saying,






Jeremiah 11:02 Hear ye the words of
this covenant, and speak unto the
men of Judah, and to the
inhabitants of Jerusalem;

Jeremiah 11:03 And say thou unto
them, Thus saith the LORD God of
Israel; Cursed be the man that

covenant,

Jeremiah 11:04 Which I
commanded your fathers in the
day that I brought them forth out
of the land of Egypt, from the iron
furnace, saying, Obey my voice,
and do them, according to all
which I command you: so shall ye
be my people, and I will be your
God:

Jeremiah 11:05 That I may perform
the oath which I have sworn unto
your fathers, to give them a land
flowing with milk and honey, as it
is this day. Then answered I, and
said, So be it, O LORD.

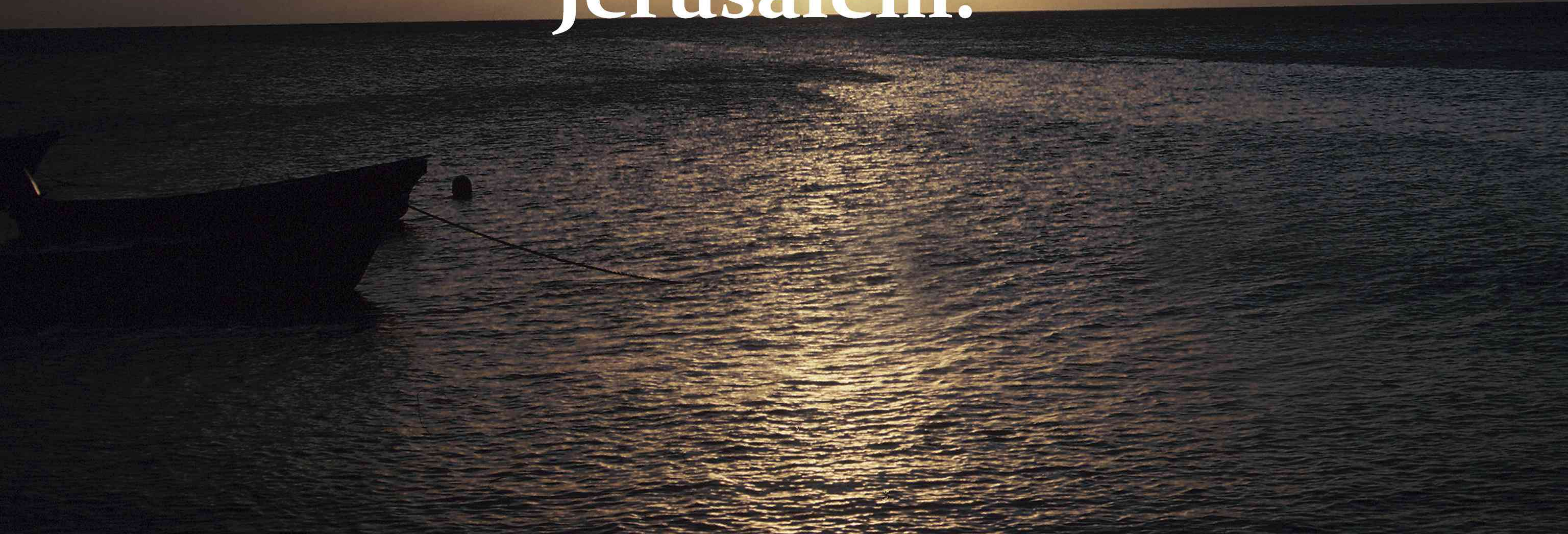




Jeremiah 11:07 For I earnestly

Jeremiah 11:08 Yet they obeyed not,
nor inclined their ear, but walked
every one in the imagination of
their evil heart: therefore I will
bring upon them all the words of
this covenant, which I
commanded them to do; but they
did them not.


Jeremiah 11:09 And the LORD said
unto me, A conspiracy is found
among the men of Judah, and

Jerusalem.





in the time of their trouble.



Jeremiah 11:16 The LORD called thy name, A green olive tree, fair, and of goodly fruit: with the noise of a great tumult he hath kindled fire upon it, and the branches of it are broken.



