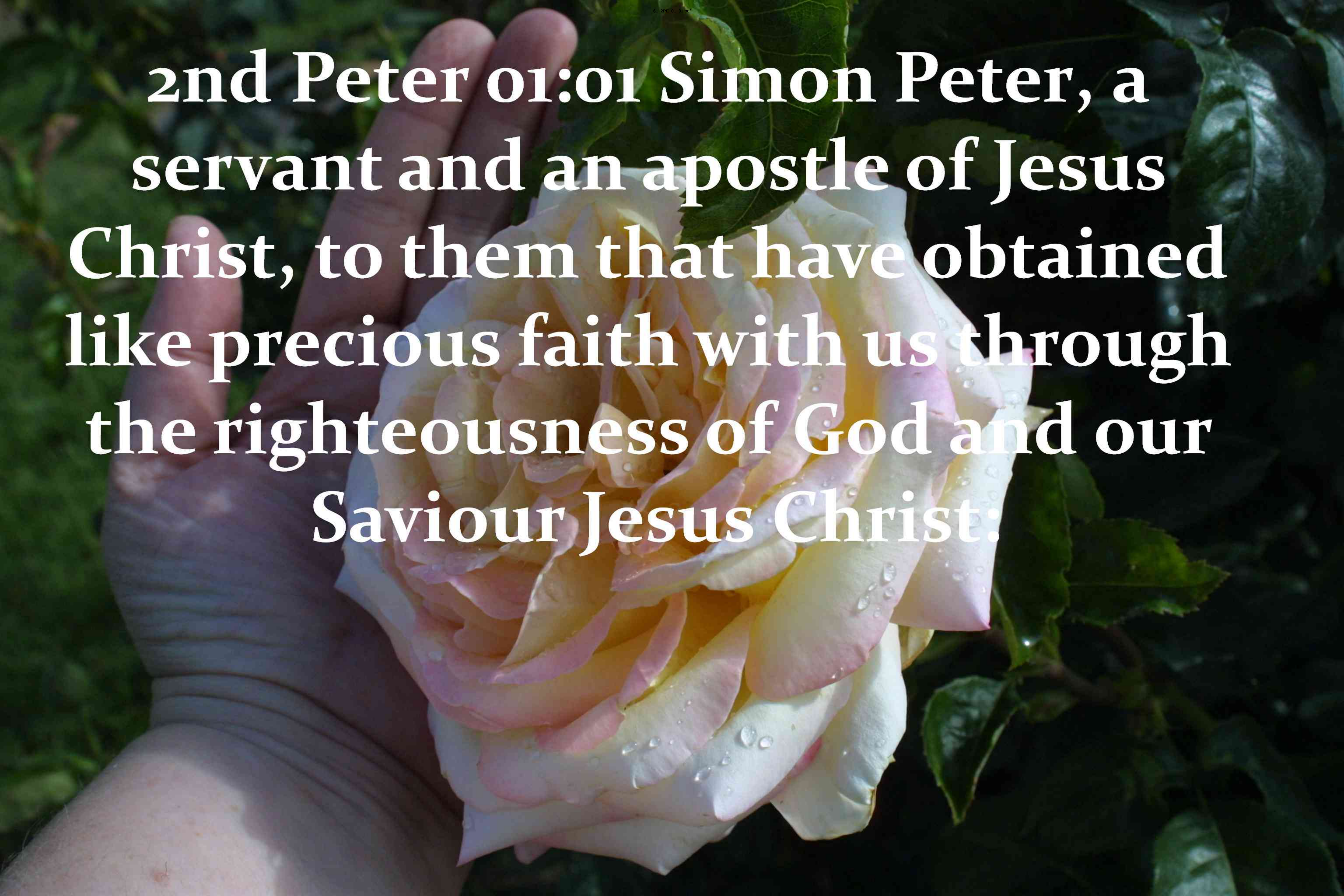
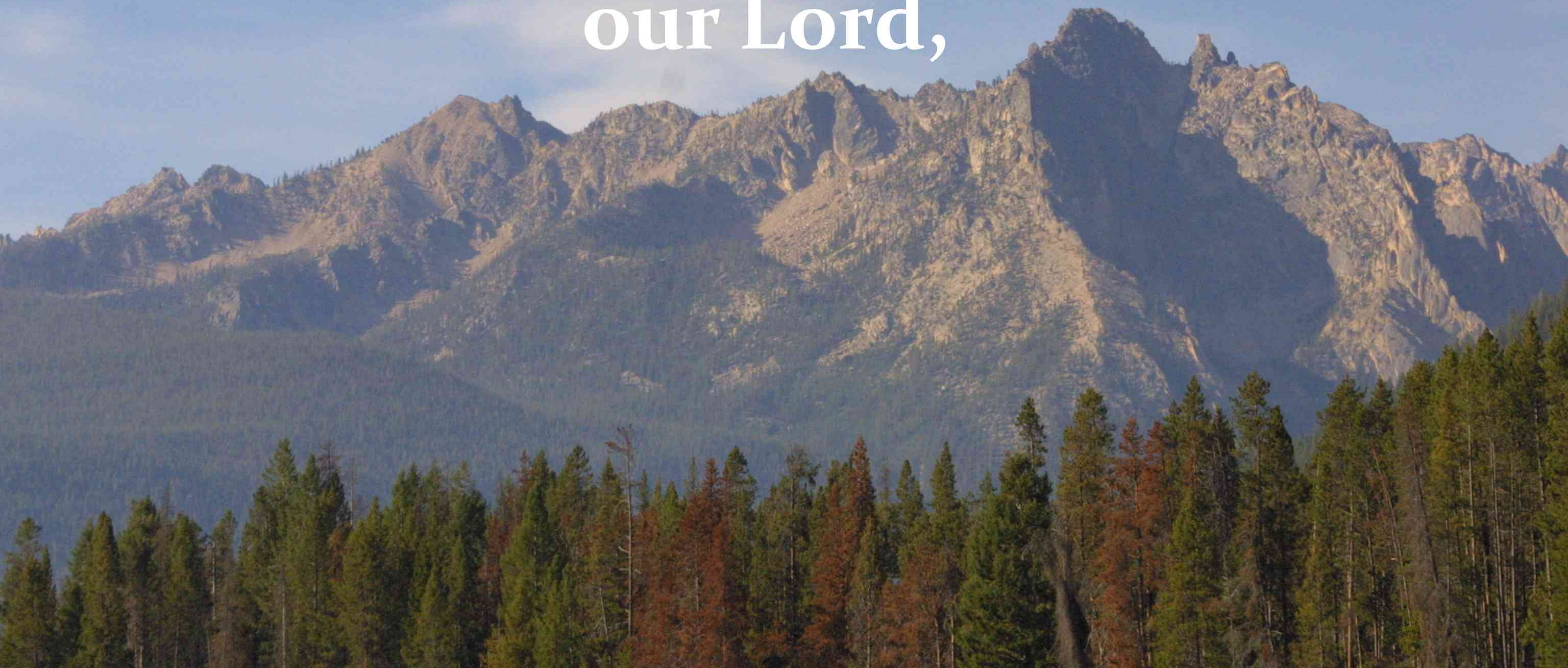




