


Jeremiah 19:01 Thus saith the  
LORD, Go and get a potter's  
earthen bottle, and take of the  
ancients of the people, and of the  
ancients of the priests;





Jeremiah 19:02 And go forth unto  
the valley of the son of Hinnom,  
which is by the entry of the east  
gate, and proclaim there the words  
that I shall tell thee,



Jeremiah 19:03 And say, Hear ye the word of the LORD, O kings of Judah, and inhabitants of Jerusalem; Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, the which whosoever heareth, his ears shall tingle.



Jeremiah 19:04 Because they have forsaken me, and have estranged this place, and have burned incense in it unto other gods, whom neither they nor their fathers have known, nor the kings of Judah, and have filled this place with the blood of innocents;



Jeremiah 19:05 They have built also  
the high places of Baal, to burn  
their sons with fire for burnt  
offerings unto Baal, which I  
commanded not, nor spake it,  
neither came it into my mind:




Jeremiah 19:06 Therefore, behold,  
the days come, saith the LORD,  
that this place shall no more be  
called Tophet, nor The valley of  
the son of Hinnom, but The valley  
of slaughter.



**Jeremiah 19:07 And I will make void the counsel of Judah and Jerusalem in this place; and I will cause them to fall by the sword before their enemies, and by the hands of them that seek their lives: and their carcasses will I give to be meat for the fowls of the heaven, and for the beasts of the earth.**

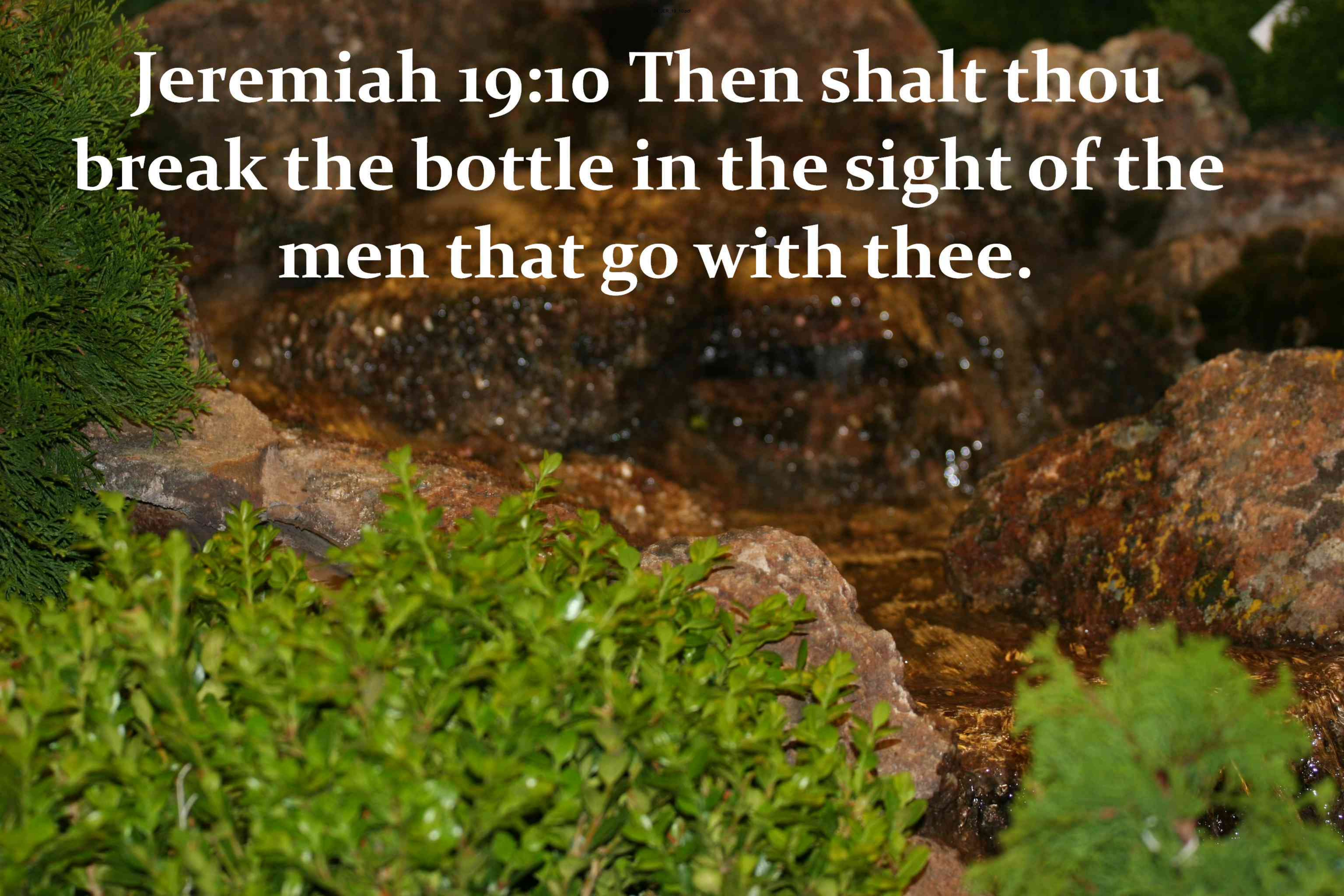
Jeremiah 19:08 And I will make

because of all the plagues thereof.