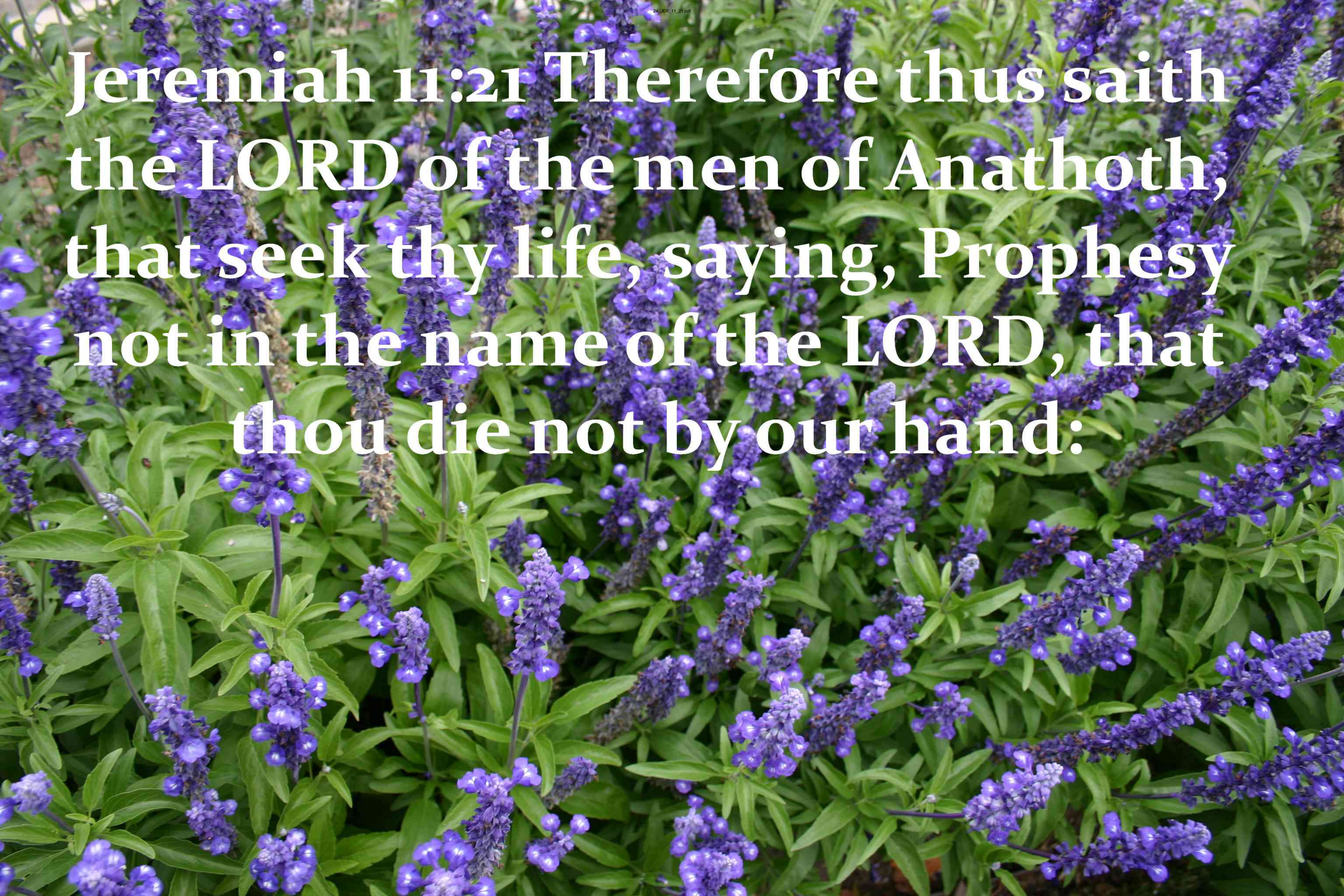
Jeremiah 11:17 For the LORD of hosts, that planted thee, hath pronounced evil against thee, for the evil of the house of Israel and of the house of Judah, which they have done against themselves to provoke me to anger in offering incense unto Baal.

Jeremiah 11:18 And the LORD hath

know it : then thou showedst me
their doings.

