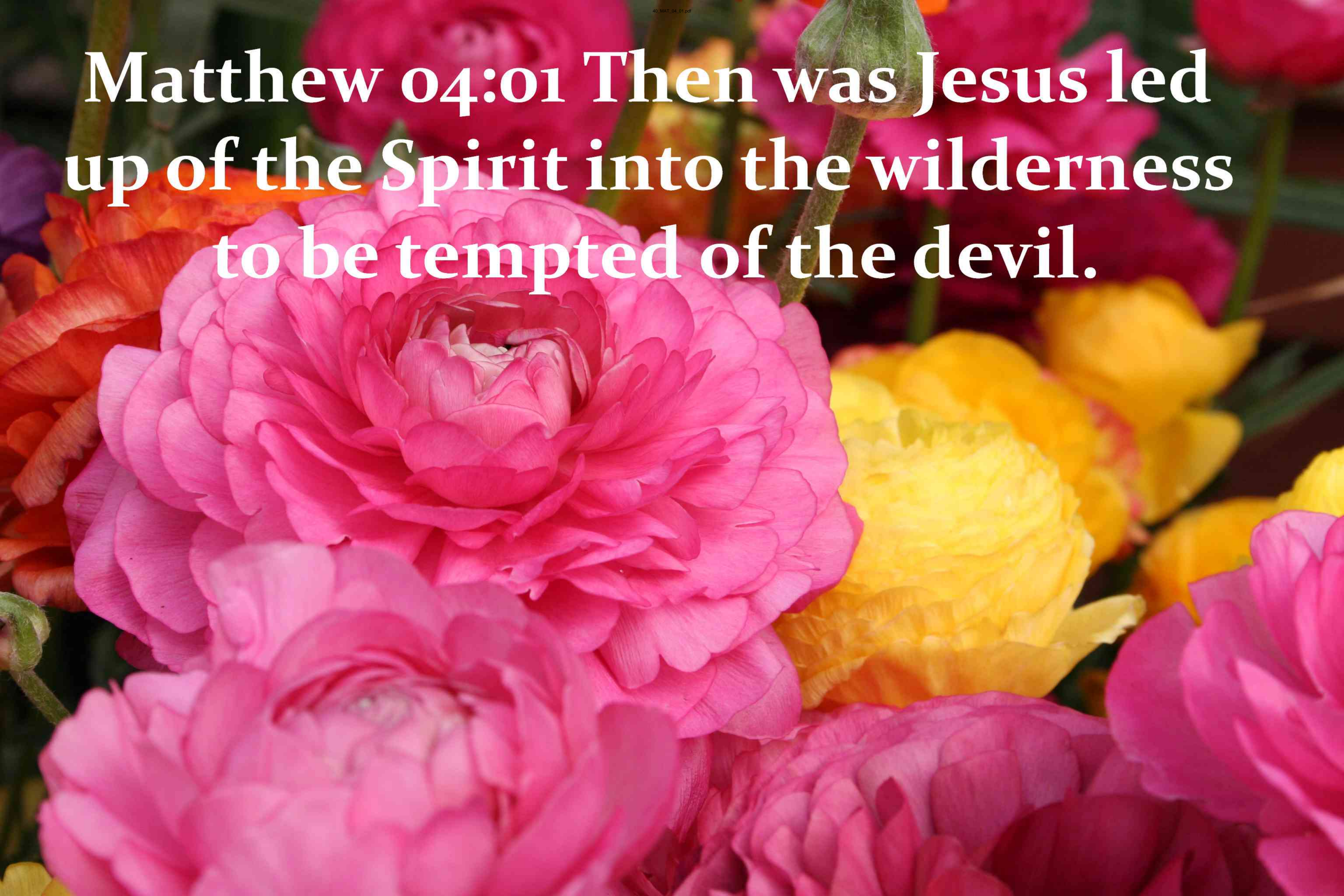


Matthew 04:01 Then was Jesus led

to be tempted of the devil.

