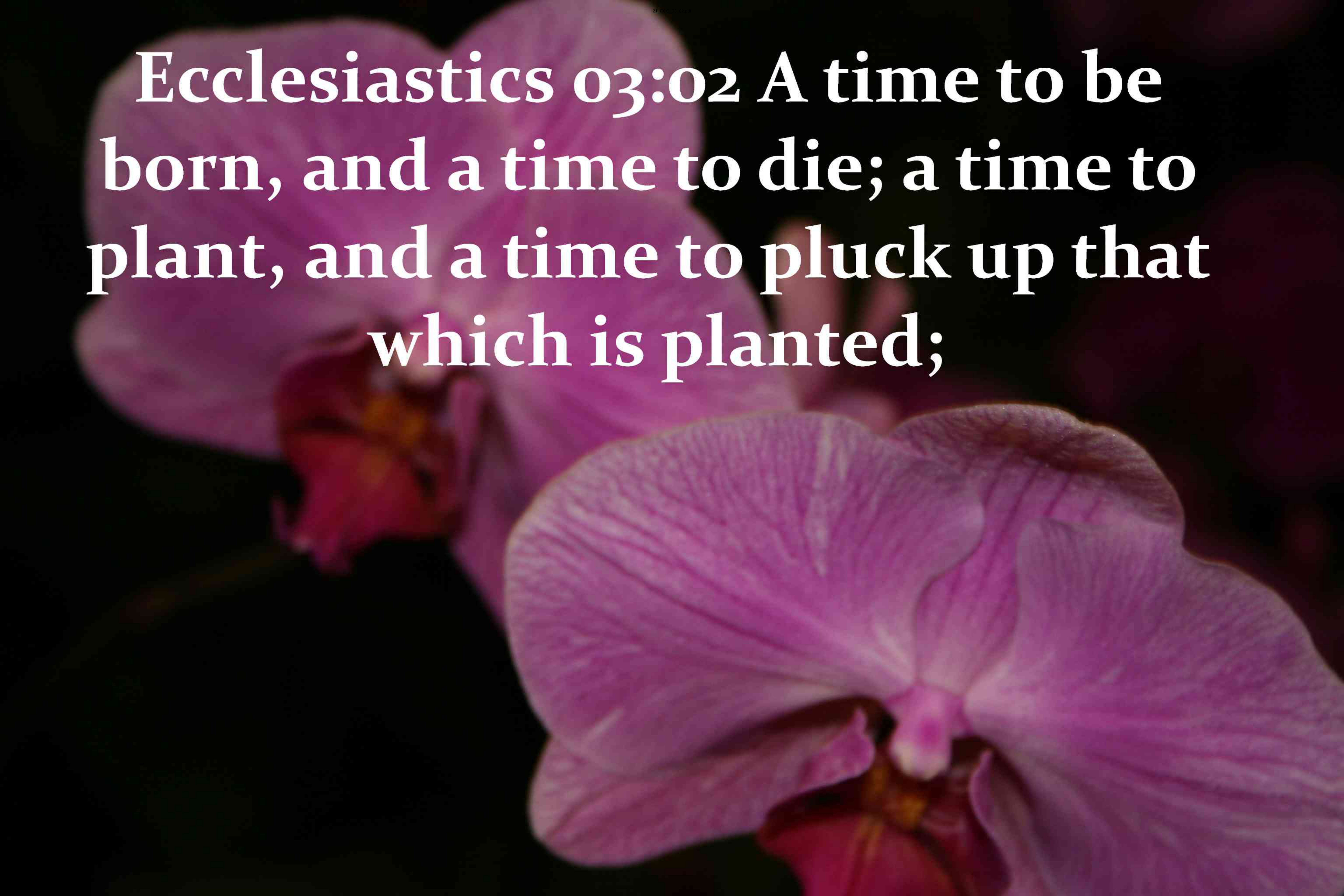


Ecclesiastics 03:01 To every thing

down, and a time to build up;

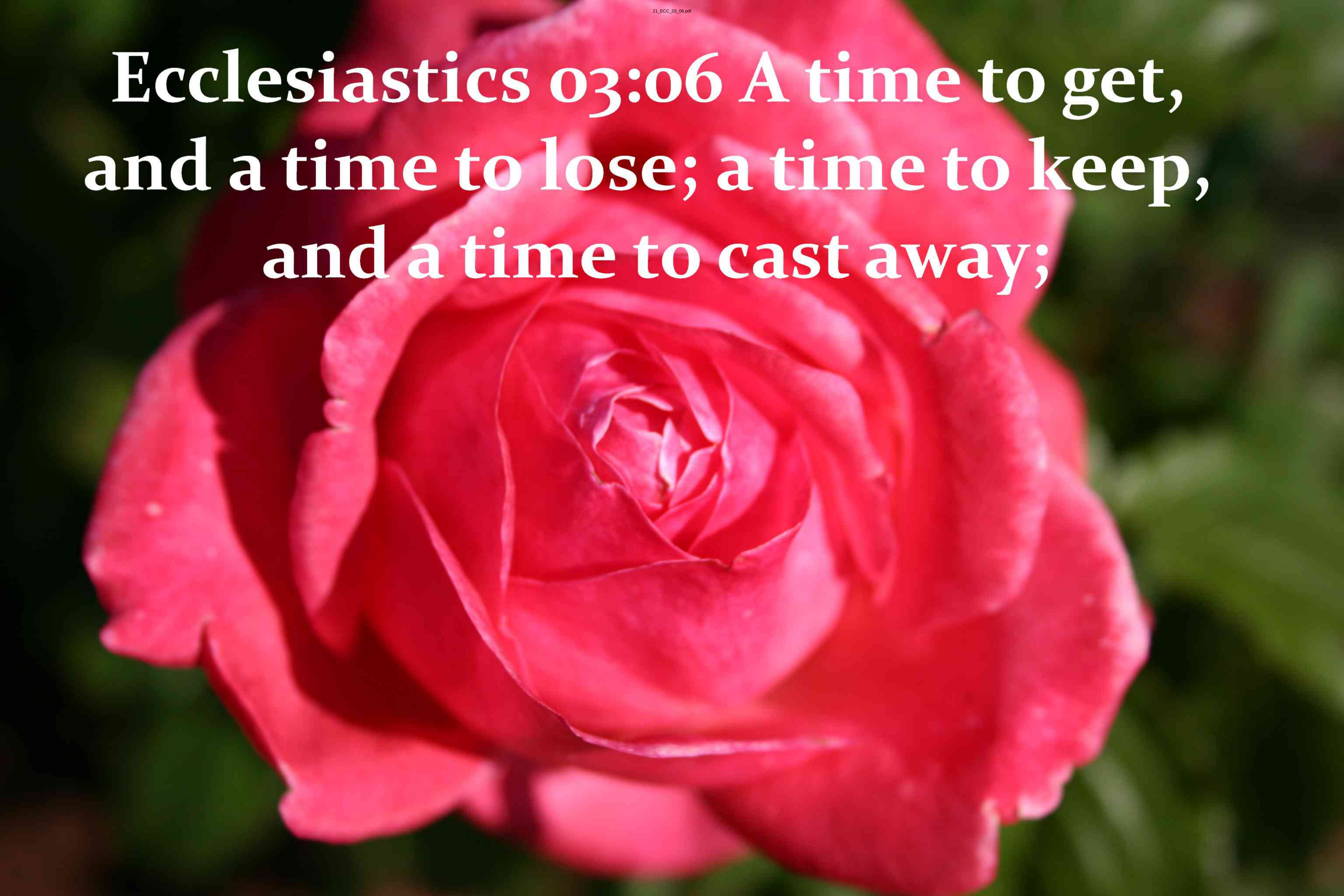
Ecclesiastics 03:04 A time to weep,

mourn, and a time to dance;