Jeremiah 19:09 And I will cause

men that go with thee.



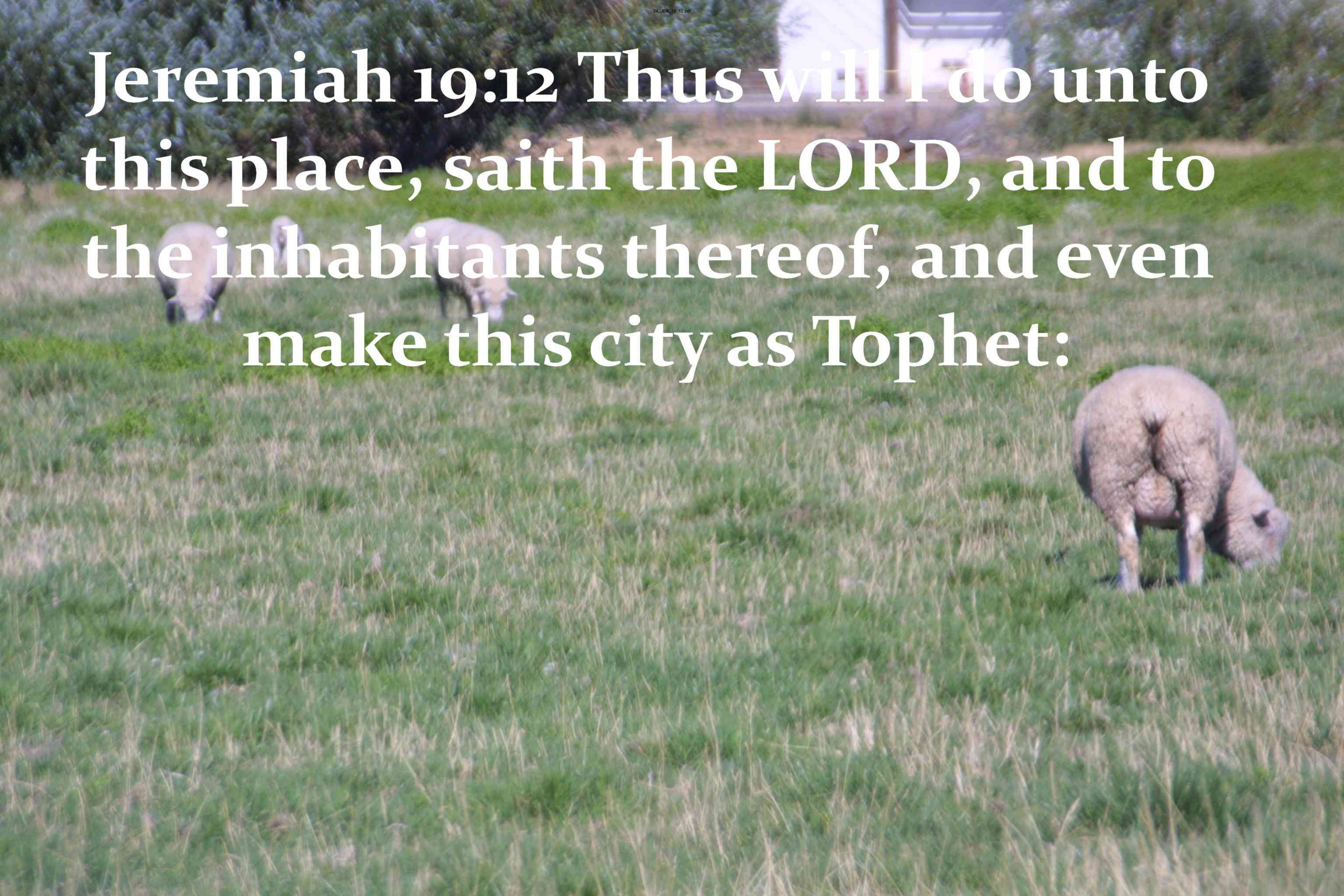

make this city as Tophet:





Jeremiah from Tophet, whither the  
LORD had sent him to prophesy;  
and he stood in the court of the  
LORD'S house; and said to all the  
people,





Jeremiah 19:15 Thus saith the  
LORD of hosts, the God of Israel;  
Behold, I will bring upon this city  
and upon all her towns all the evil  
that I have pronounced against it,  
because they have hardened their  
necks, that they might not hear my  
words.
