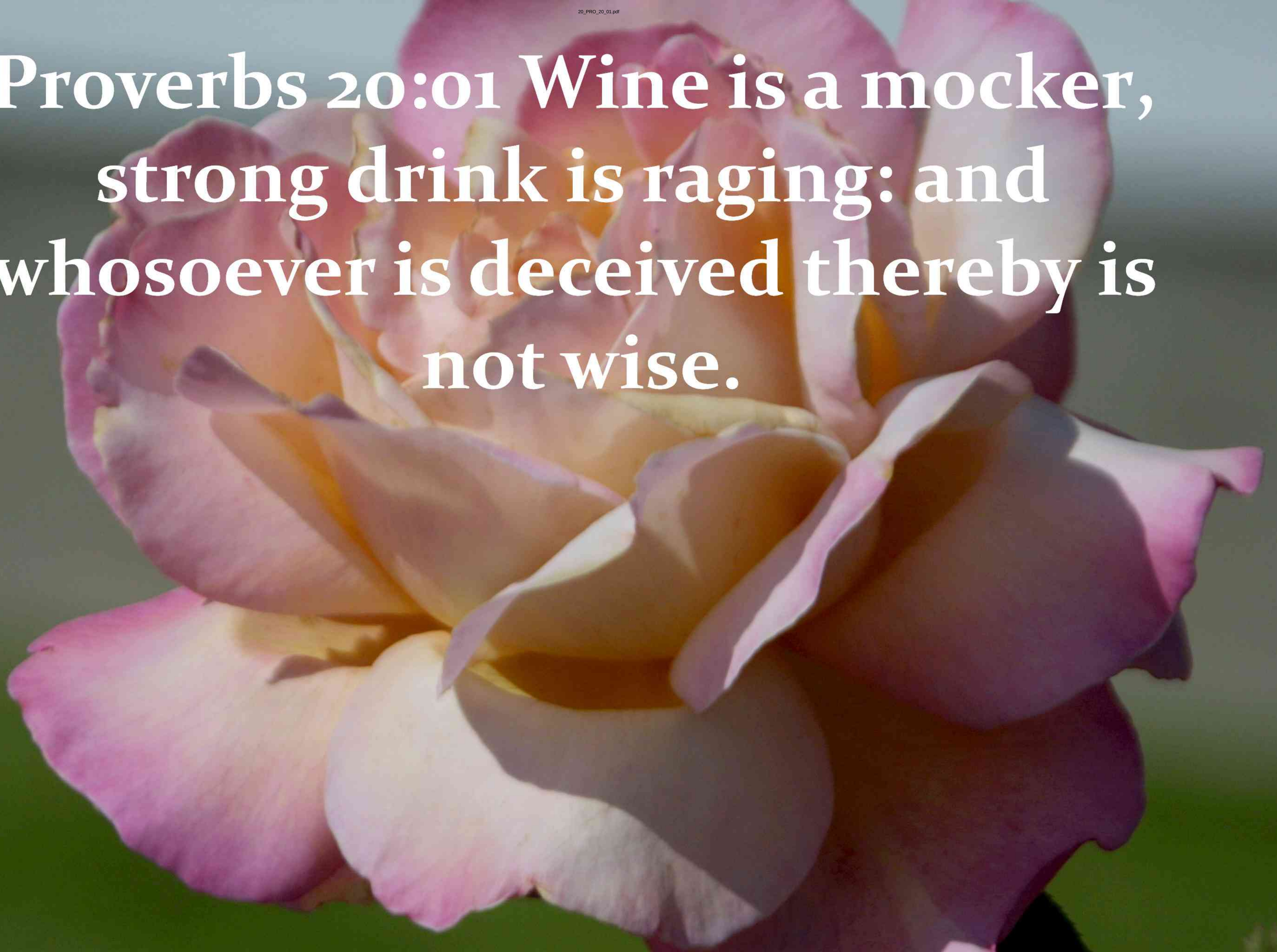
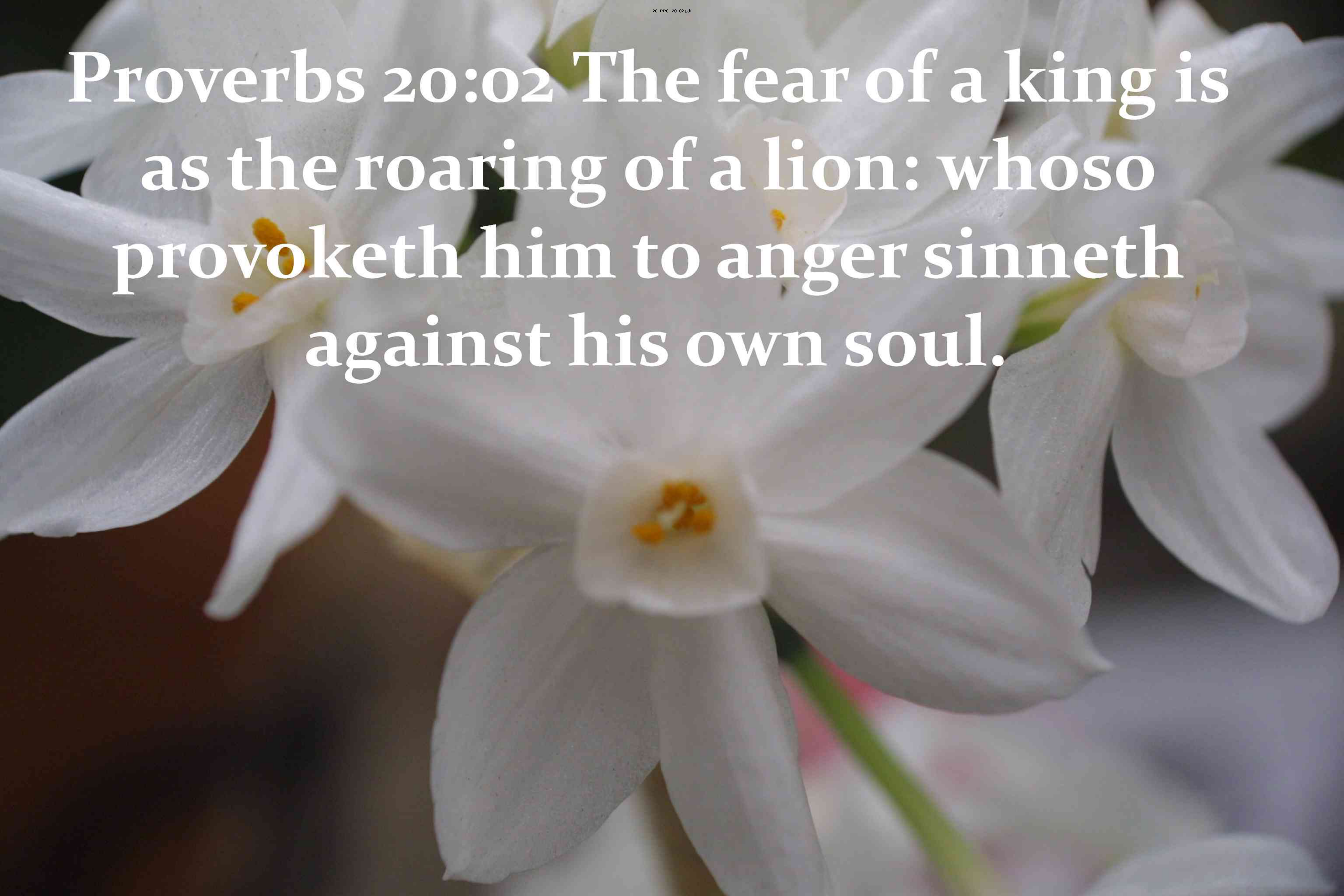