2nd Peter 01:01 Simon Peter, a

our Lord,

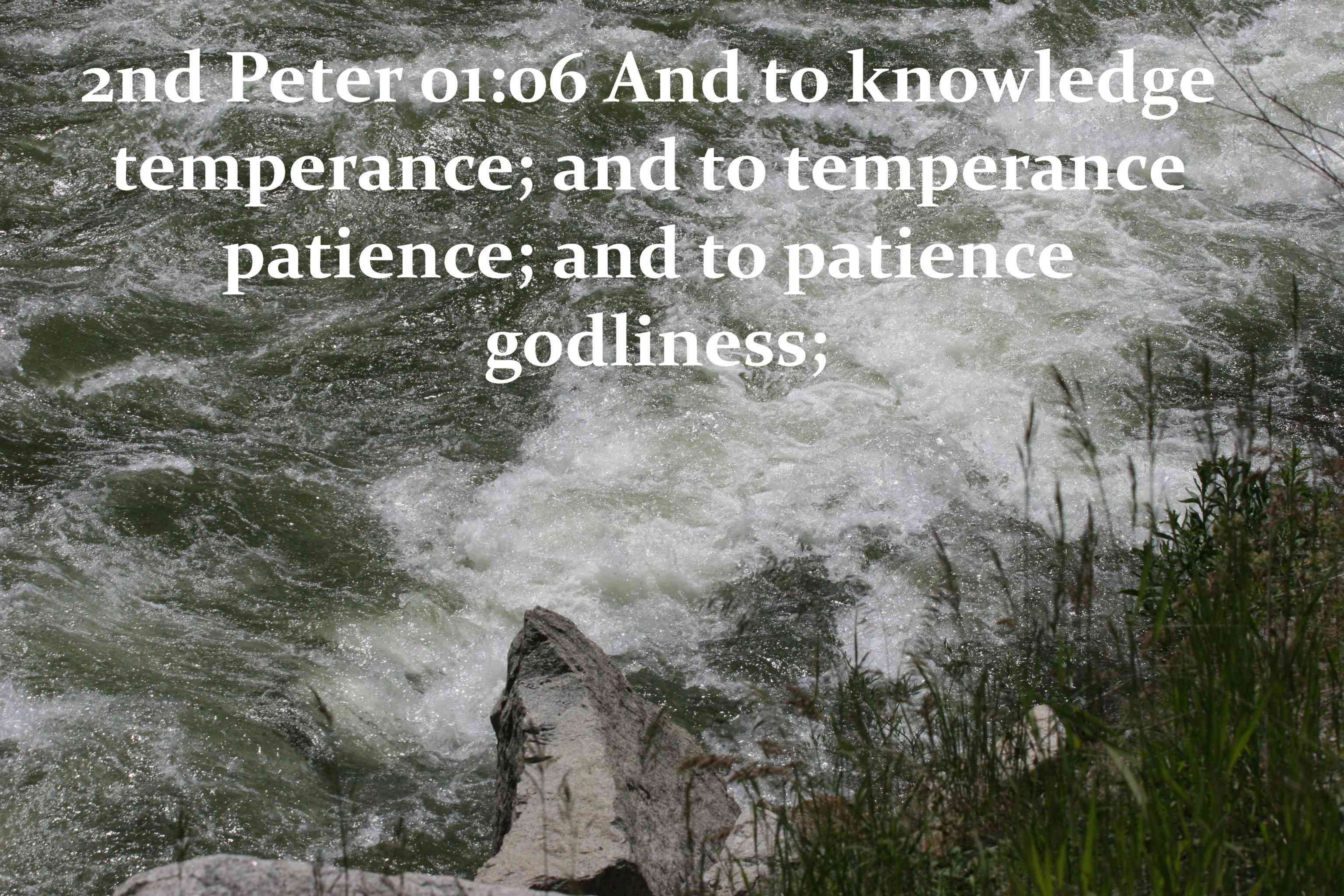


2nd Peter 01:03 According as his

and virtue:



