

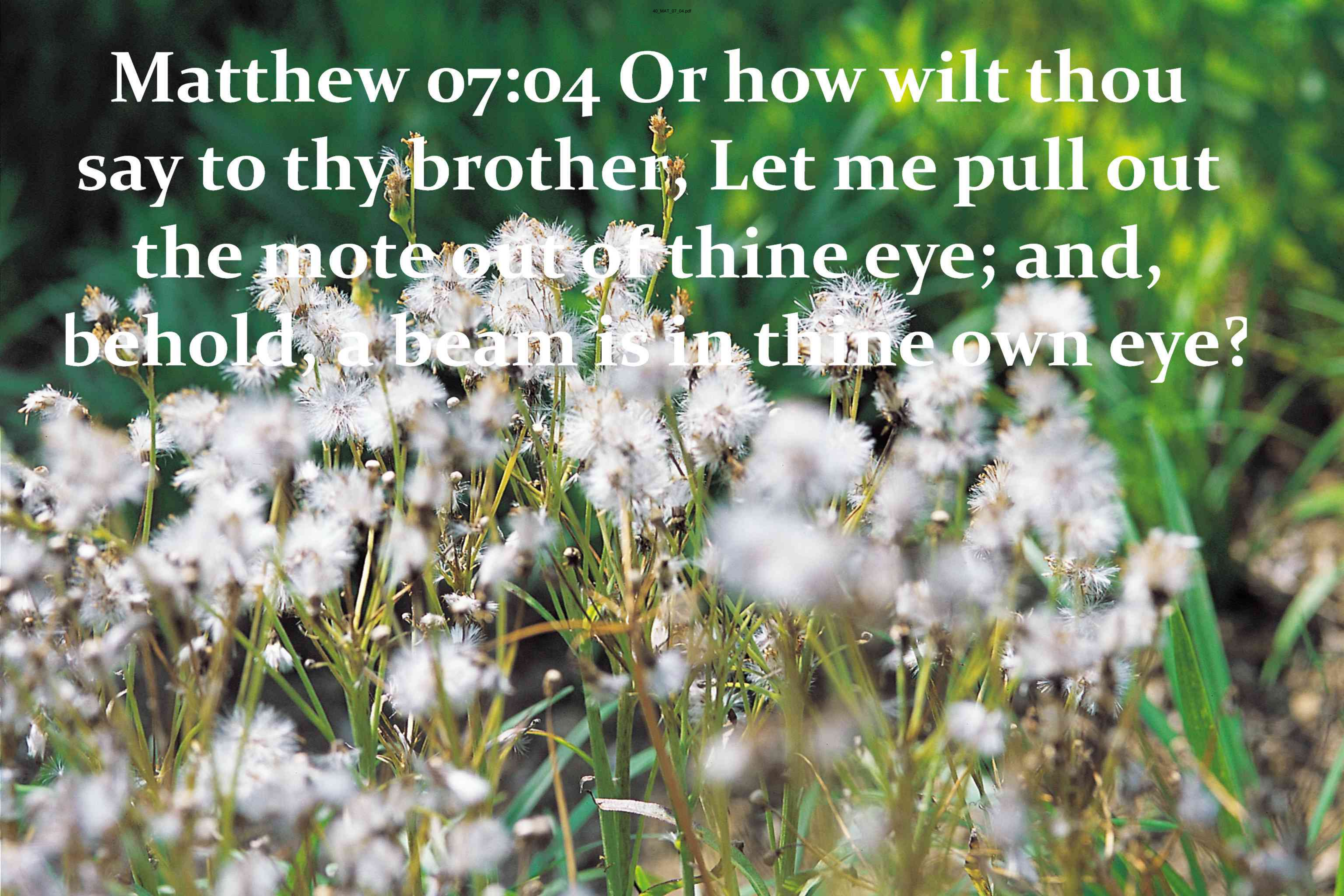
Matthew 07:01 Judge not, that ye

behold, a beam is in thine own eye?

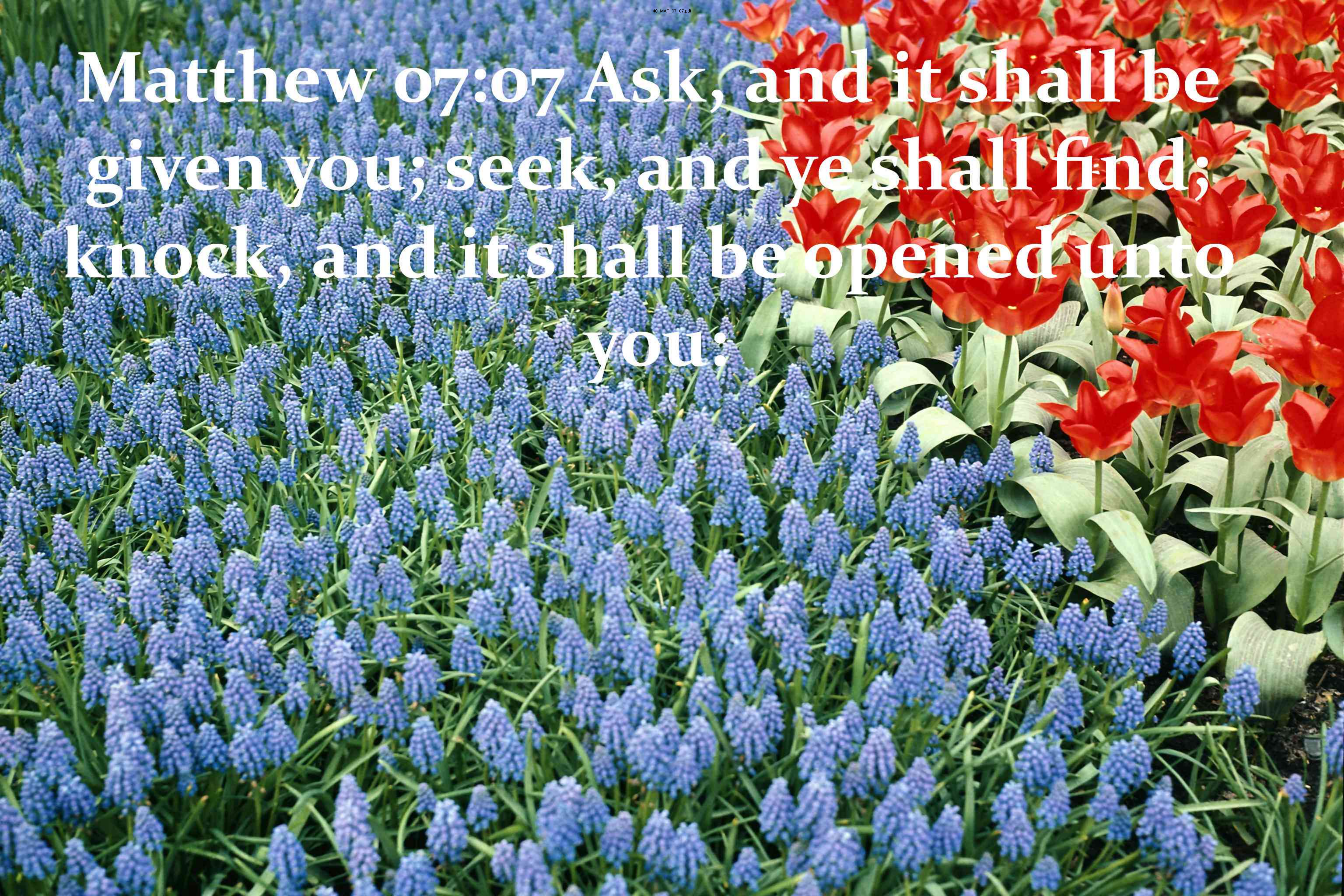


Matthew 07:05 Thou hypocrite,

thy brother's eye.