Proverbs 20:01 Wine is a mocker,

not wise.

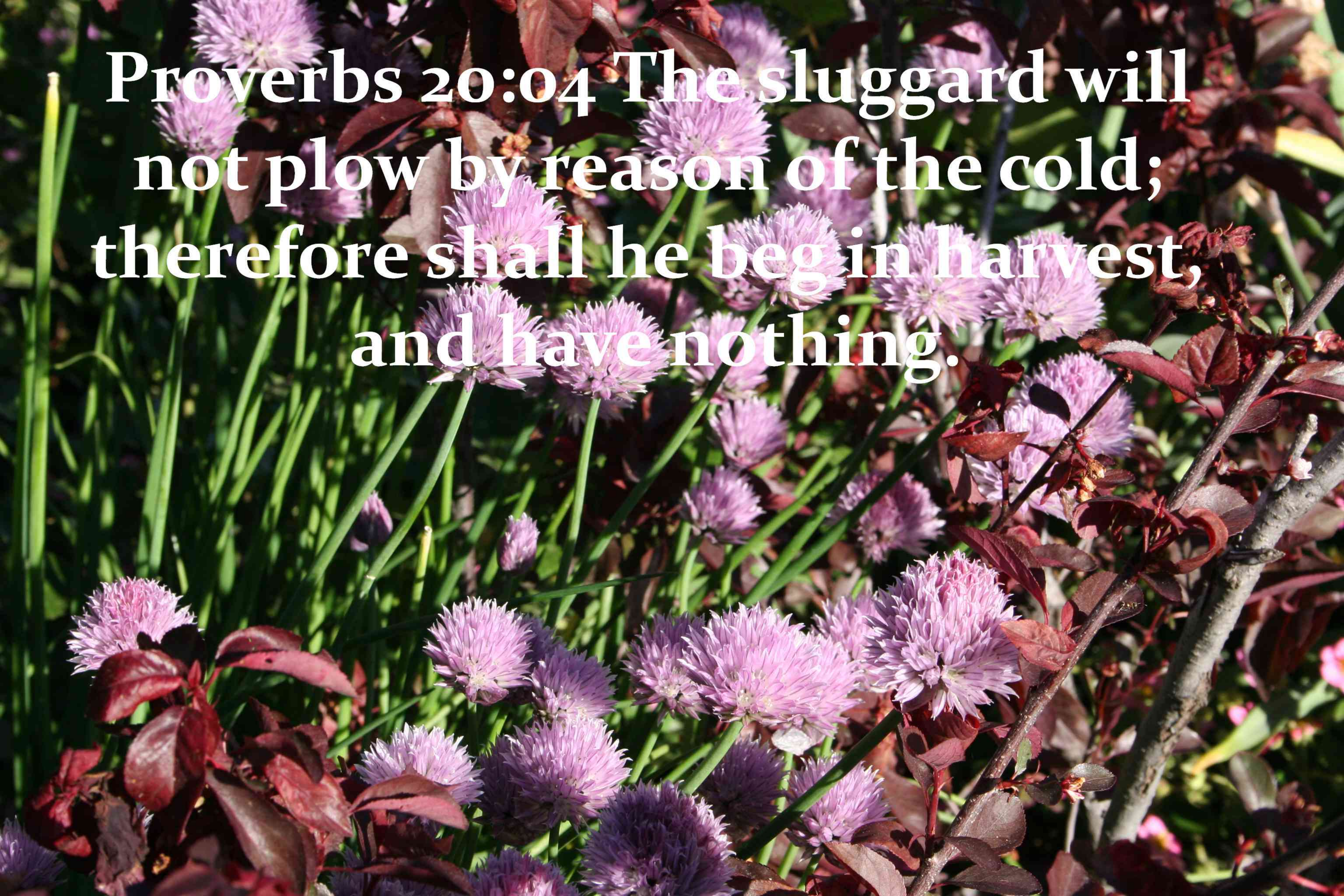




Proverbs 20:02 The