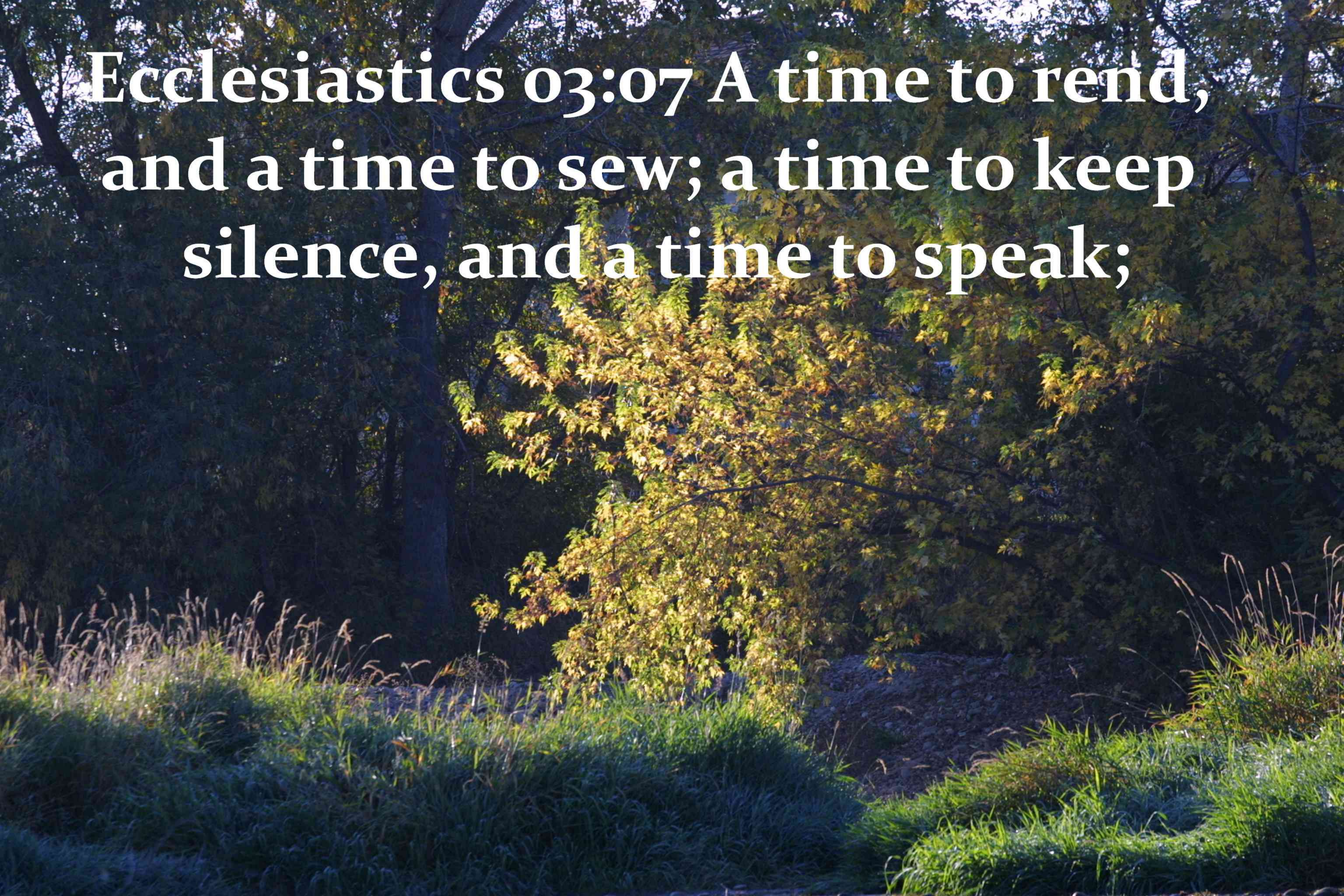


Ecclesiastics 03:05 A time to cast

embracing;



