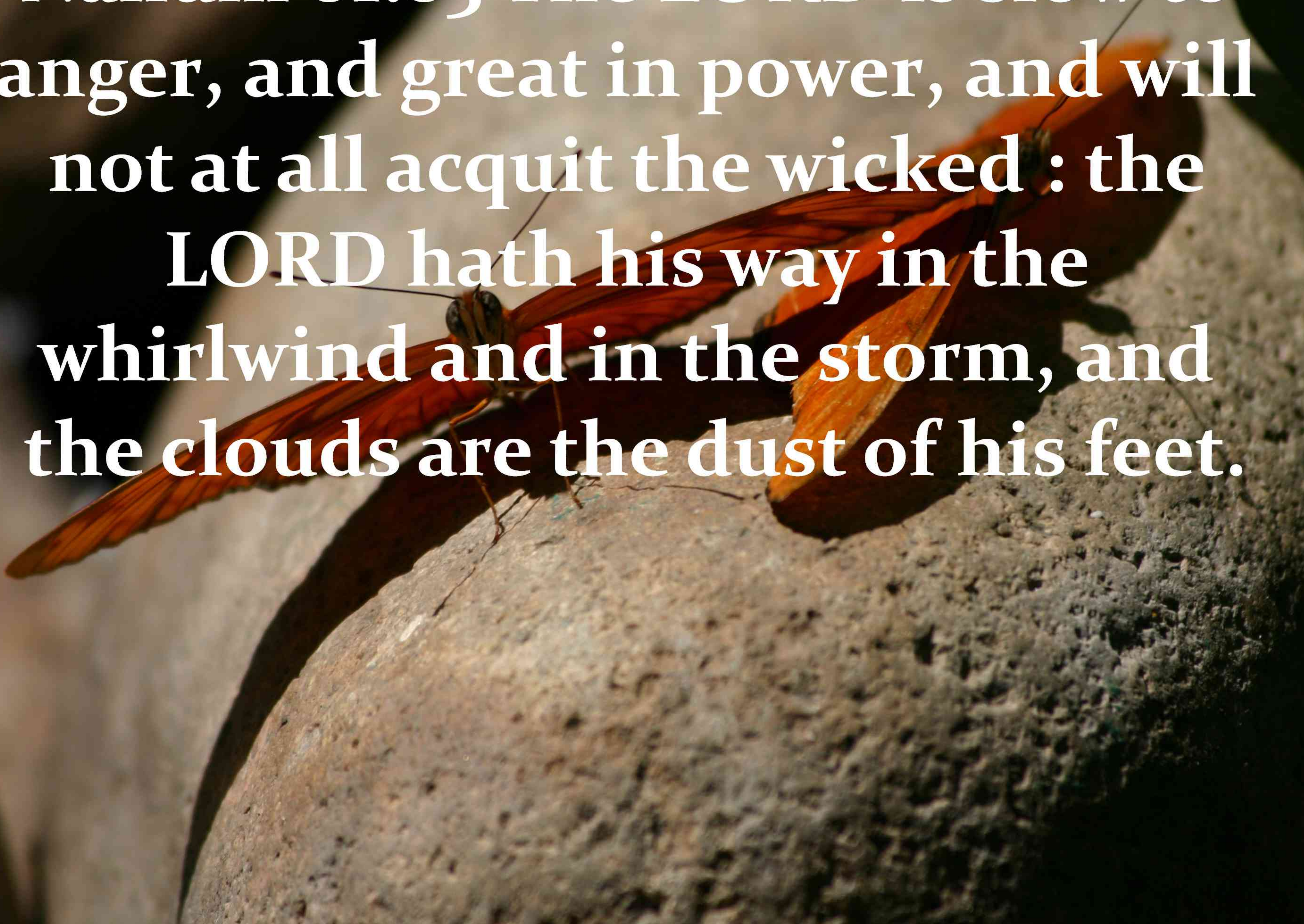


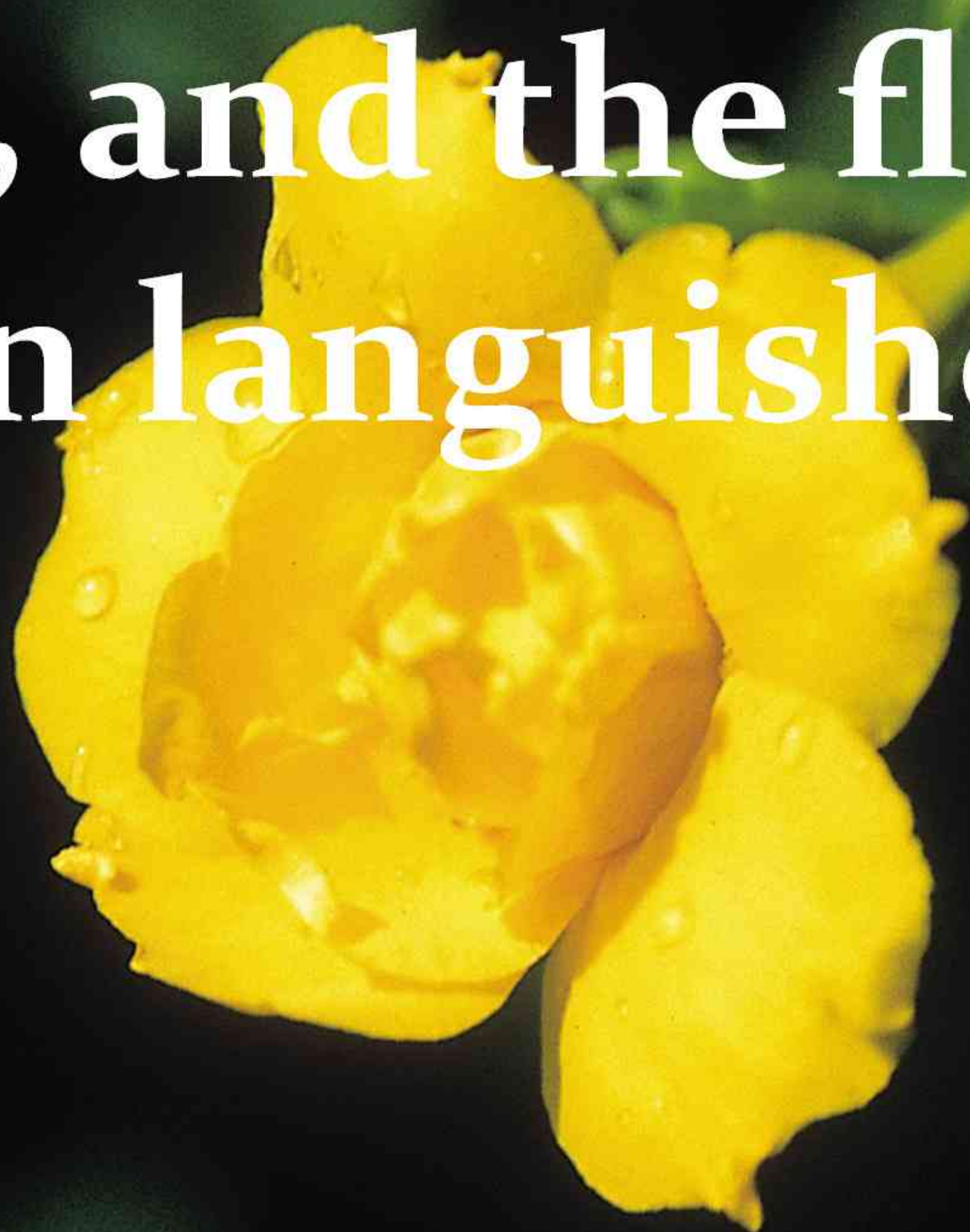
Nahum 01:01 The burden of

wrath for his enemies.