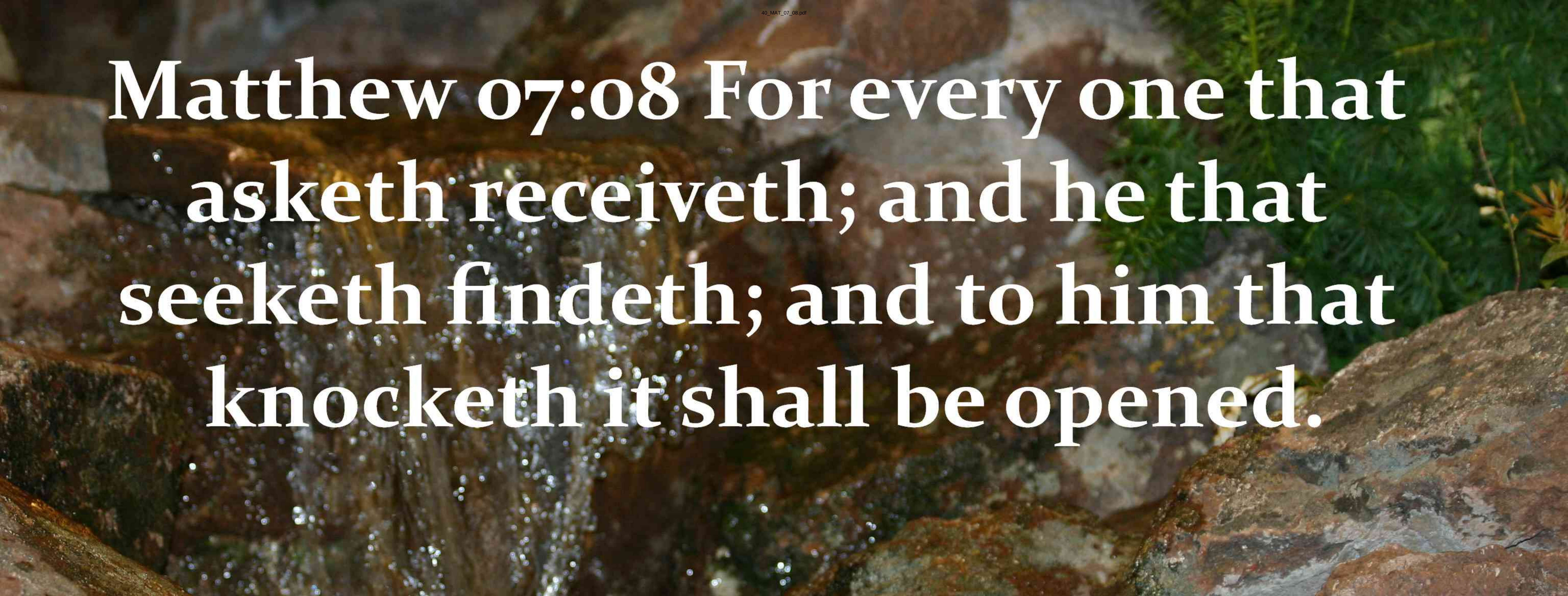


Matthew 07:06 Give not that which

and turn again and rend you.



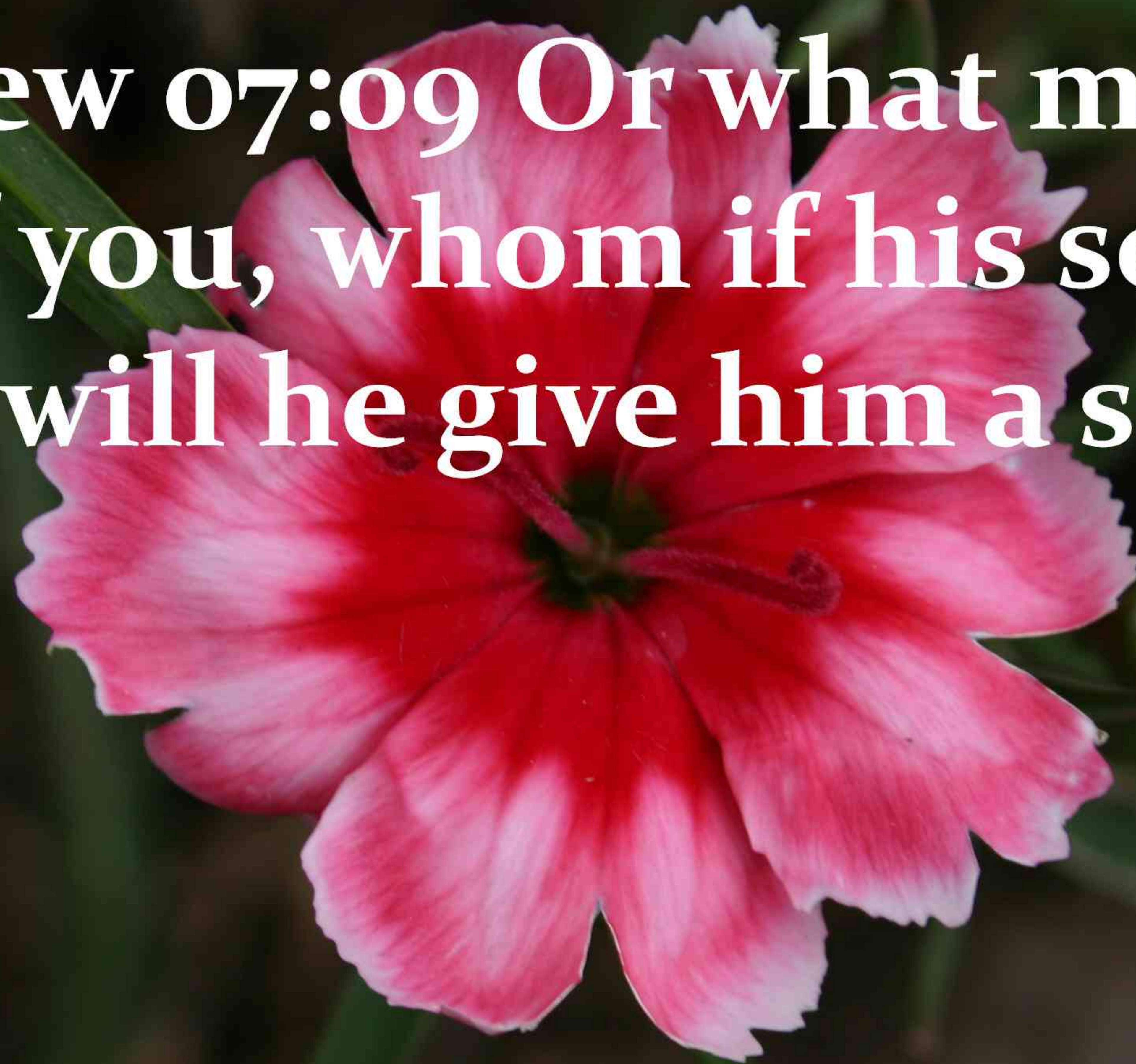


Matthew 07:07 Ask, and it shall be

you:

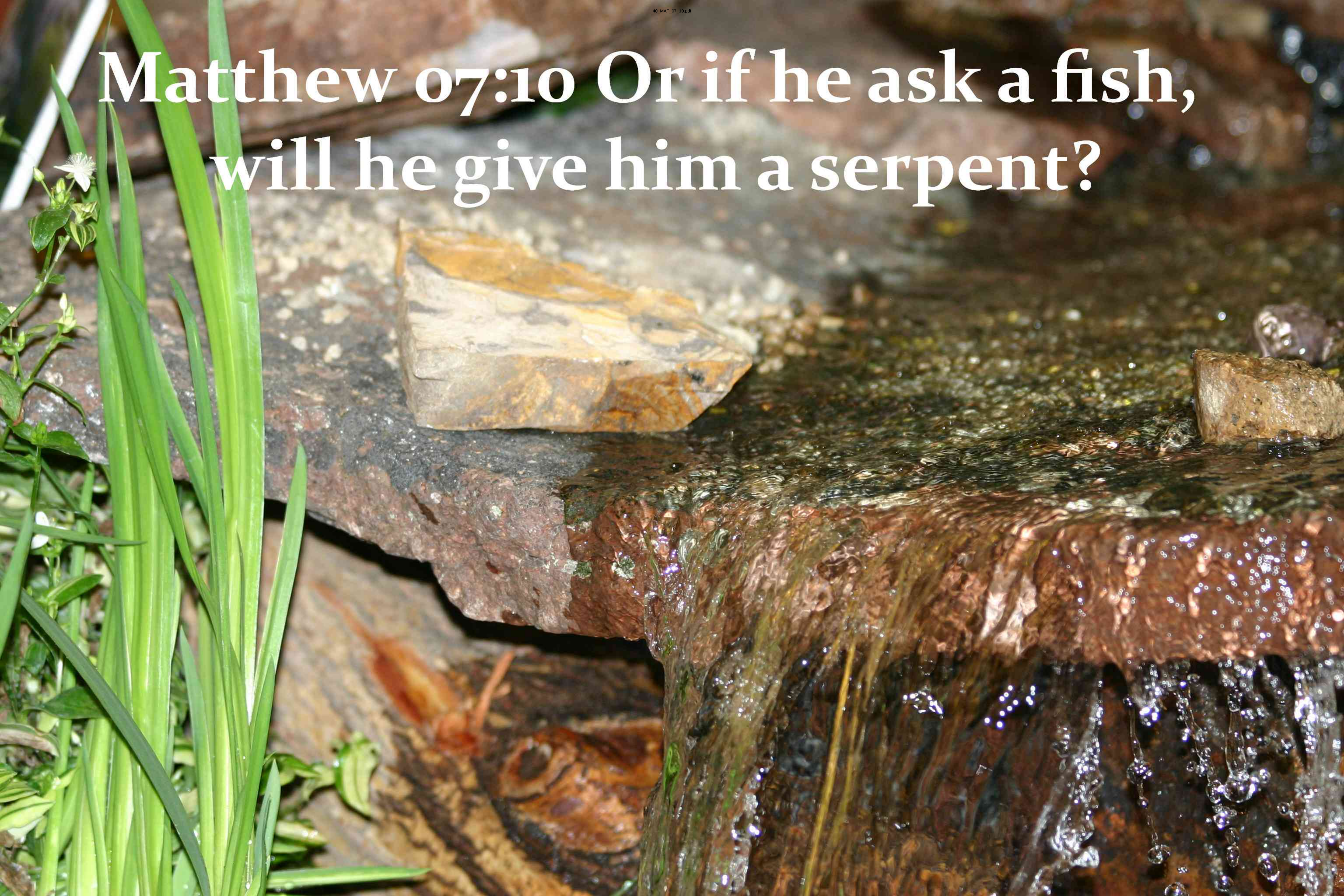


**Matthew 07:08 For every one that

knocketh it shall be opened.**

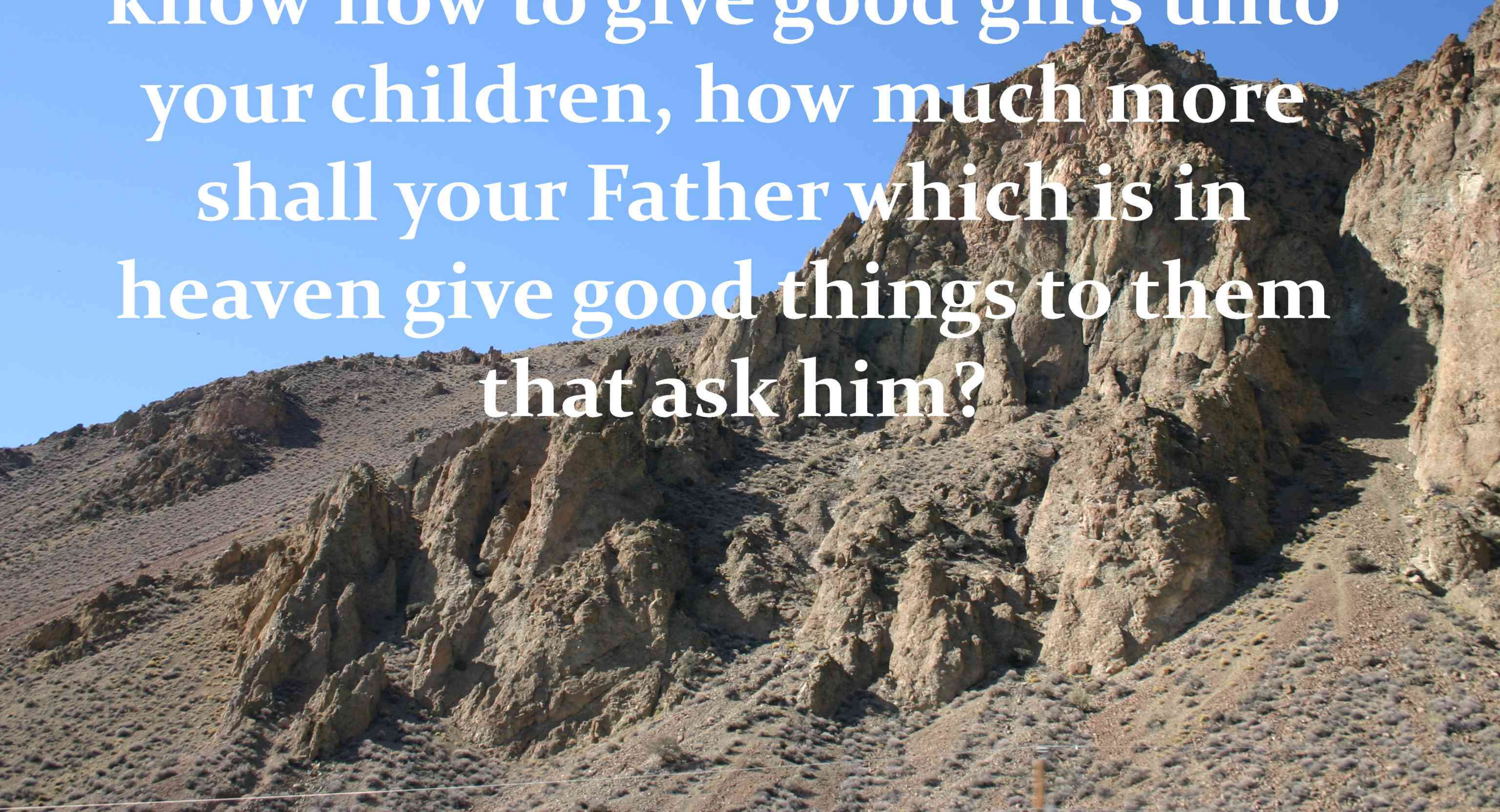
**Matthew 07:09 Or what man is

bread, will he give him a stone?**

