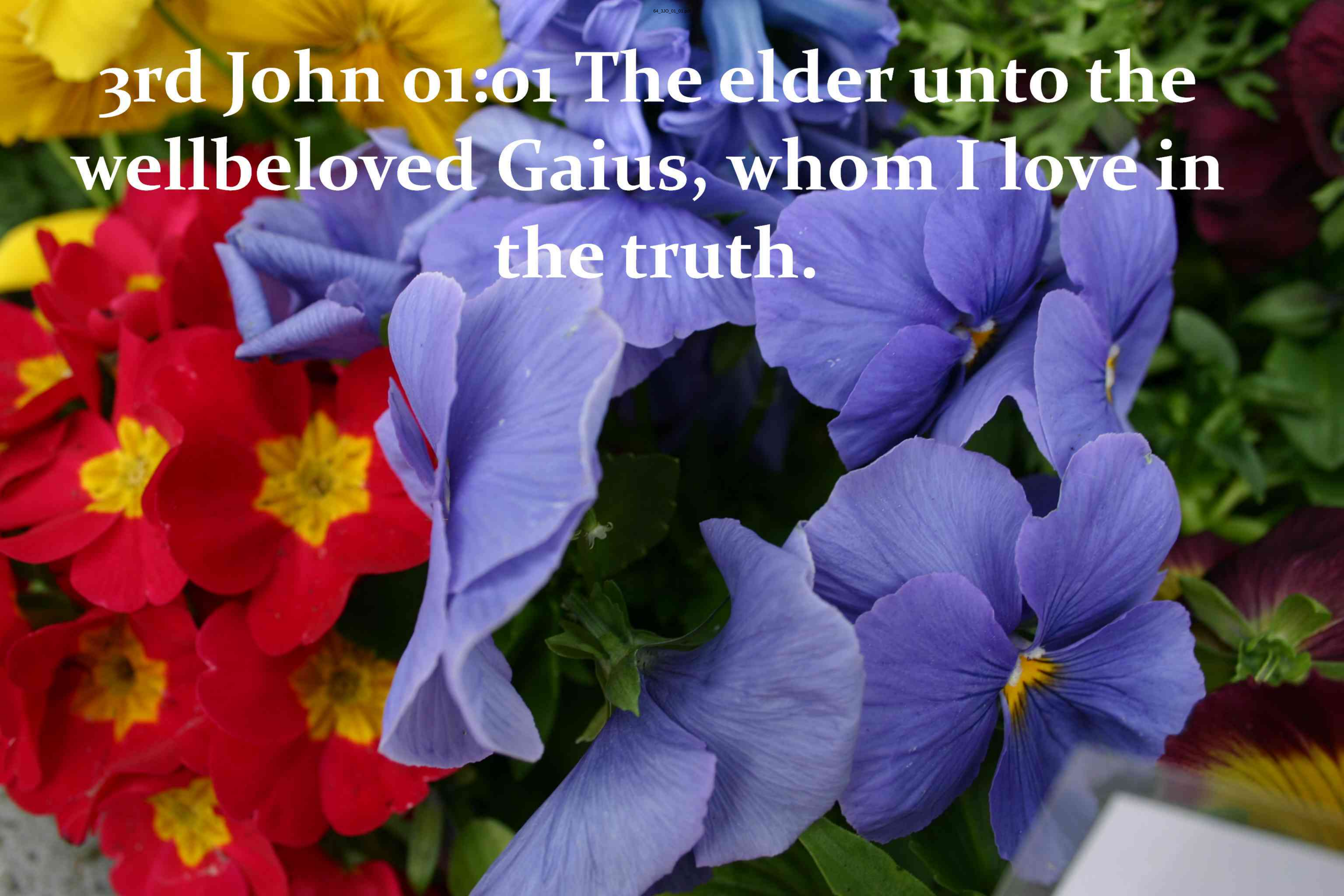