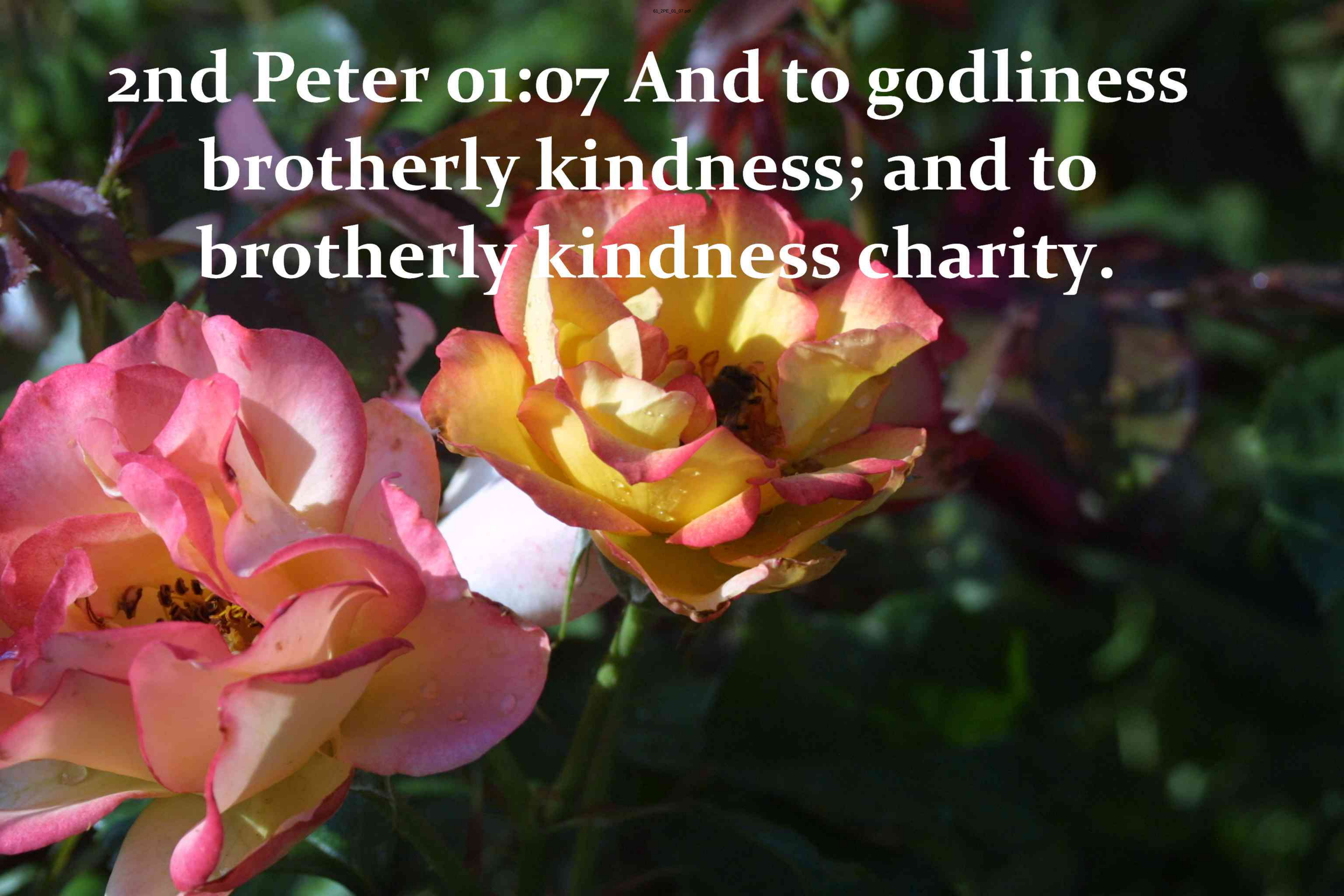
2nd Peter 01:04 Whereby are given

brotherly kindness charity.