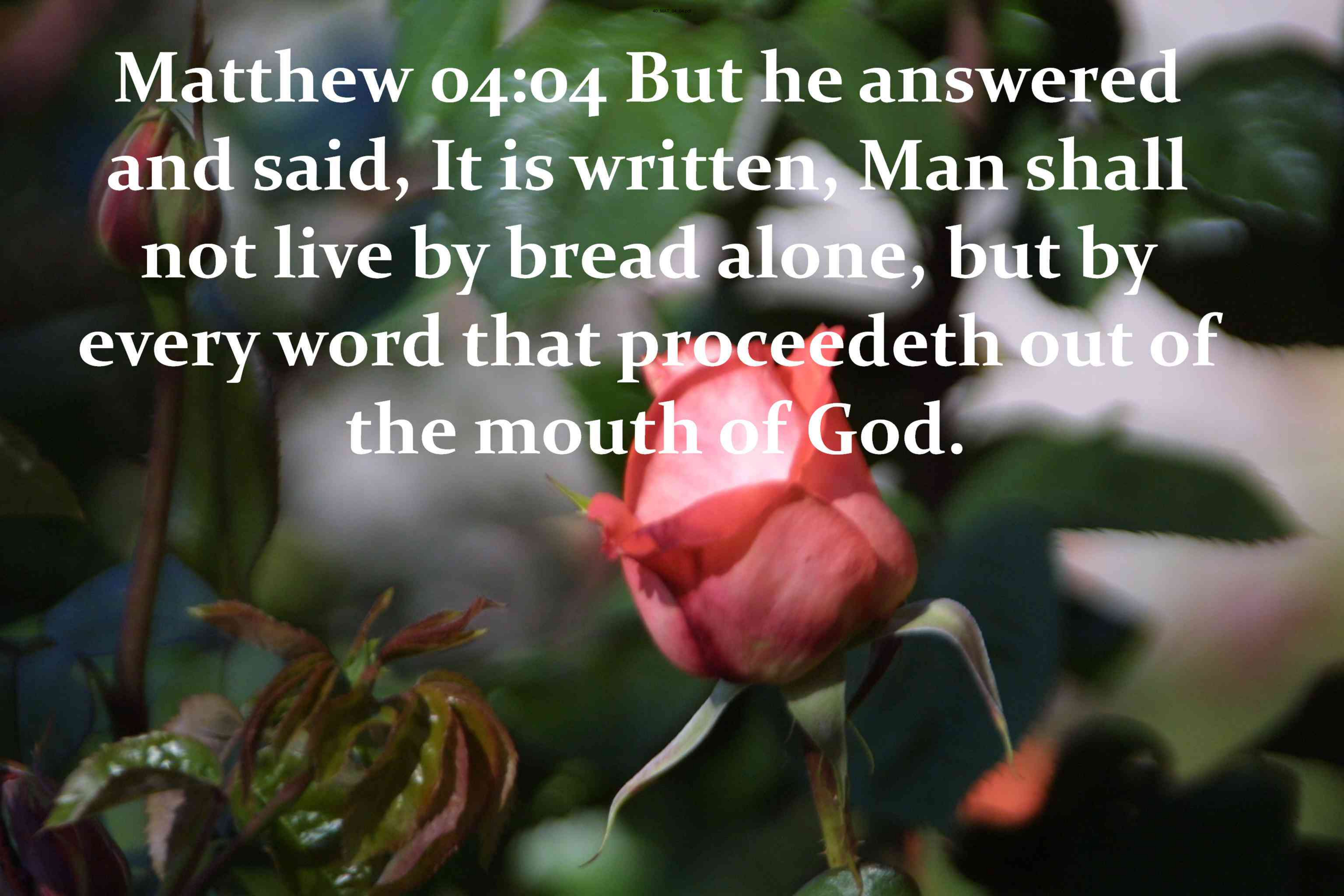


**Matthew 04:02 And when he had

he was afterward an hungered.**

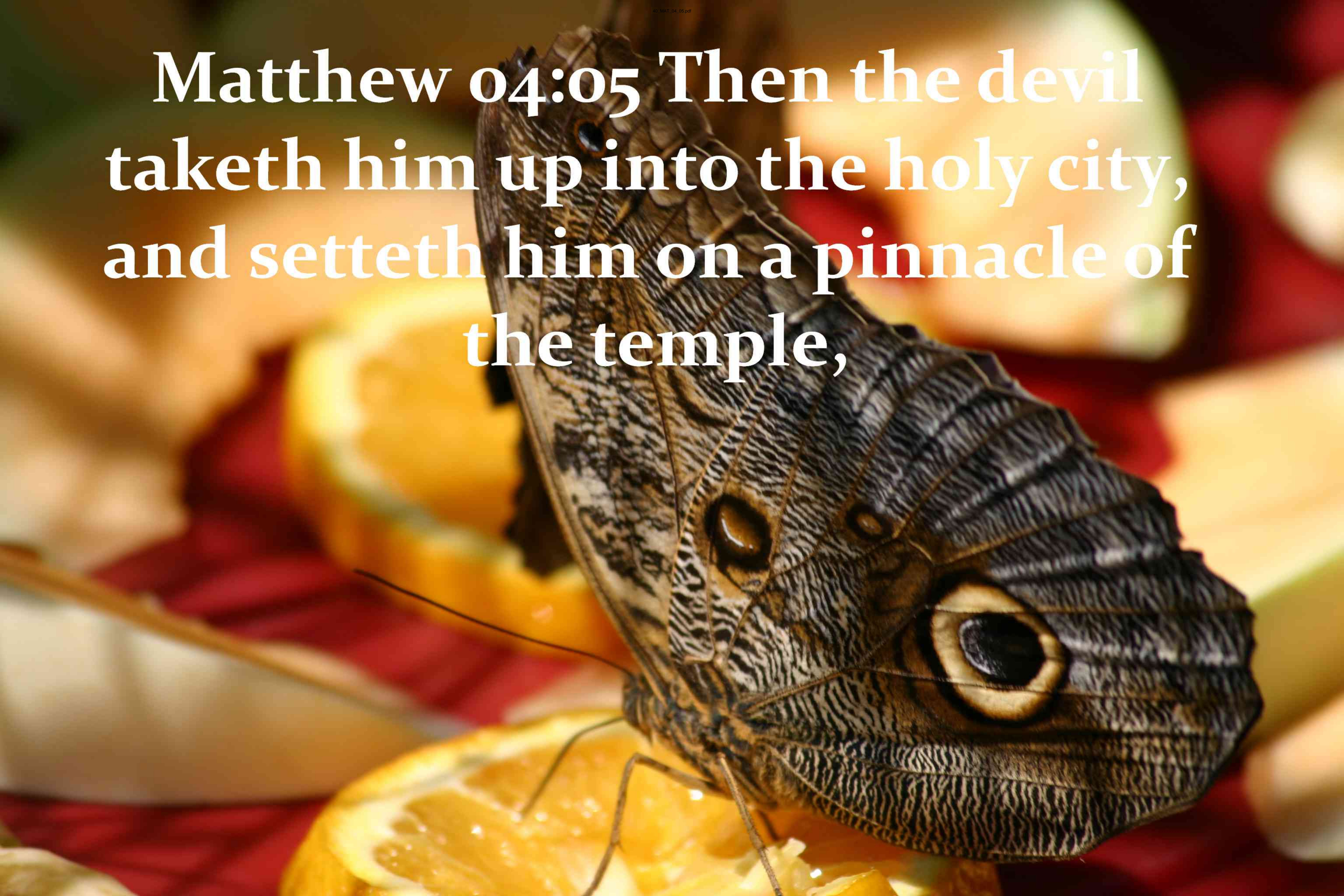
Matthew 04:03 And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.

against a stone.