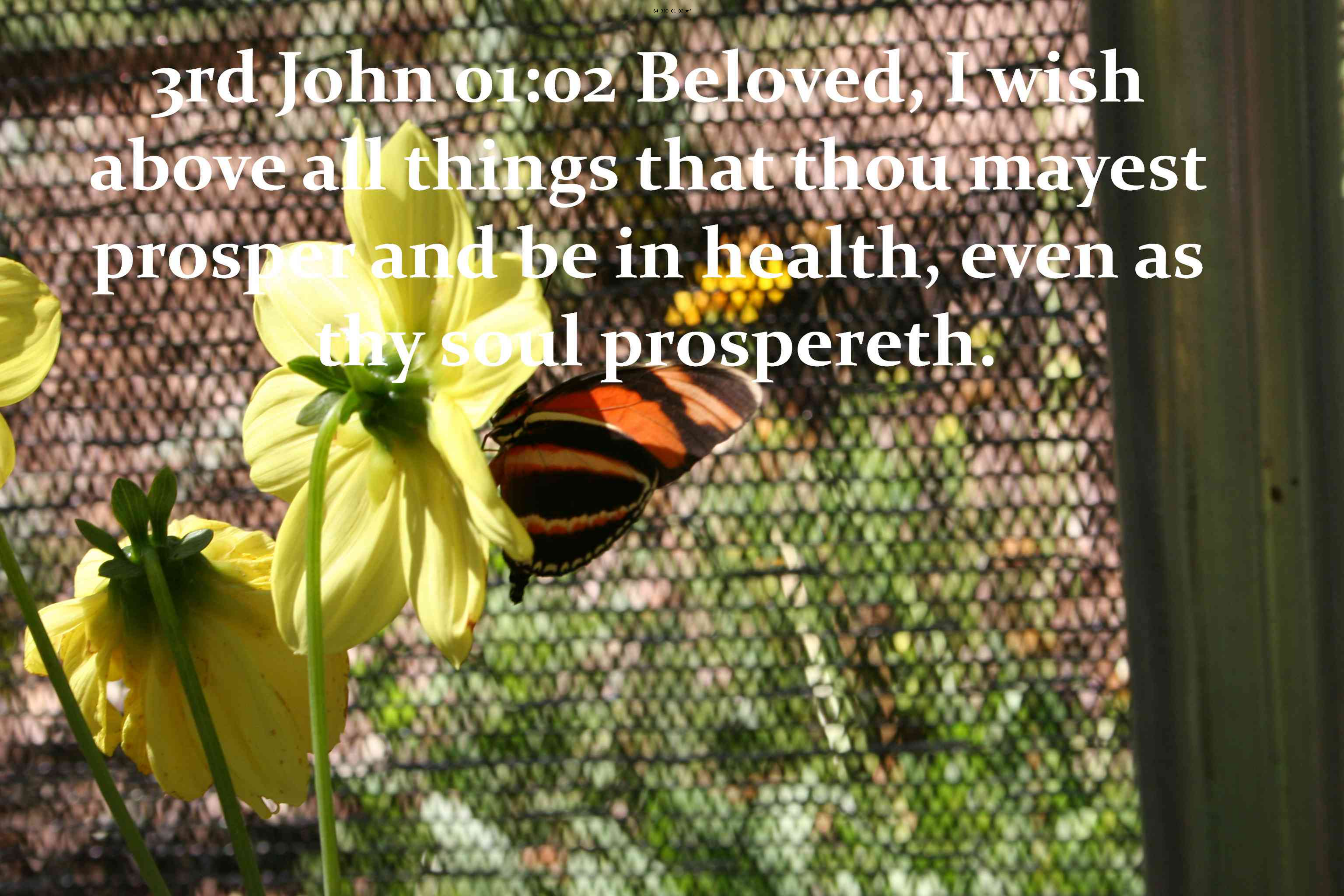