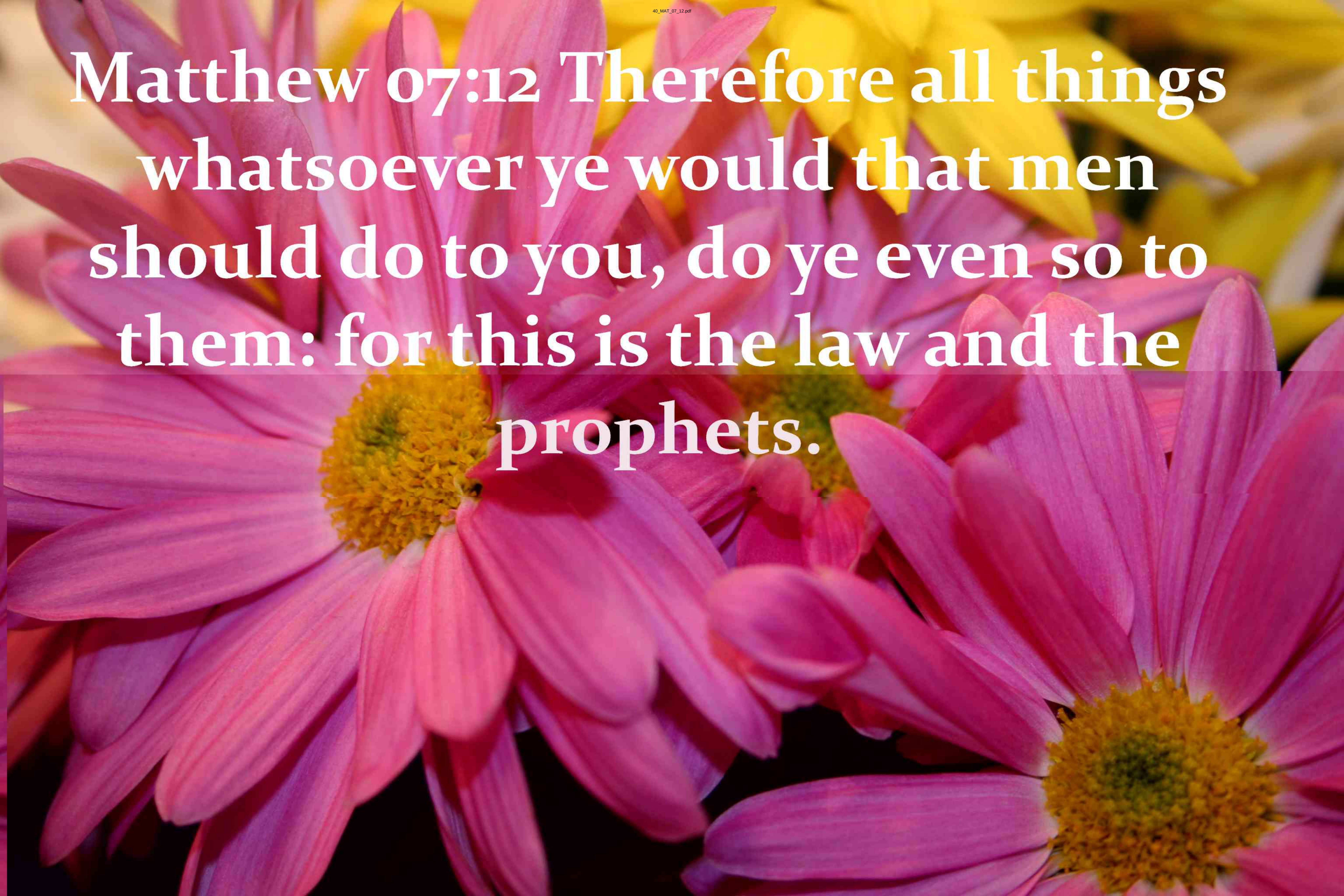


Matthew 07:10 Or if he ask a fish,
will he give him a serpent?



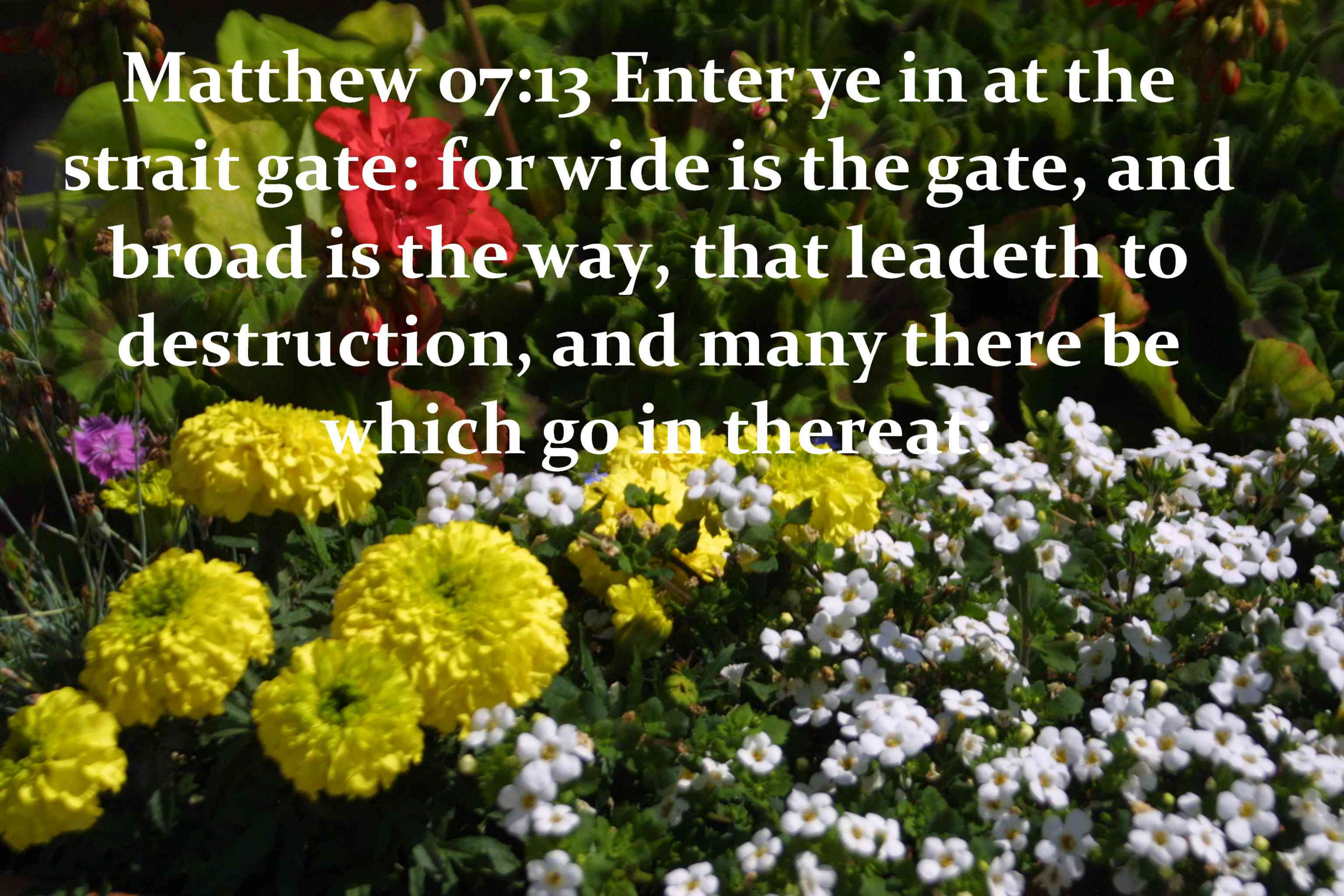
Matthew 07:11 If ye then, being evil,

which go in thereat:

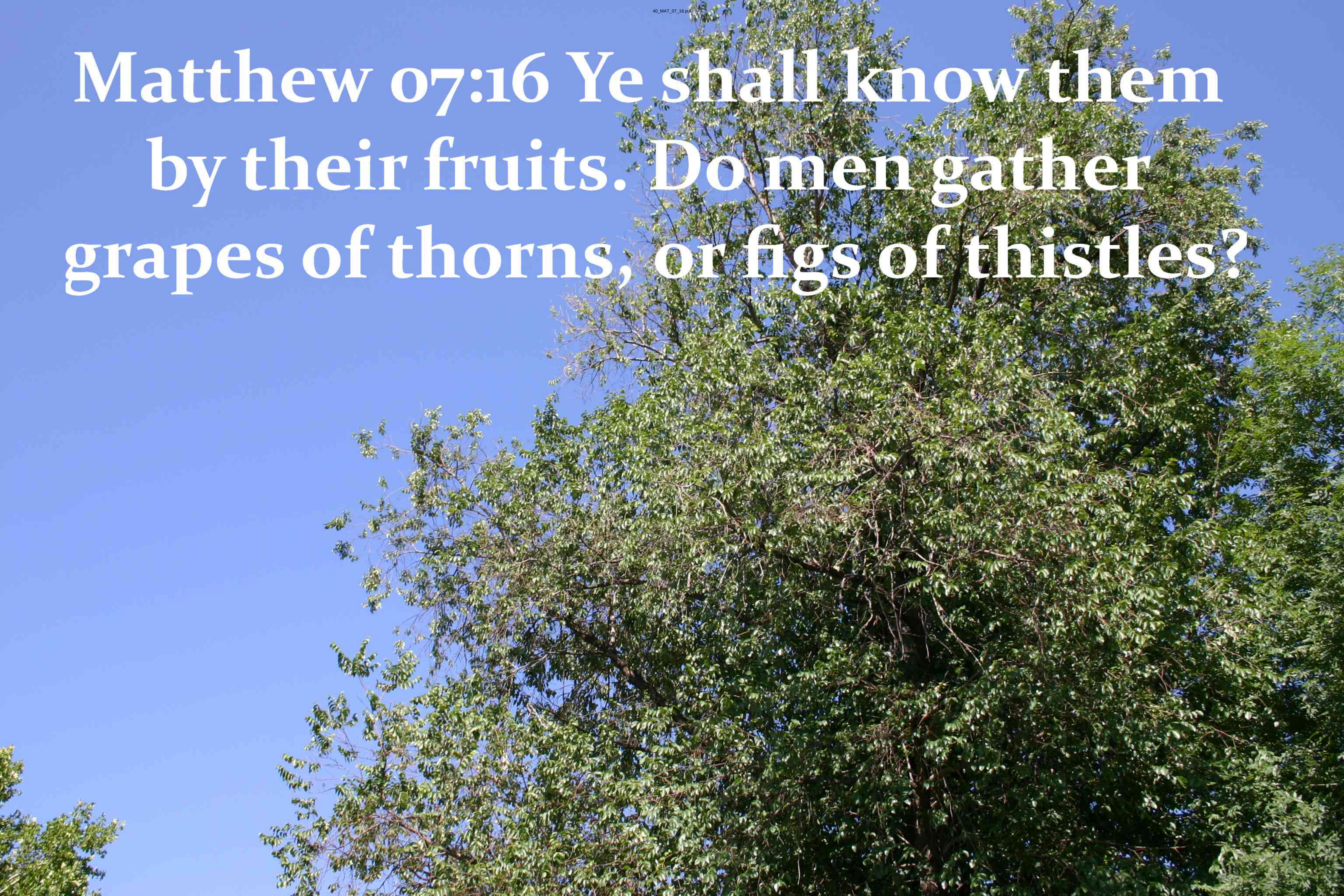


Matthew 07:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

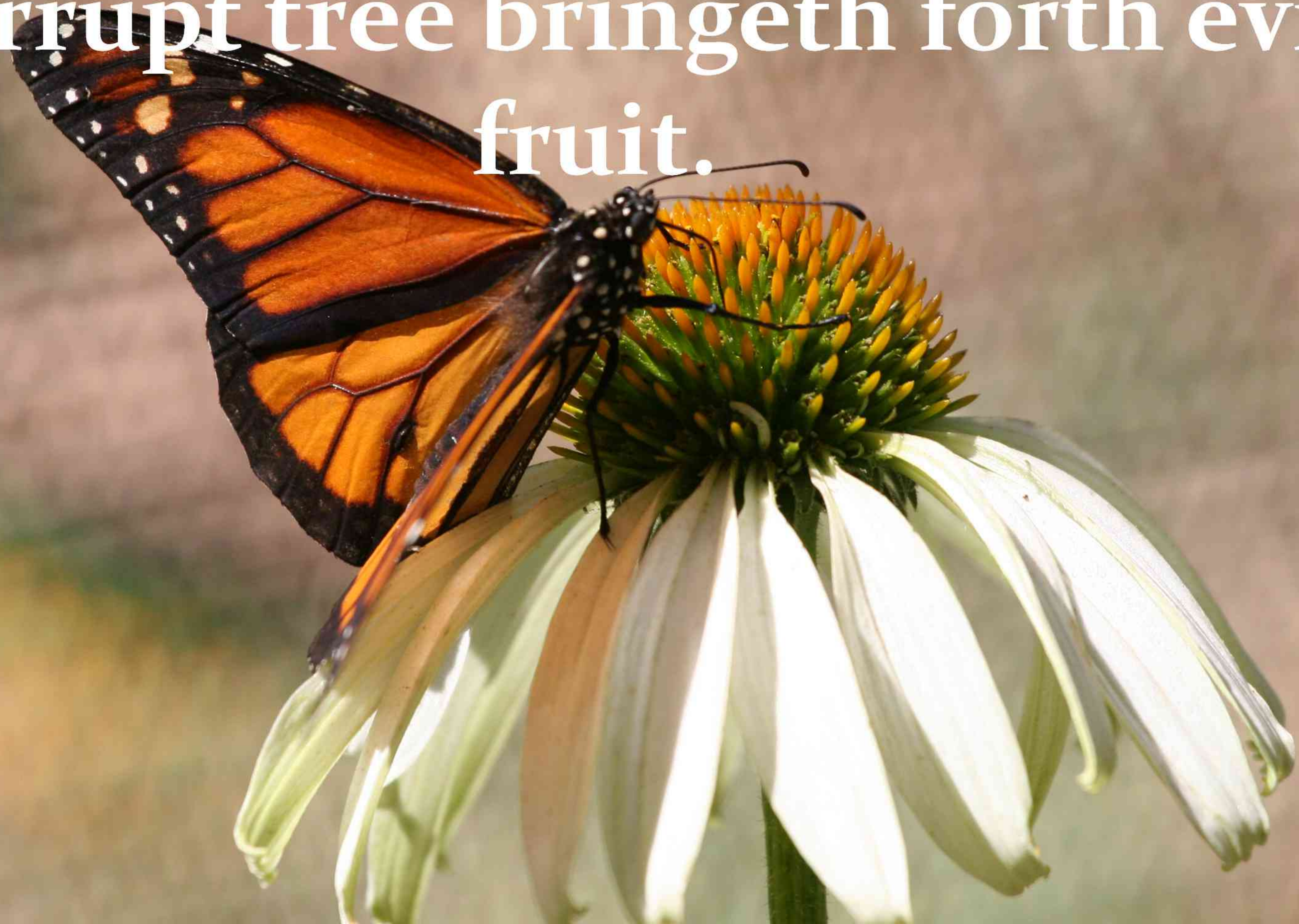
Matthew 07:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

Matthew 07:17 Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit.



