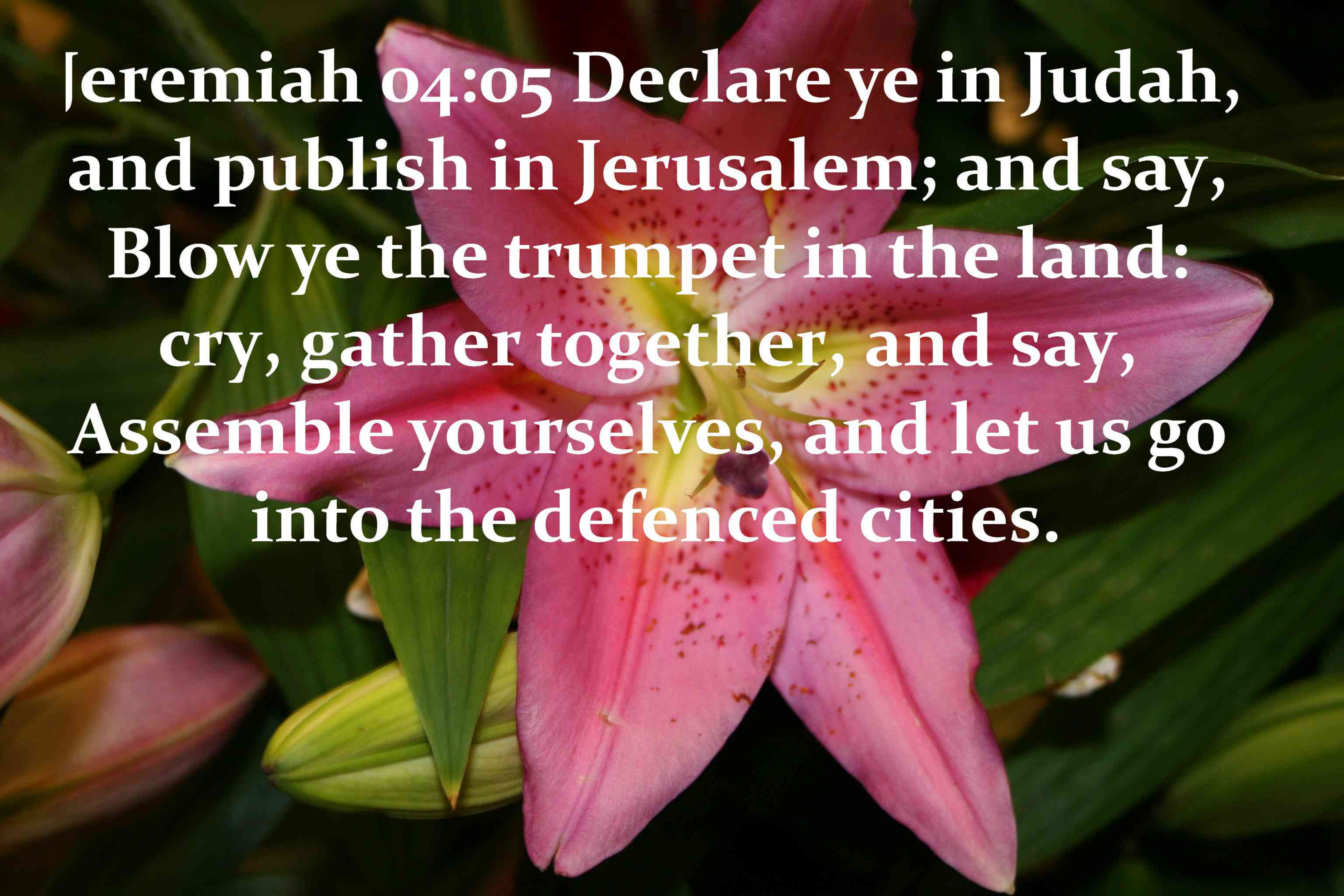


eremiah 04:01 If thou wilt return, O

into the defenced cities.