3rd John 01:01 The elder unto the

the truth.

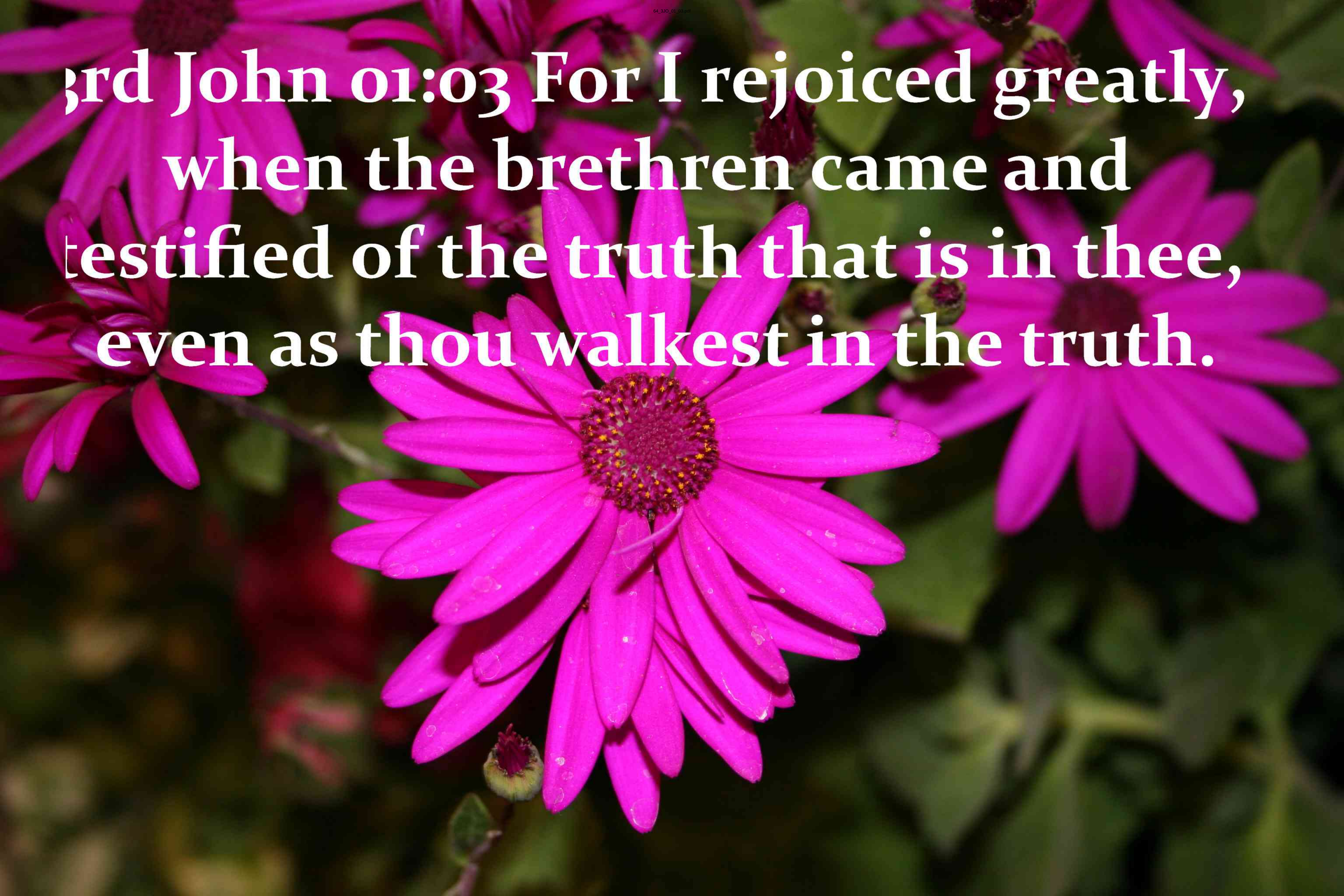




3rd John 01:02 Beloved, I wish

even as thou walkest in the truth.