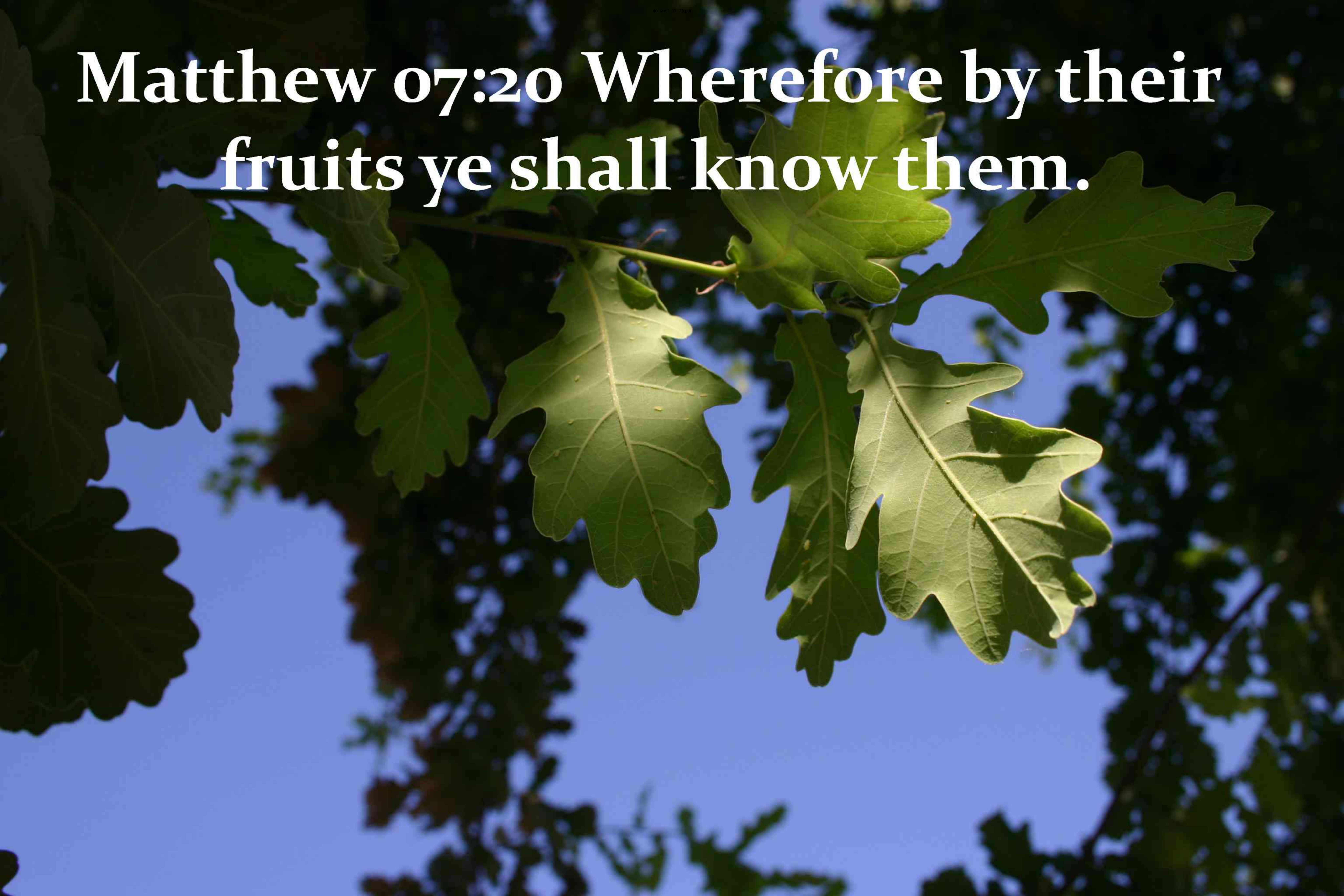


Matthew 07:18 A good tree cannot

corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.

