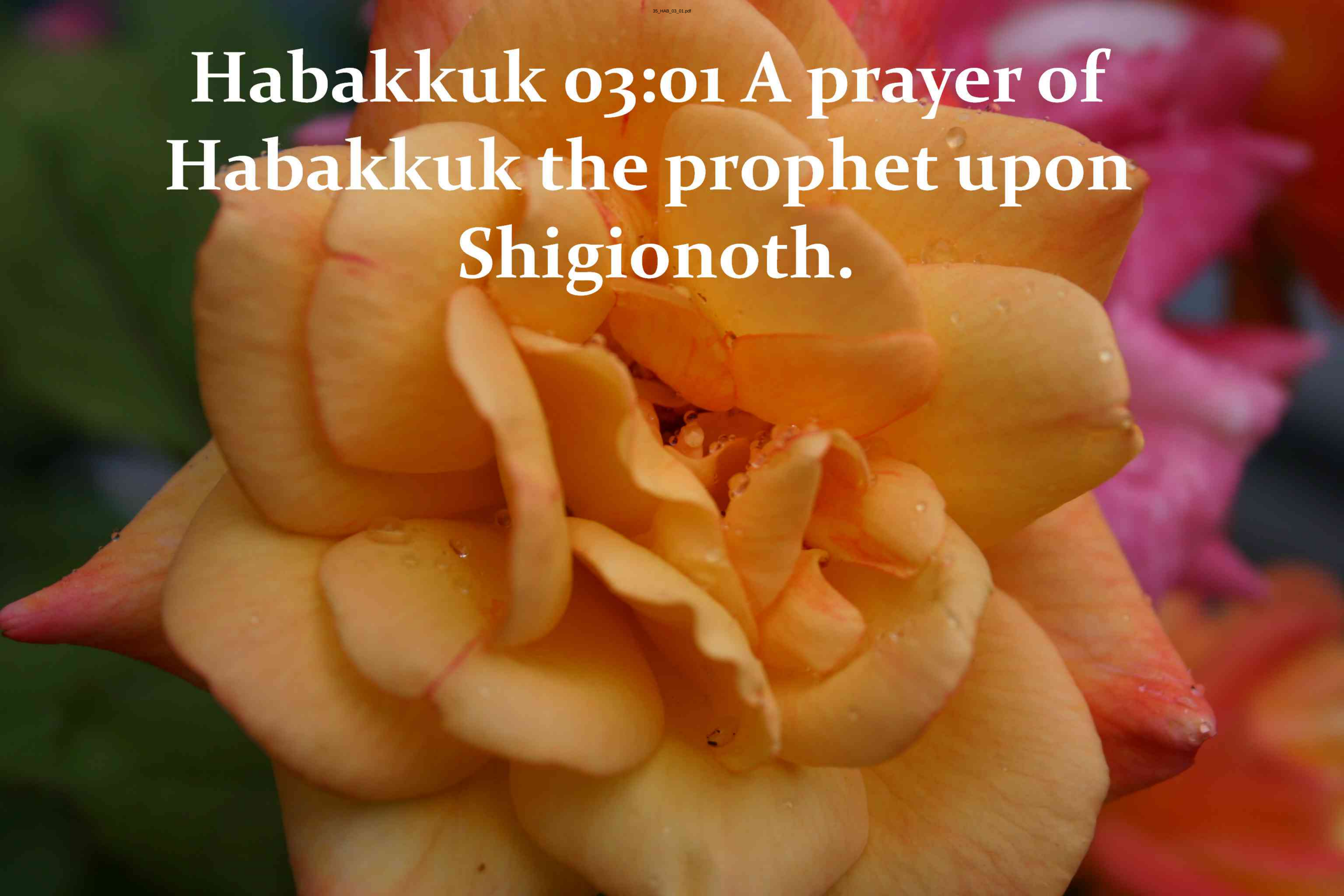


**Habakkuk 03:01 A prayer of

Shigionoth.