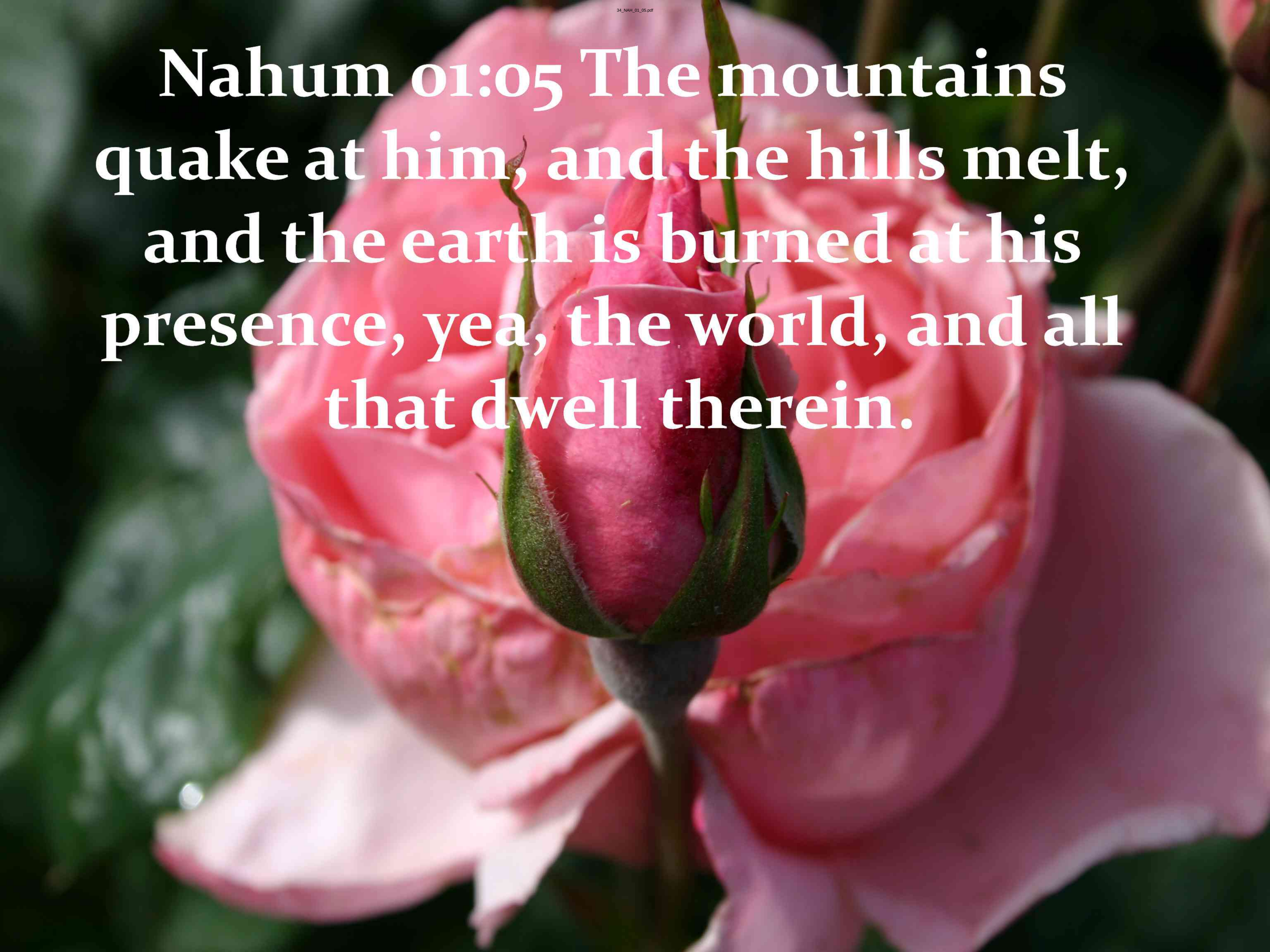

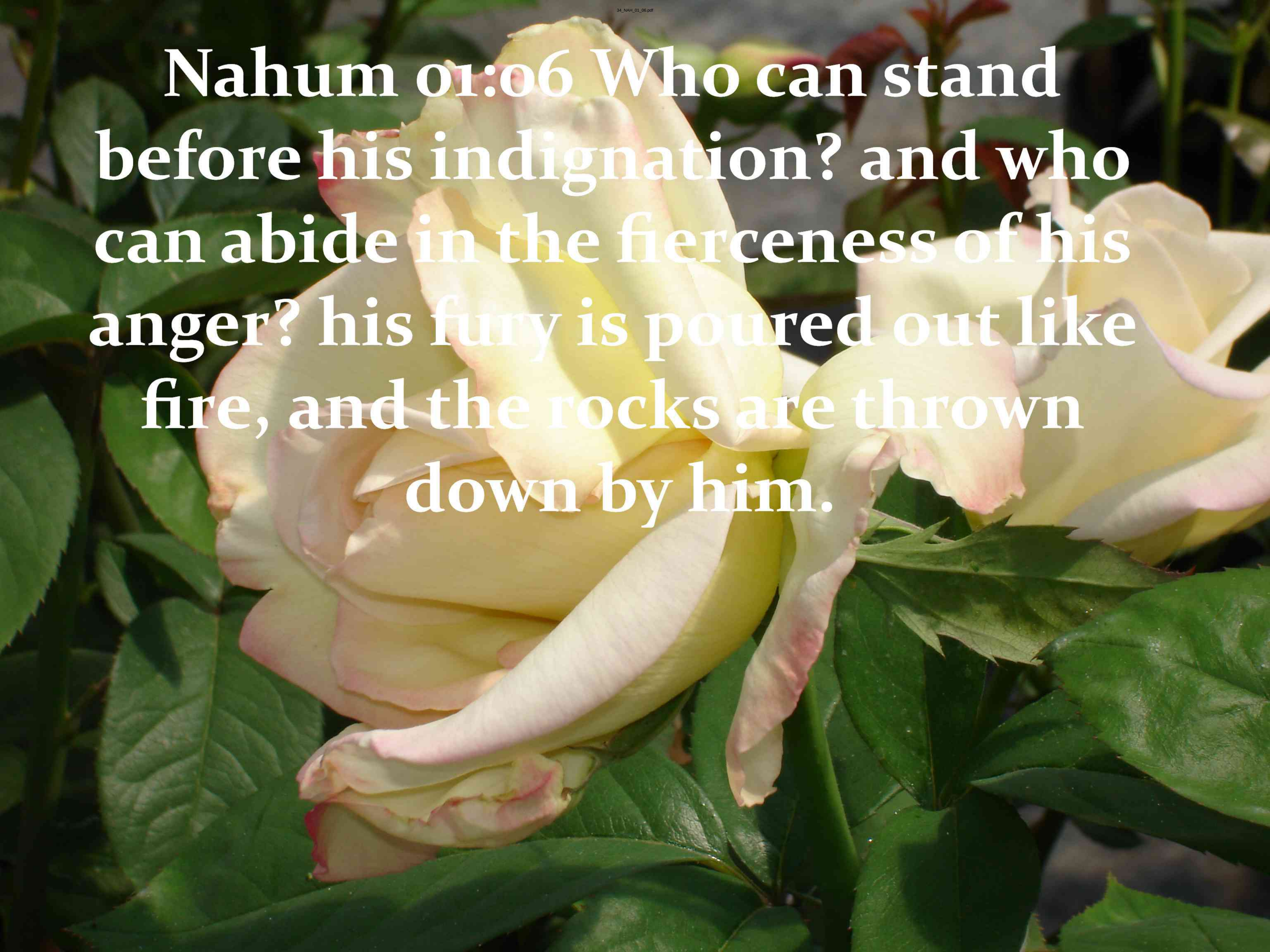