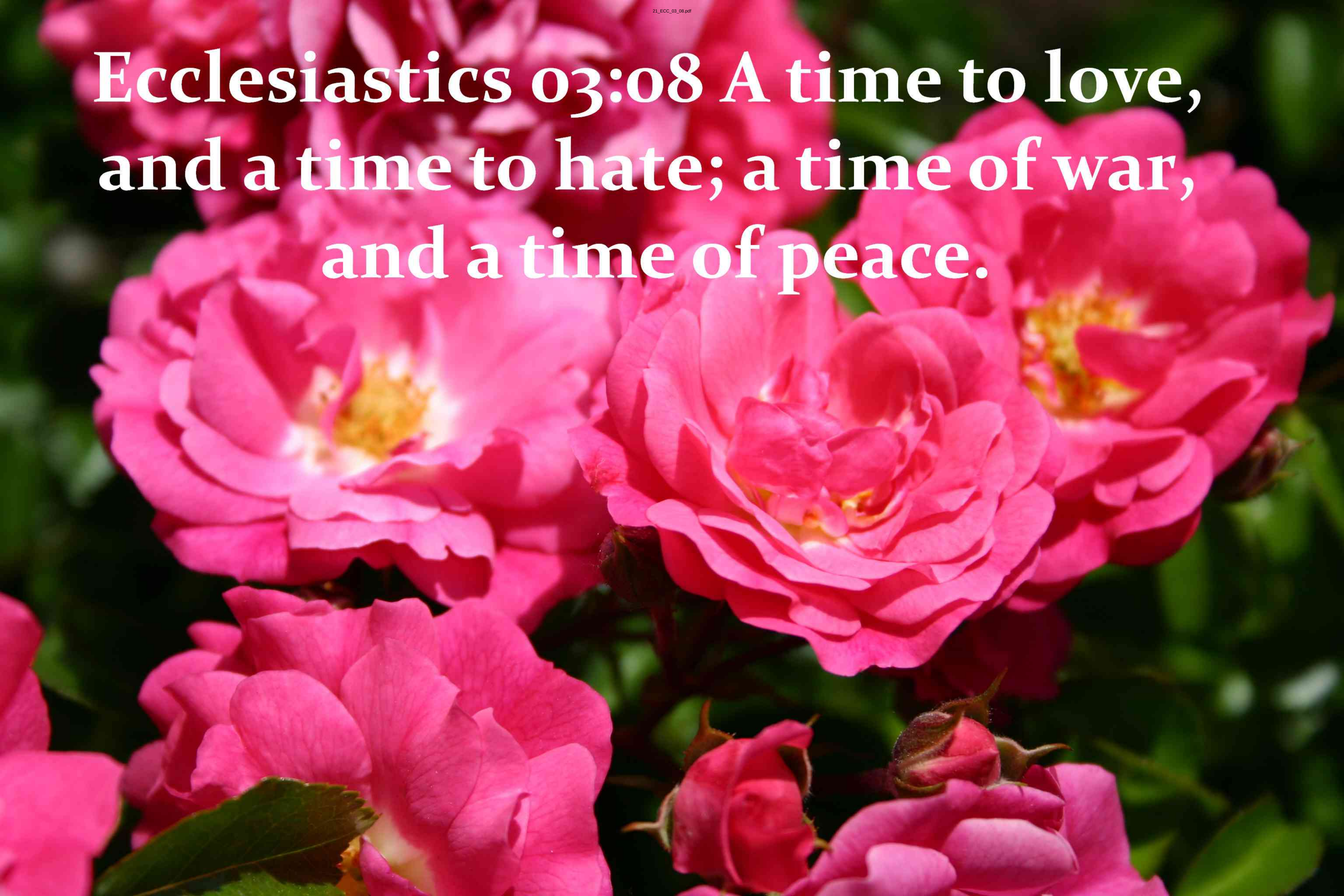

and a time to cast away;**



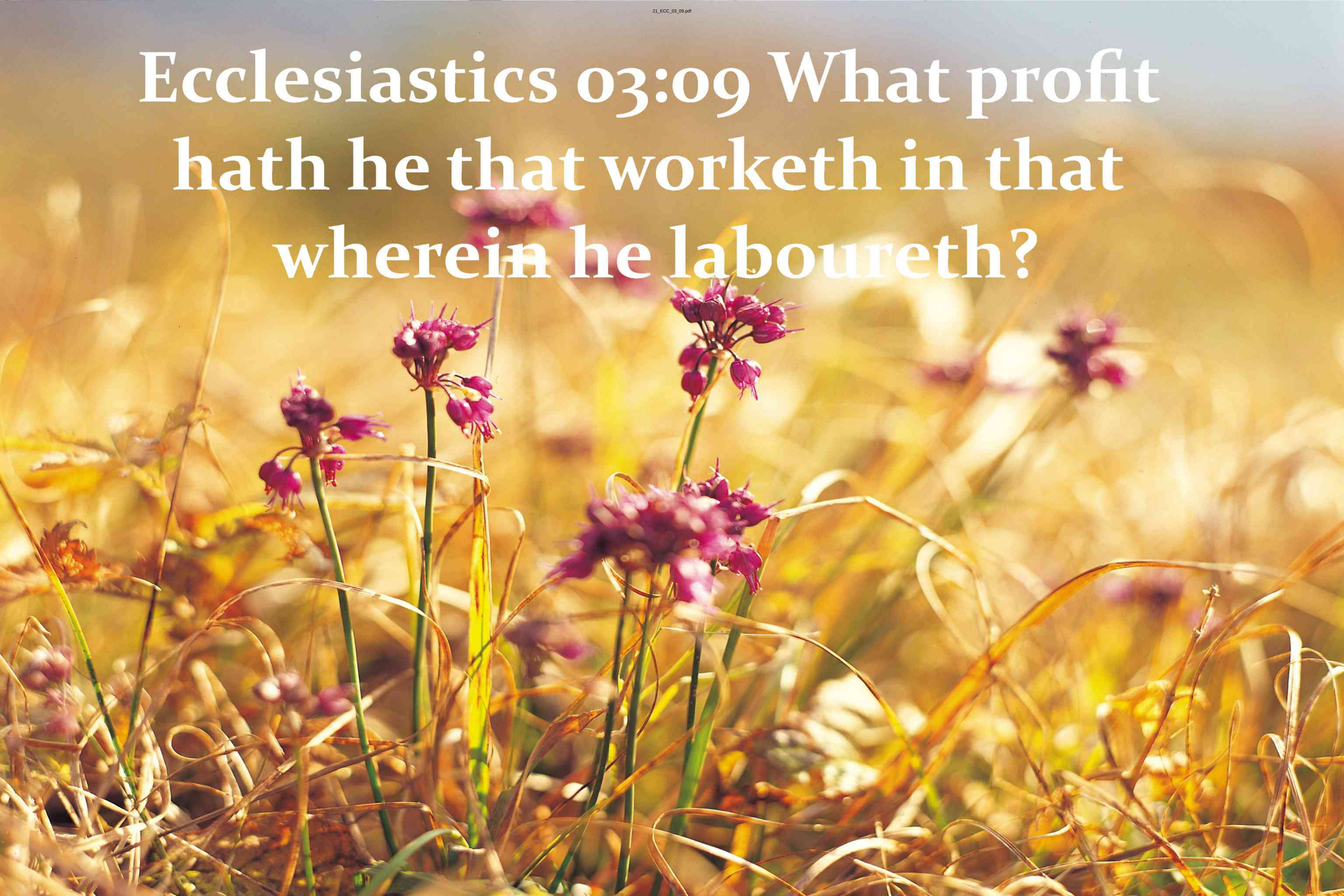


Ecclesiastics 03:07 A time to rend,

silence, and a time to speak;