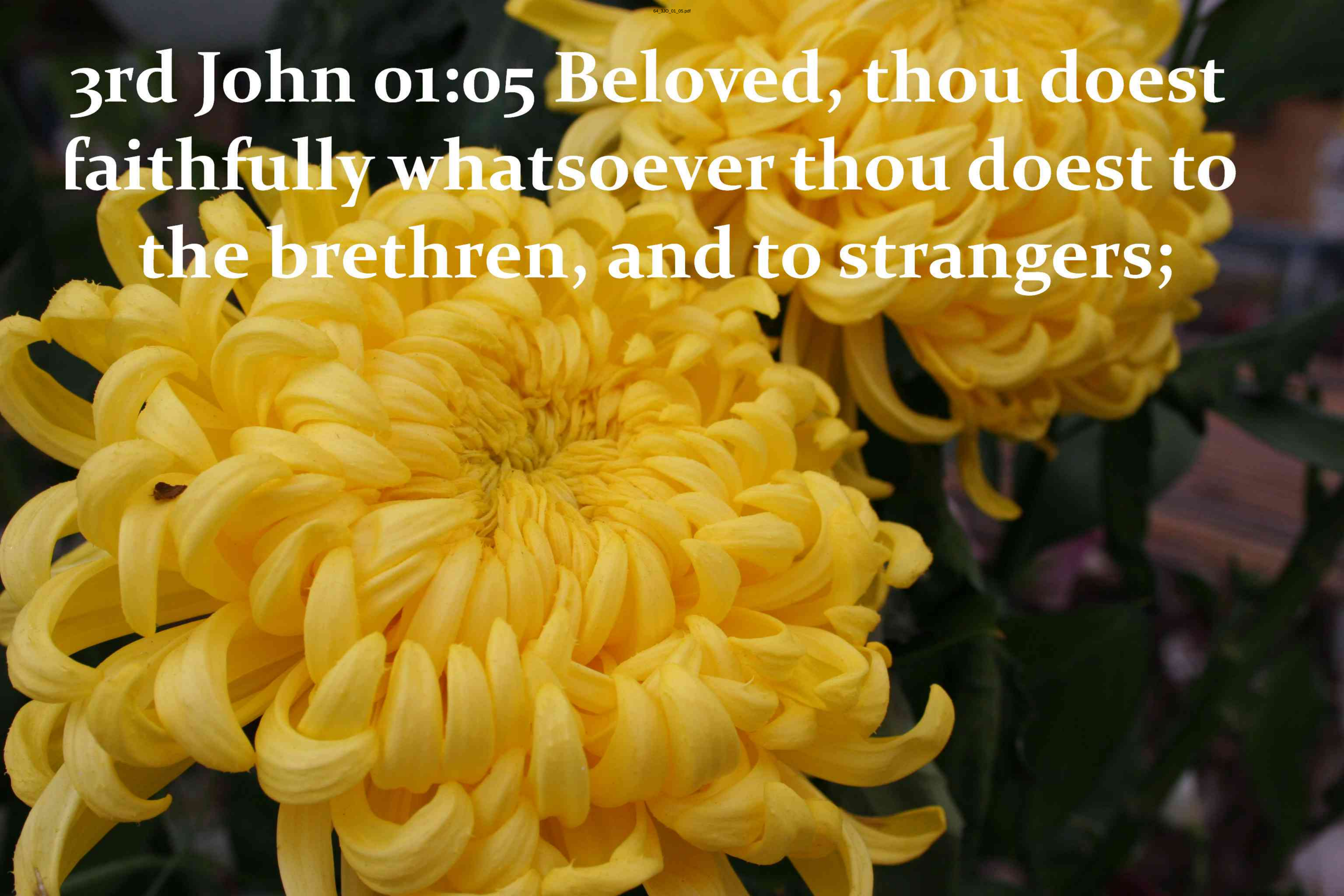


3rd John 01:04 I have no greater joy

in truth.