that dwell therein.**

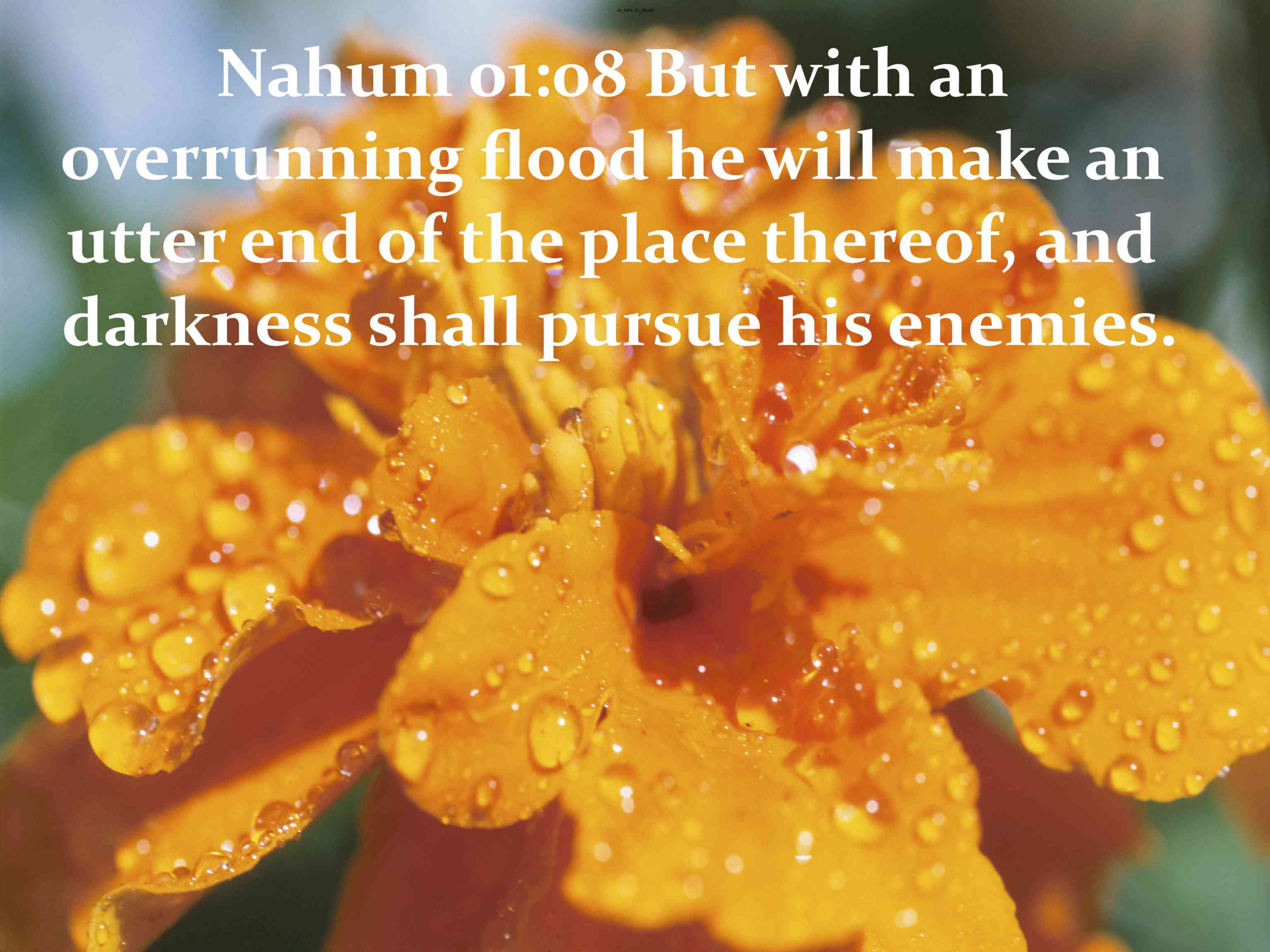




Nahum 01:06 Who can stand