**



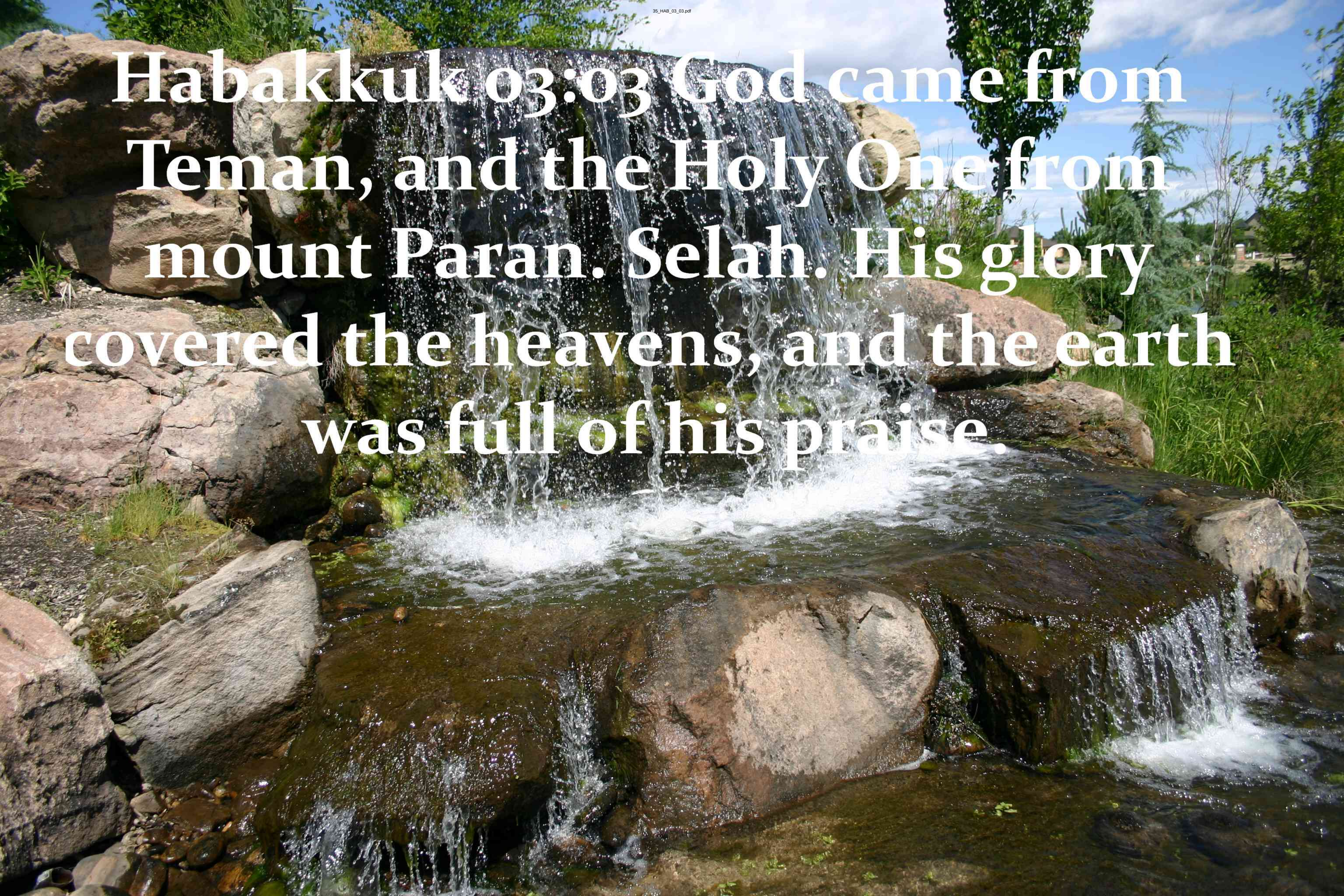

remember mercy.