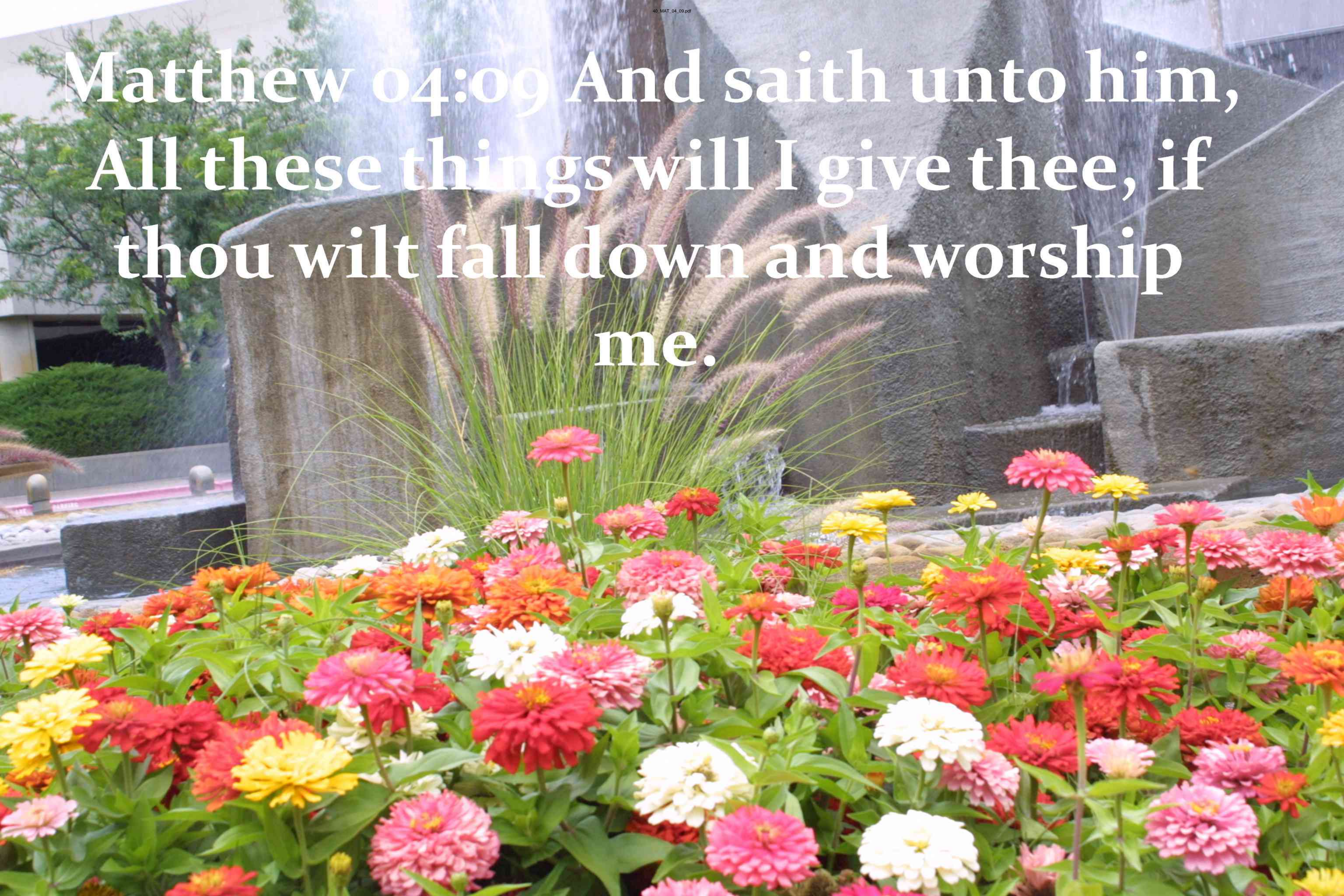
Matthew 04:07 Jesus said unto him,

the glory of them;