fear of a king is

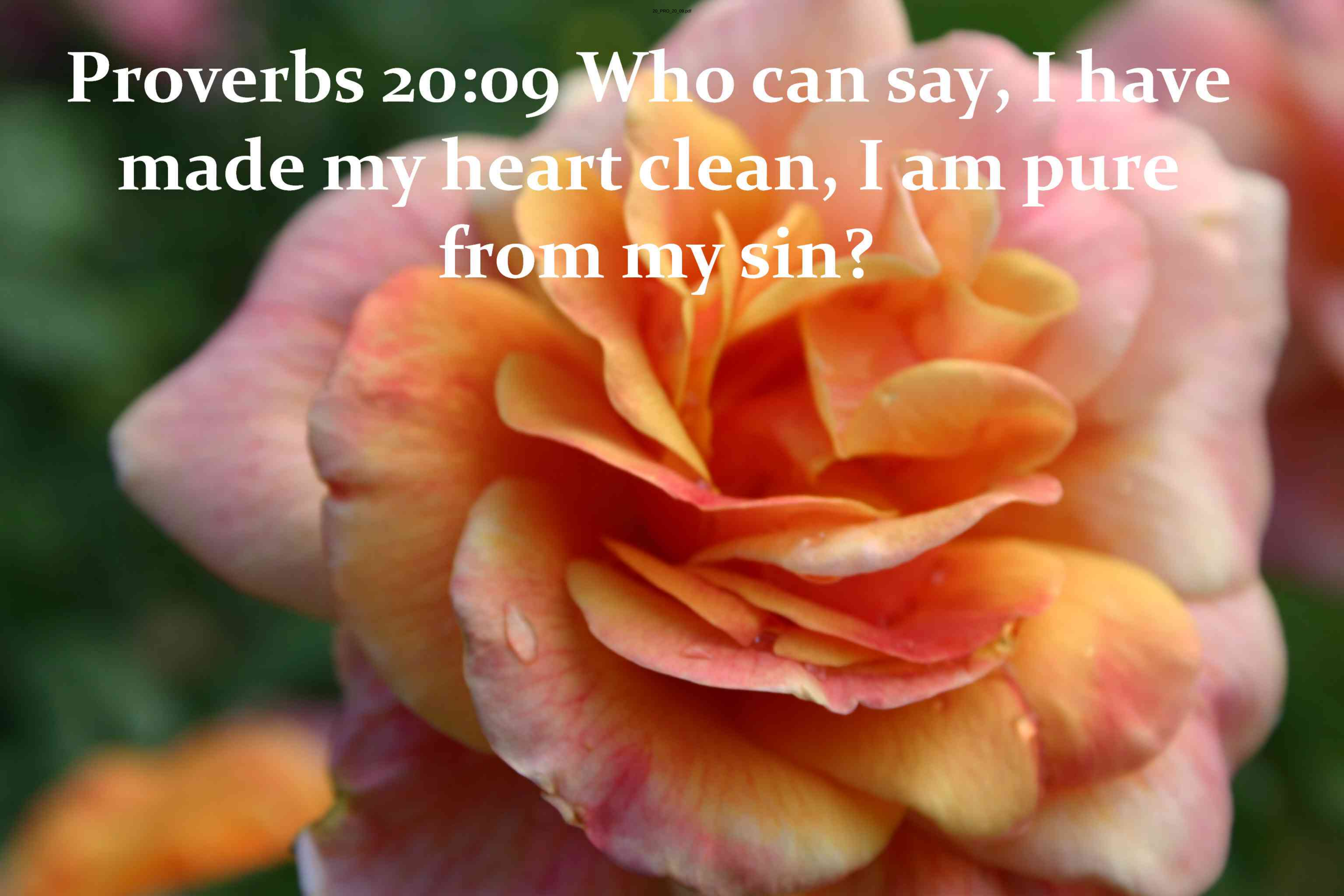

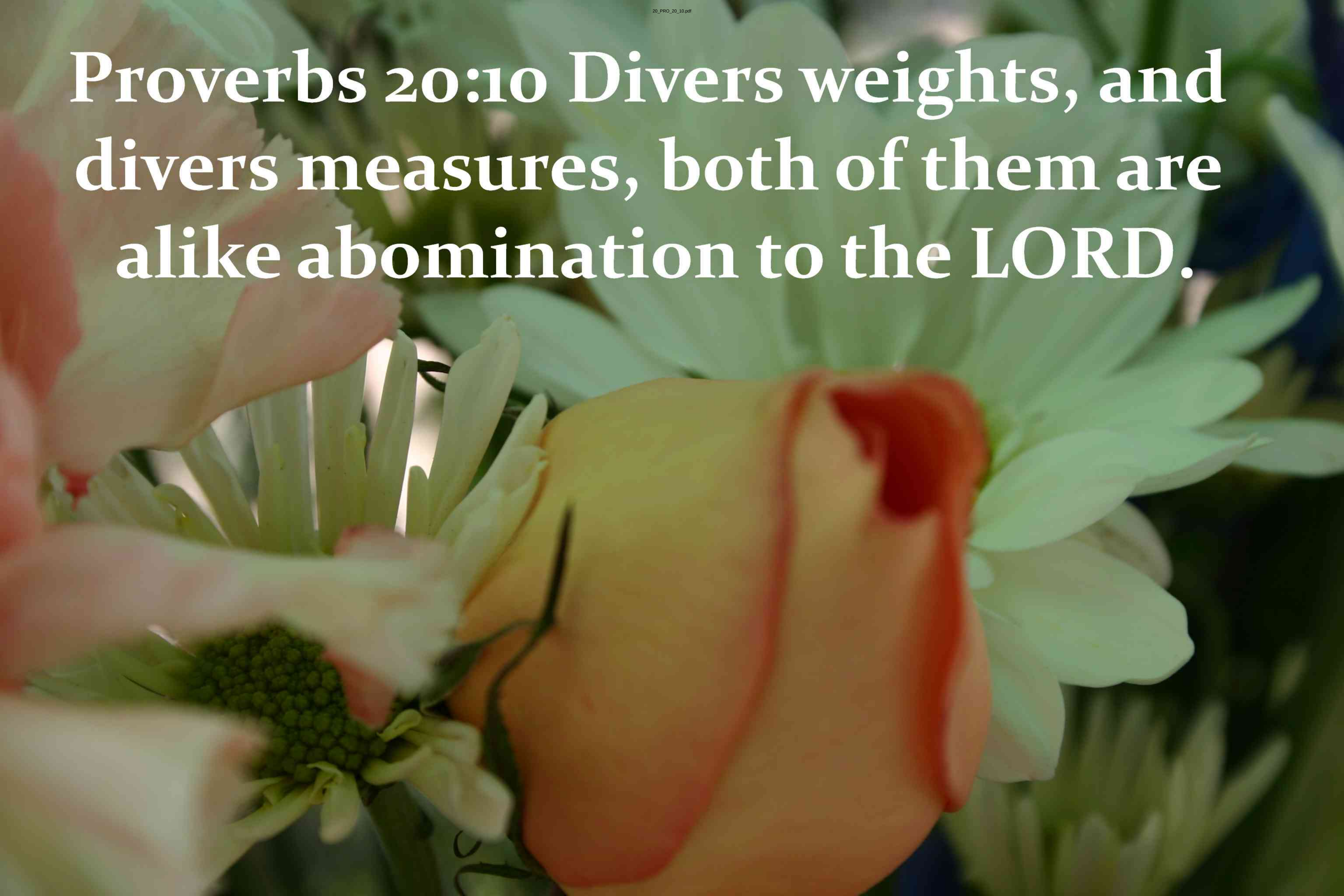