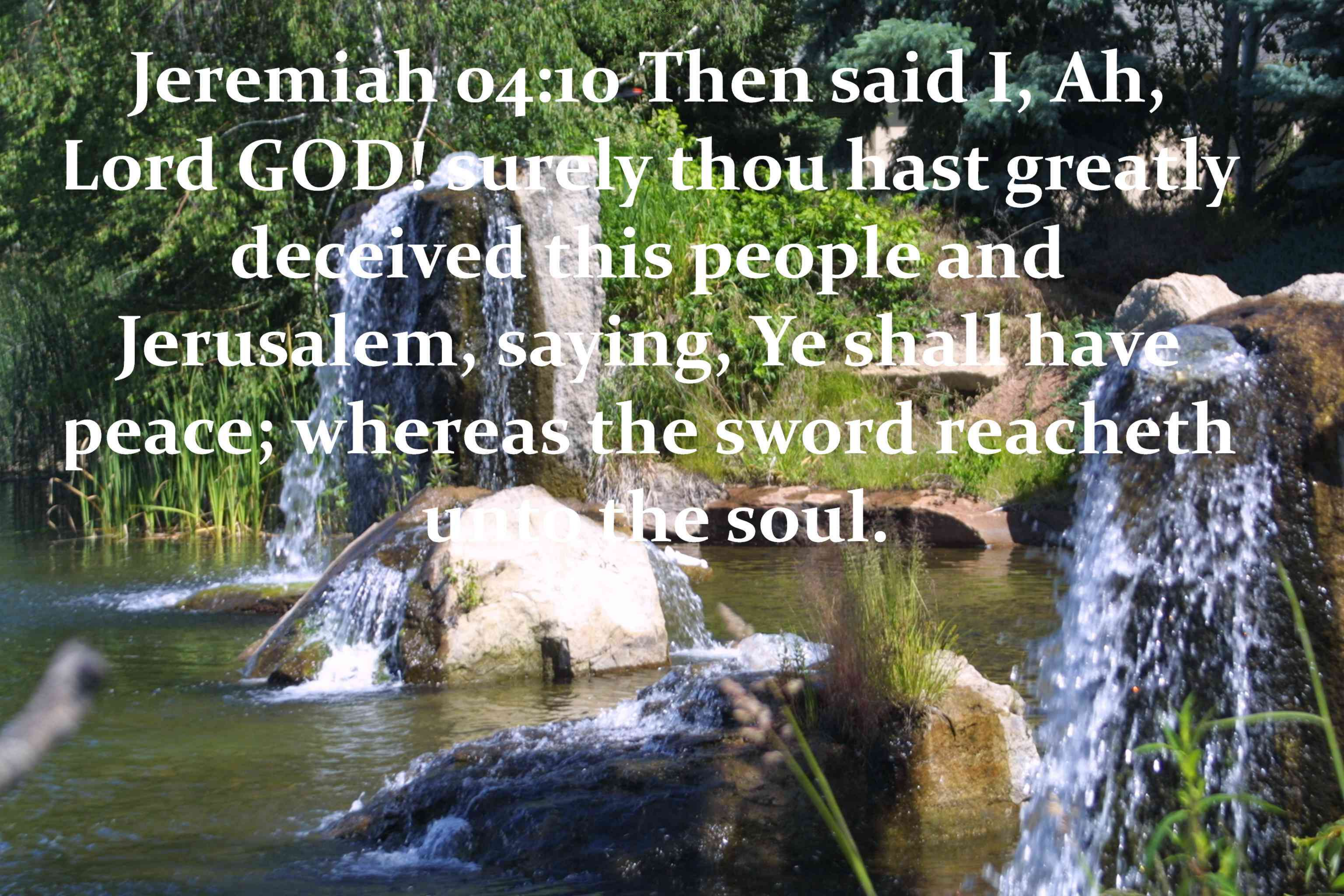
Jeremiah 04:06 Set up the standard

inhabitant.

