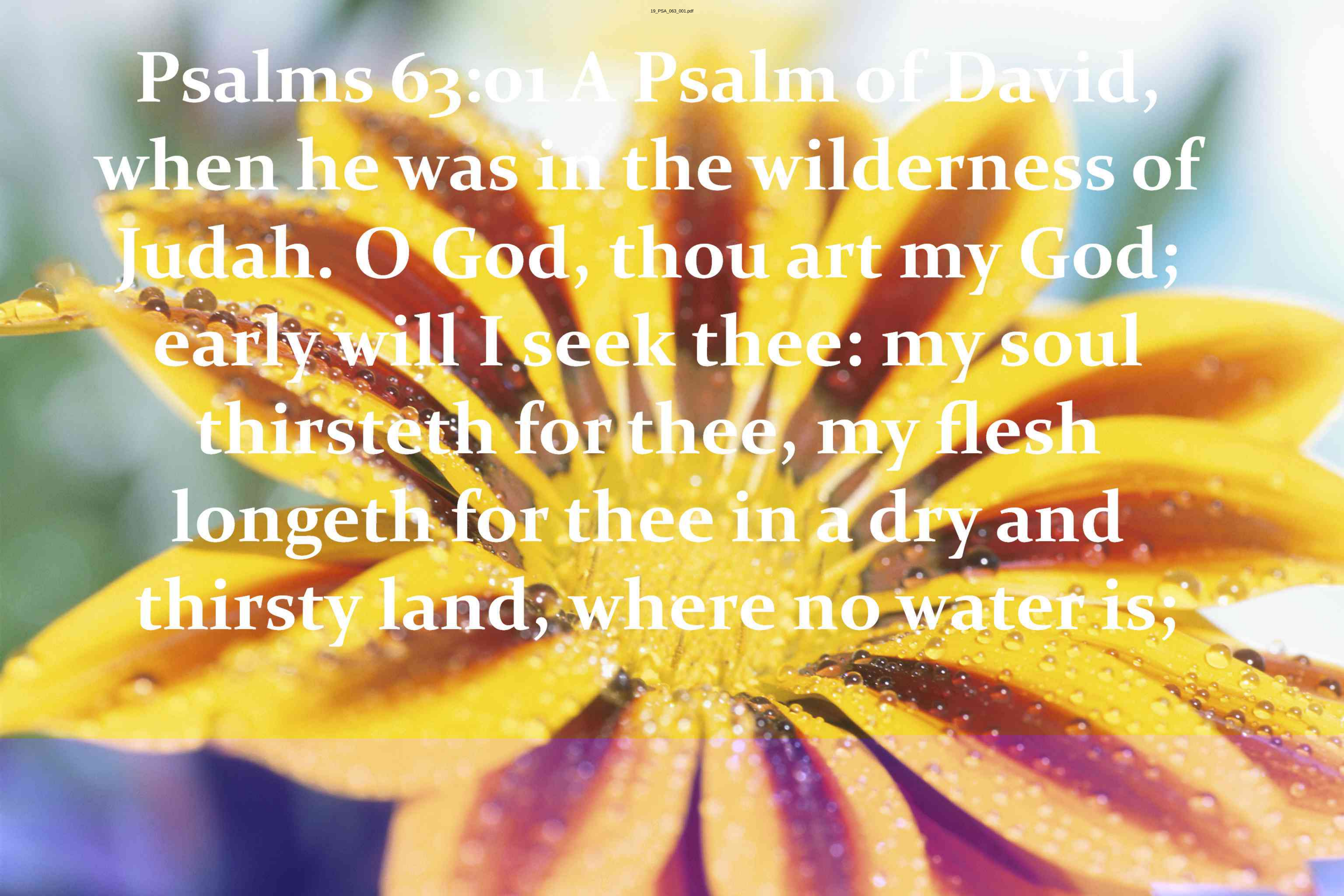
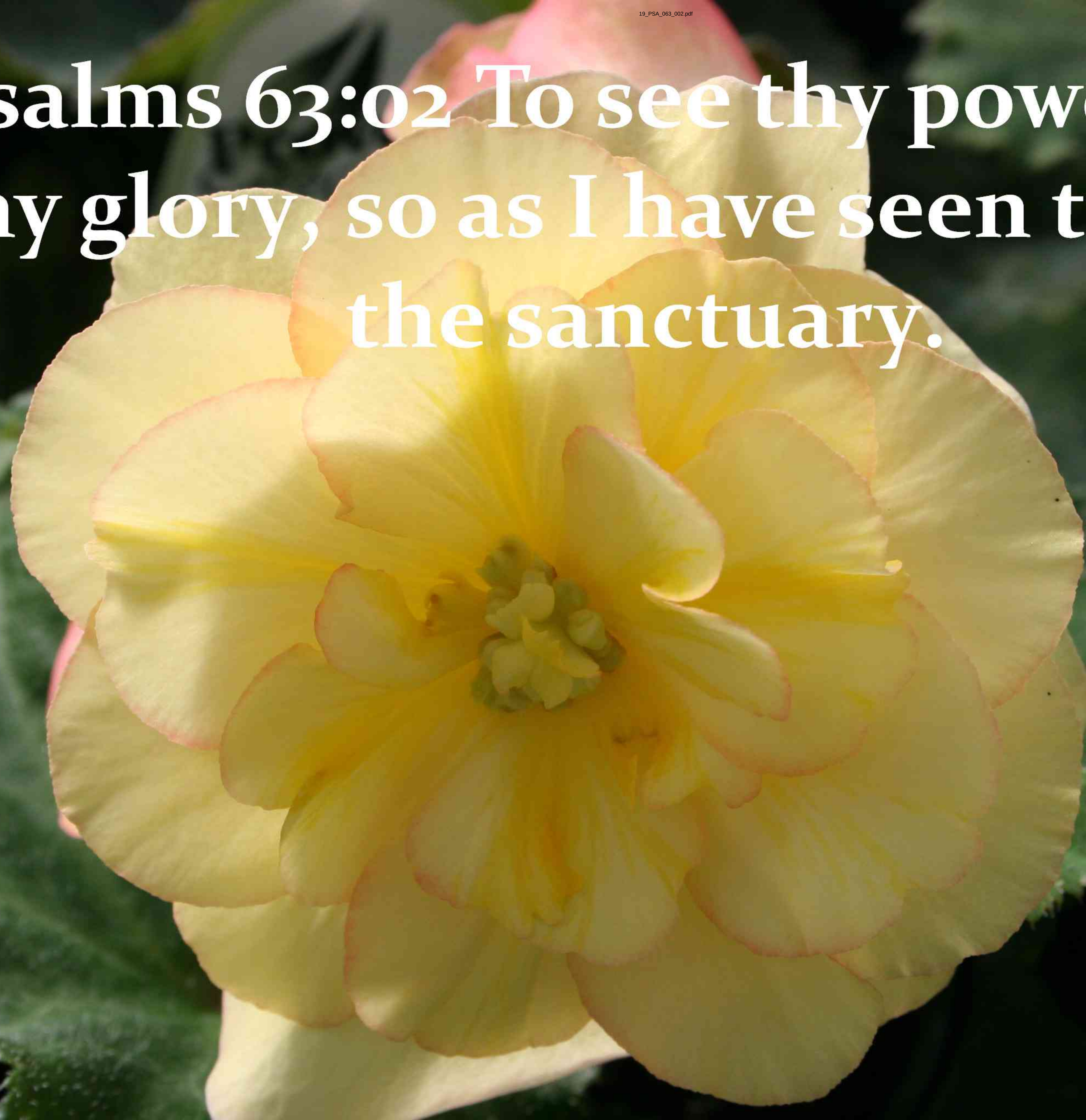