right.



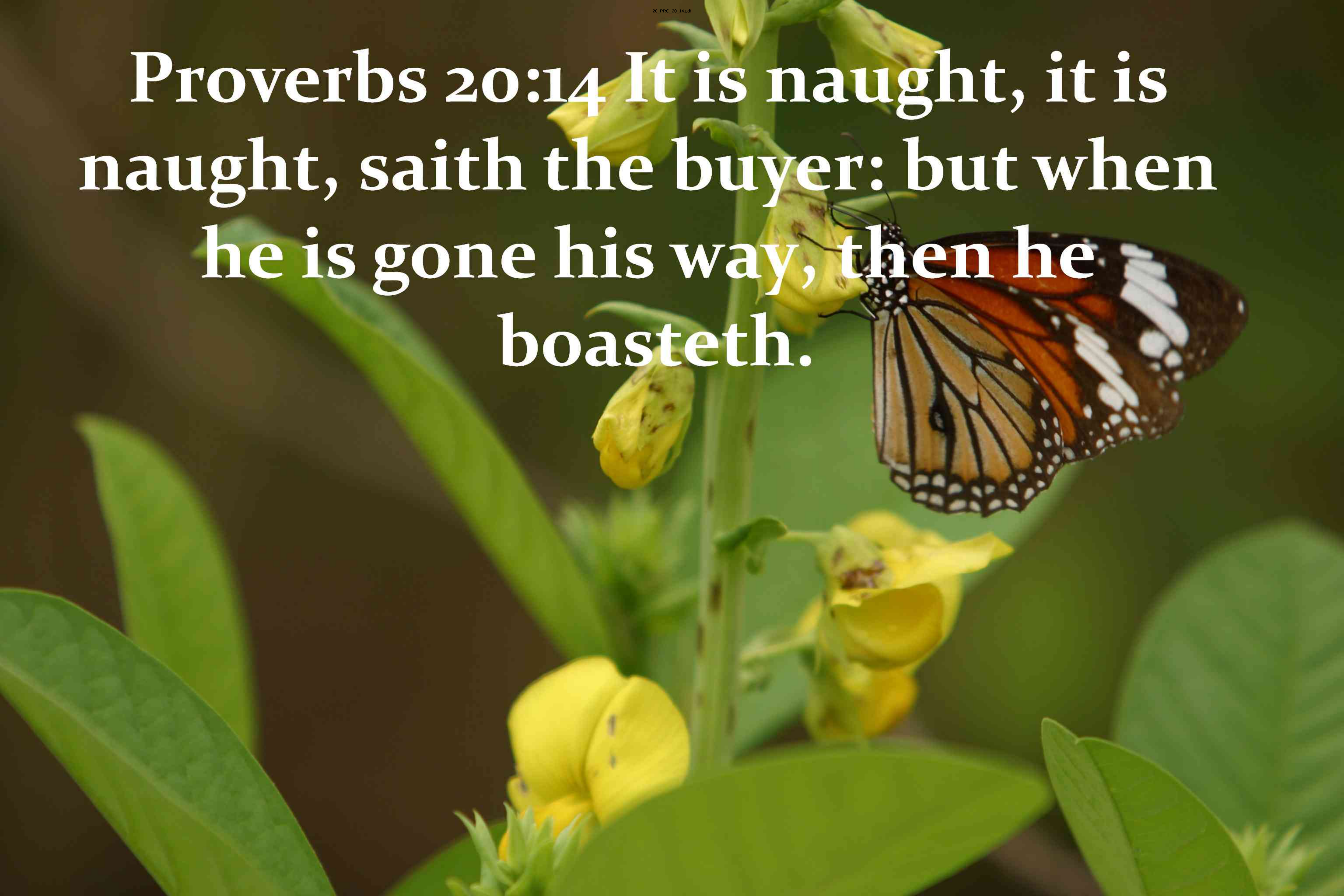
Proverbs 20:12 The hearing ear,

made even both of them.