down by him.

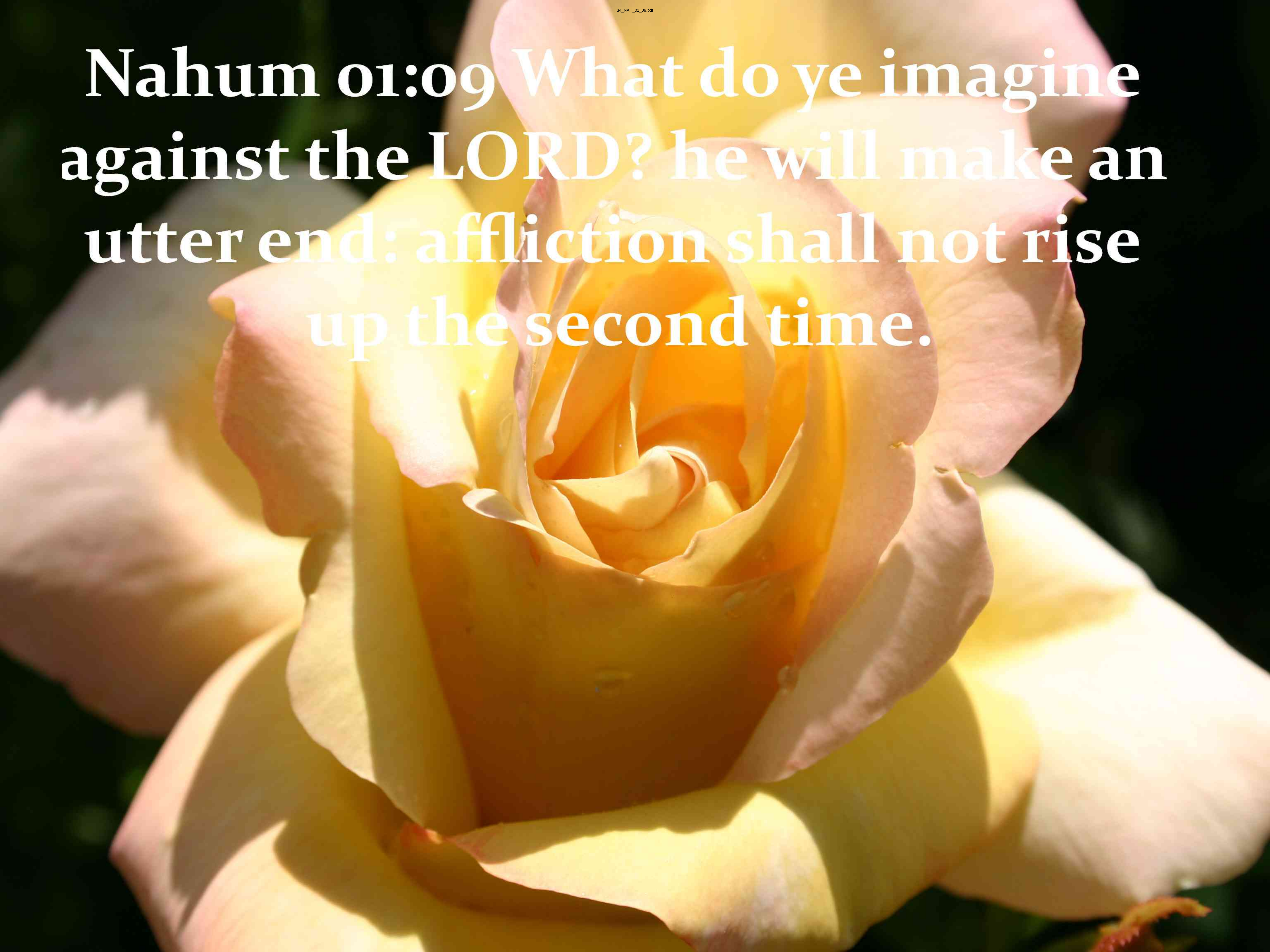
**Nahum 01:07 The LORD is good, a

