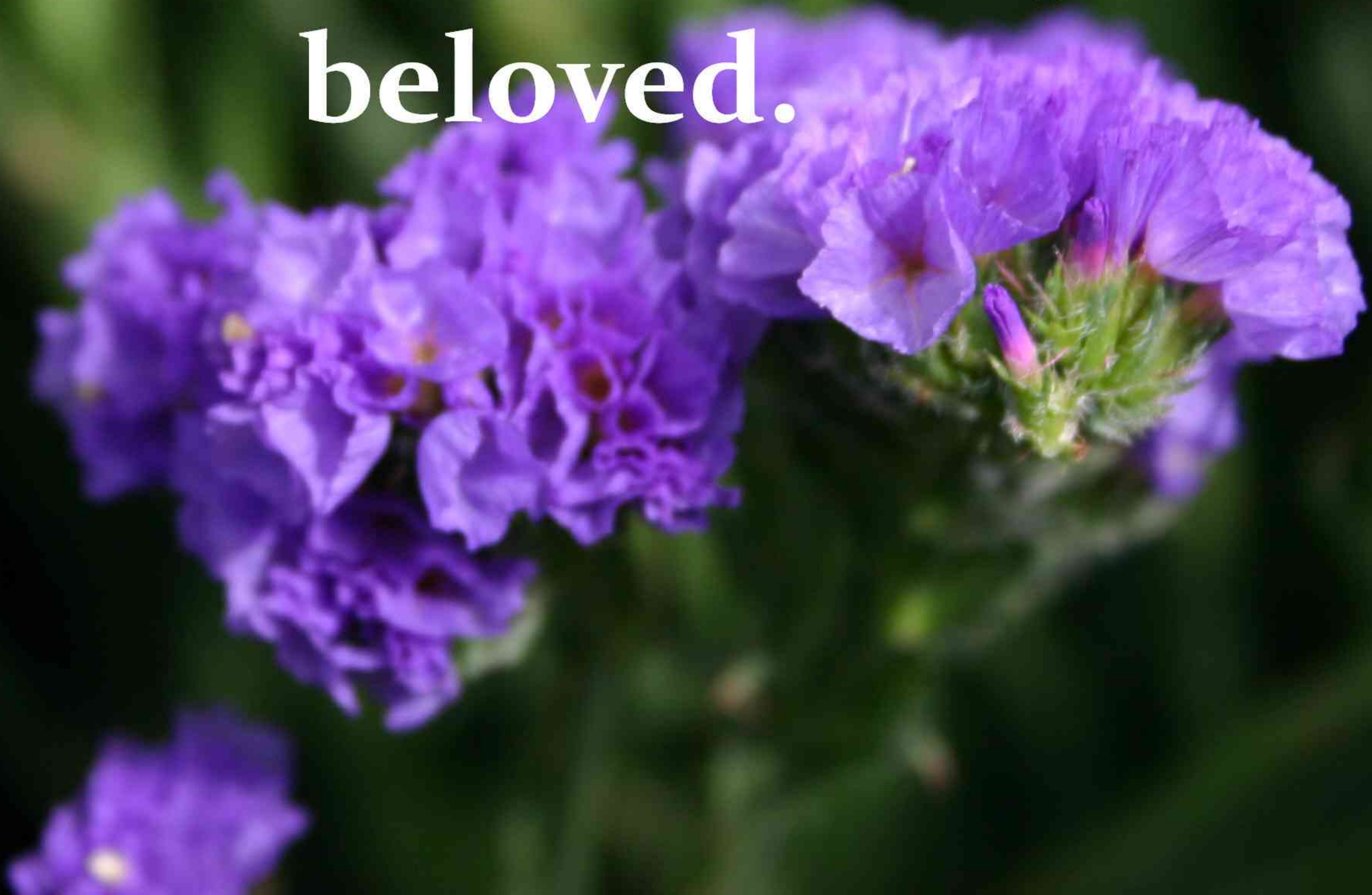