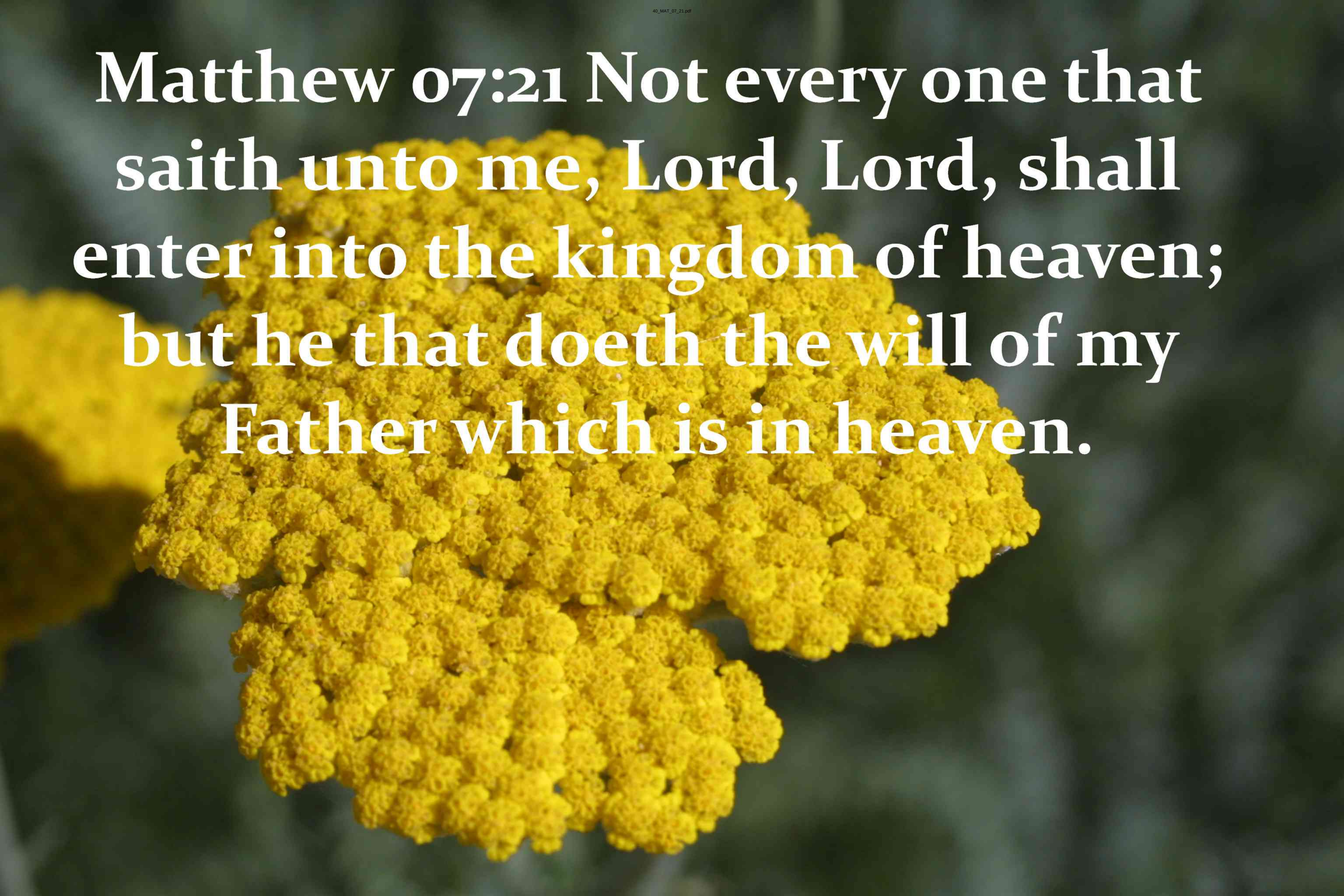
Matthew 07:19 Every tree that

fruits ye shall know them.**

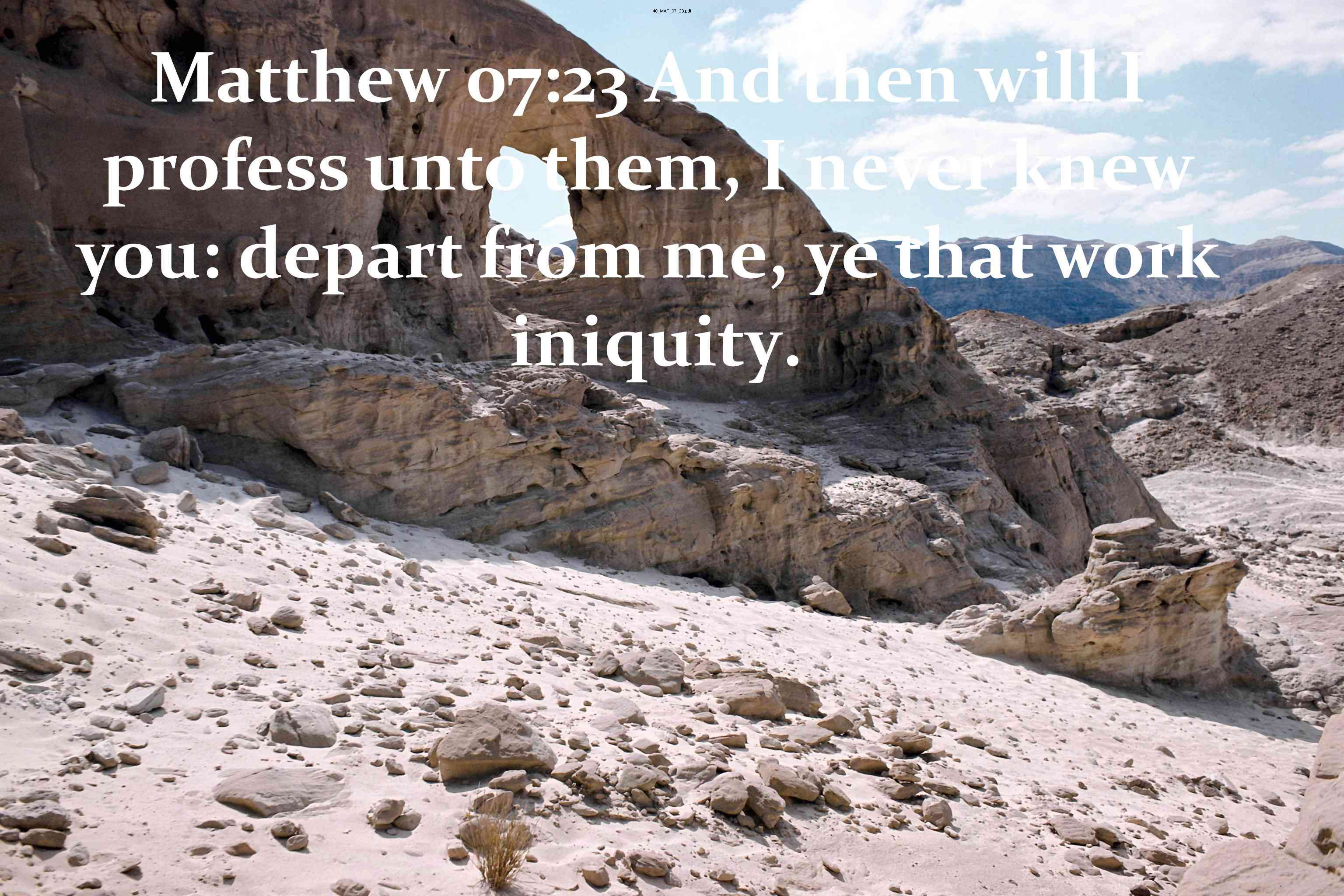


**Matthew 07:21 Not every one that

Father which is in heaven.**



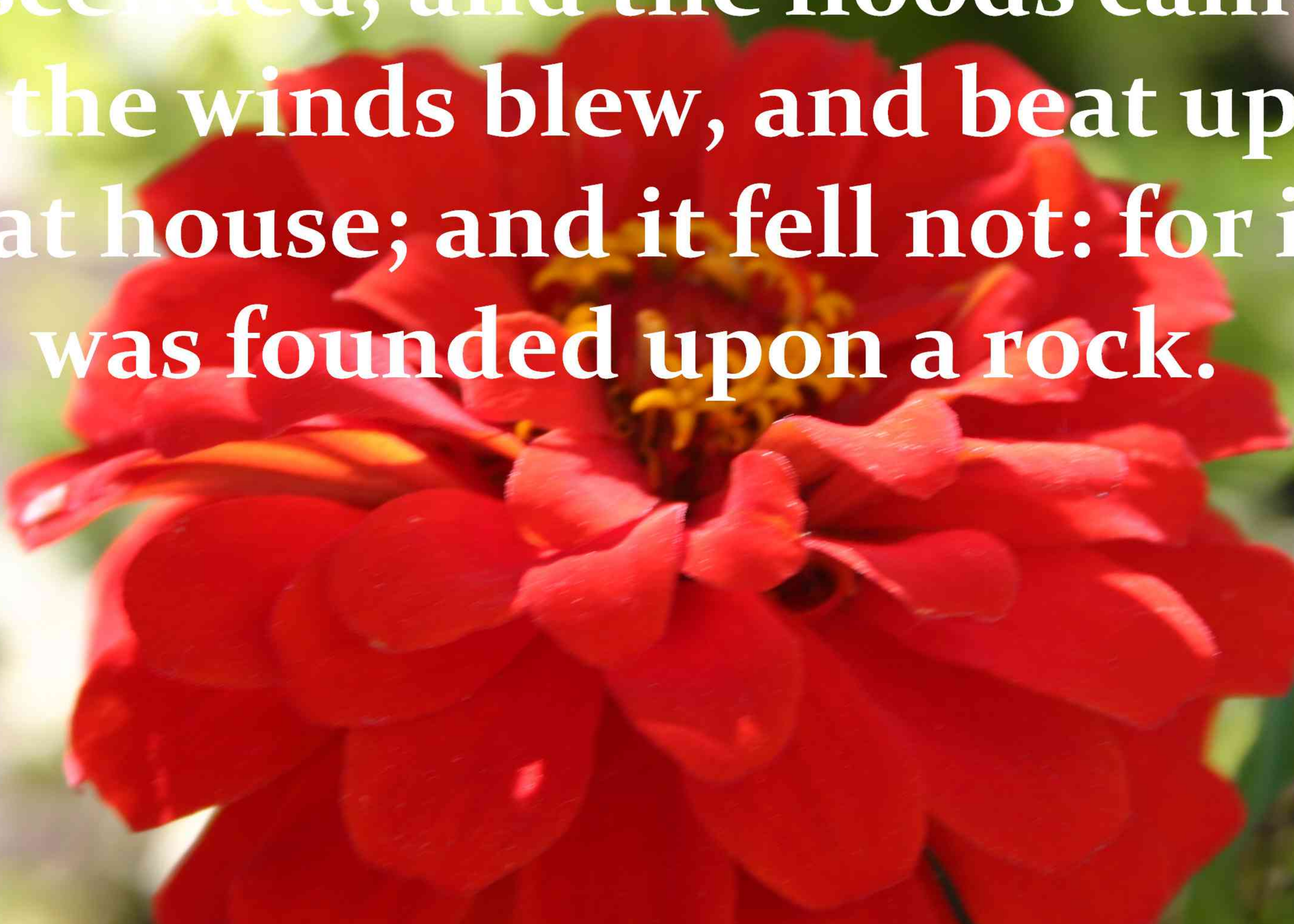
Matthew 07:22 Many will say to me

iniquity.

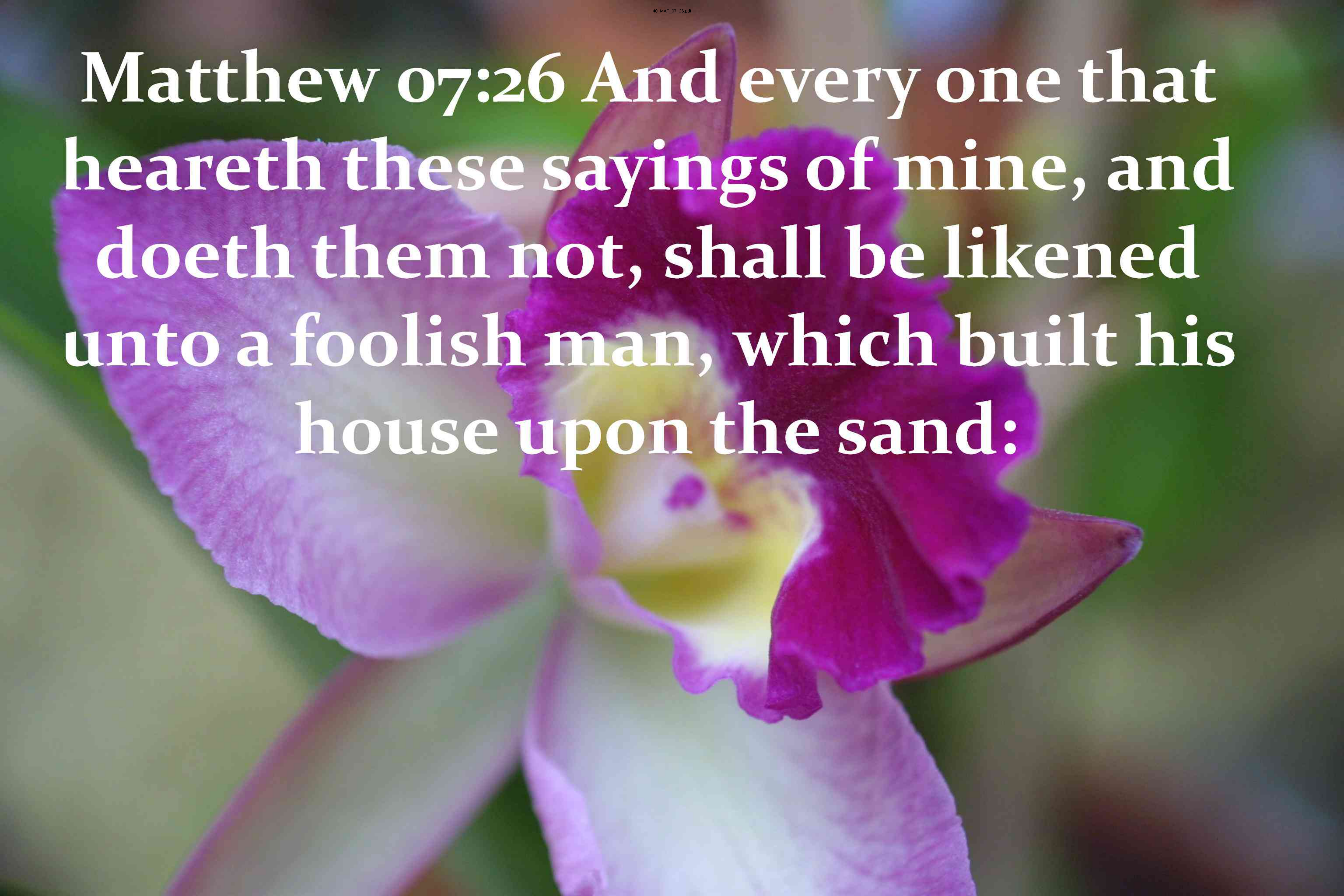


**Matthew 07:24 Therefore

was founded upon a rock.