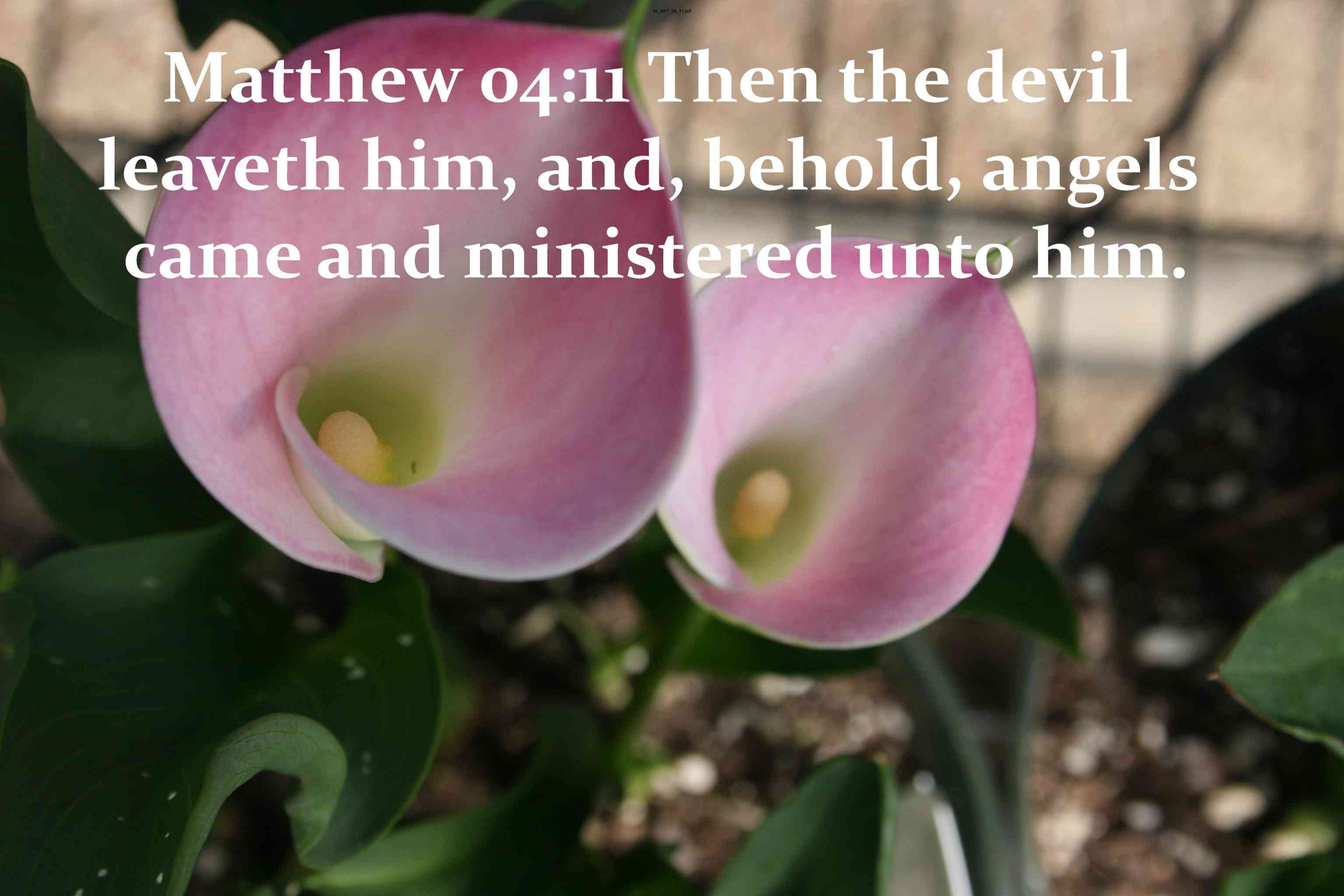
Matthew 04:09 And saith unto him,

me.