Psalms 63:01 A Psalm of David,

in thy name.**

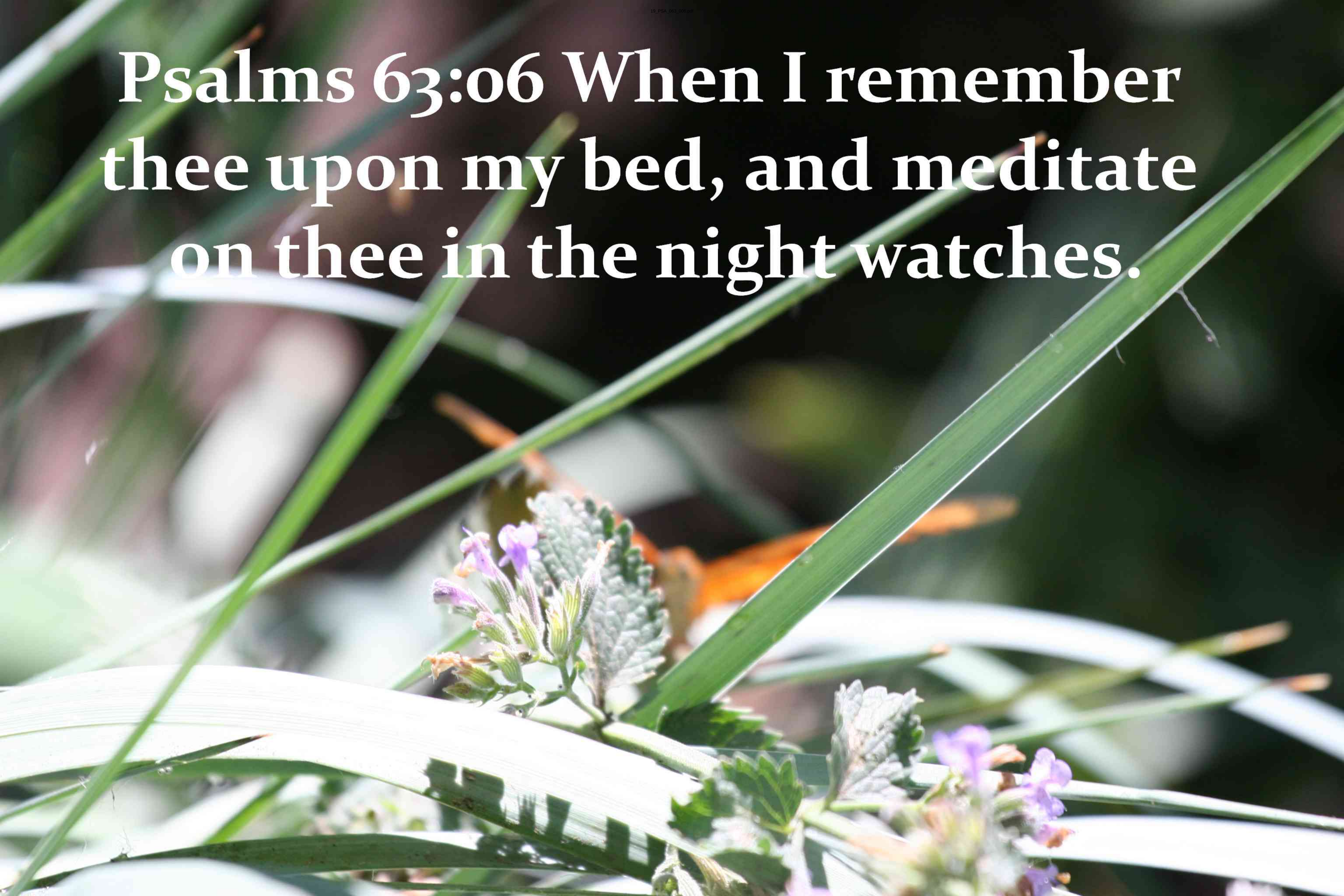