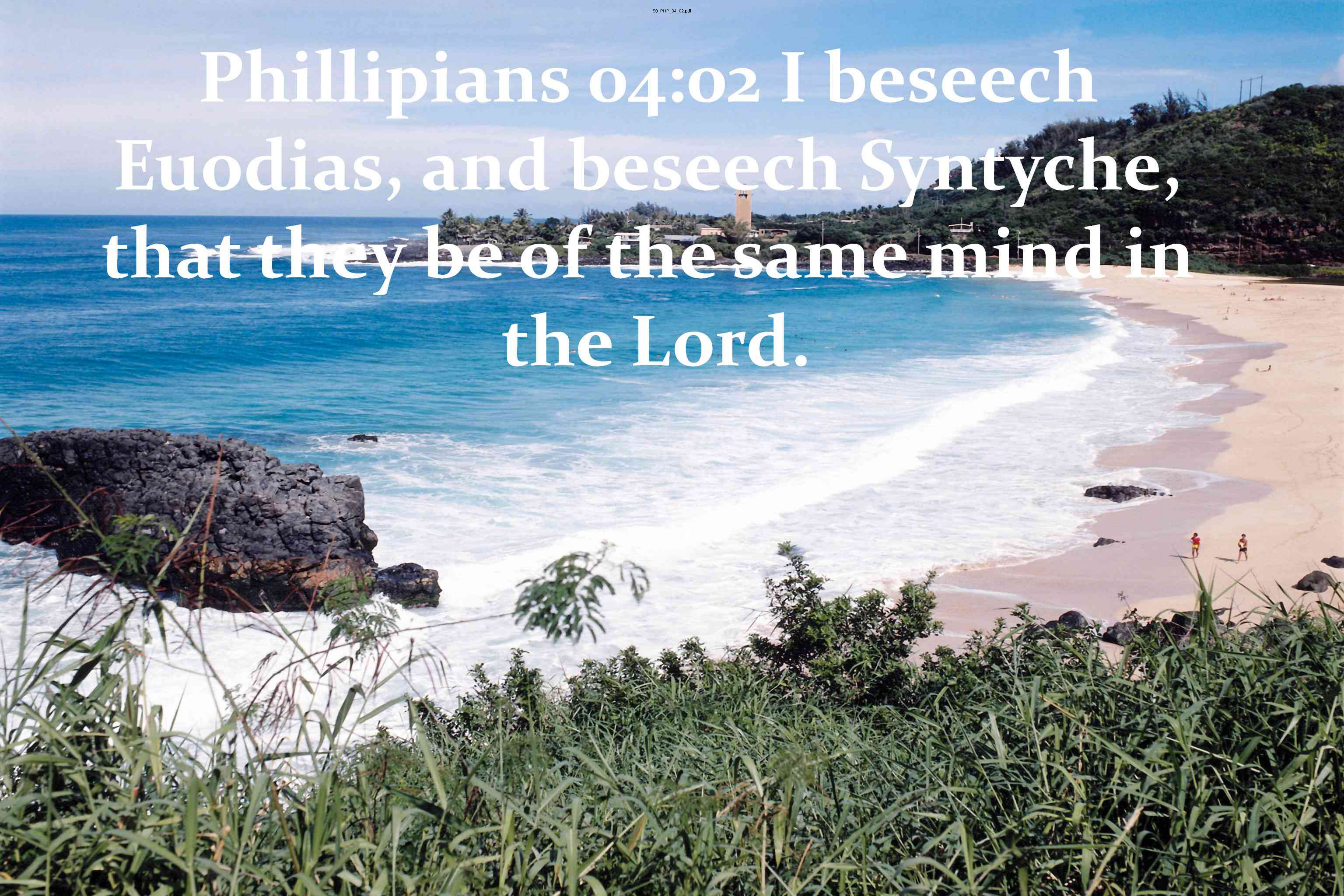