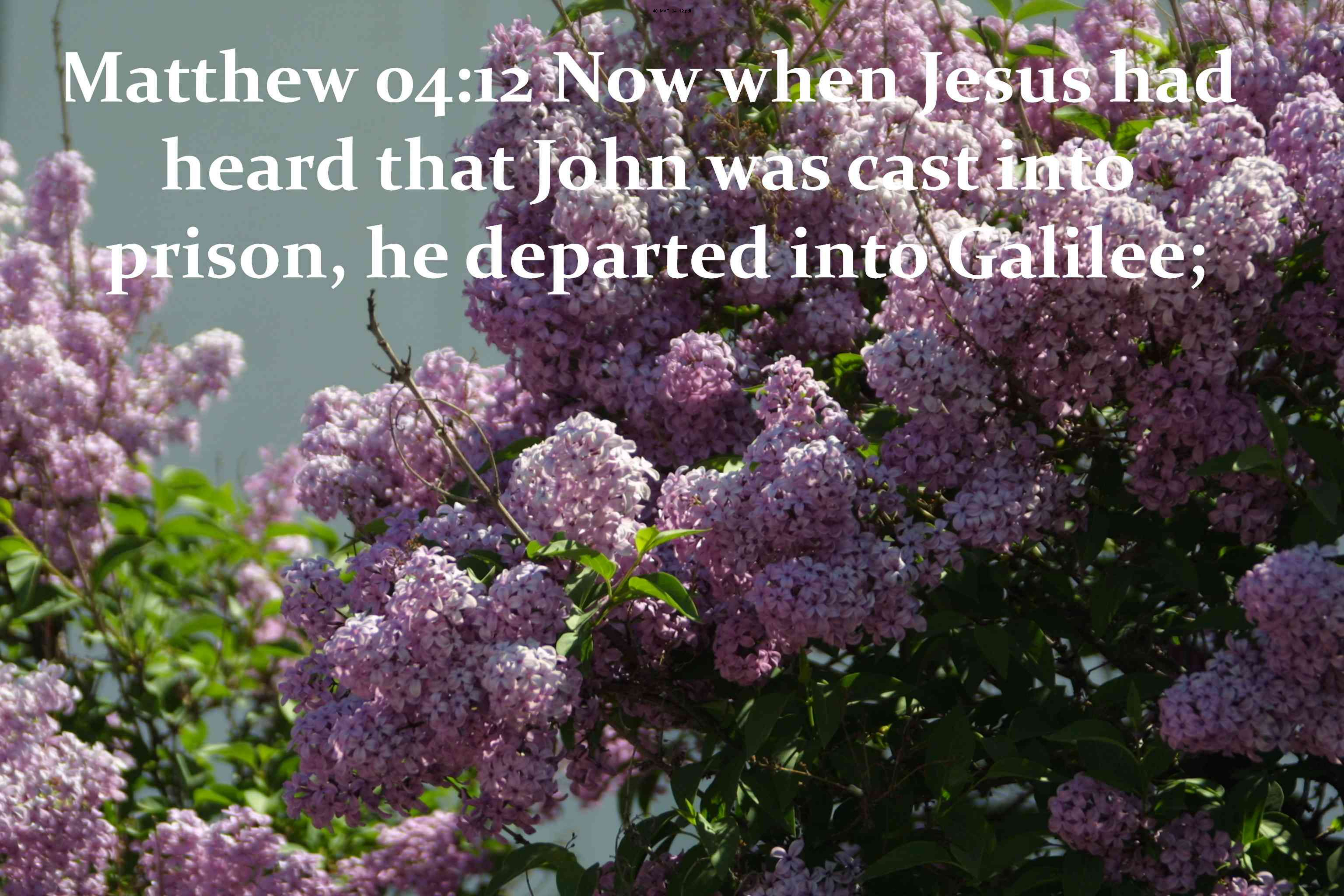

prison, he departed into Galilee;