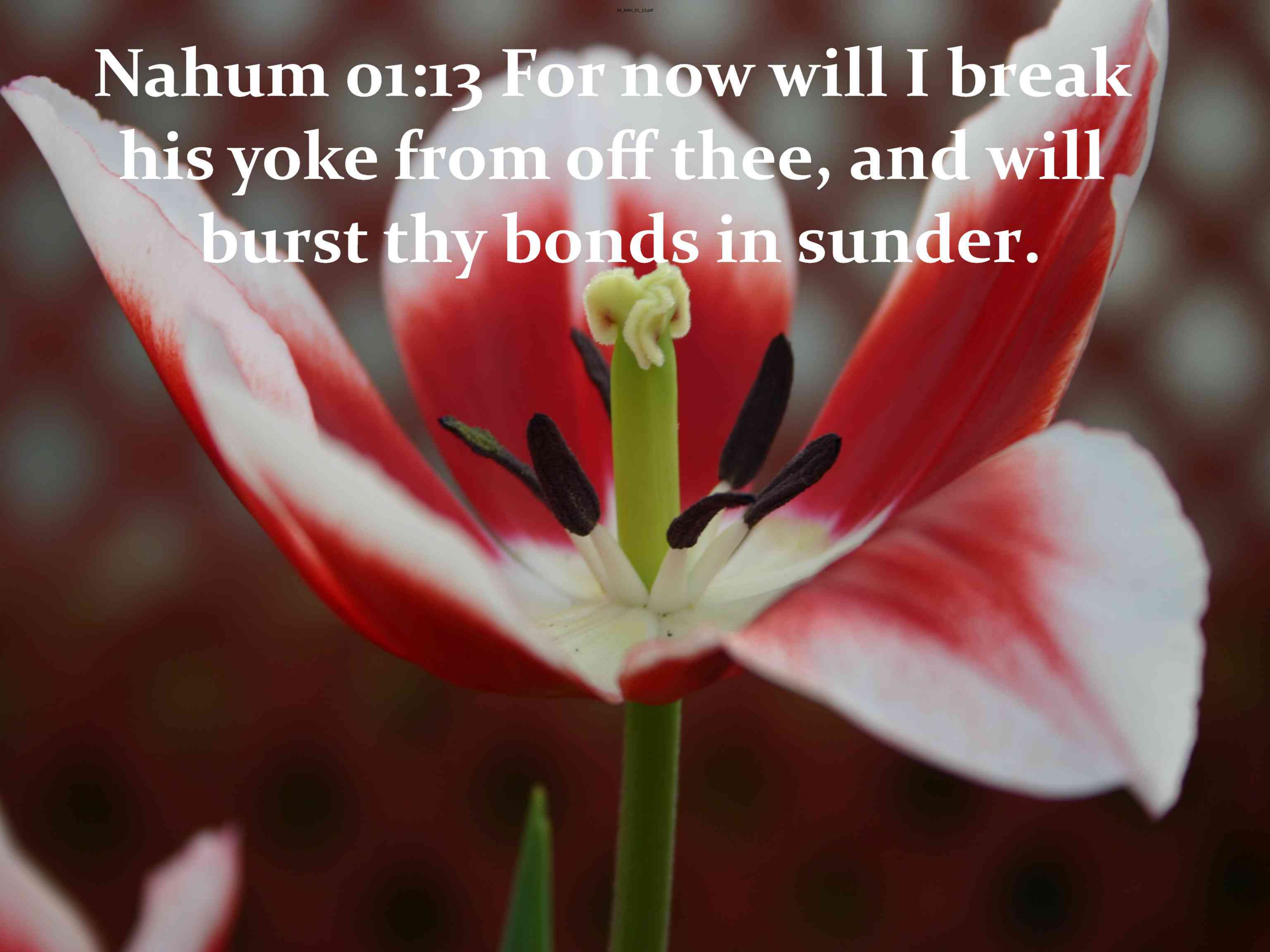
Nahum 01:10 For while they be

as stubble fully dry.