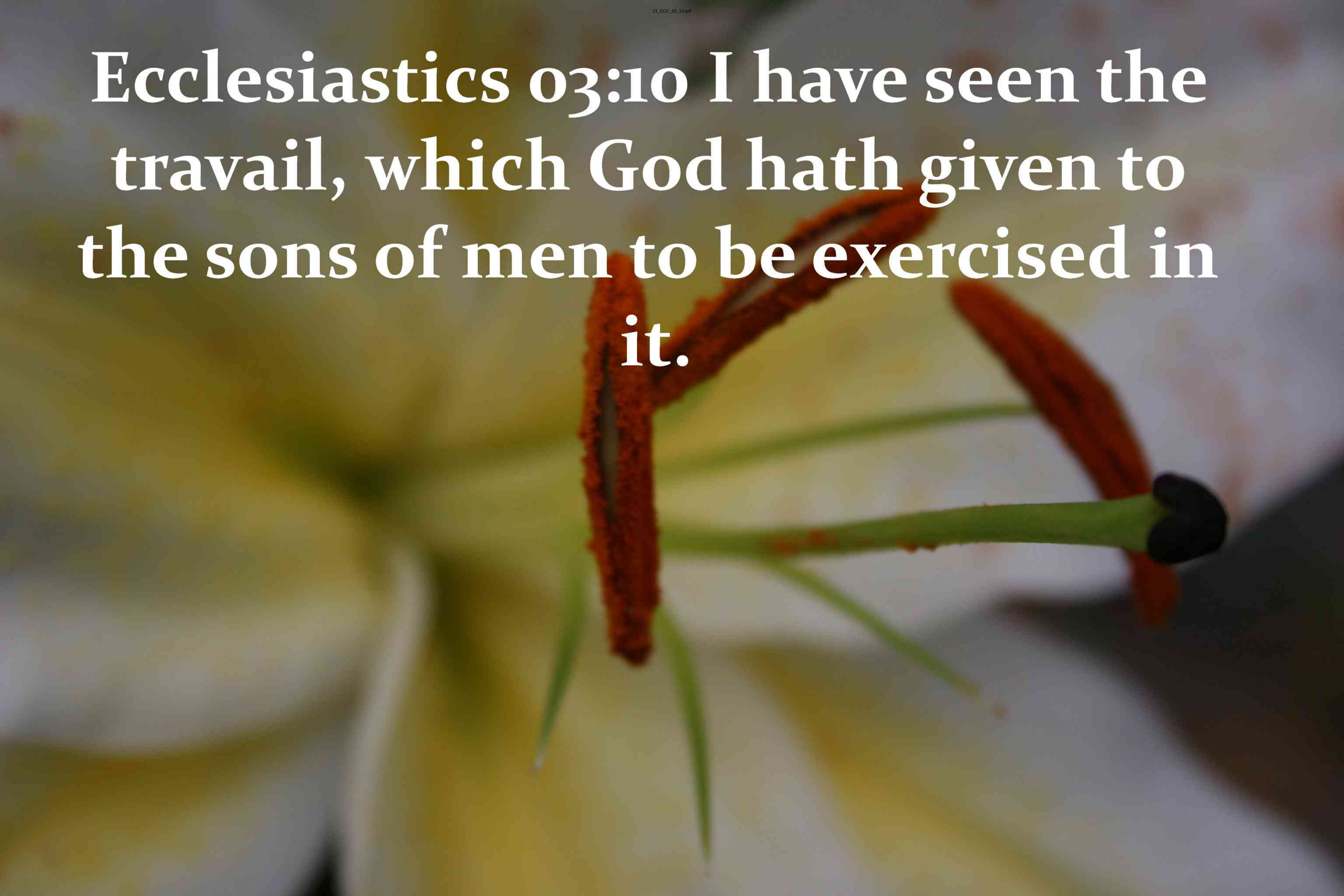
**Ecclesiastics 03:08 A time to love,

wherein he laboureth?

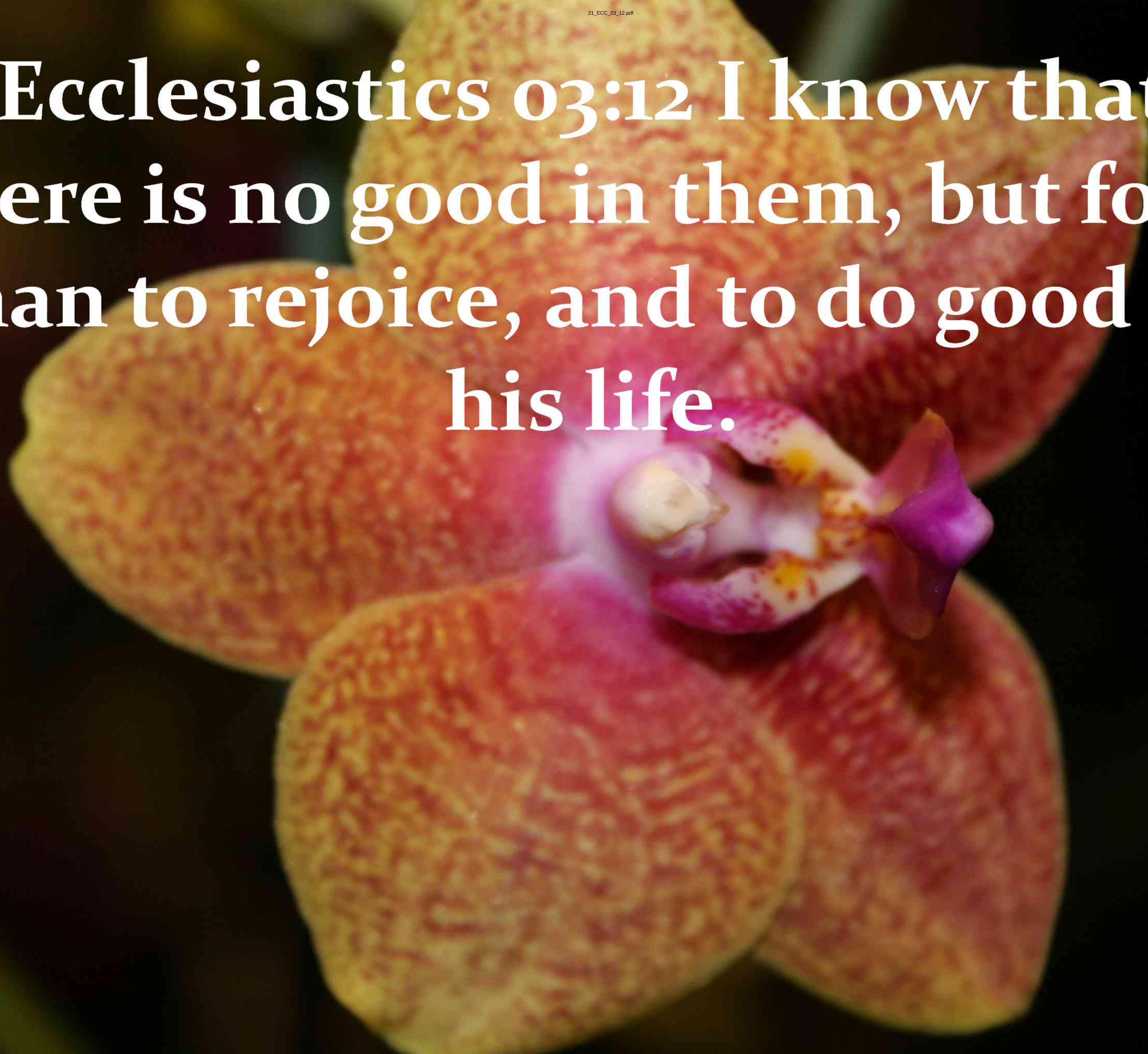


Ecclesiastics 03:10 I have seen the

it.