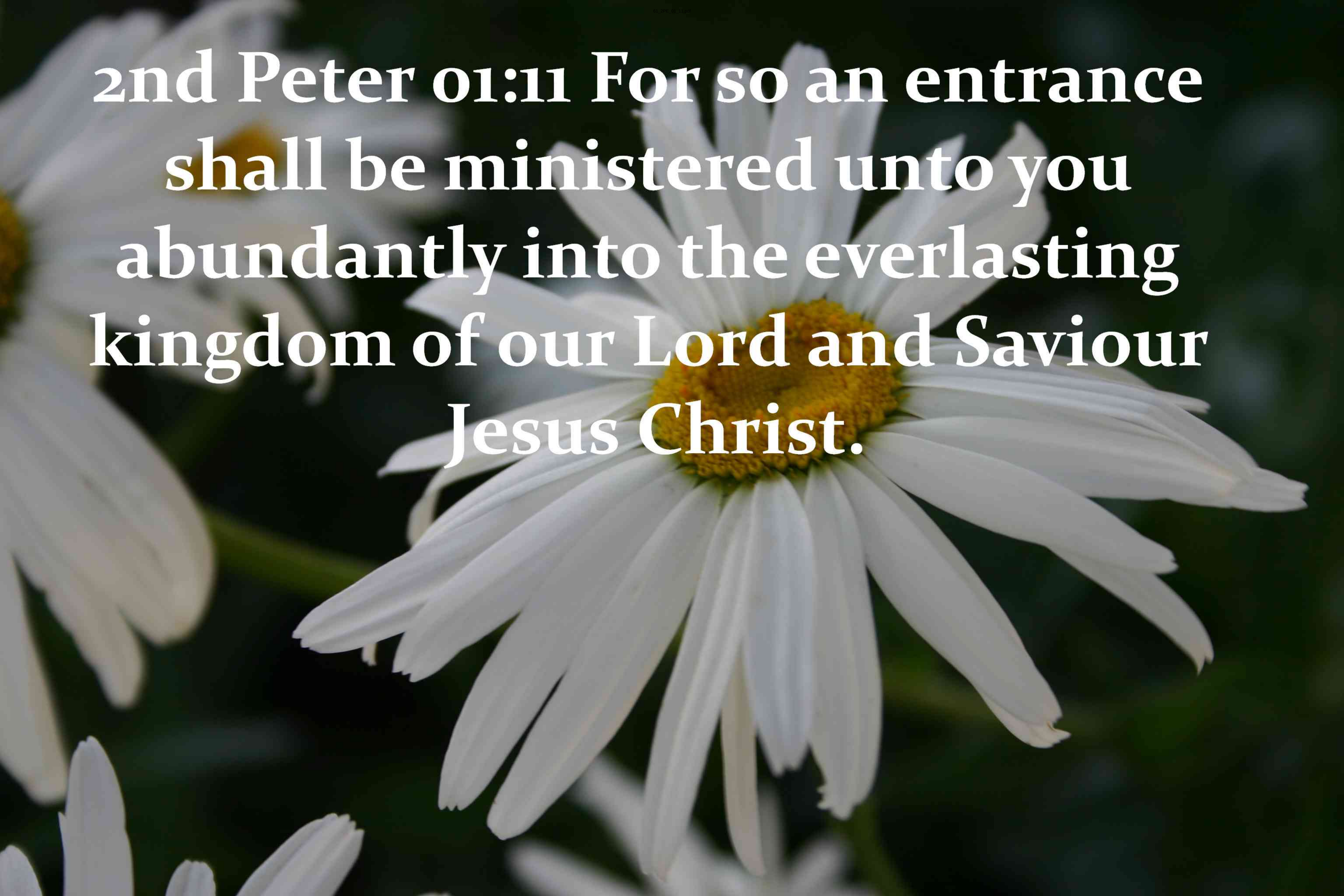


2nd Peter 01:08 For if these things

our Lord Jesus Christ.

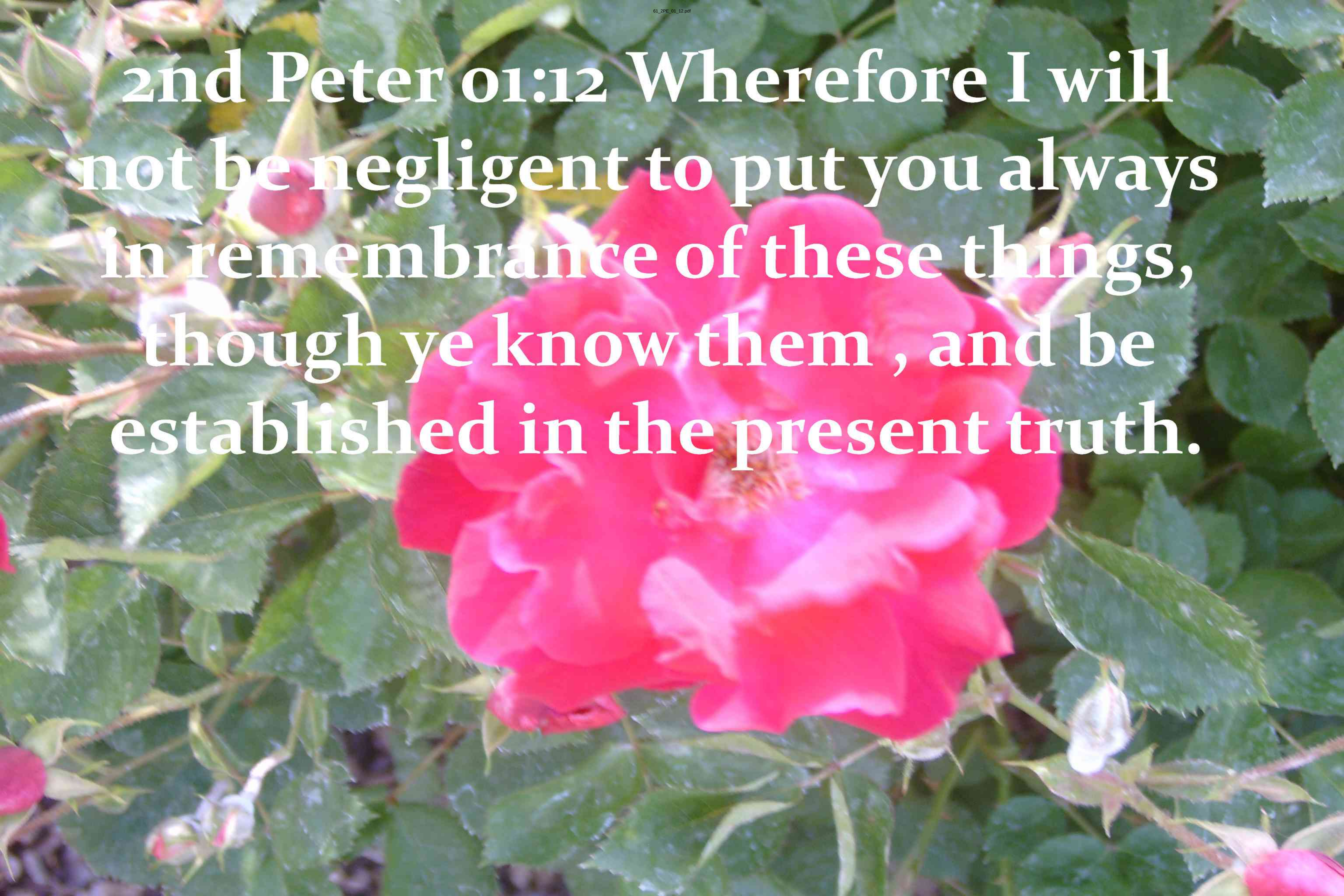

shall never fall:

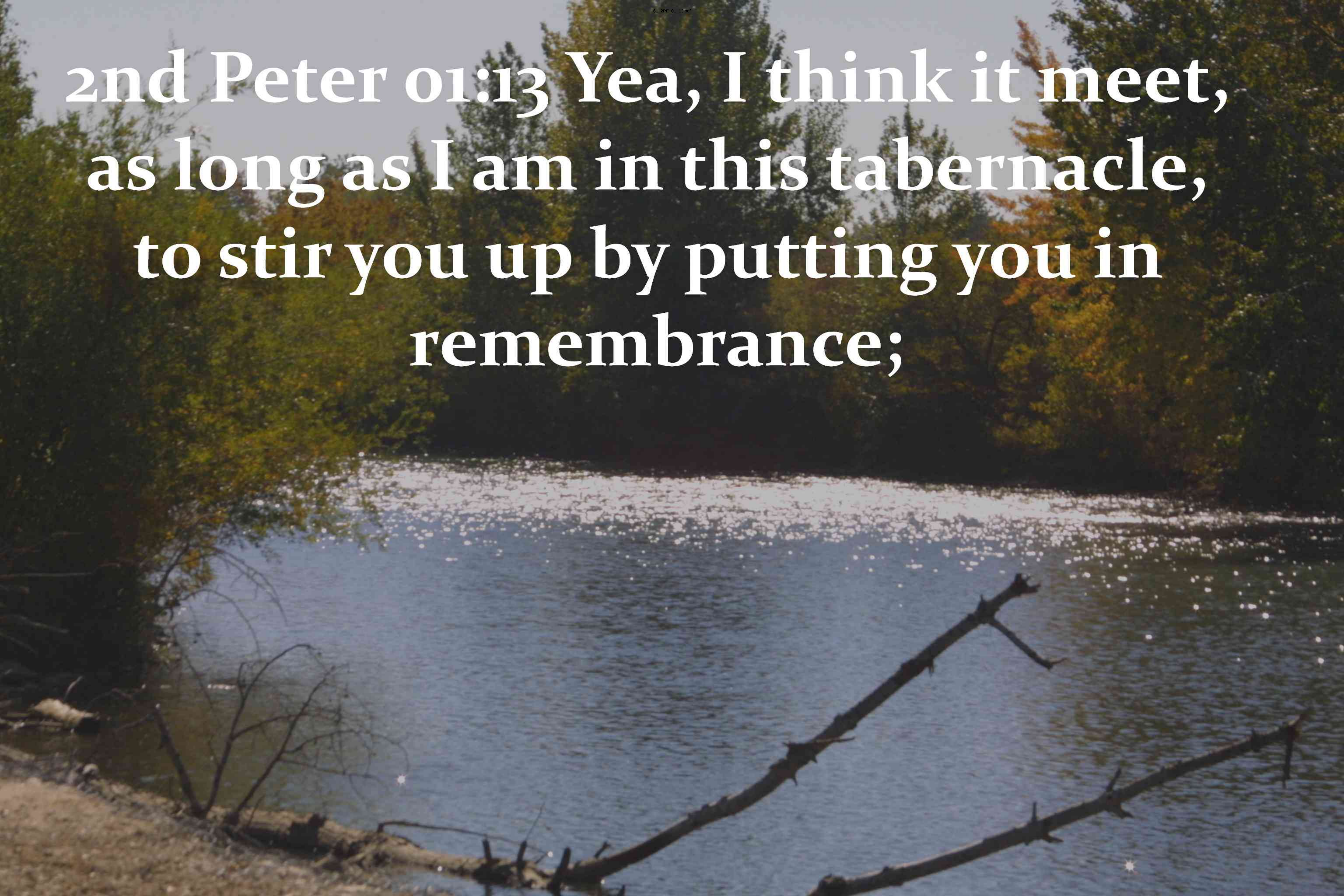


2nd Peter 01:11 For so an entrance

Jesus Christ.