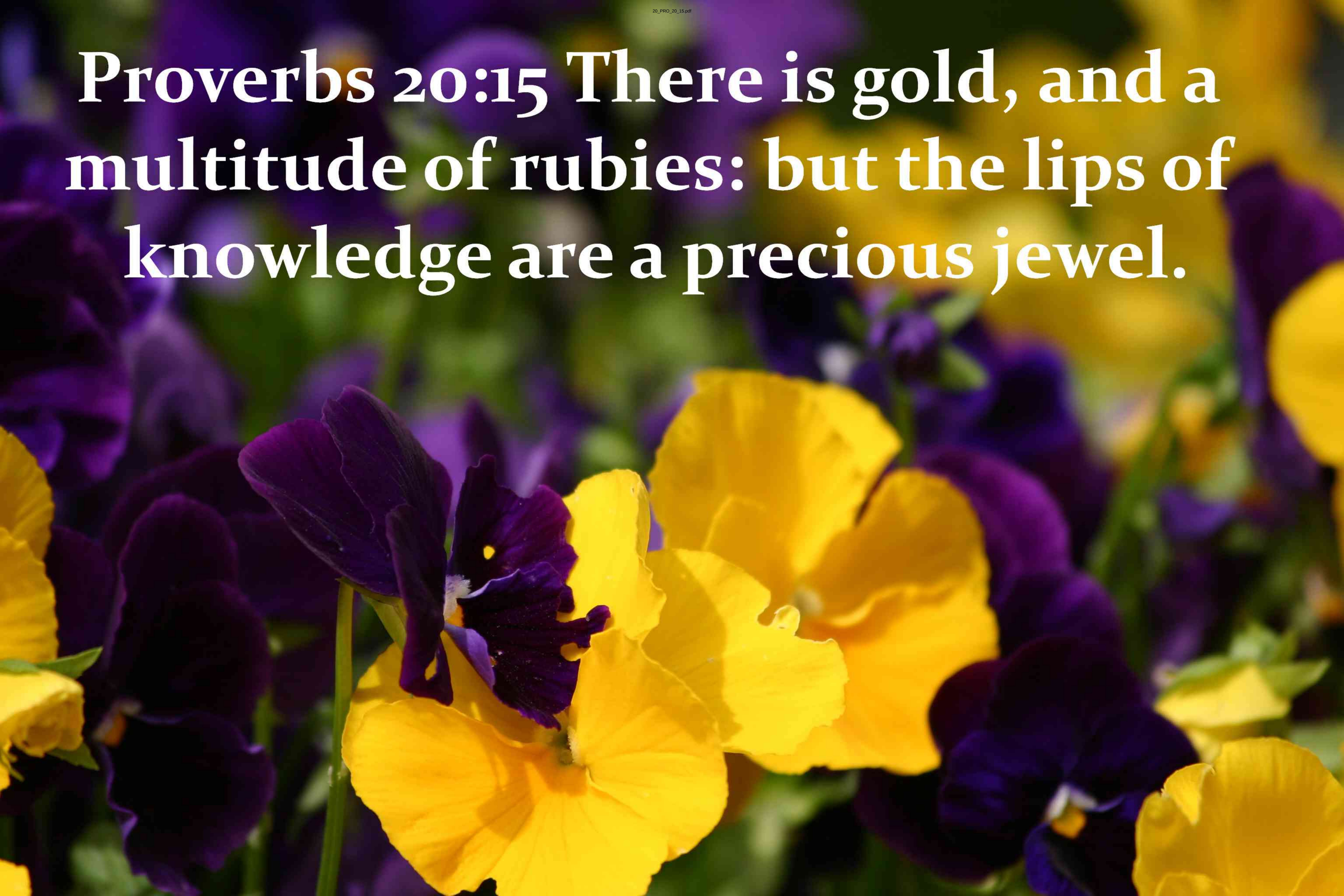
Proverbs 20:13 Love not sleep, lest

woman.**



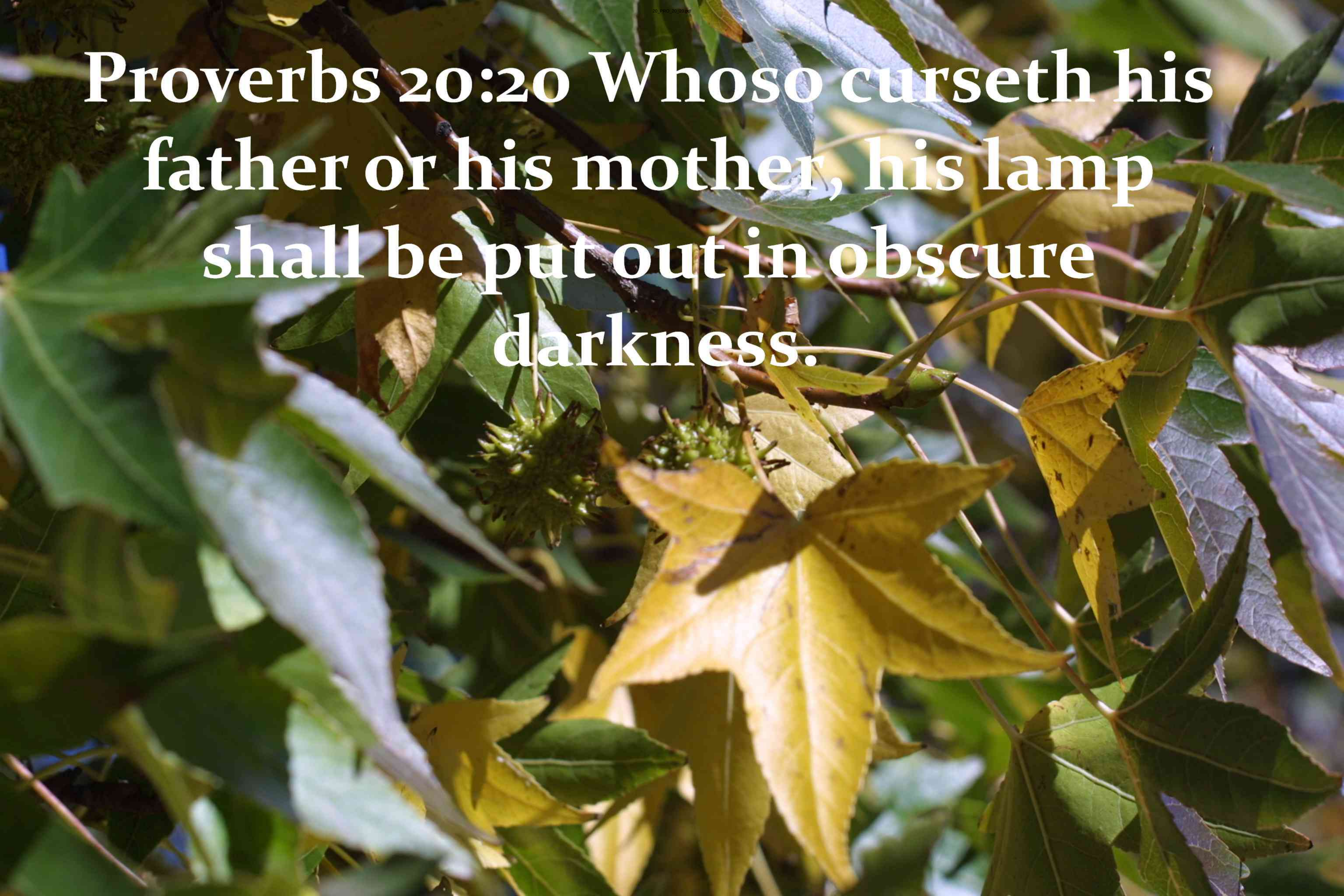