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**Psalm 63:05 My soul shall be

shadow of thy wings will I rejoice.**

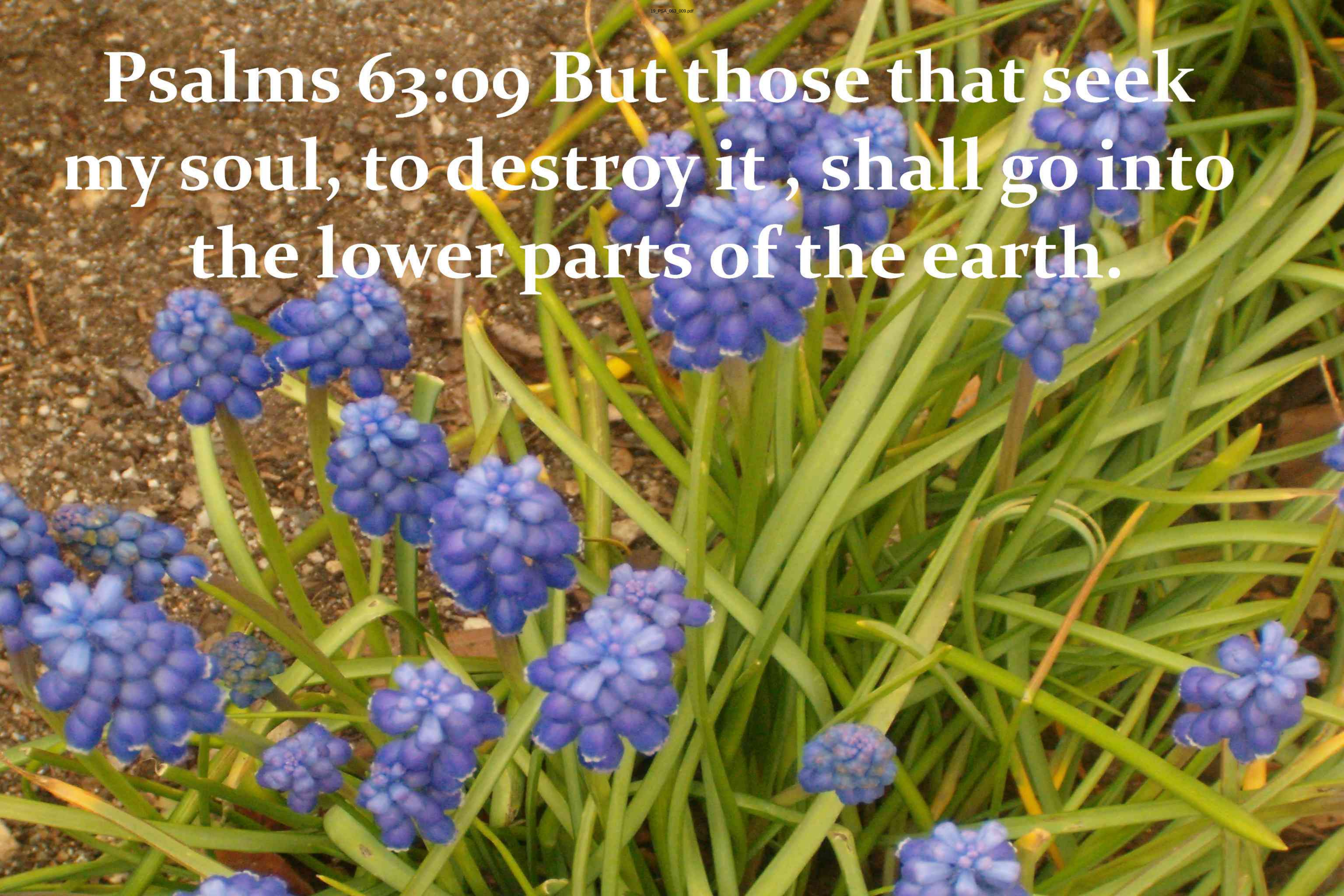