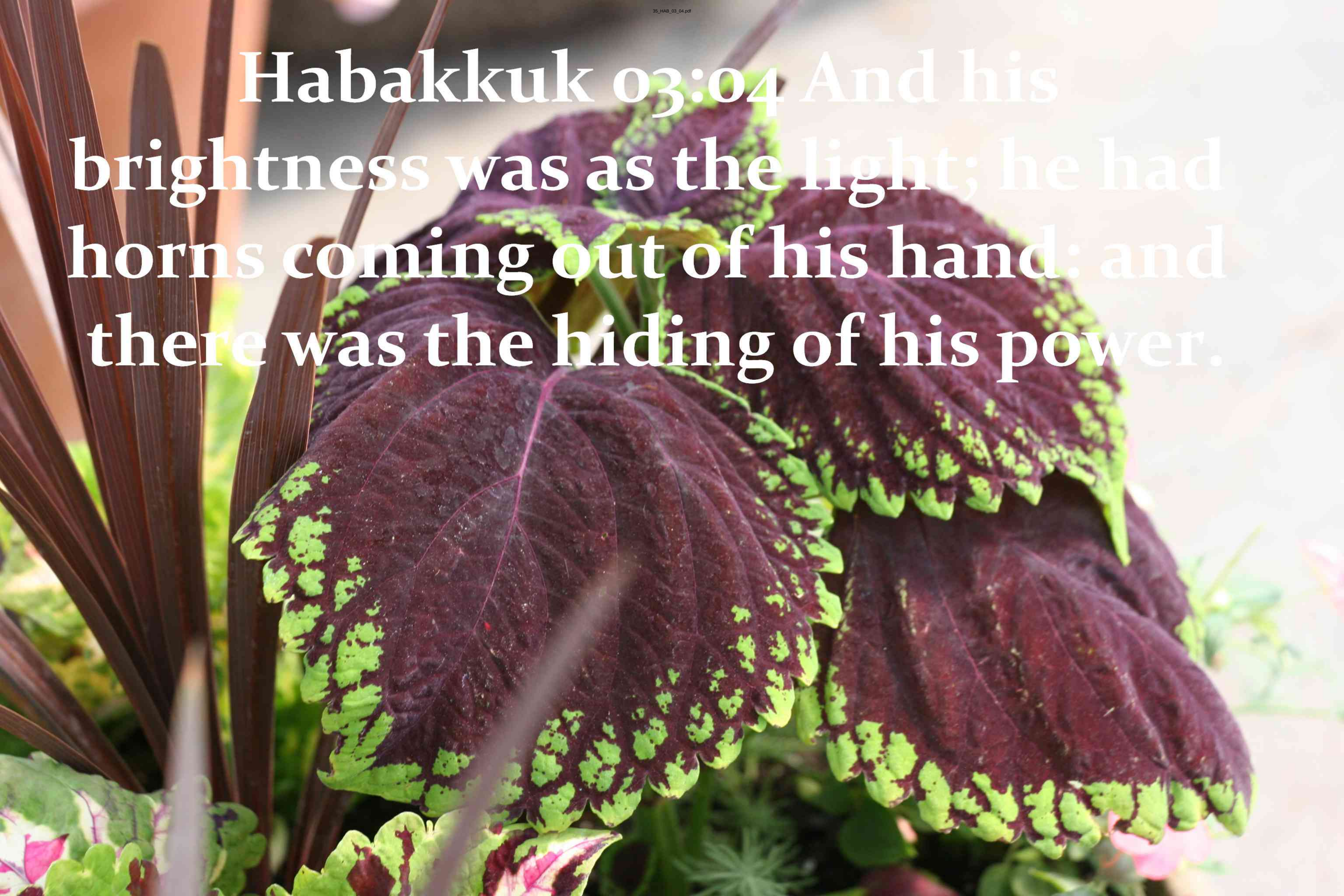


Habakkuk 03:03 God came from

was full of his praise.