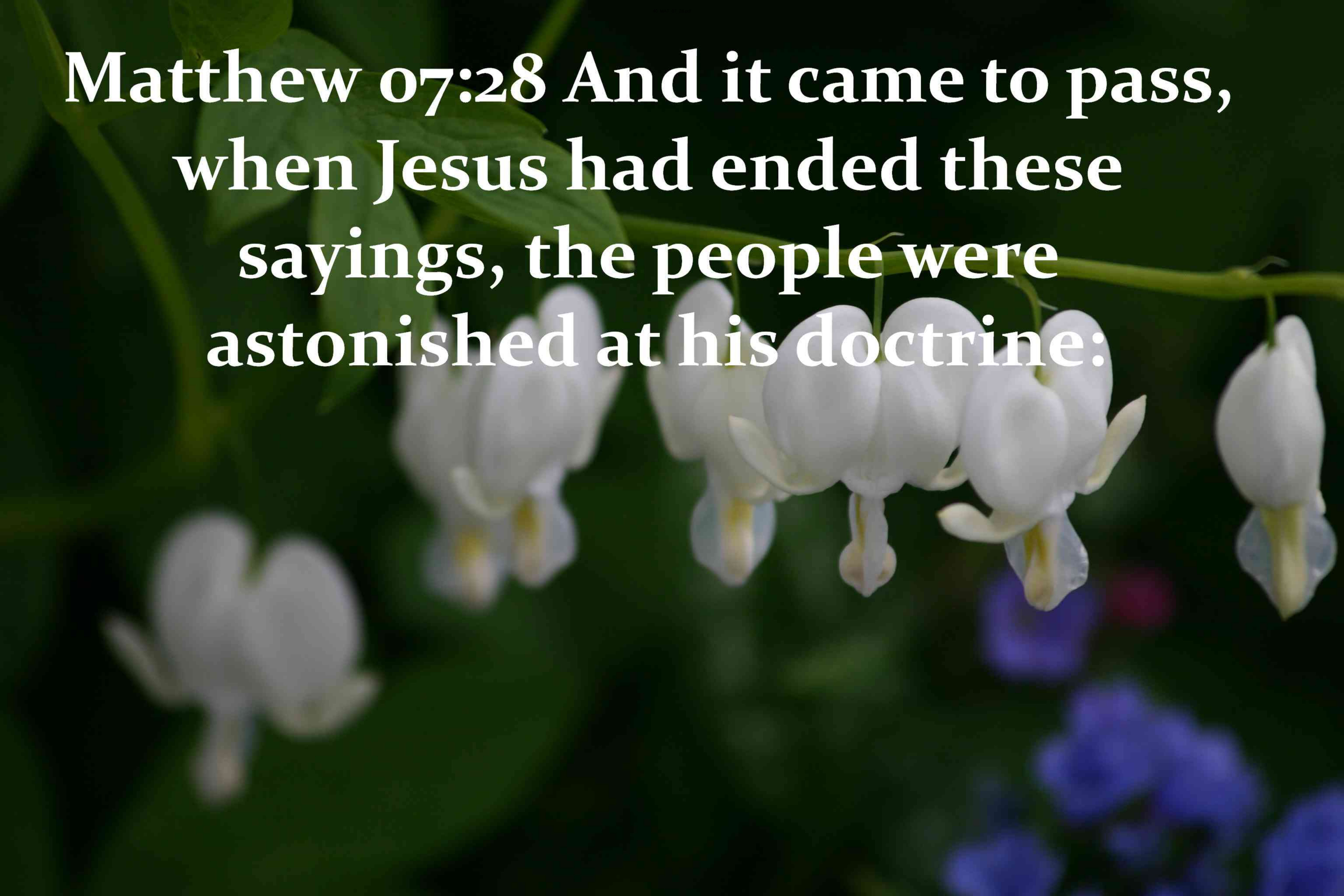
**Matthew 07:26 And every one that

house upon the sand:**



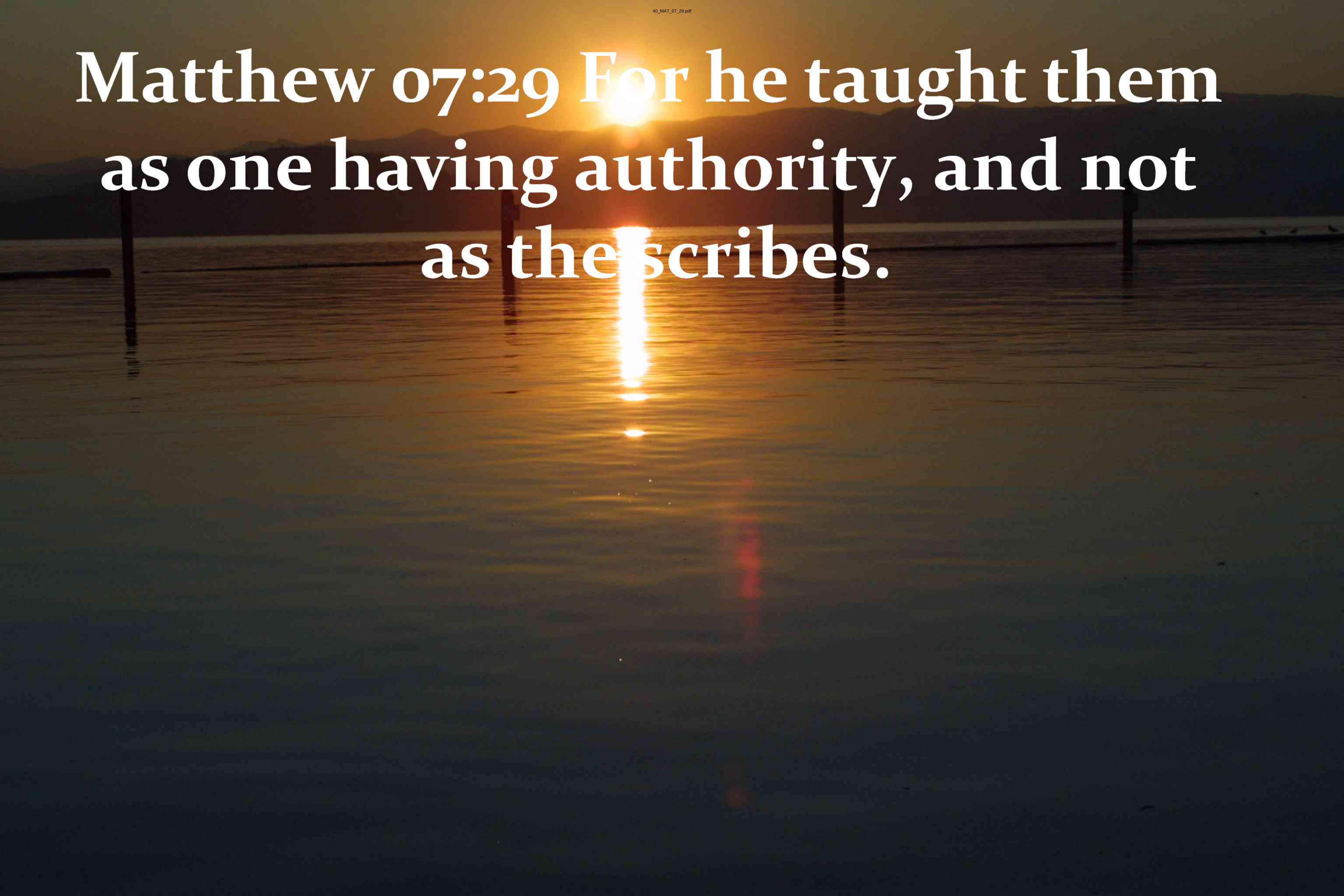
Matthew 07:27 And the rain