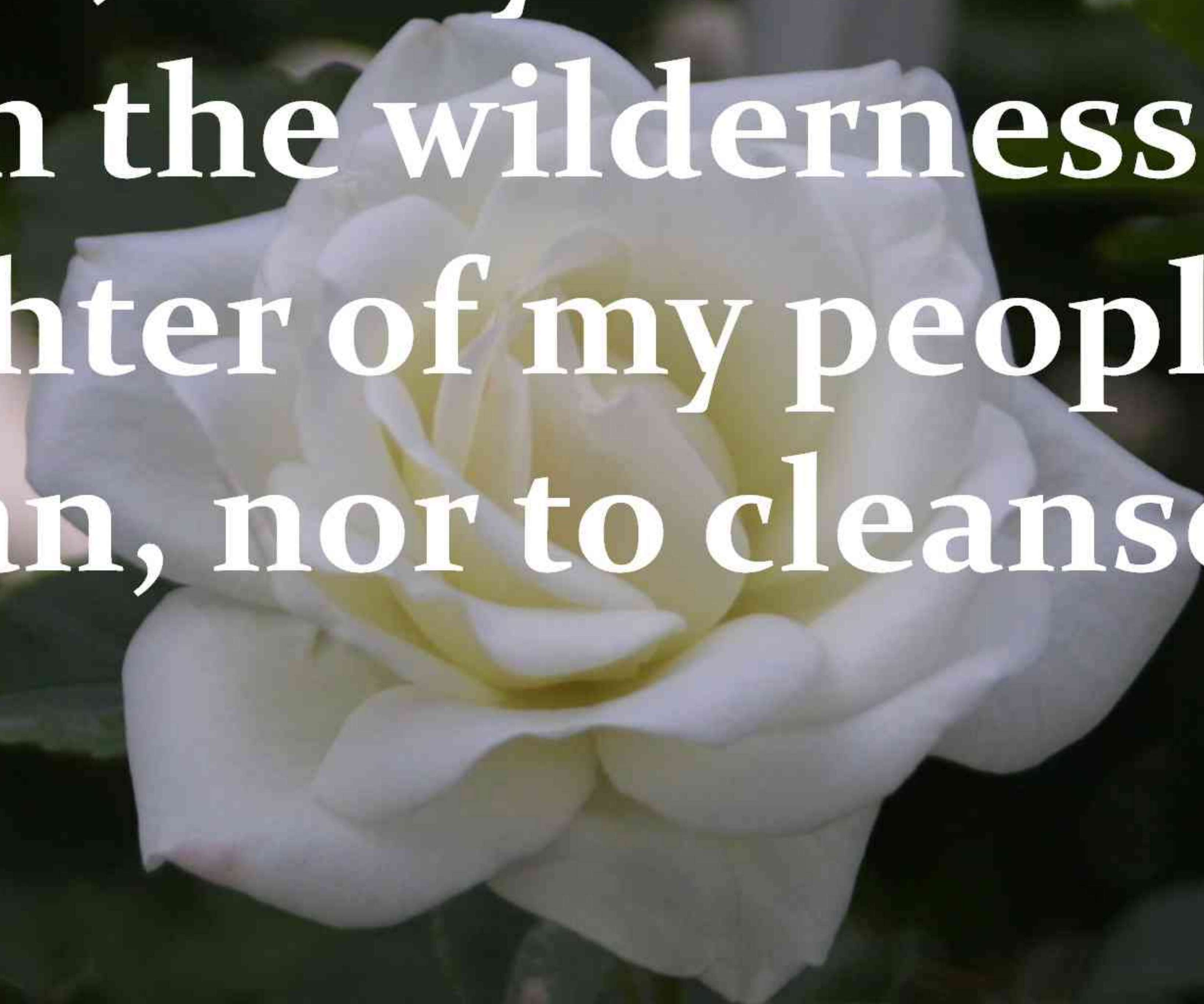
Jeremiah 04:08 For this gird you

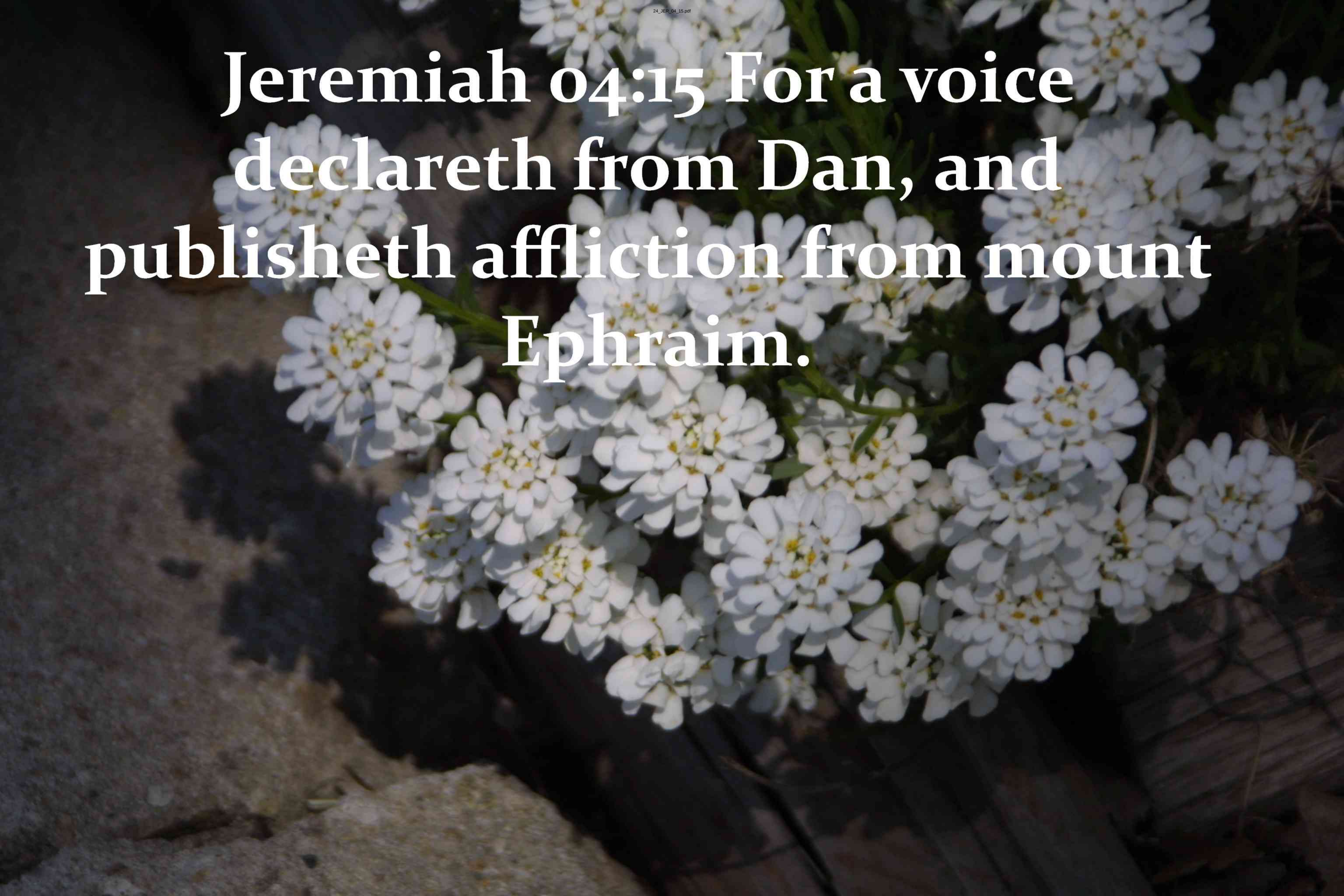
Jeremiah 04:12 Even a full wind

against them.