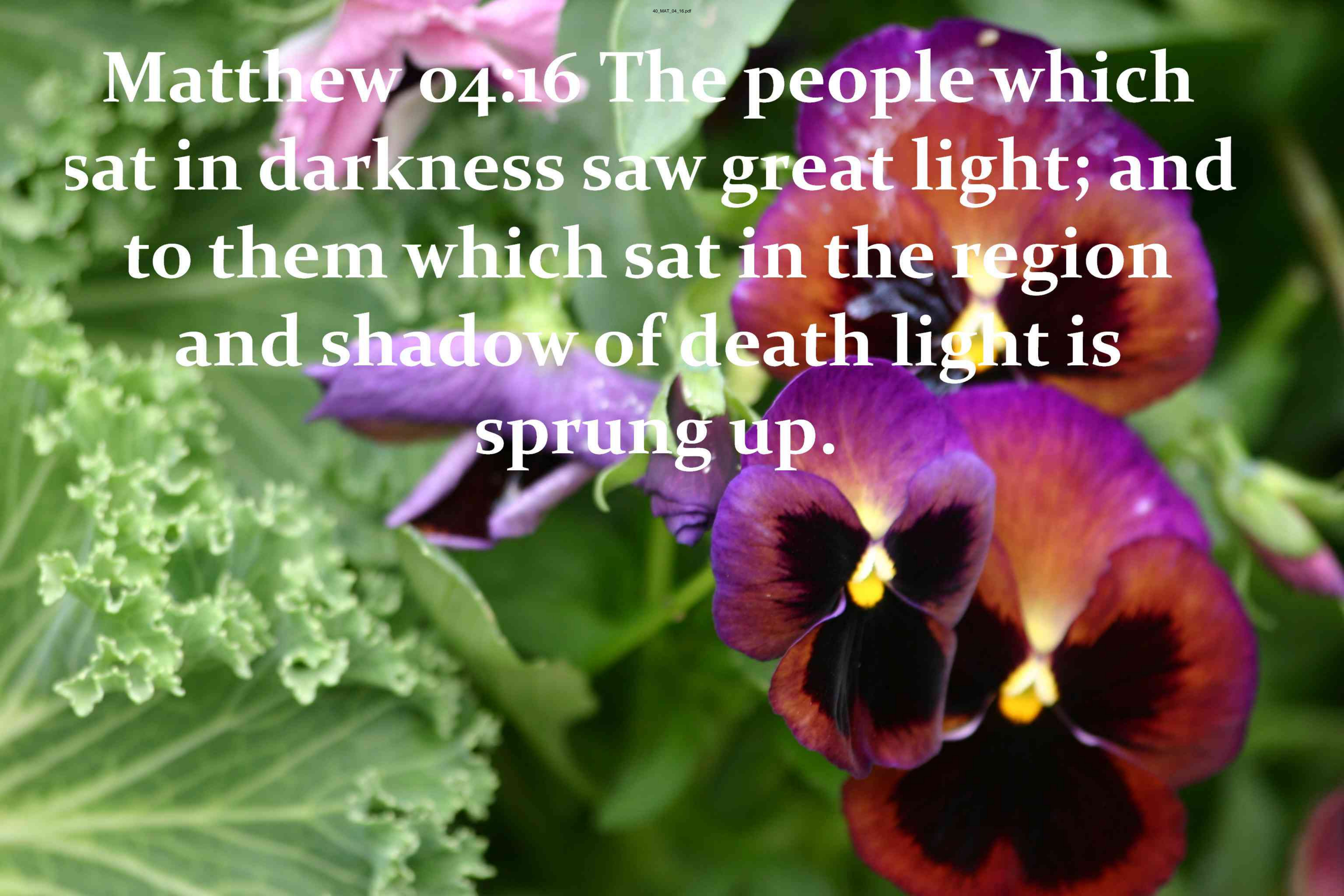
Matthew 04:13 And leaving

Esaias the prophet, saying,




**Matthew 04:15 The land