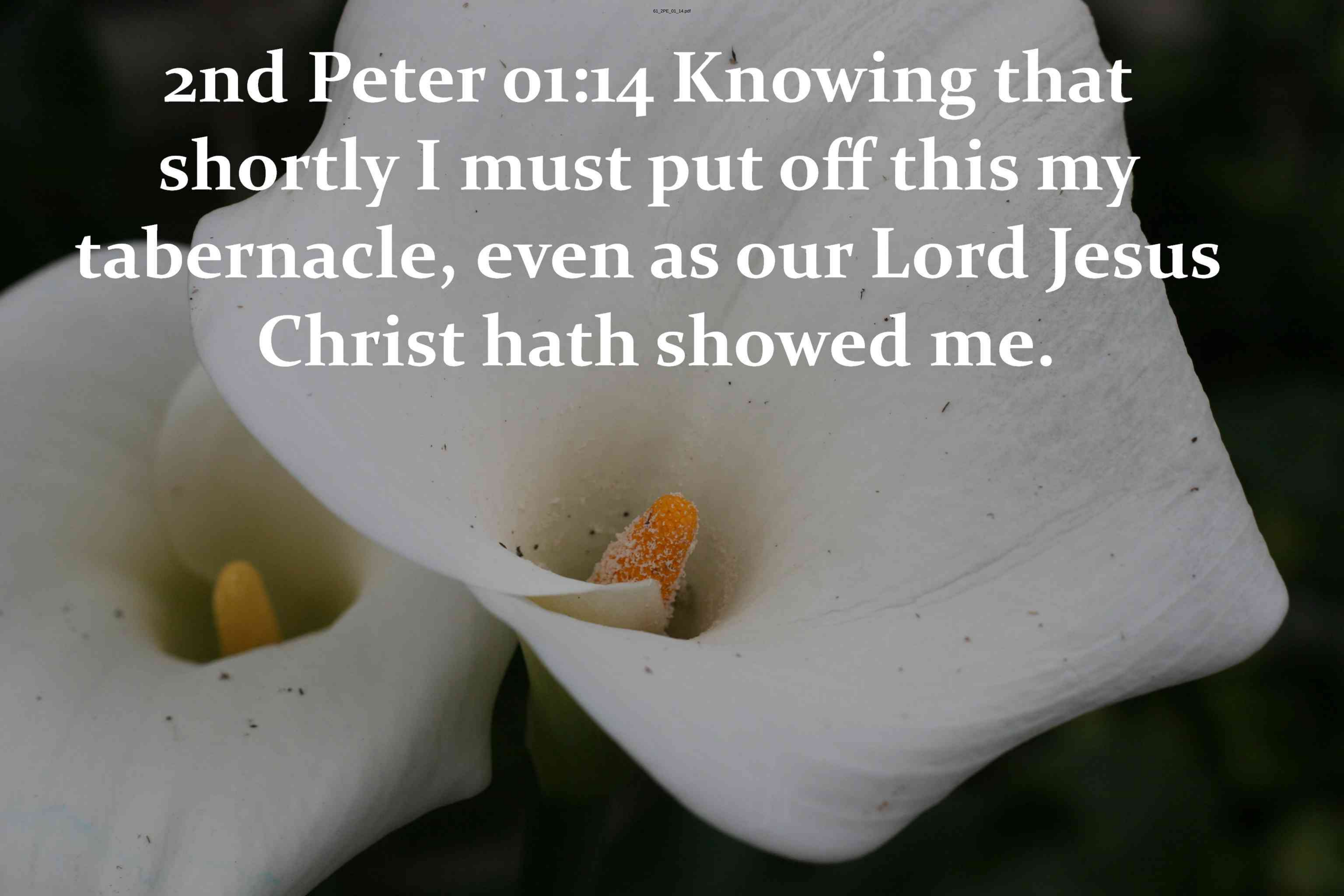


2nd Peter 01:12 Wherefore I will

established in the present truth.

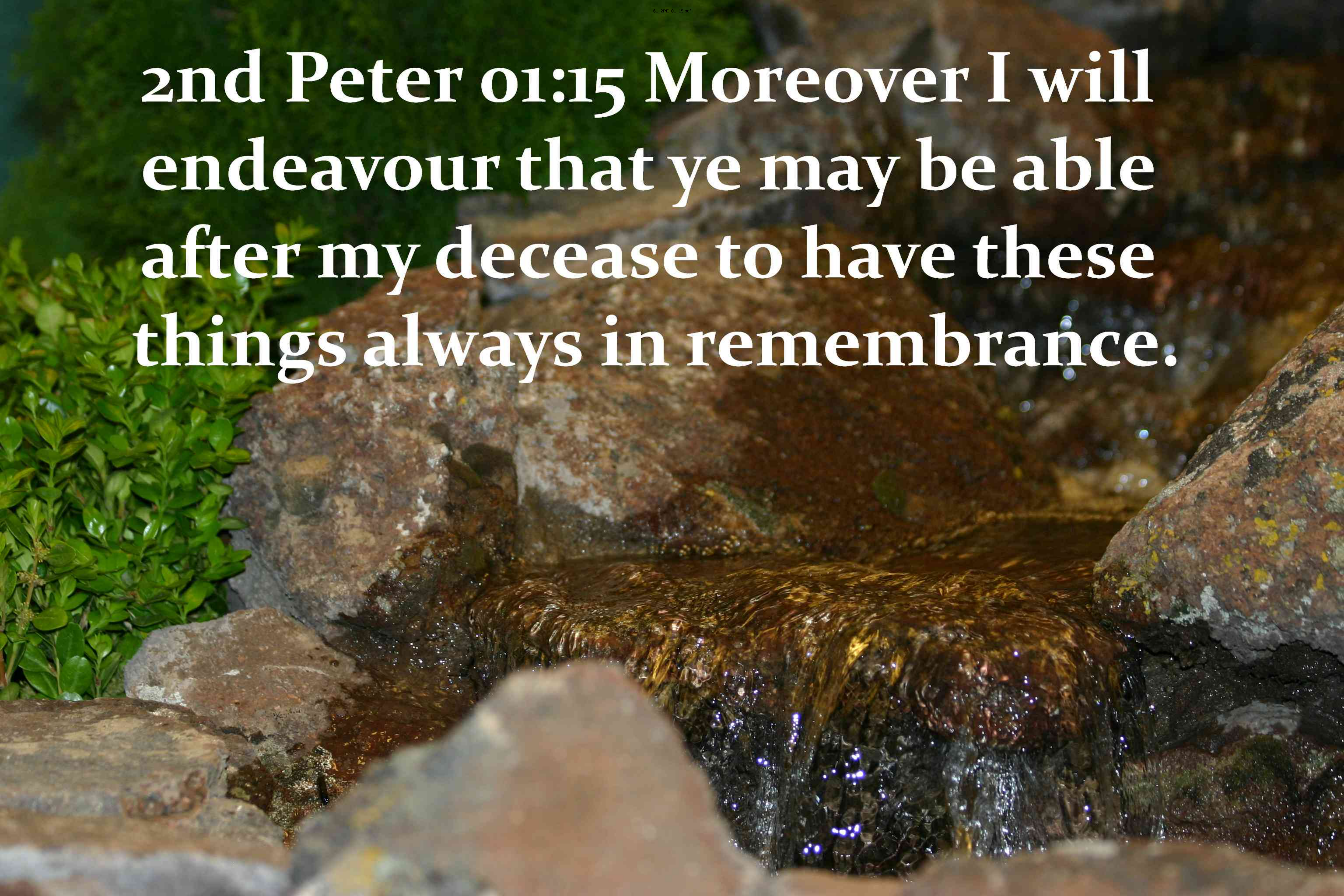
2nd Peter 01:13 Yea, I think it meet,

remembrance;