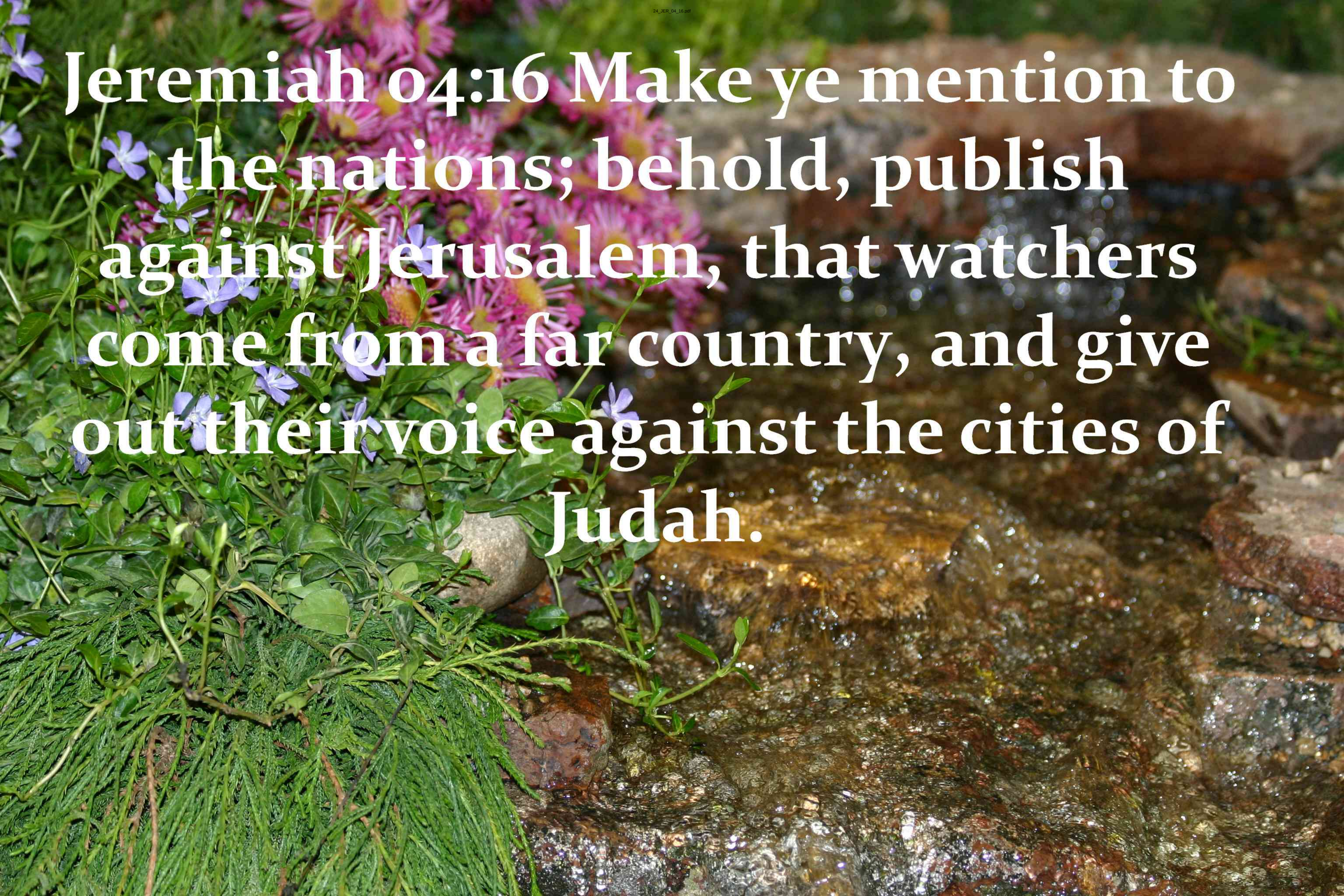


Jeremiah 04:13 Behold, he shall

within thee?

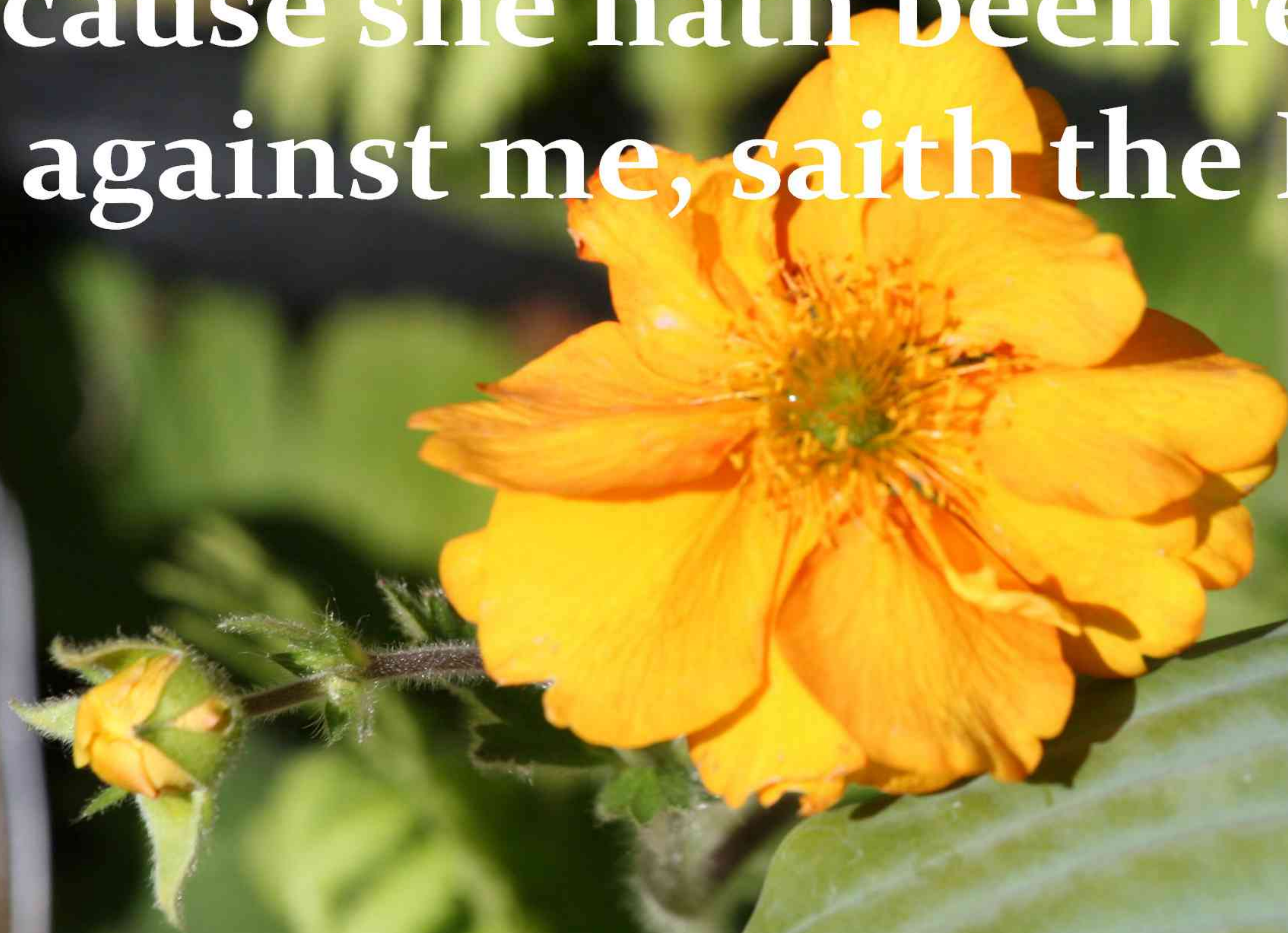
Jeremiah 04:15 For a voice

Ephraim.