Phillipians 04:01 Therefore, my

Rejoice.

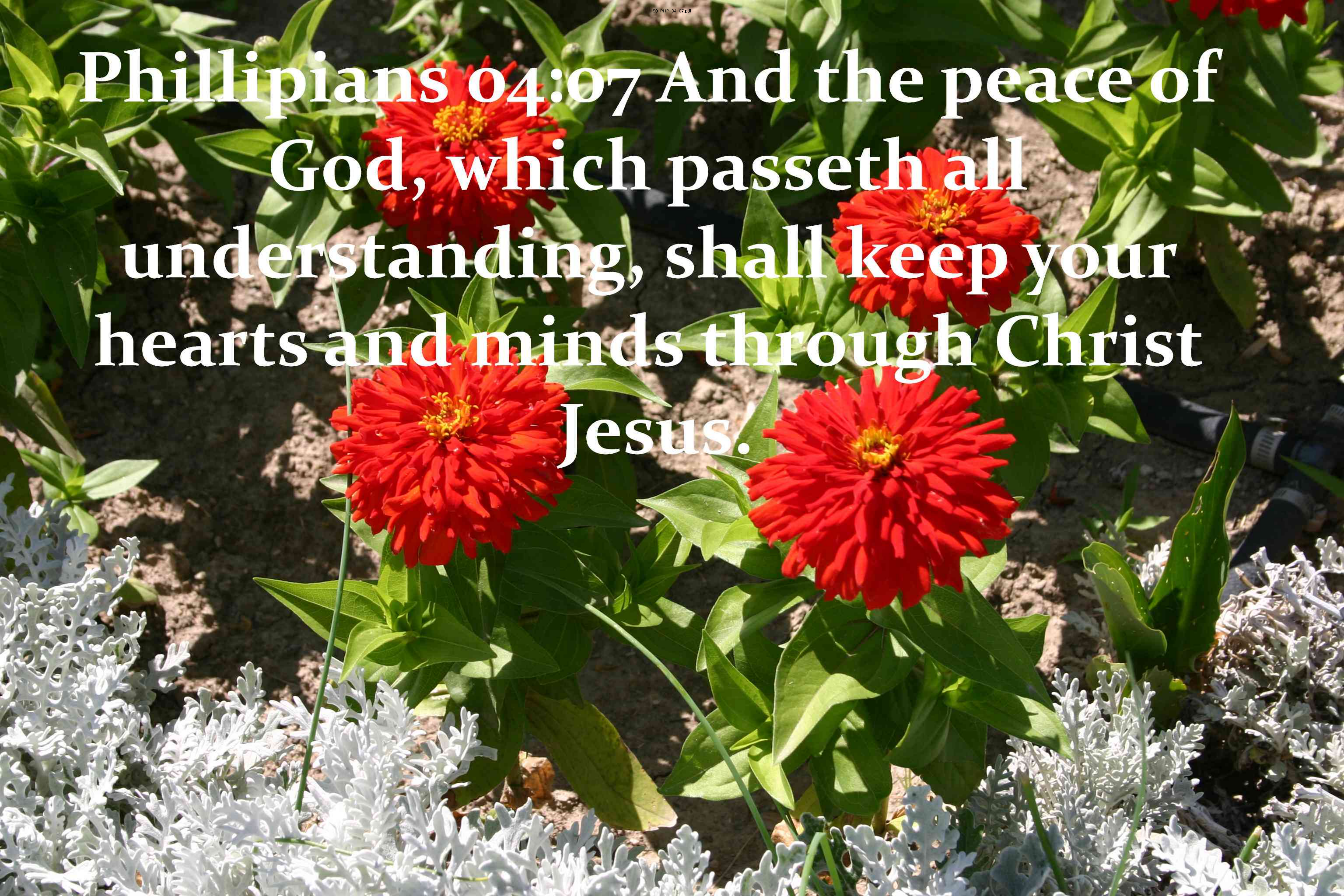


**Phillipians 04:05 Let your

if