**Proverbs 20:17 Bread of deceit is

good advice make war.



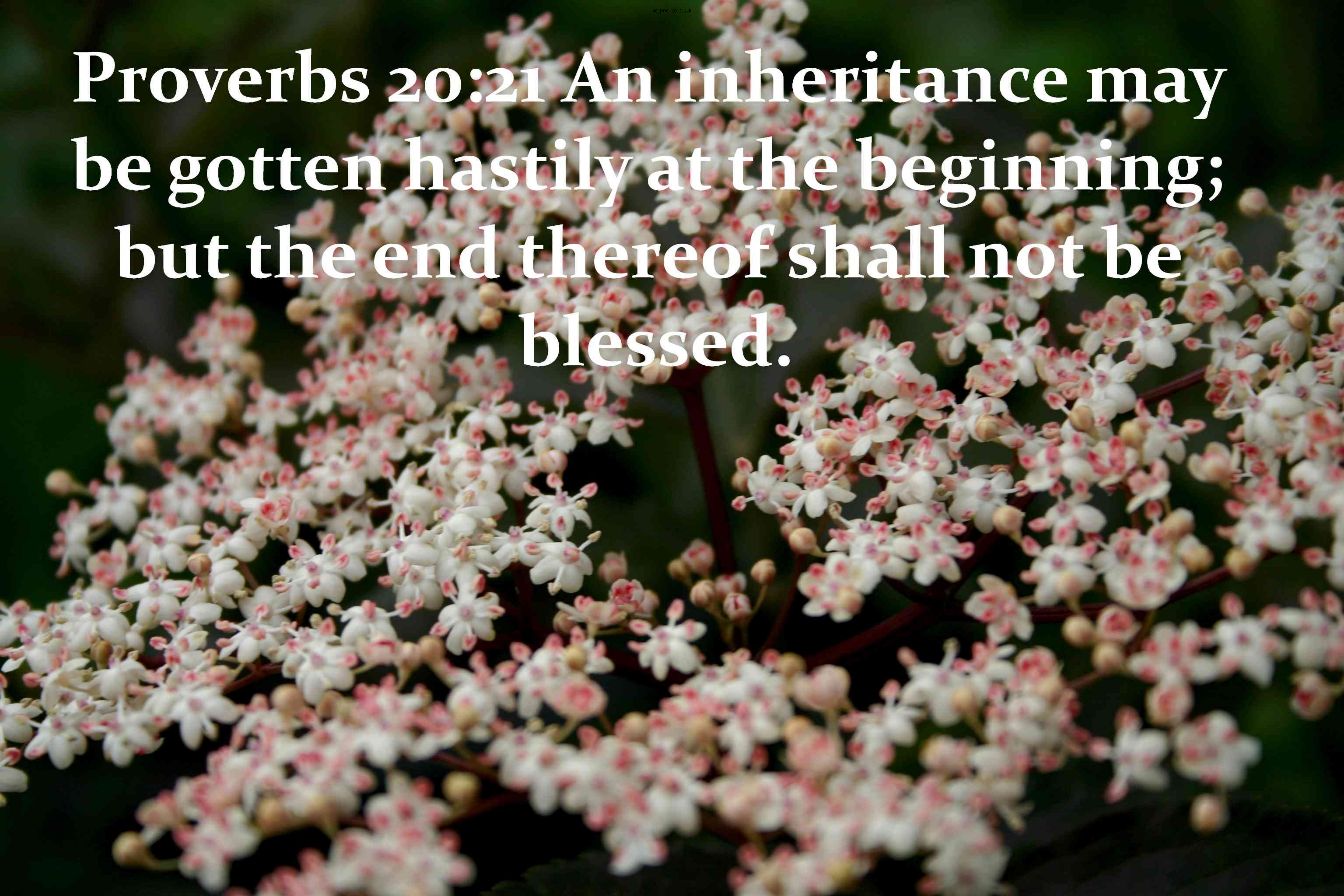
Proverbs 20:19 He that goeth about

that flattereth with his lips.