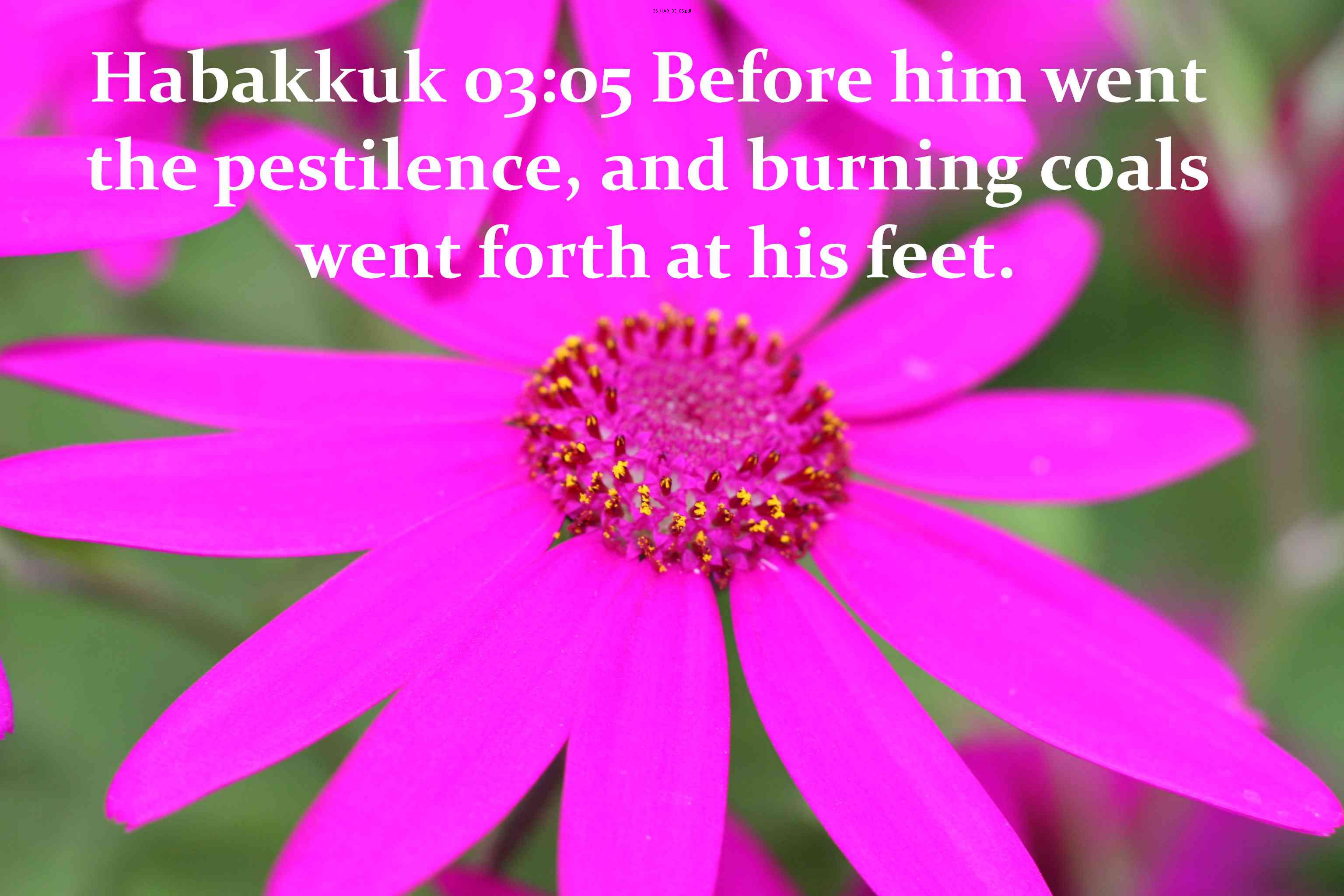


Habakkuk 03:04 And his

there was the hiding of his power.