there be any praise, think on

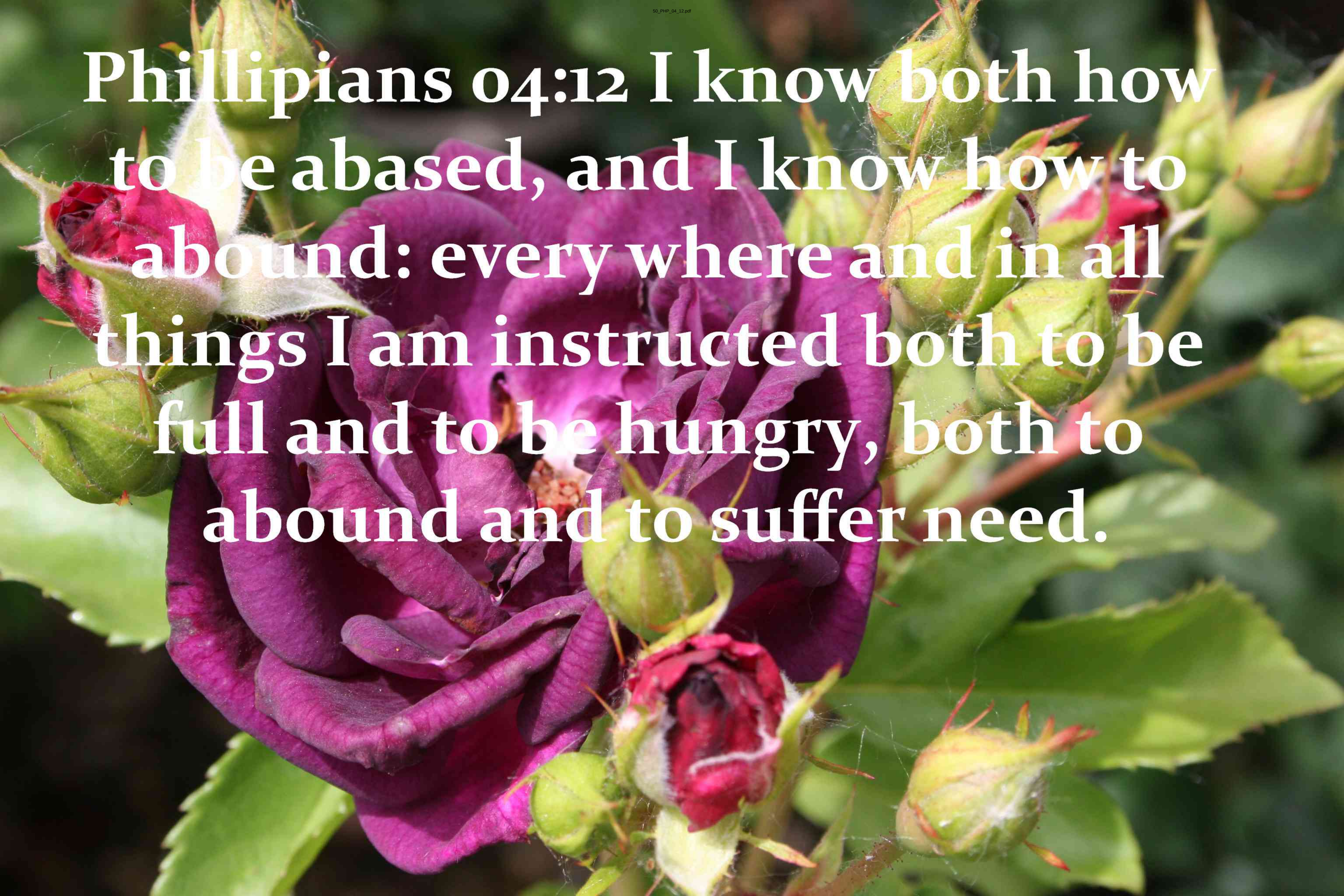
Phillipians 04:09 Those things,

strengtheneth me.