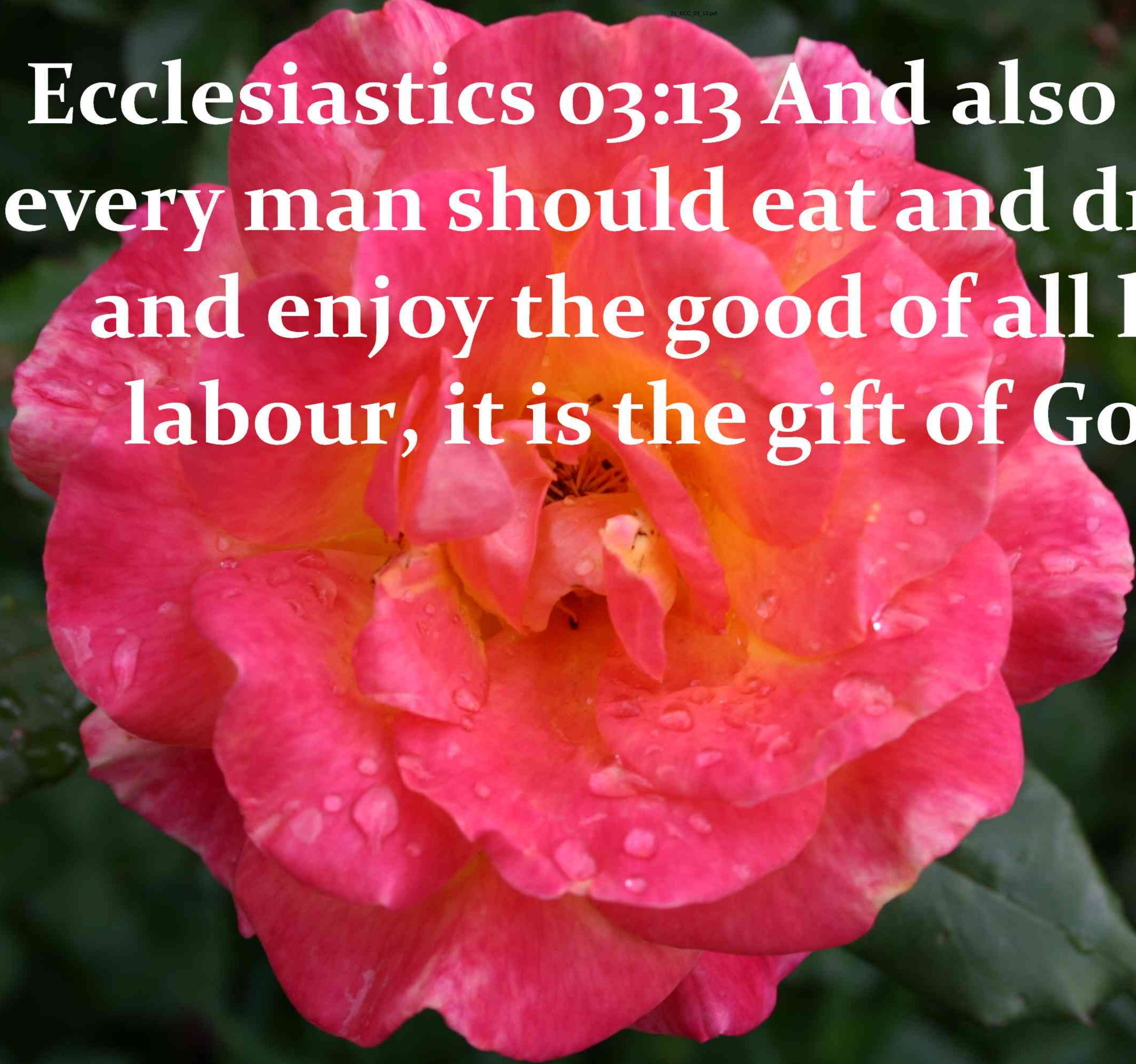


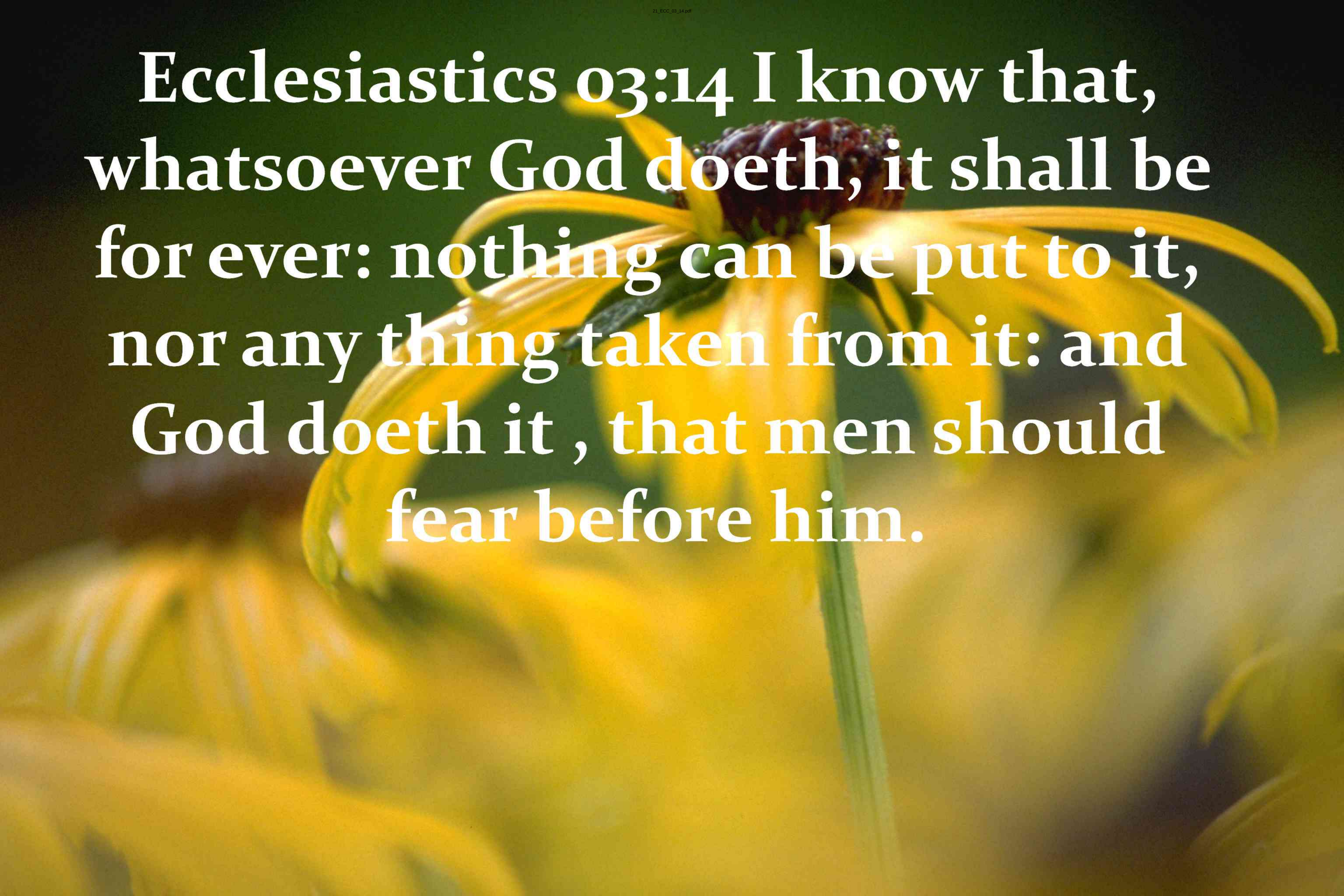
**Ecclesiastics 03:11 He hath made

his life.