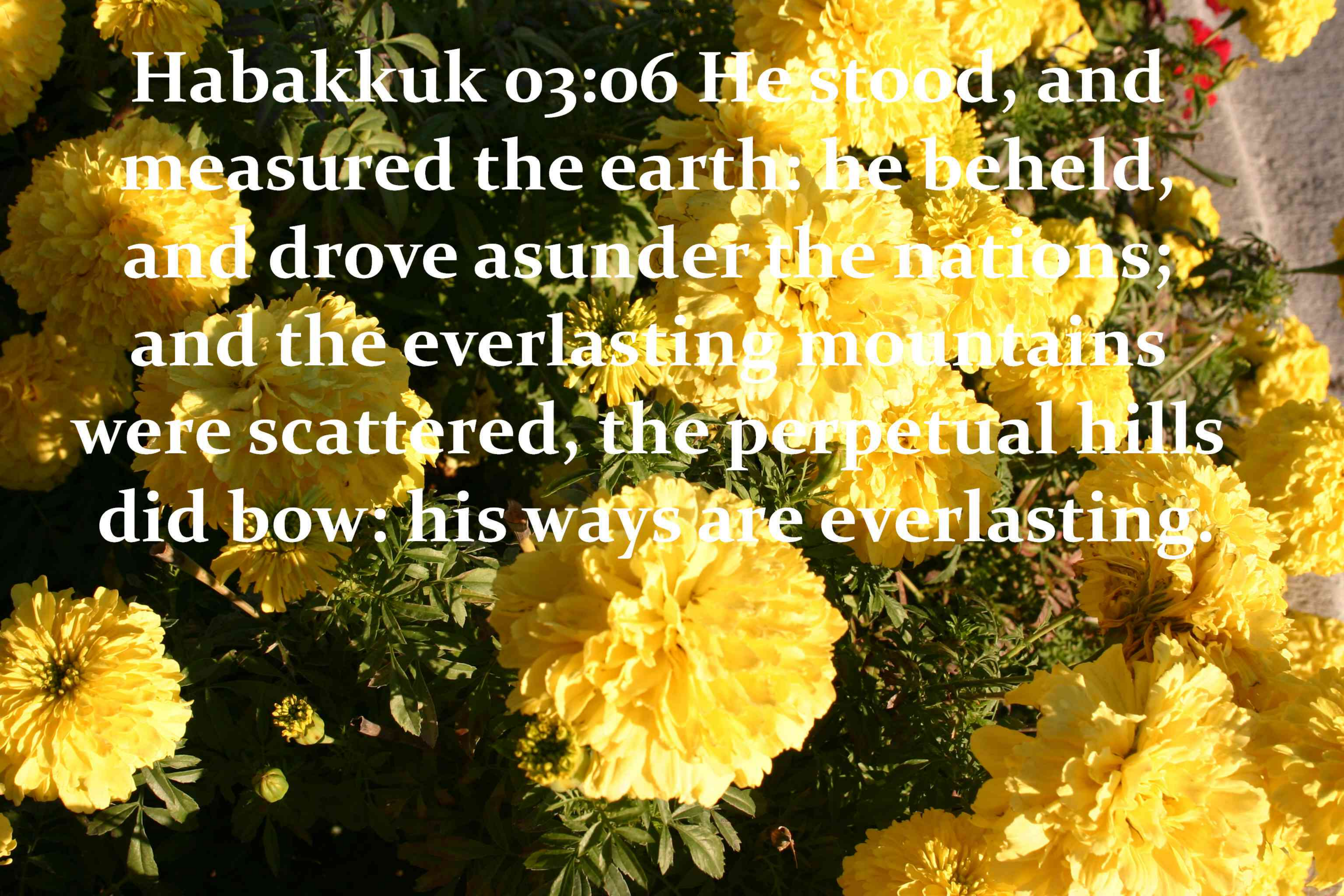




**Habakkuk 03:05 Before him went

went forth at his feet.**