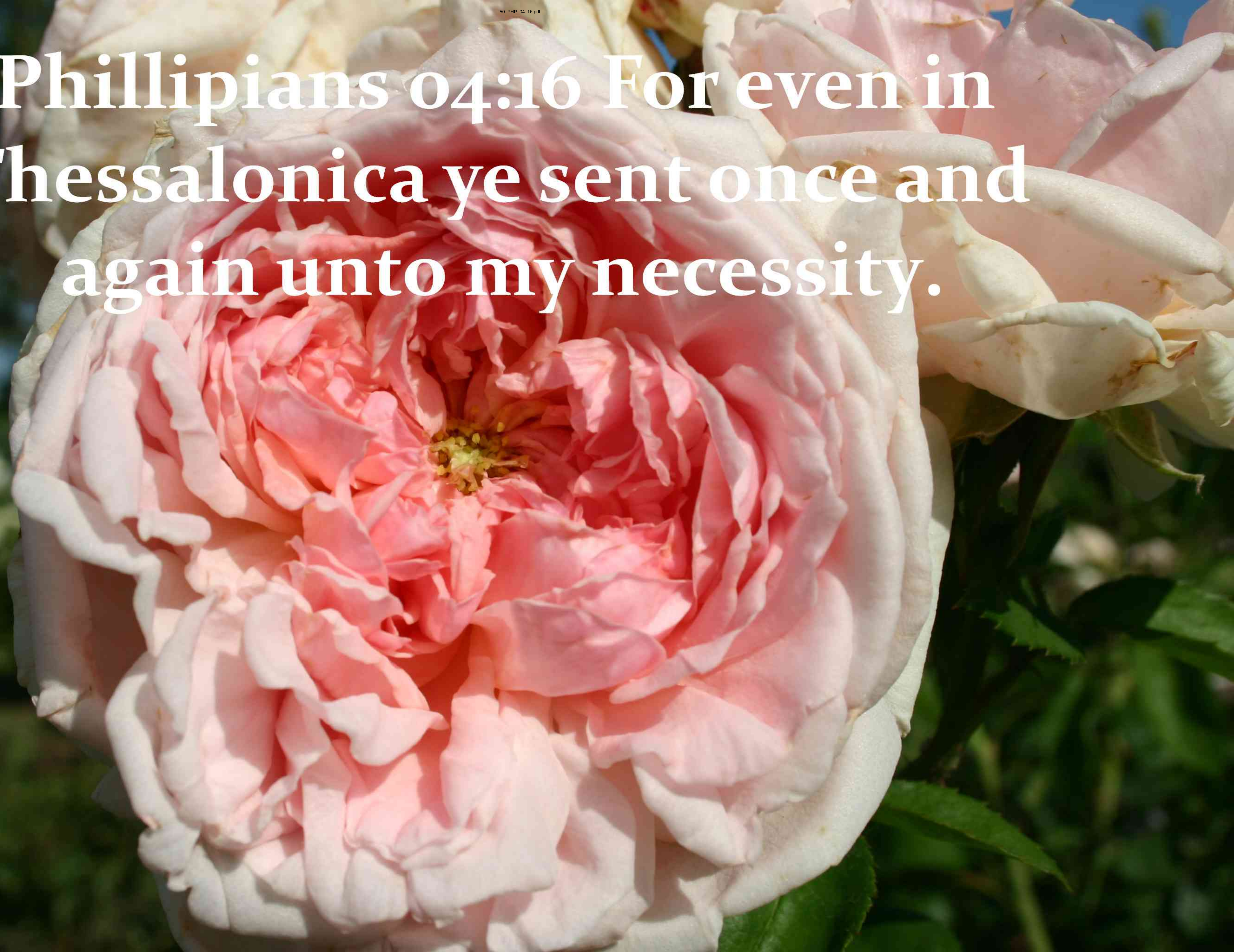


Phillipians 04:14 Notwithstanding

but ye only.