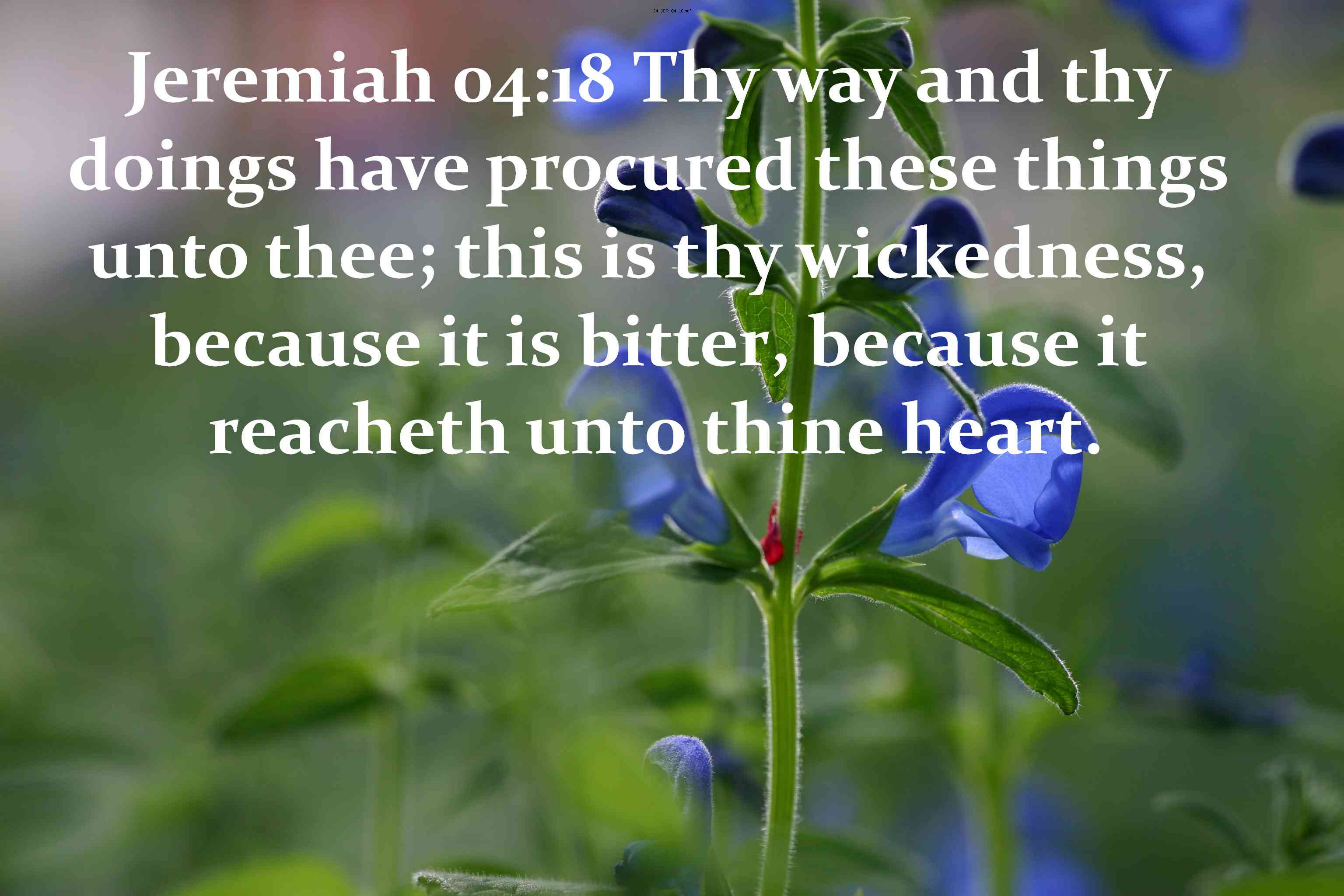


Jeremiah 04:16 Make ye mention to

Judah.