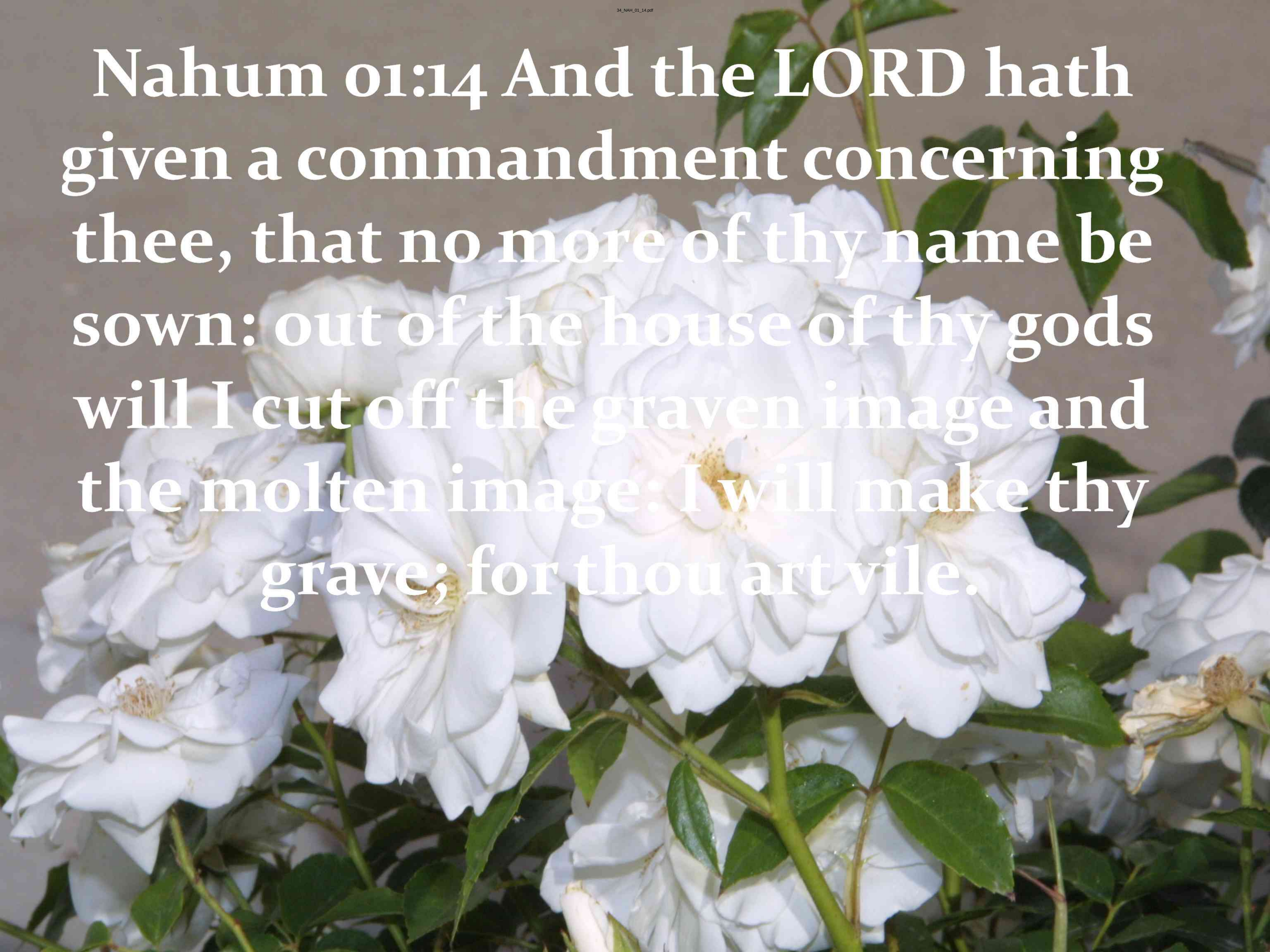
Nahum 01:11 There is one come out

counsellor.