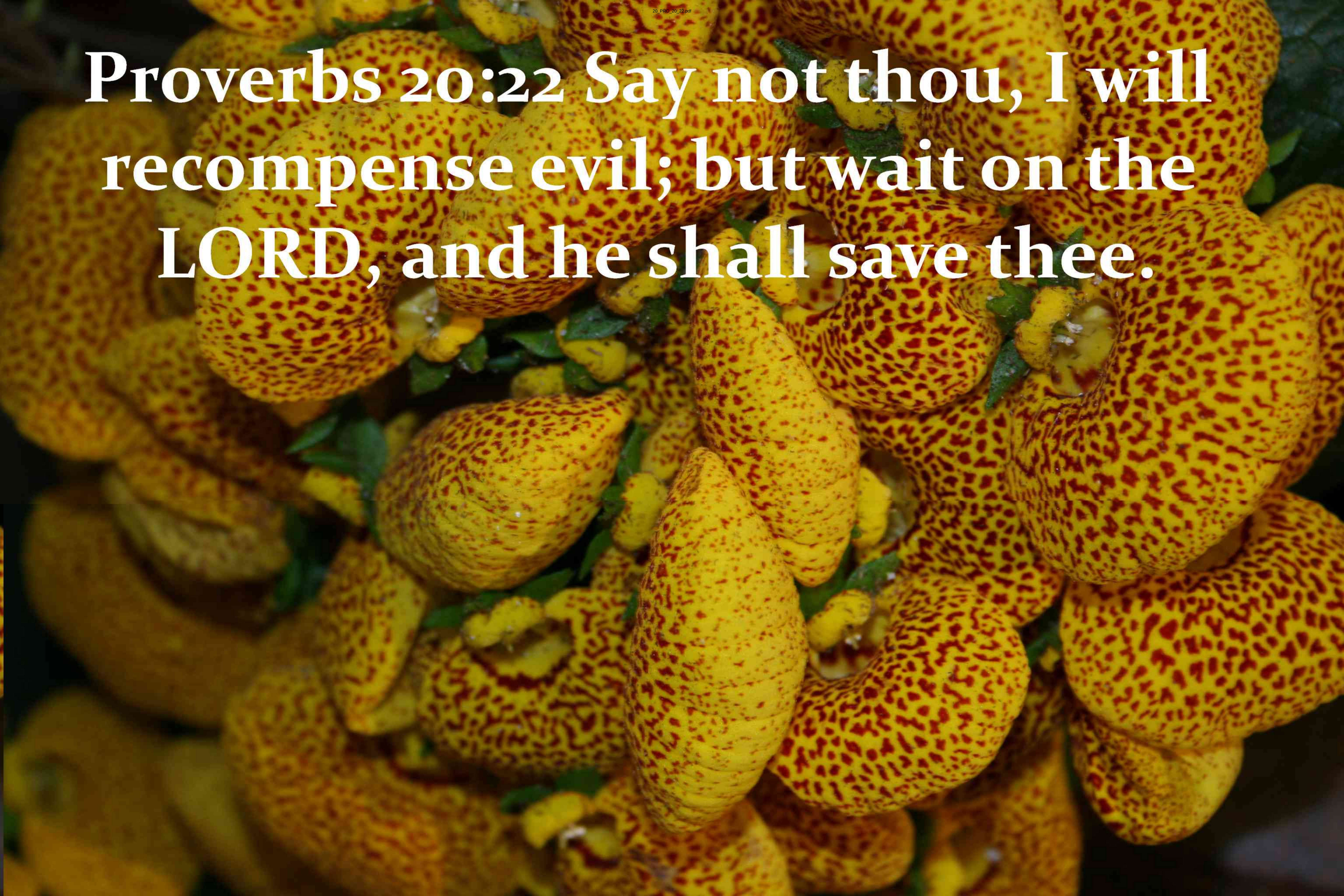

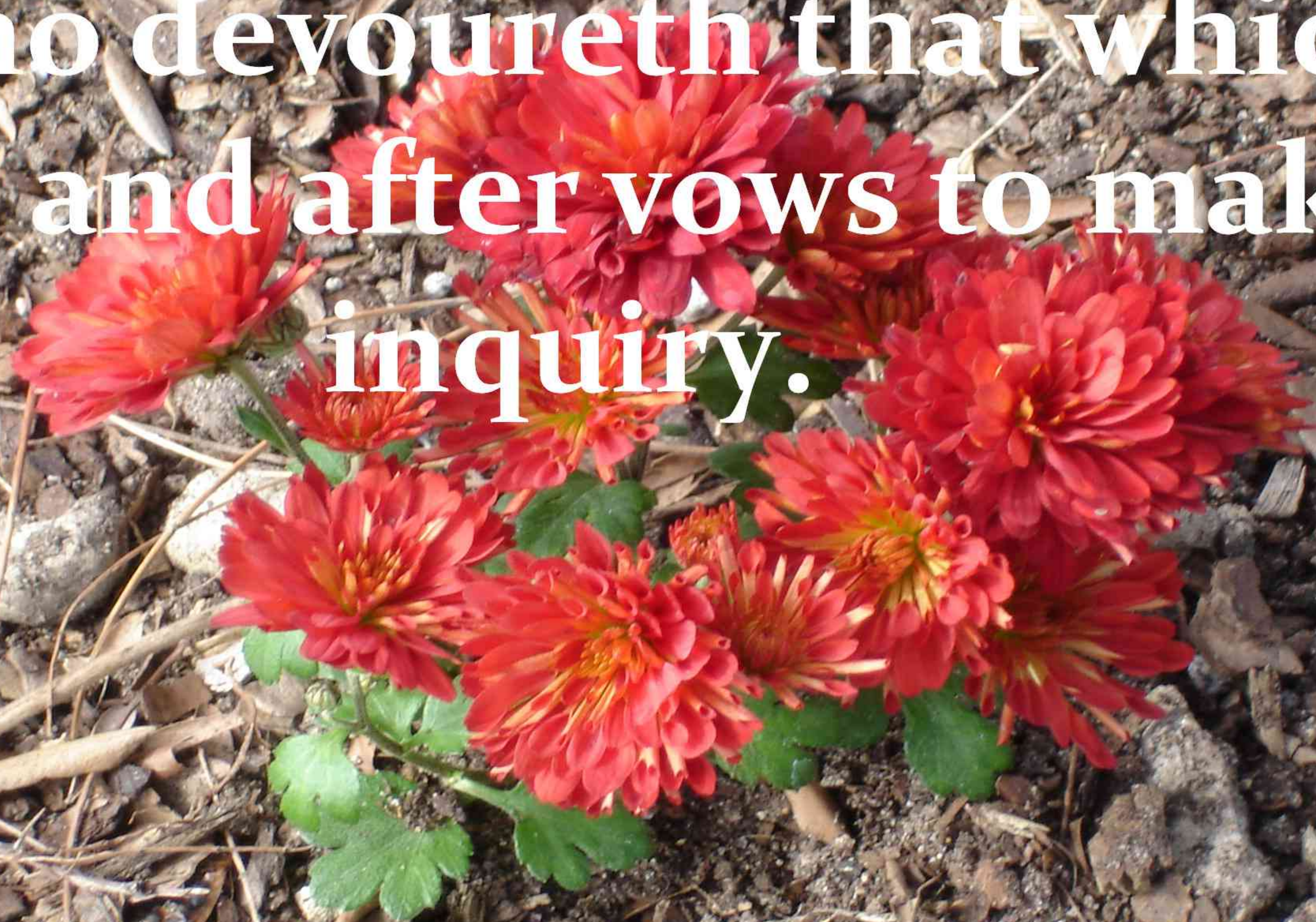
Proverbs 20:23 Divers weights are