of Zabulon,

sprung up.

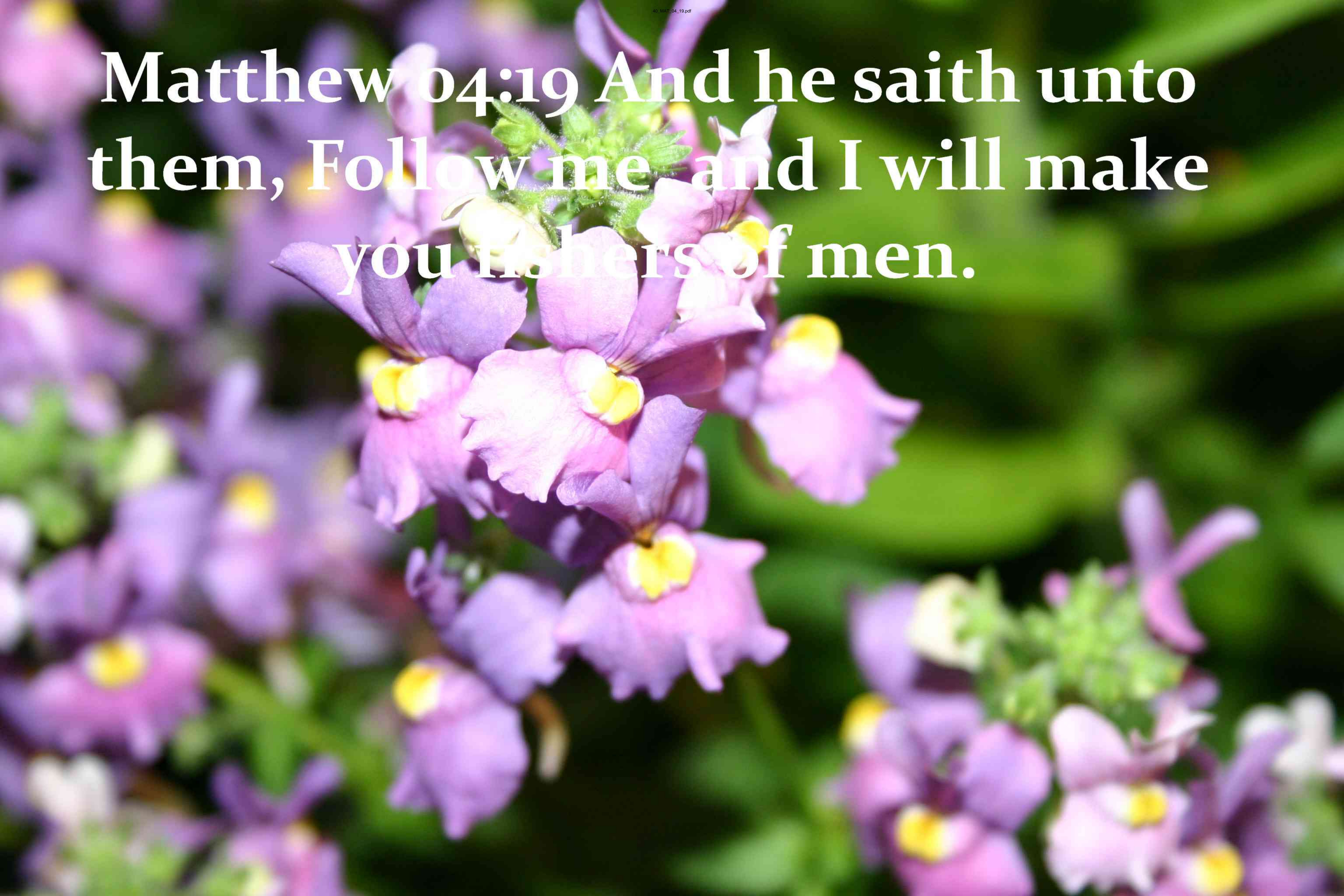


**Matthew 04:17 From that time



you fishers of men.