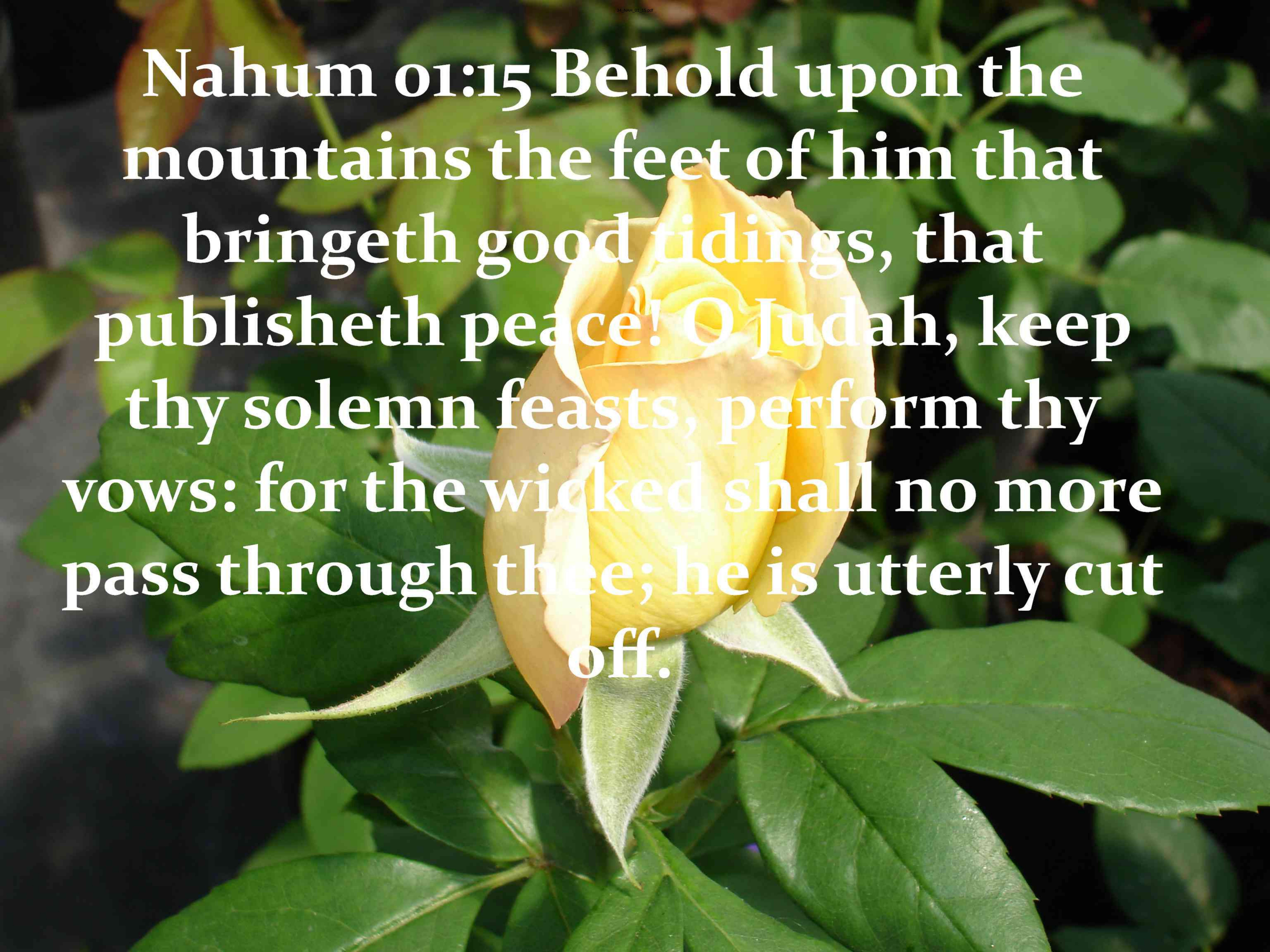
Nahum 01:12 Thus saith the LORD;