bringeth the wheel over them.



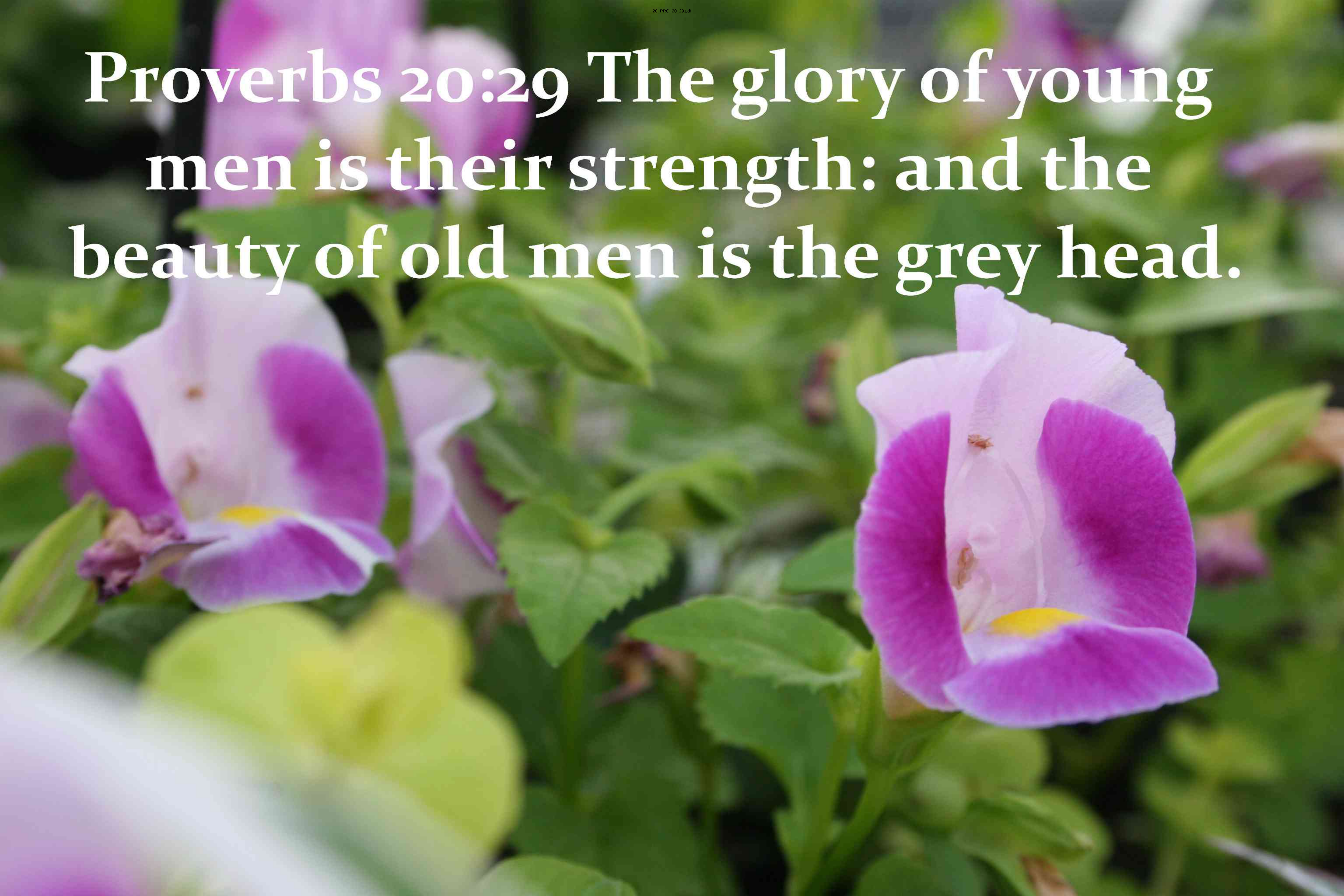
Proverbs 20:27 The spirit of man is