**

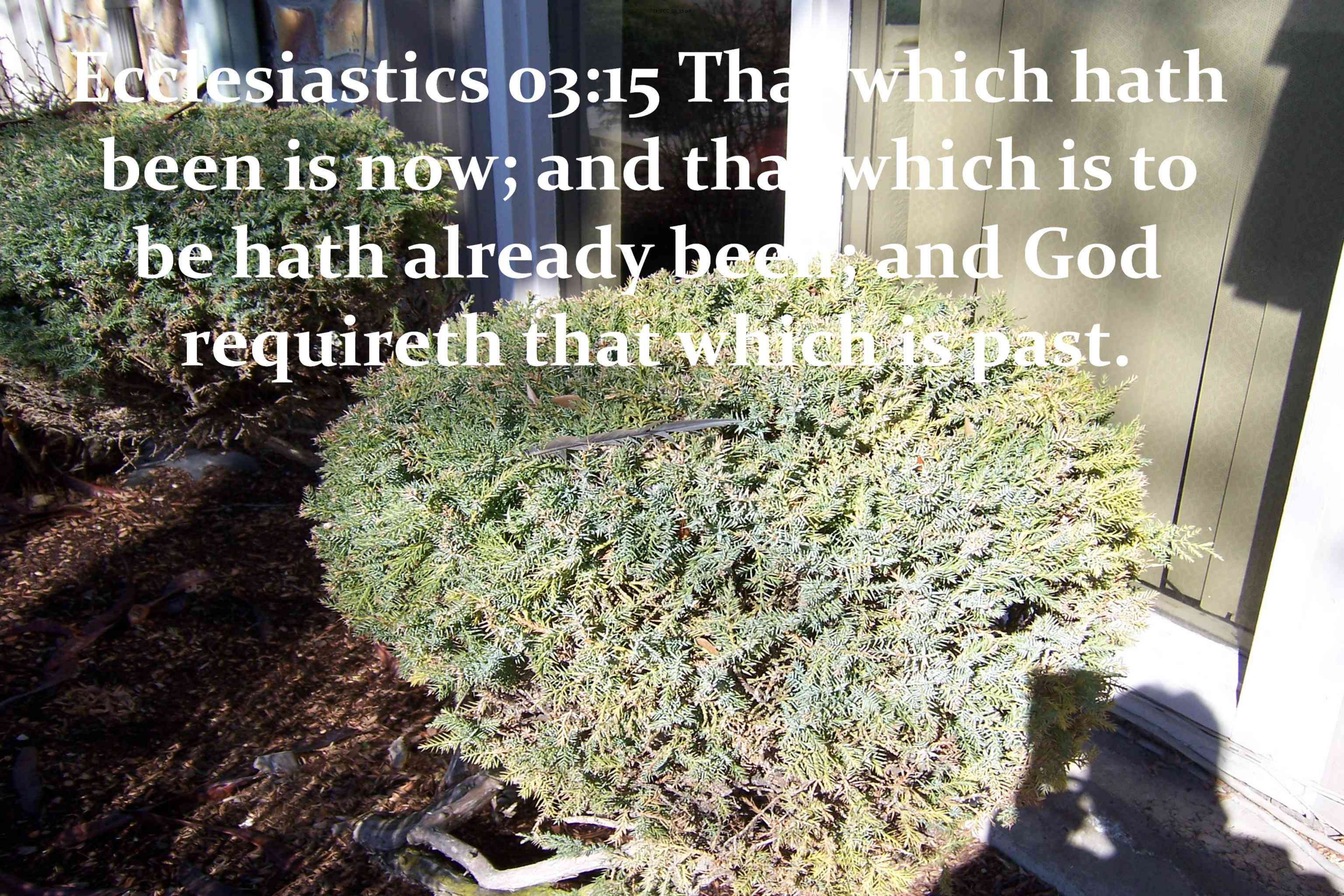


**Ecclesiastics 03:13 And also that

fear before him.