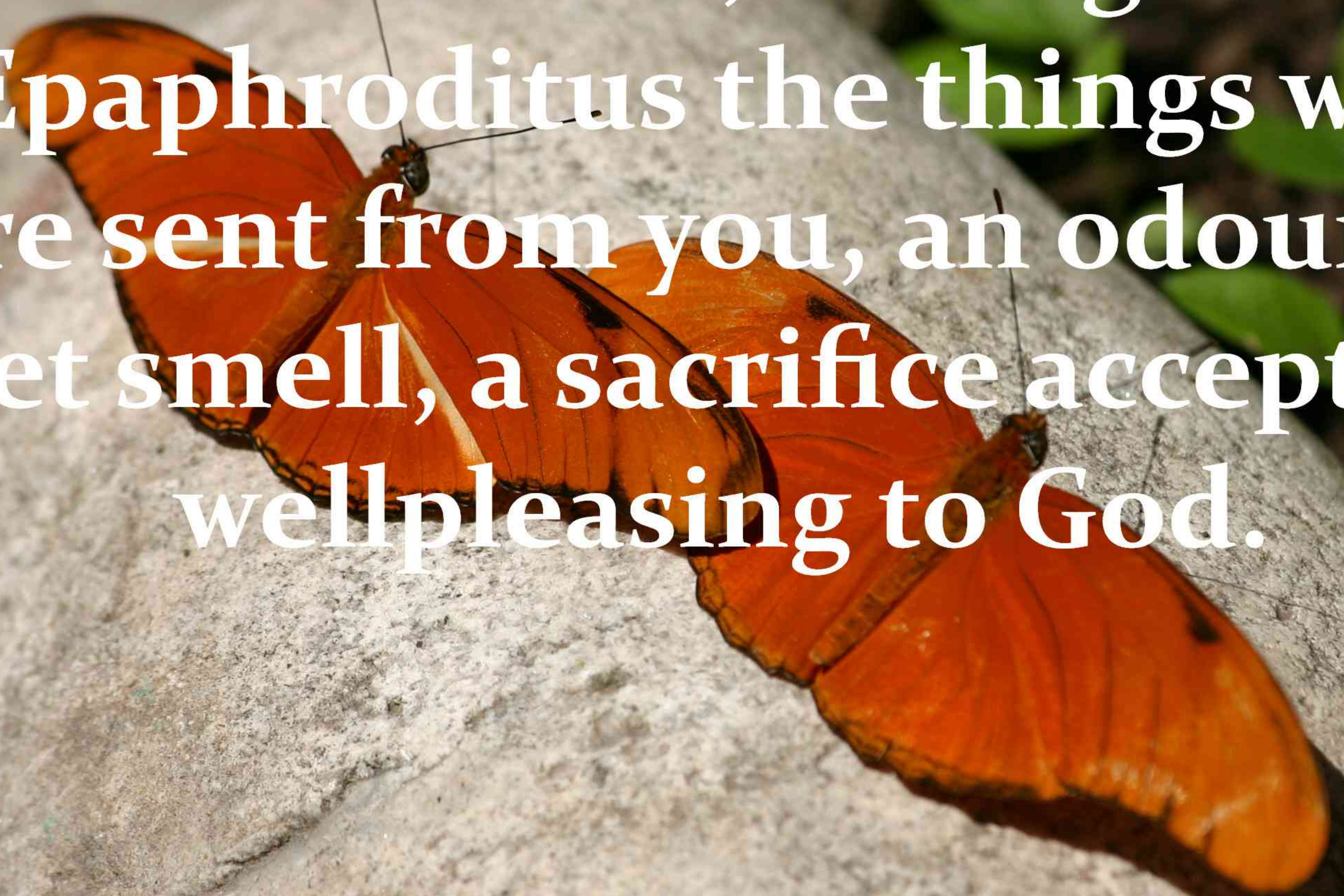
Phillipians 04:16 For even in

may abound to your account.