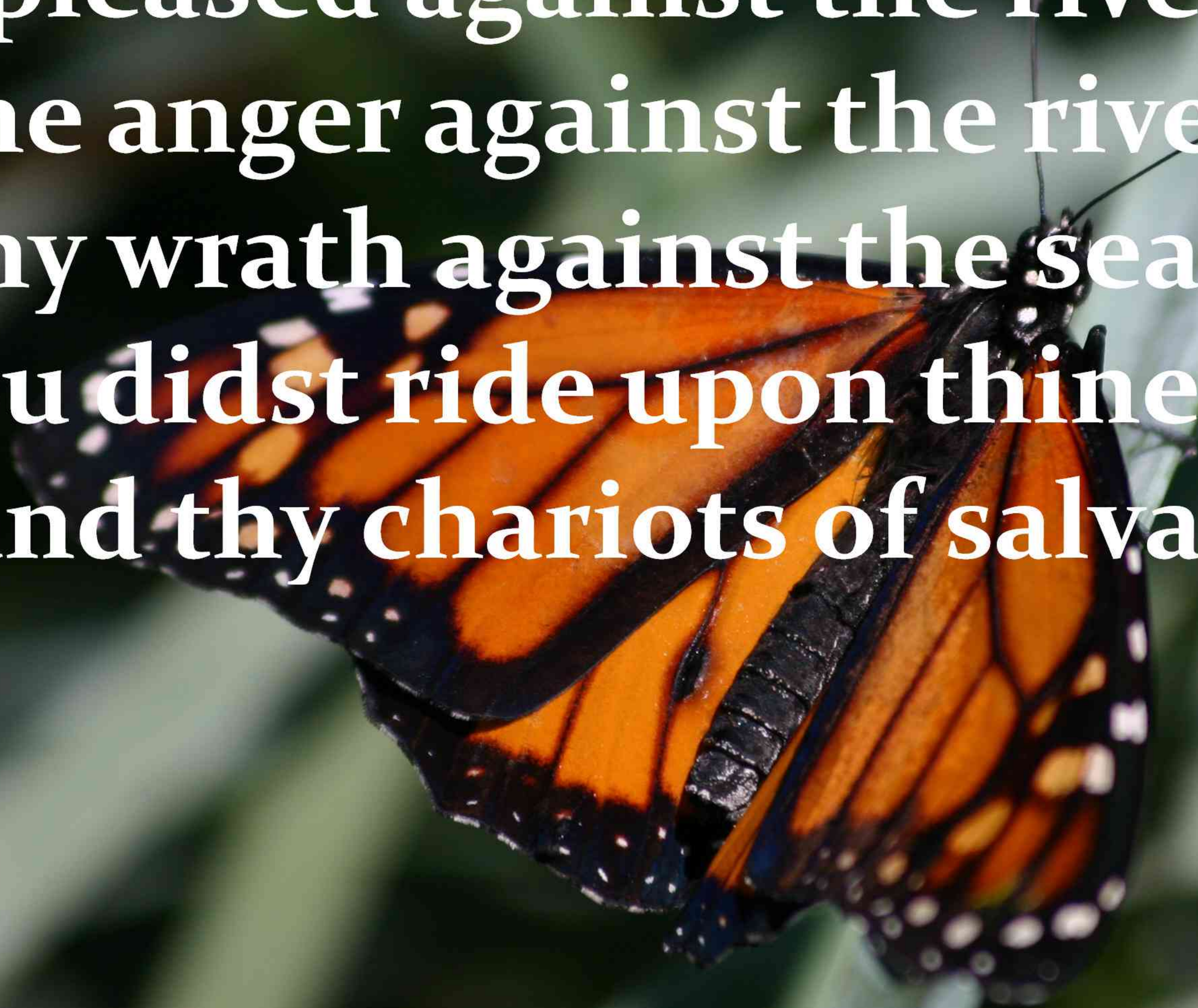
Habakkuk 03:06 He stood, and

tremble.**

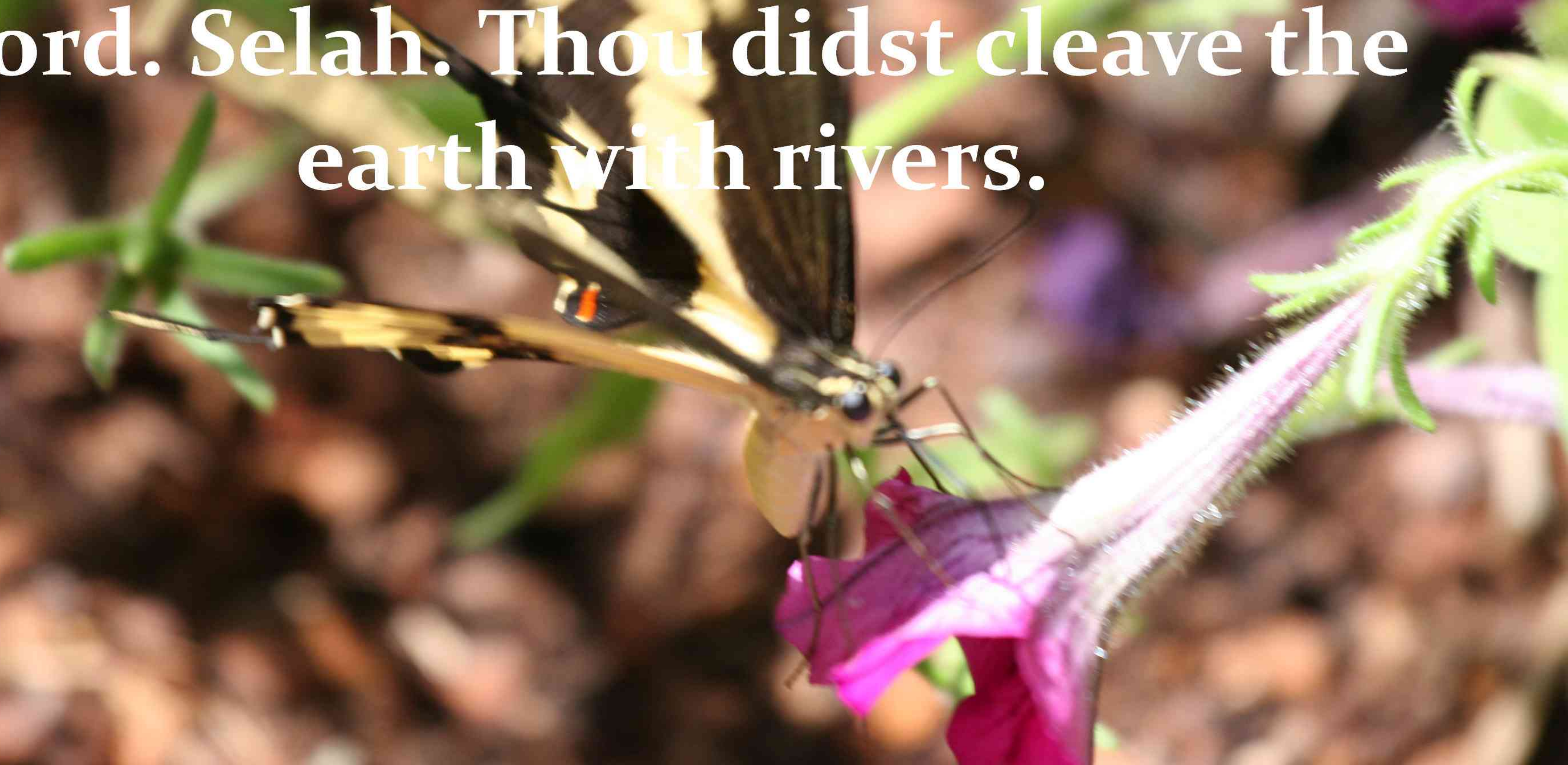


Habakkuk 03:08 Was the LORD