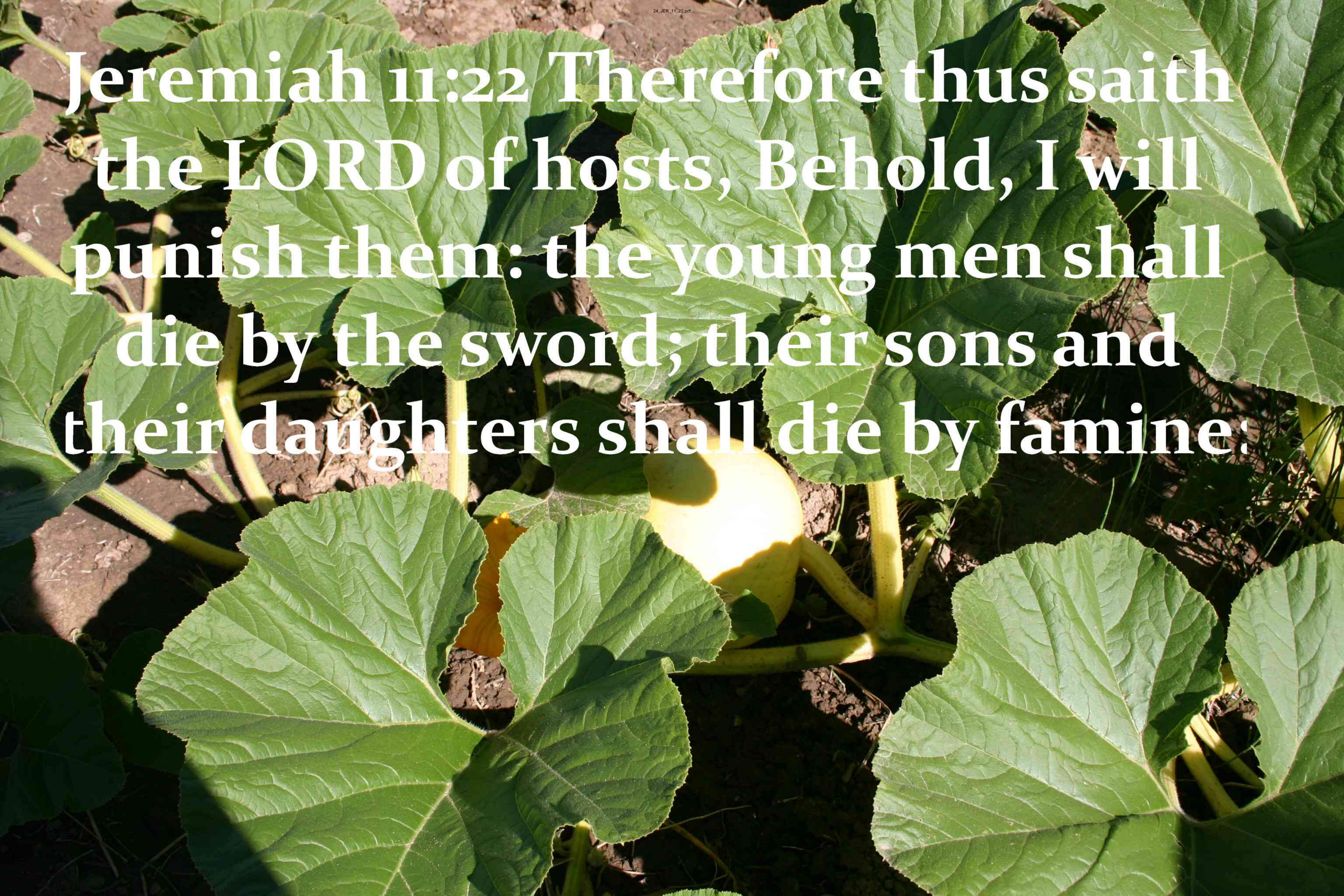


**Jeremiah 11:19 But I was like a lamb

hosts, that judgest righteously,
that triest the reins and the heart,
let me see thy vengeance on them:
for unto thee have I revealed my

the LORD of the men of Anathoth,
that seek thy life, saying, Prophecy
not in the name of the LORD, that
thou die not by our hand:



Jeremiah 11:22 Therefore thus saith
the LORD of hosts, Behold, I will
punish them: the young men shall
die by the sword; their sons and
their daughters shall die by famine:

Jeremiah 11:23 And there shall be
no remnant of them: for I will
bring evil upon the men of
Anathoth, even the year of their
visitation.