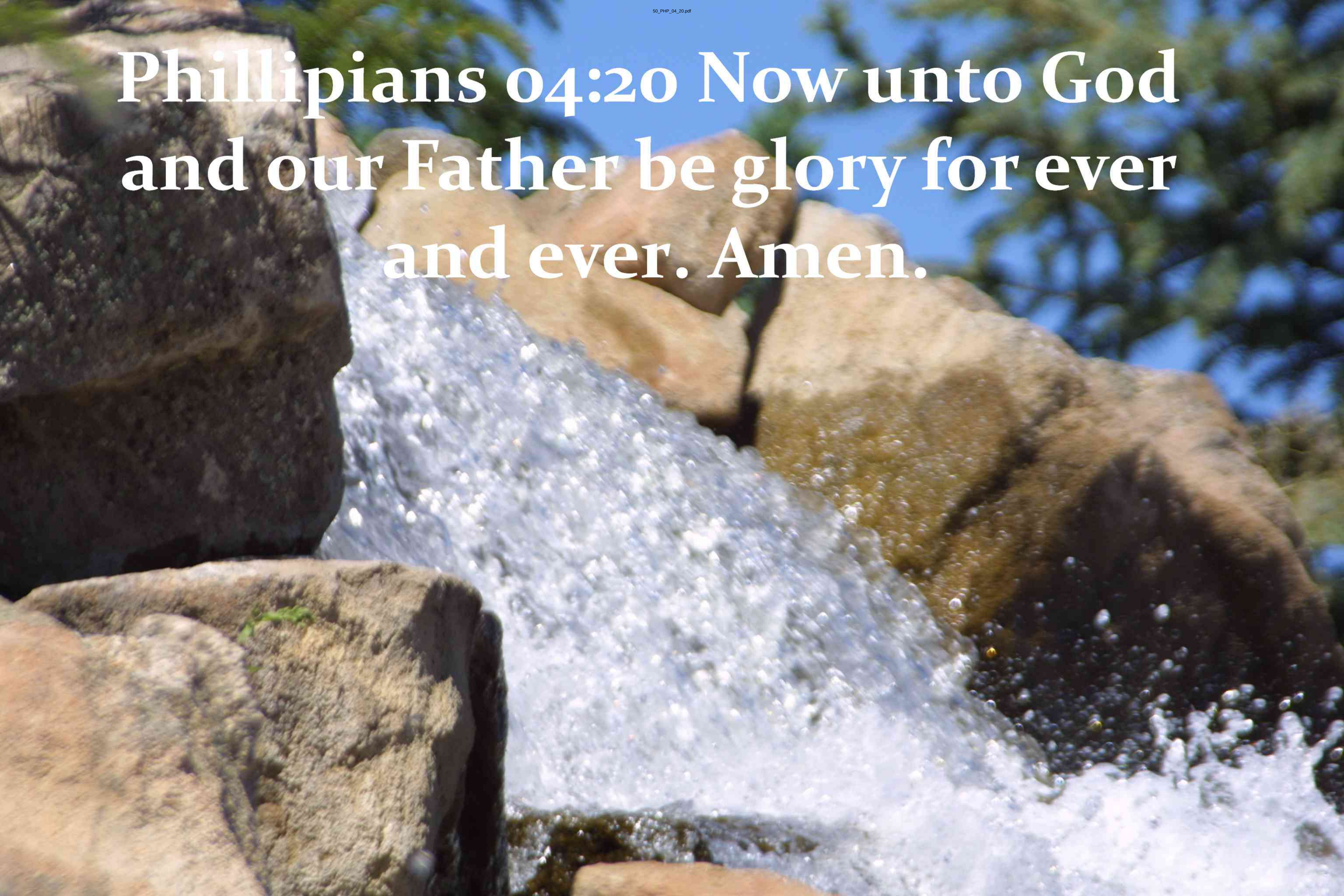

and ever. Amen.