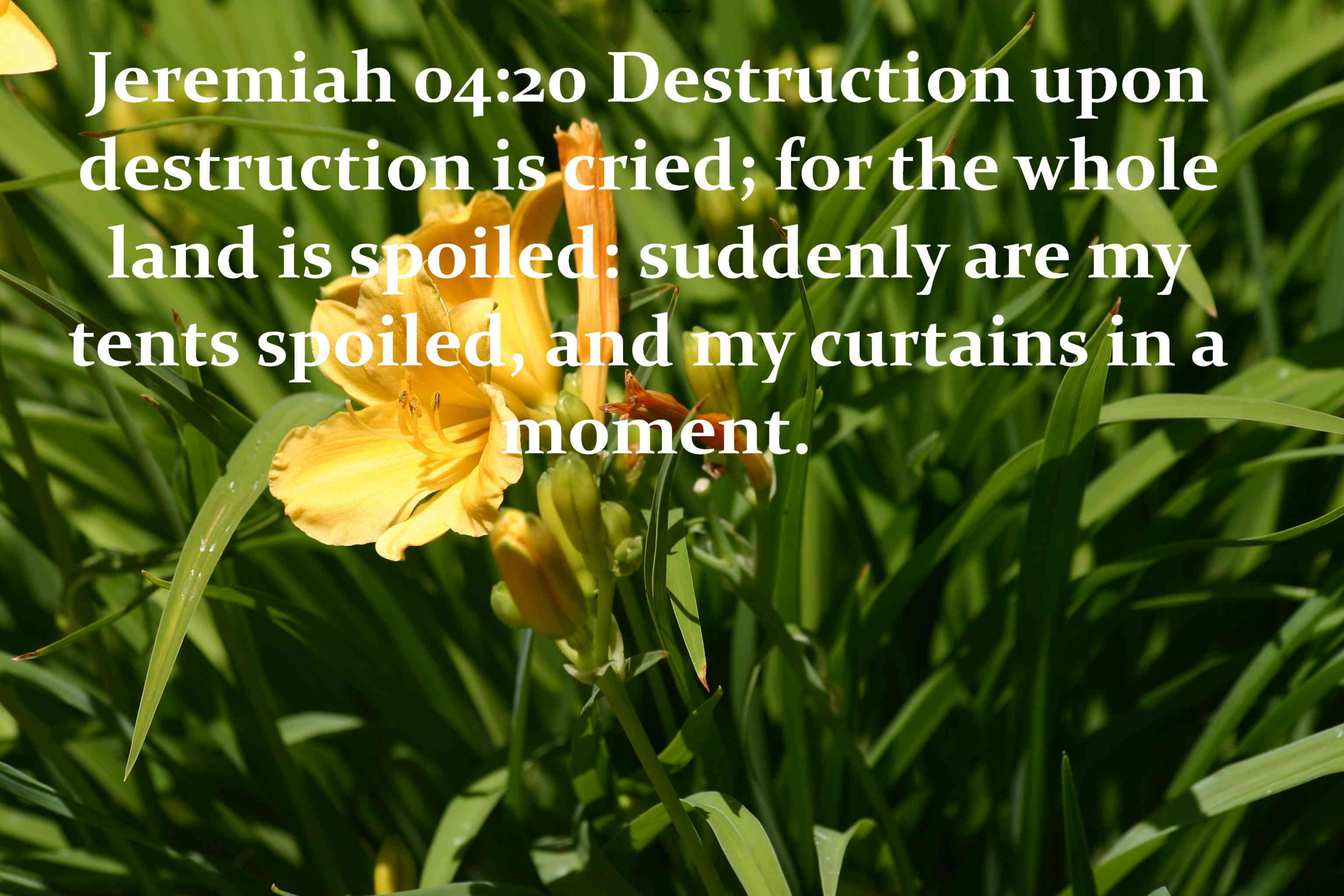
Jeremiah 04:17 As keepers of a field,

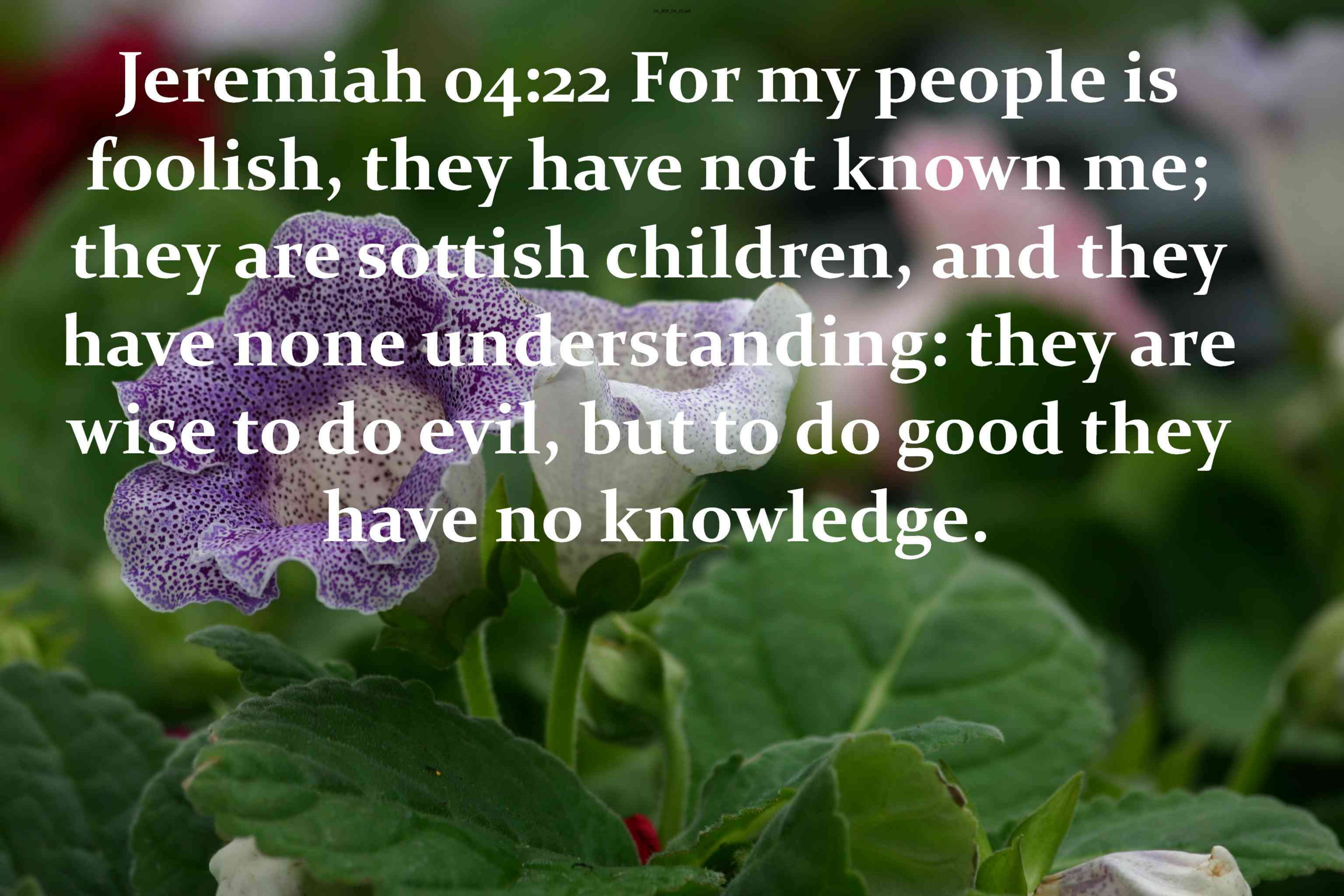


Jeremiah 04:20 Destruction upon

moment.