and thy chariots of salvation?



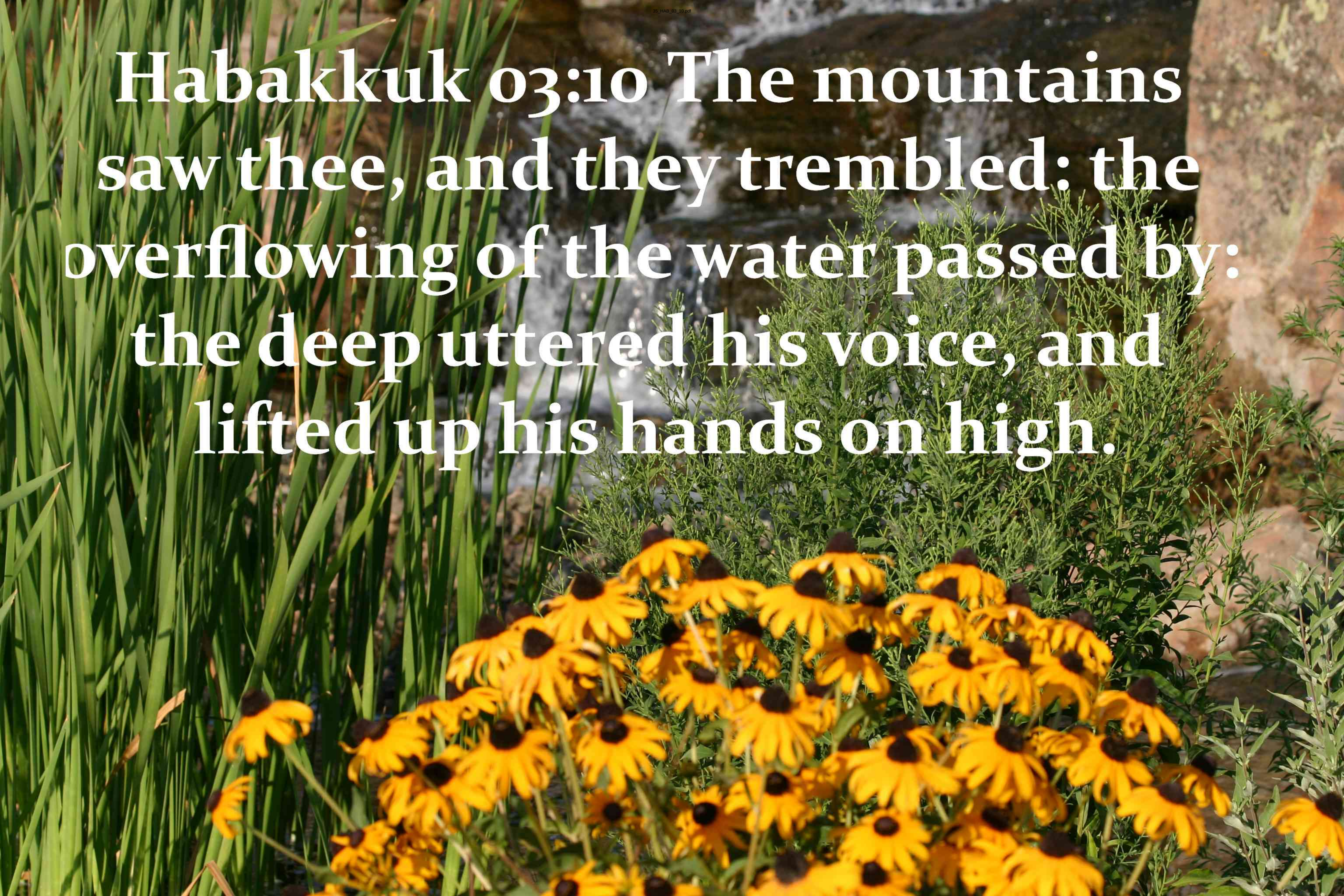


Habakkuk 03:09 Thy bow was

spear.