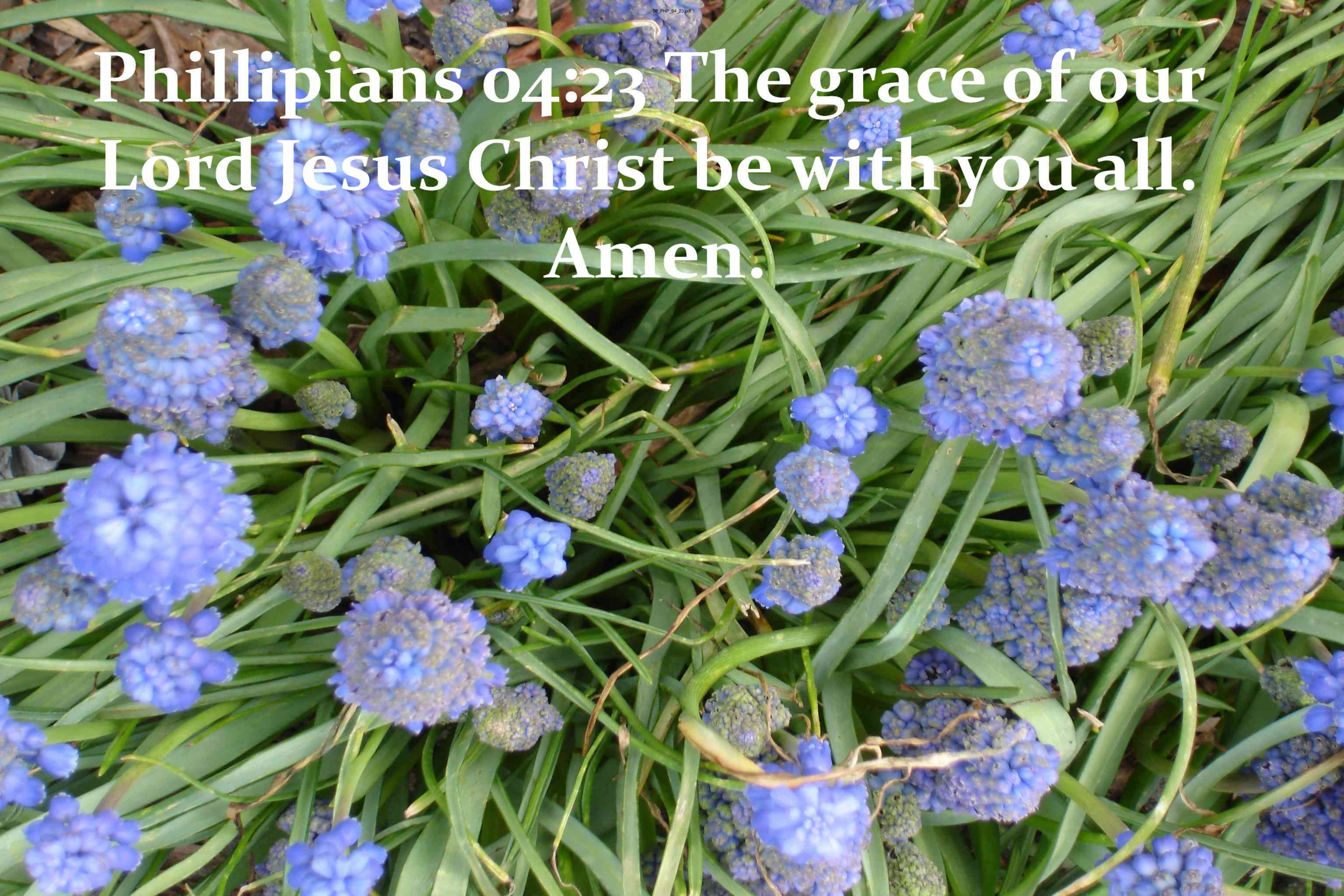


Phillipians 04:21 Salute every saint