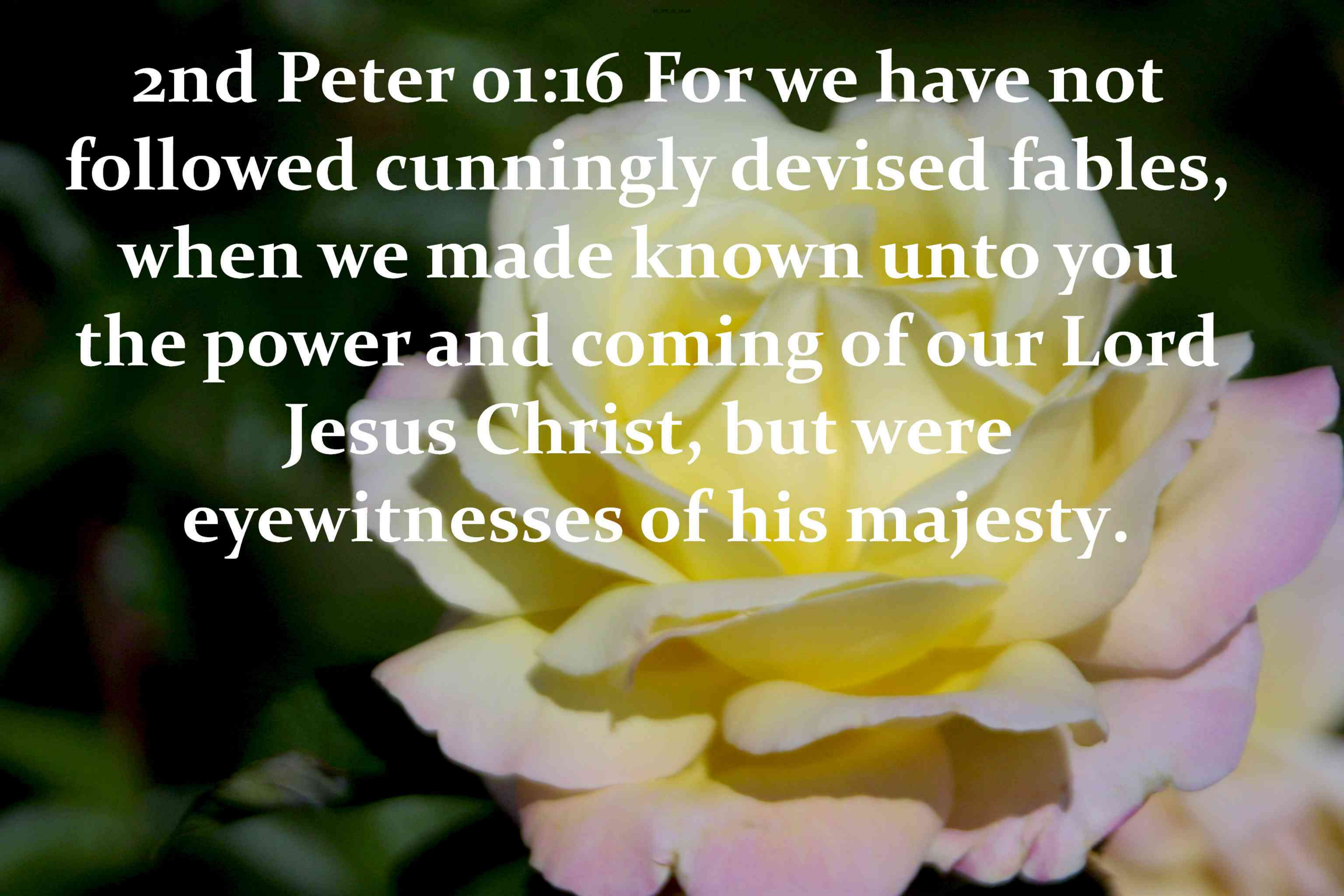


**2nd Peter 01:14 Knowing that

Christ hath showed me.**



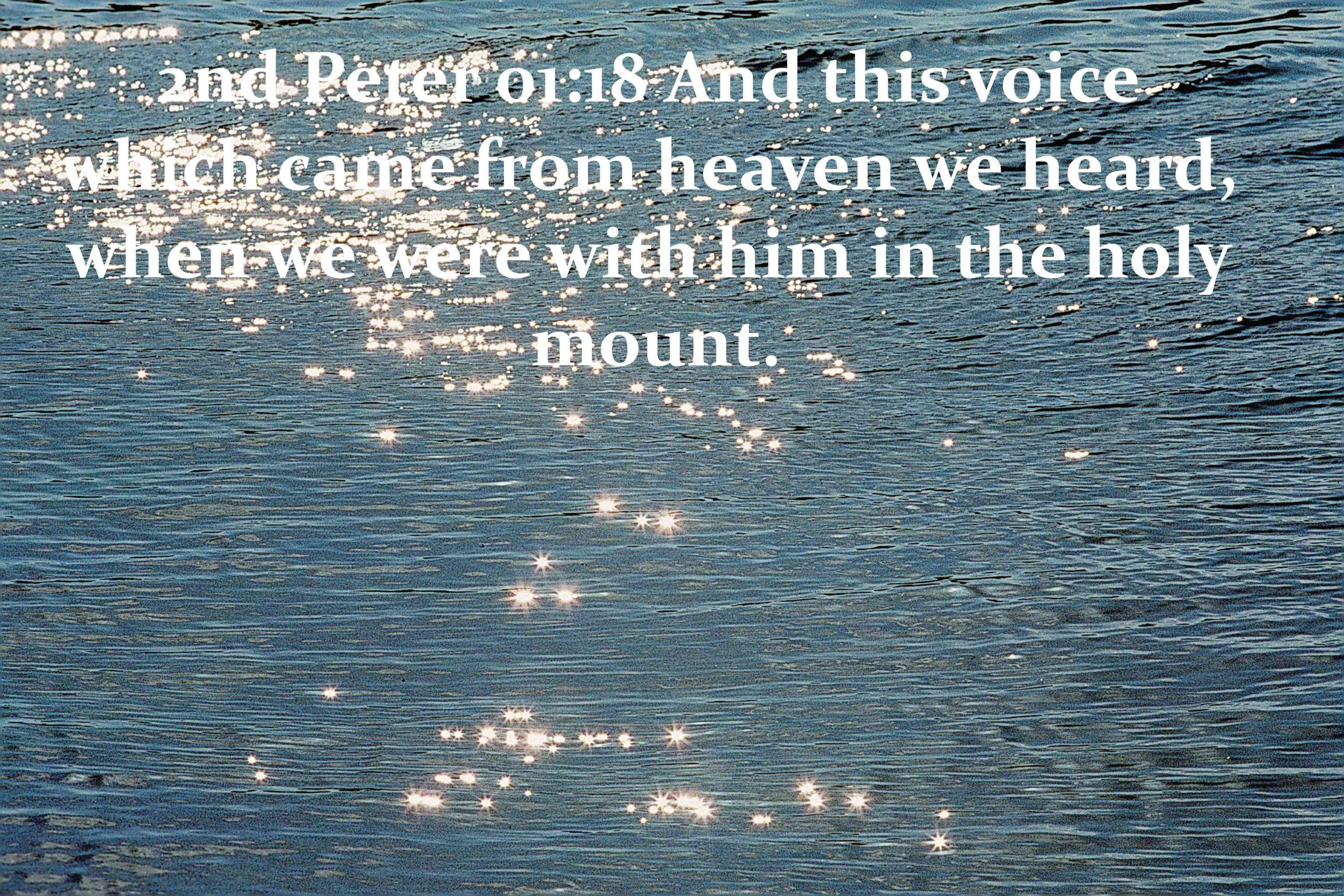