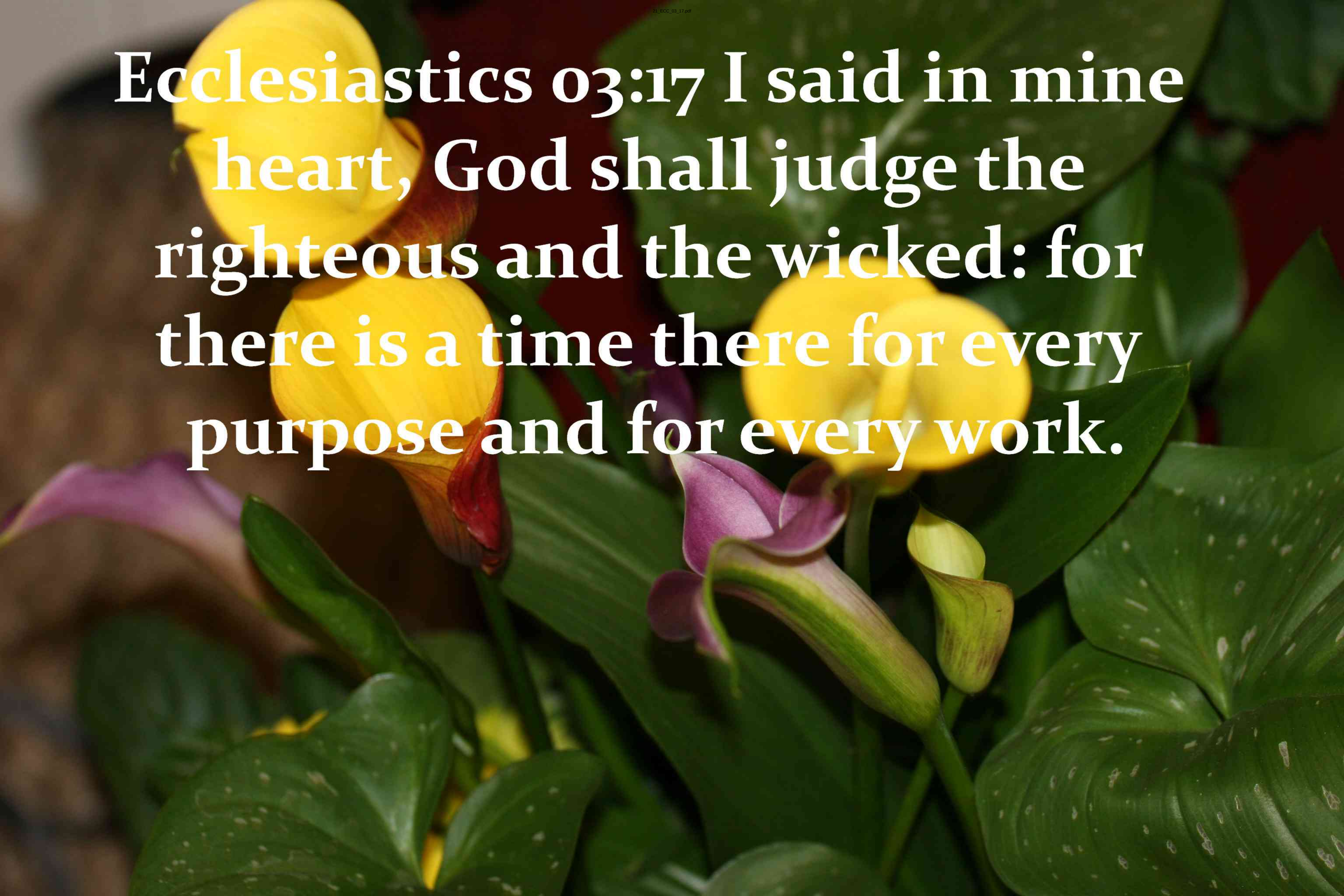


**Ecclesiastics 03:15 That which hath

requireth that which is past.**

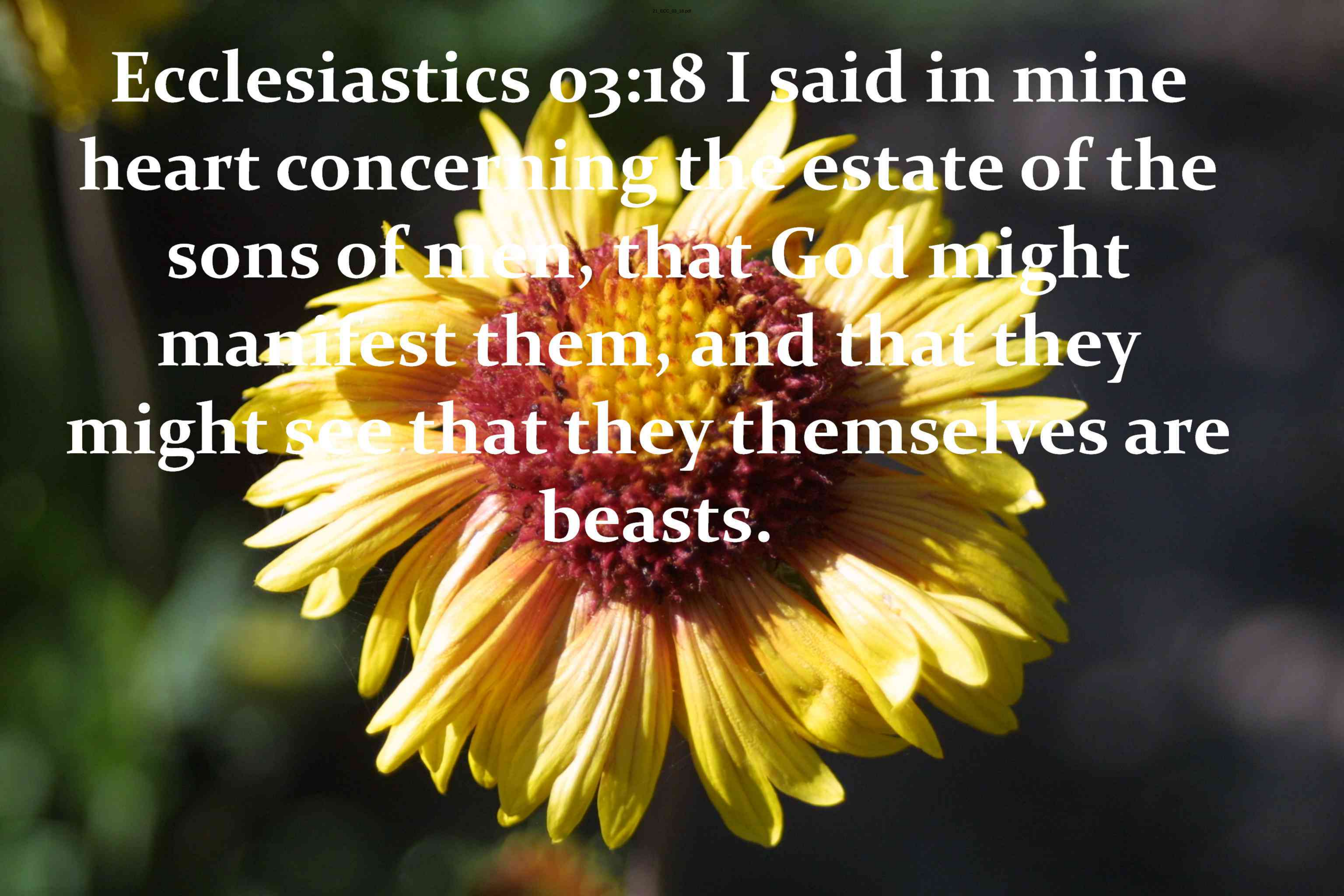
Ecclesiastics 03:16 And moreover I

purpose and for every work.