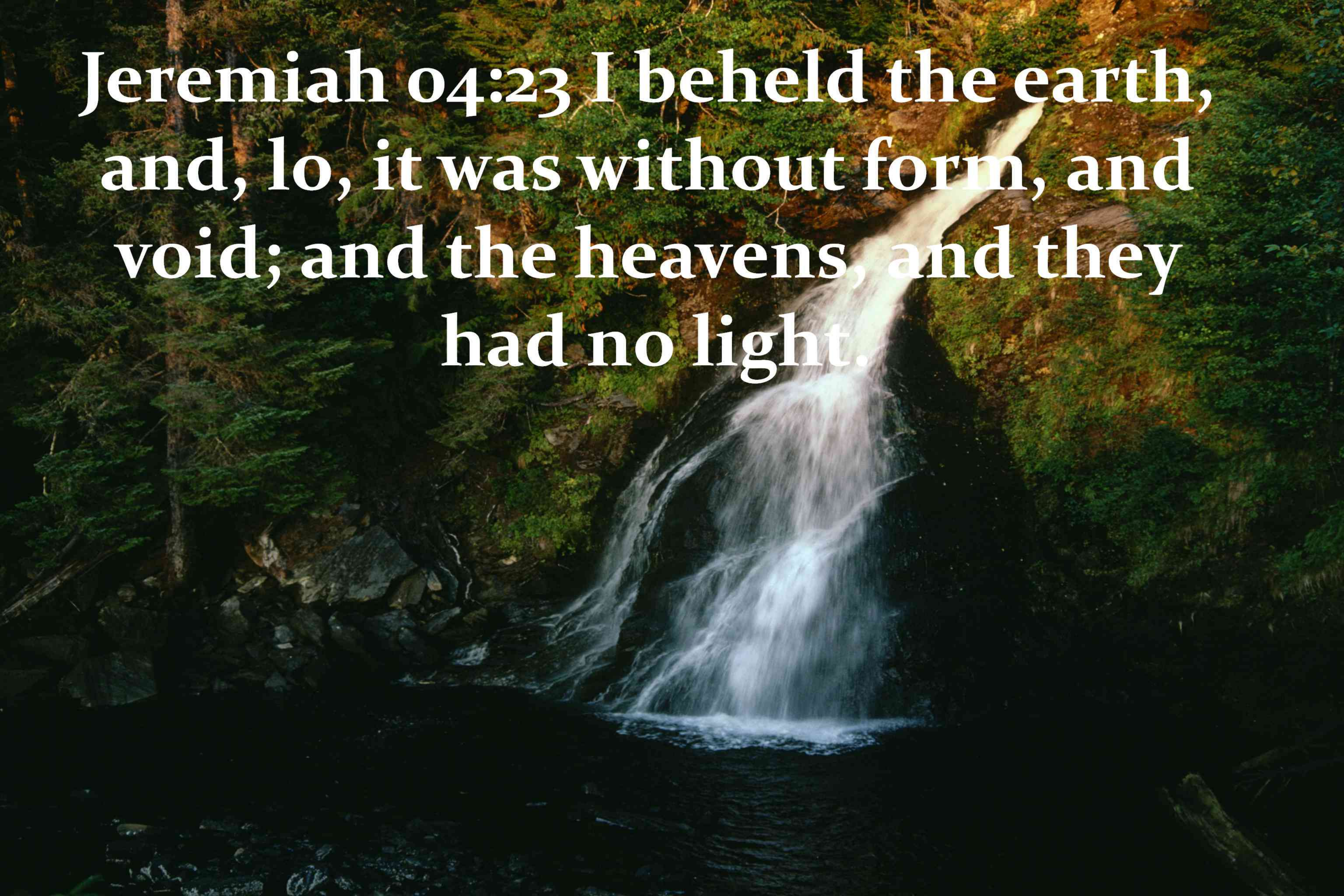
Jeremiah 04:21 How long shall I see

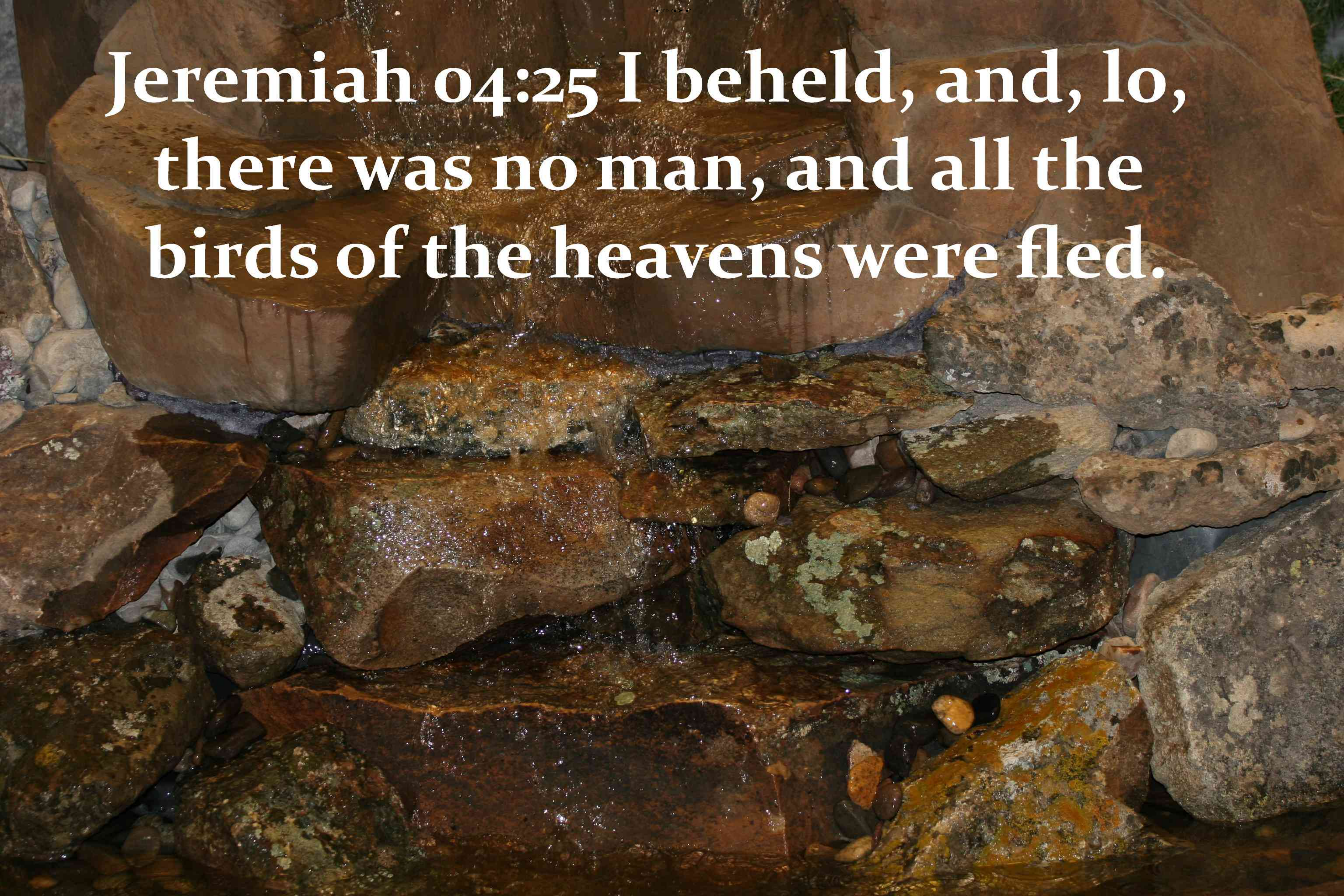
Jeremiah 04:23 I beheld the earth,

had no light.

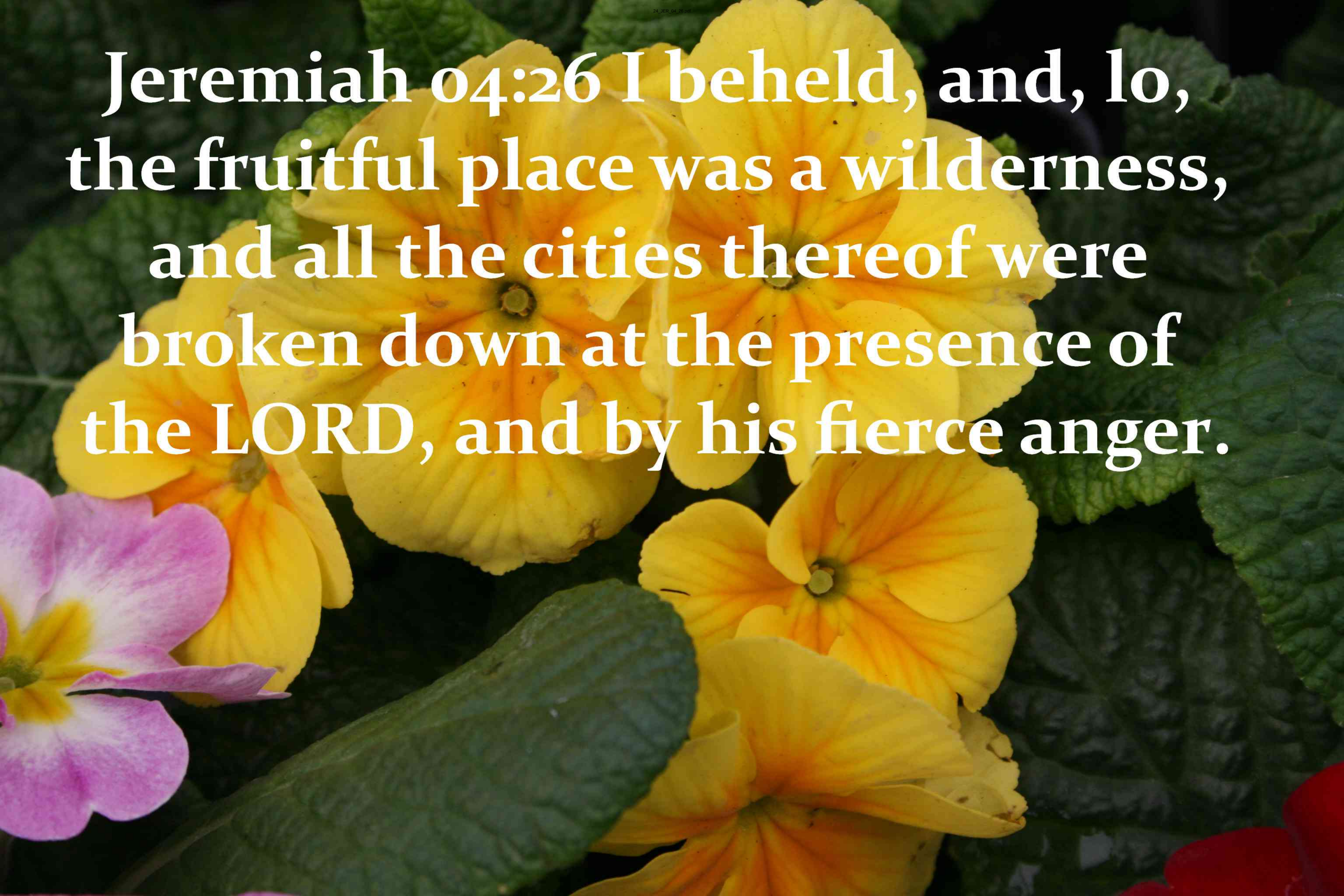


Jeremiah 04:24 I beheld the

Jeremiah 04:30 And when thou art spoiled, what wilt thou do? Though thou clothest thyself with crimson, though thou deckest thee with ornaments of gold, though thou rentest thy face with painting, in vain shalt thou make thyself fair; thy lovers will despise thee, they will seek thy life.

Jeremiah 04:31 For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, and the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, that bewaileth herself, that spreadeth her hands, saying , Woe is me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.