2nd Peter 01:15 Moreover I will

things always in remembrance.





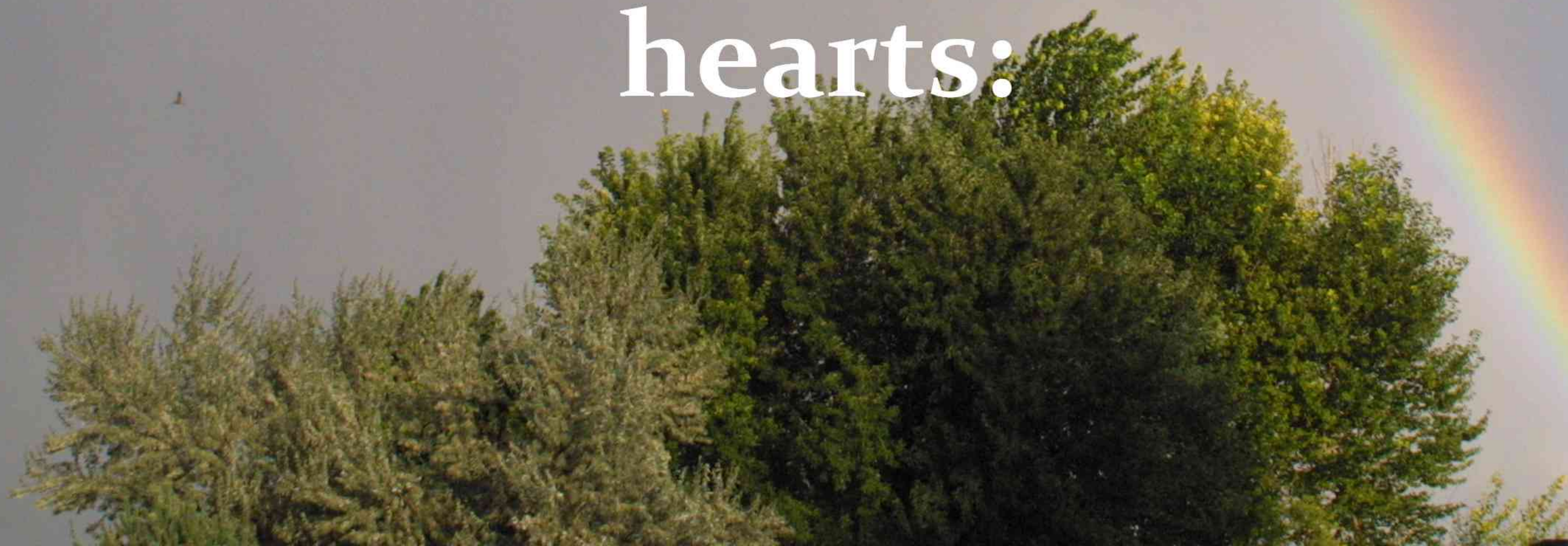