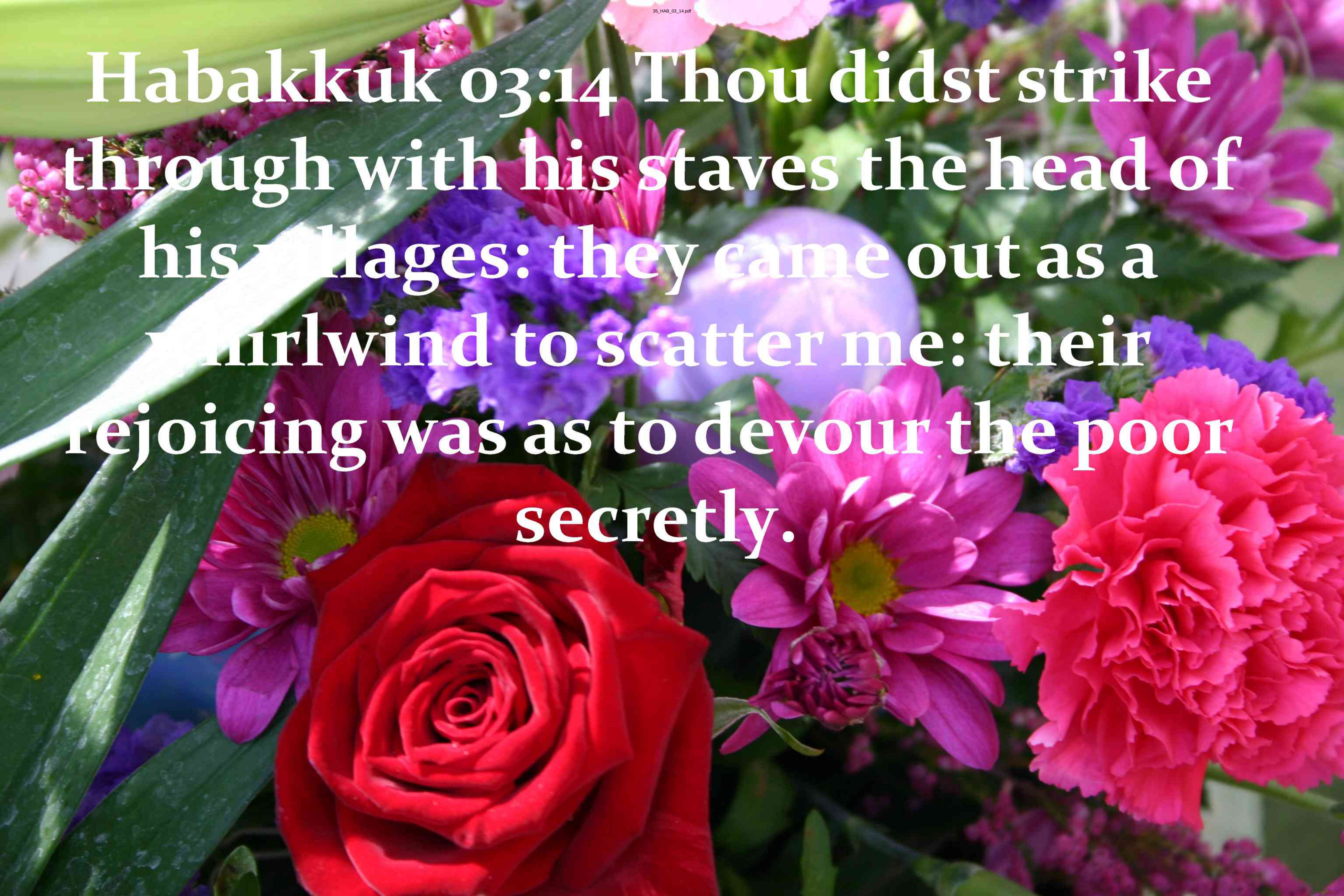
**Habakkuk 03:12 Thou didst march