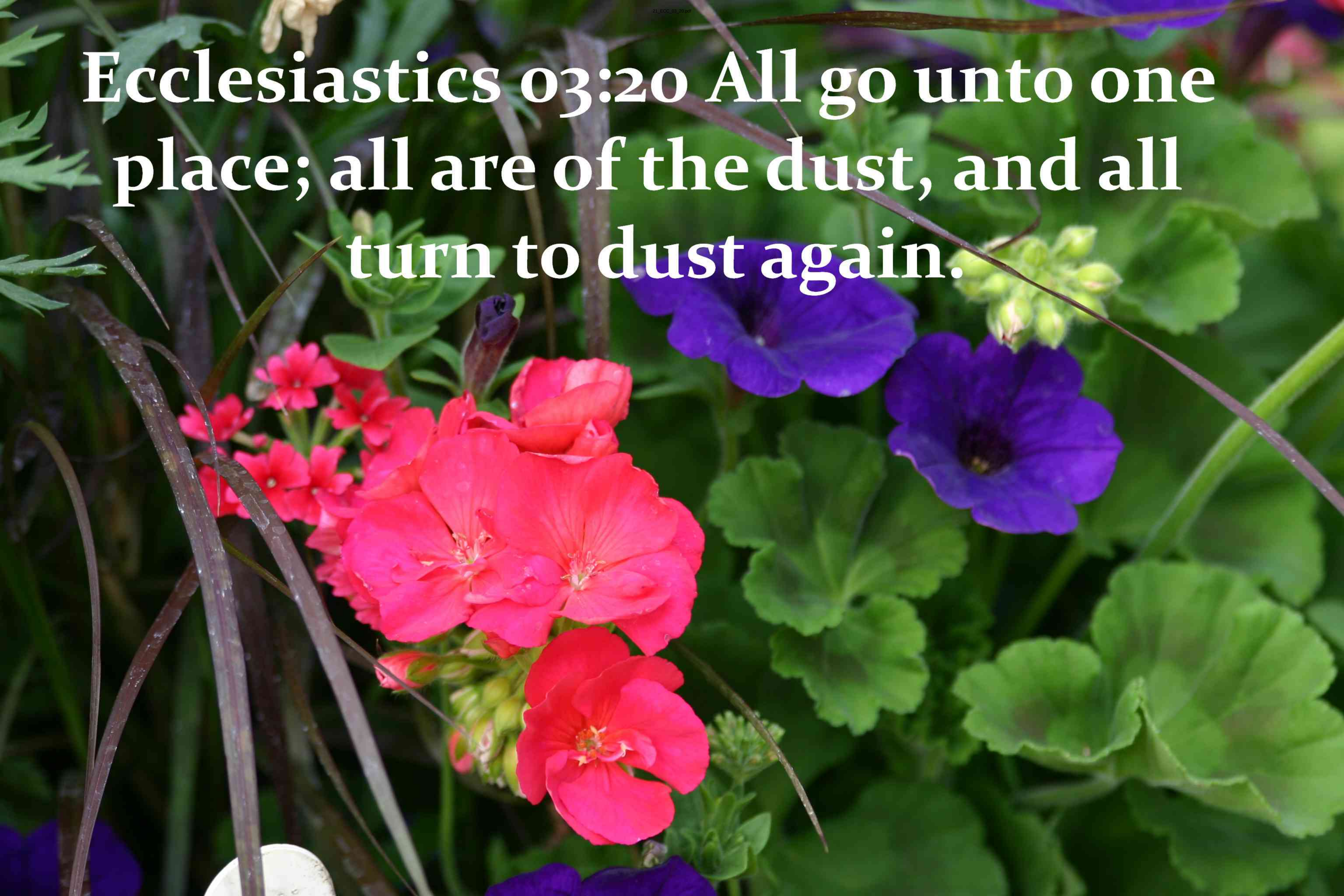


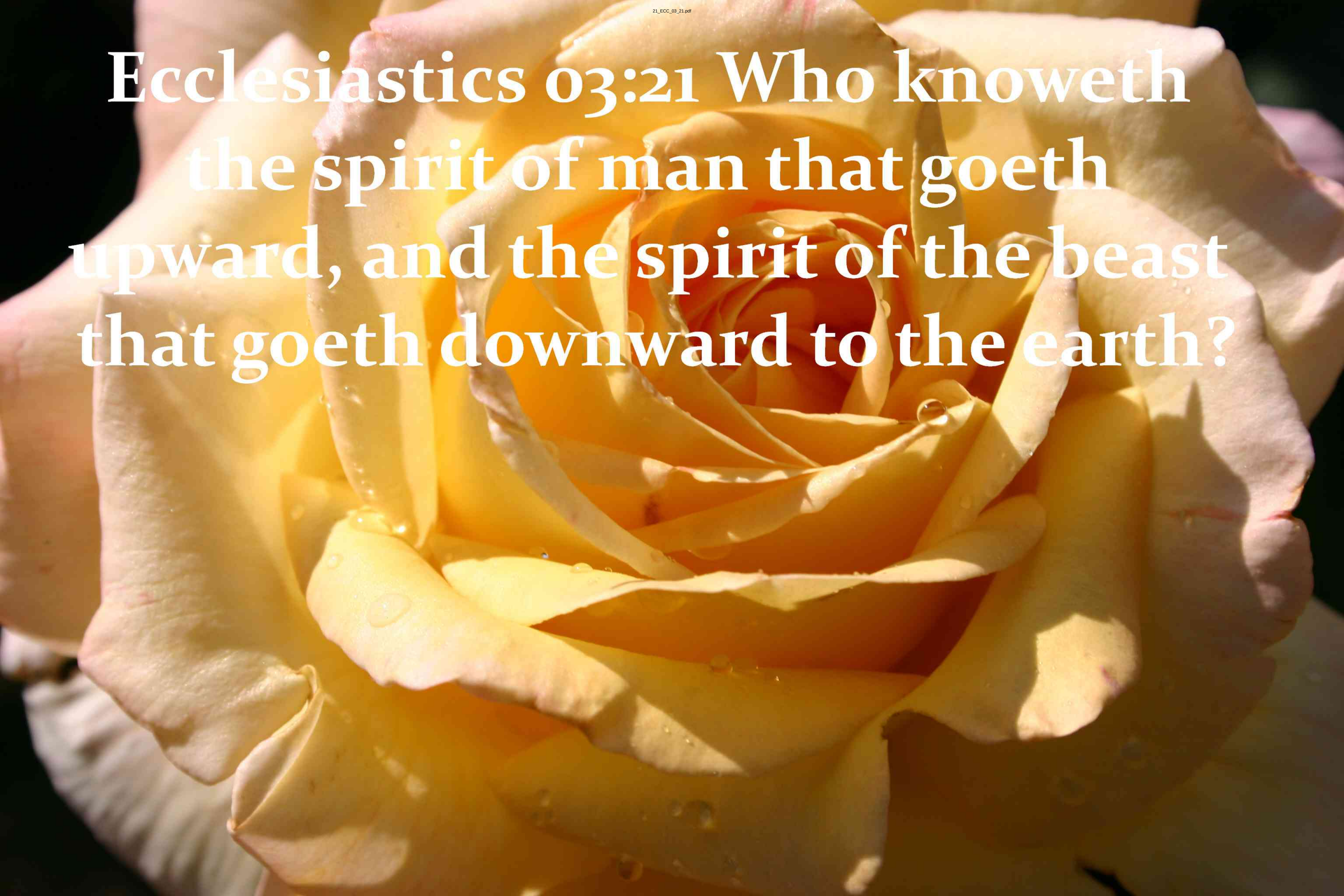
**Ecclesiastics 03:18 I said in mine

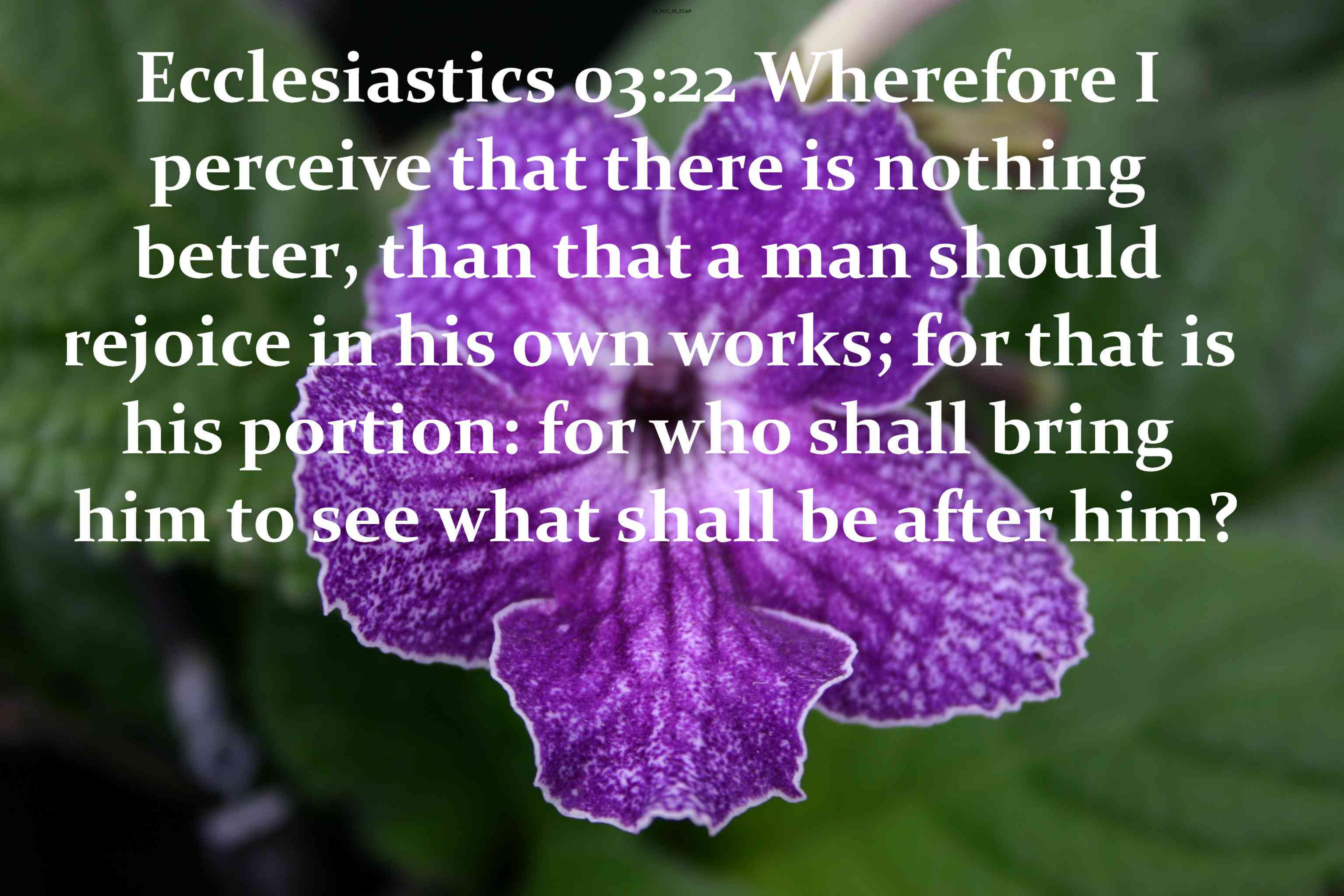