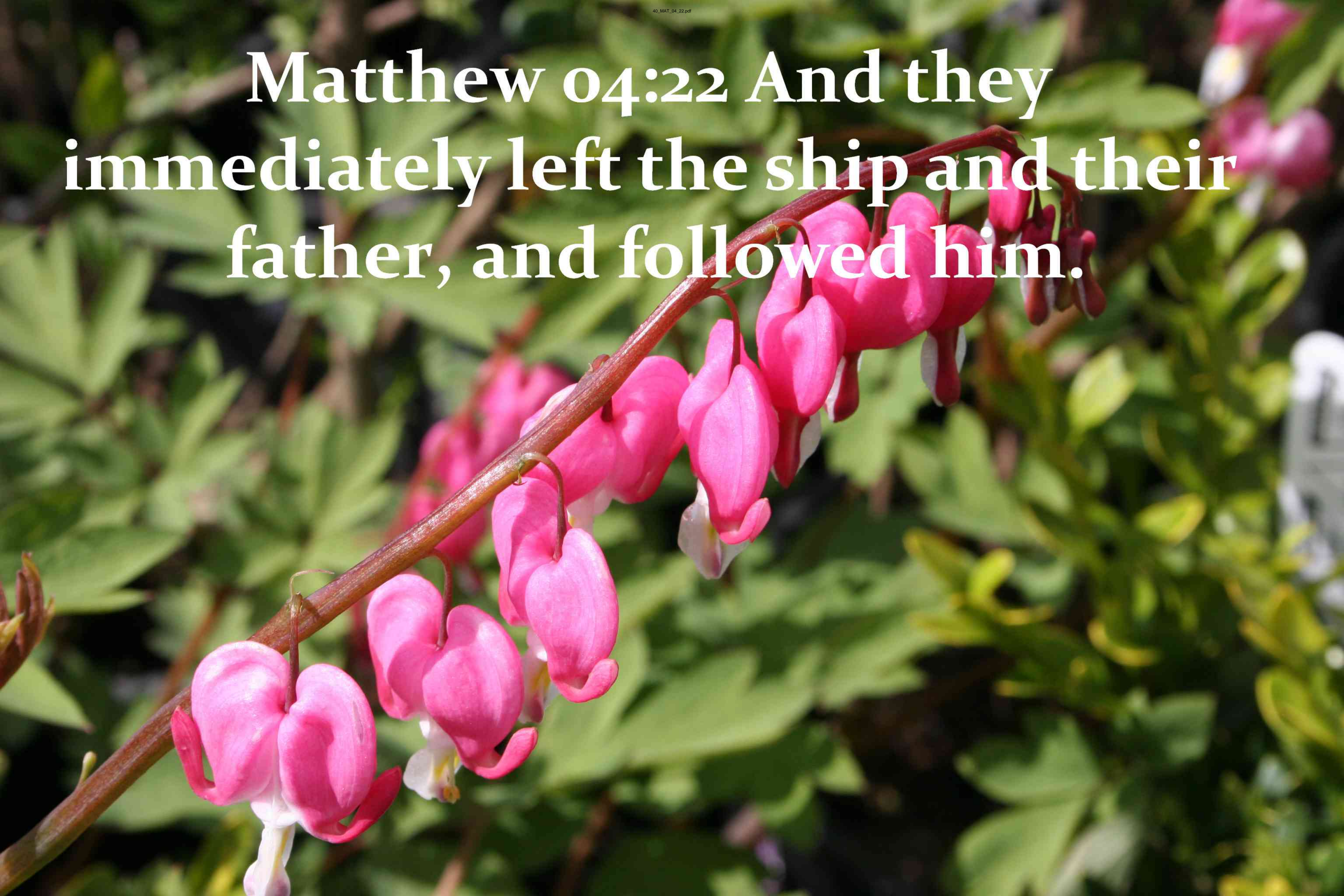
**Matthew 04:20 And they

followed him.**






Matthew 04:21 And going on from

their nets; and he called them.


Matthew 04:22 And they