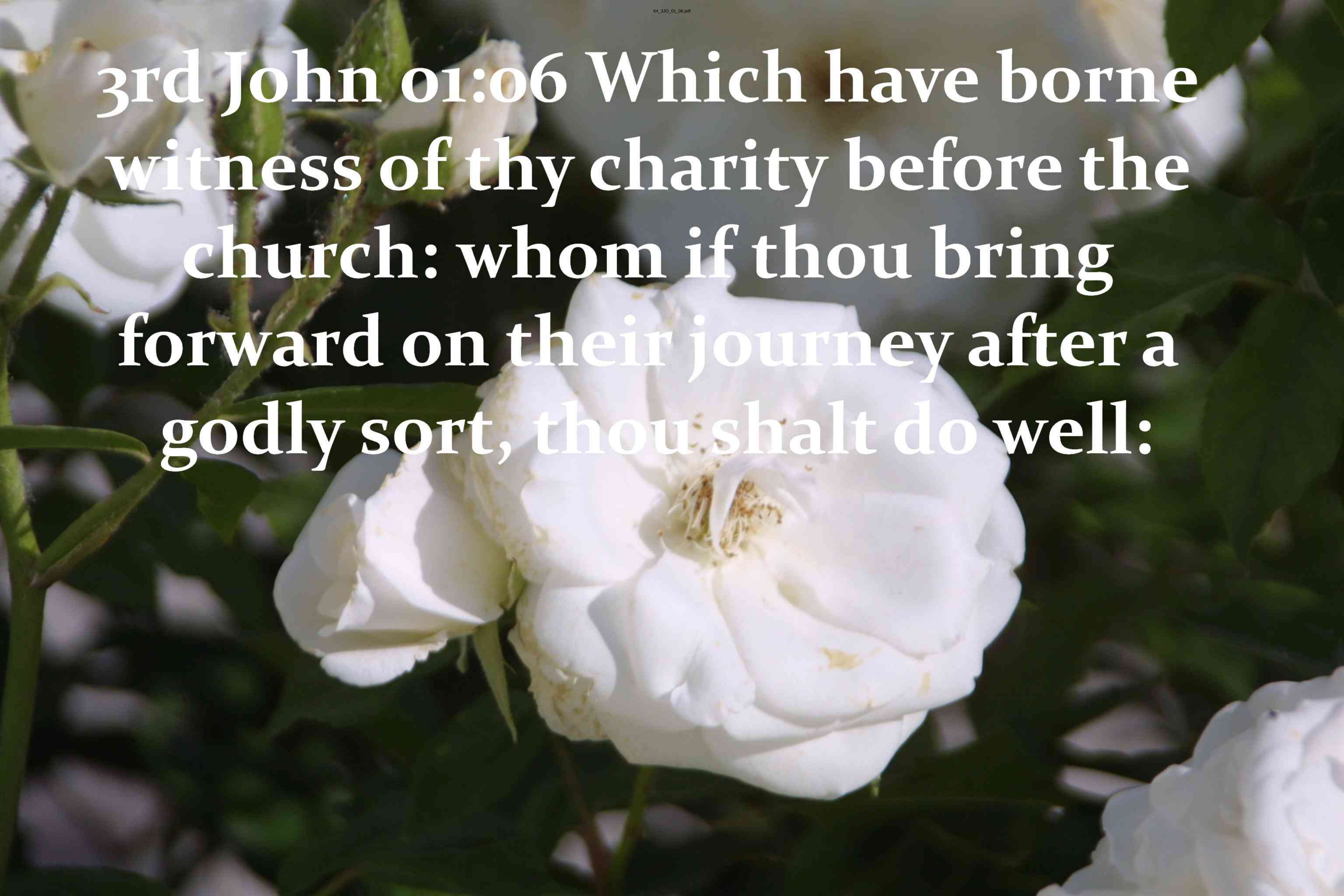


3rd John 01:05 Beloved, thou doest

godly sort, thou shalt do well:

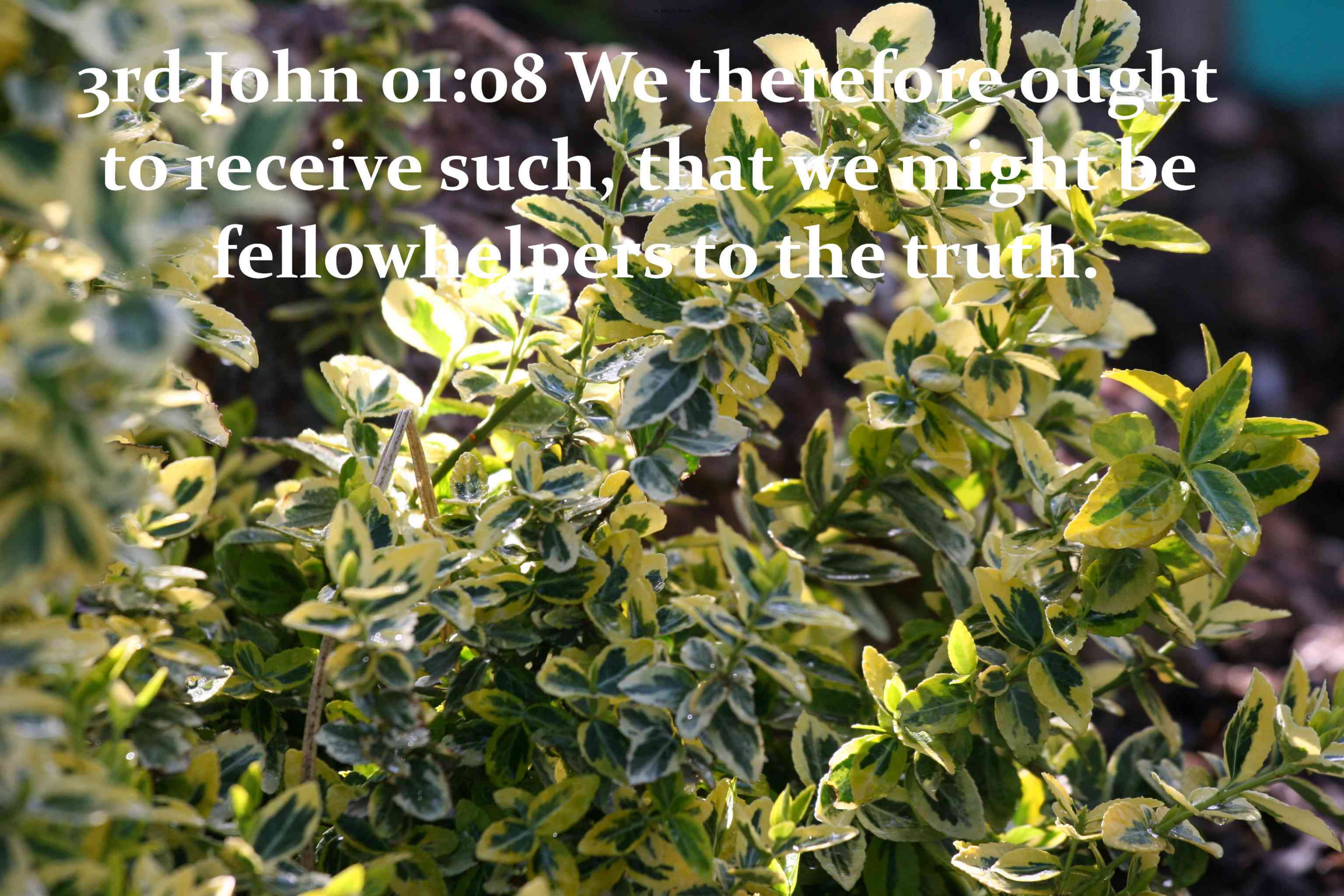




3rd John 01:07 Because that for his

among them, receiveth us not.

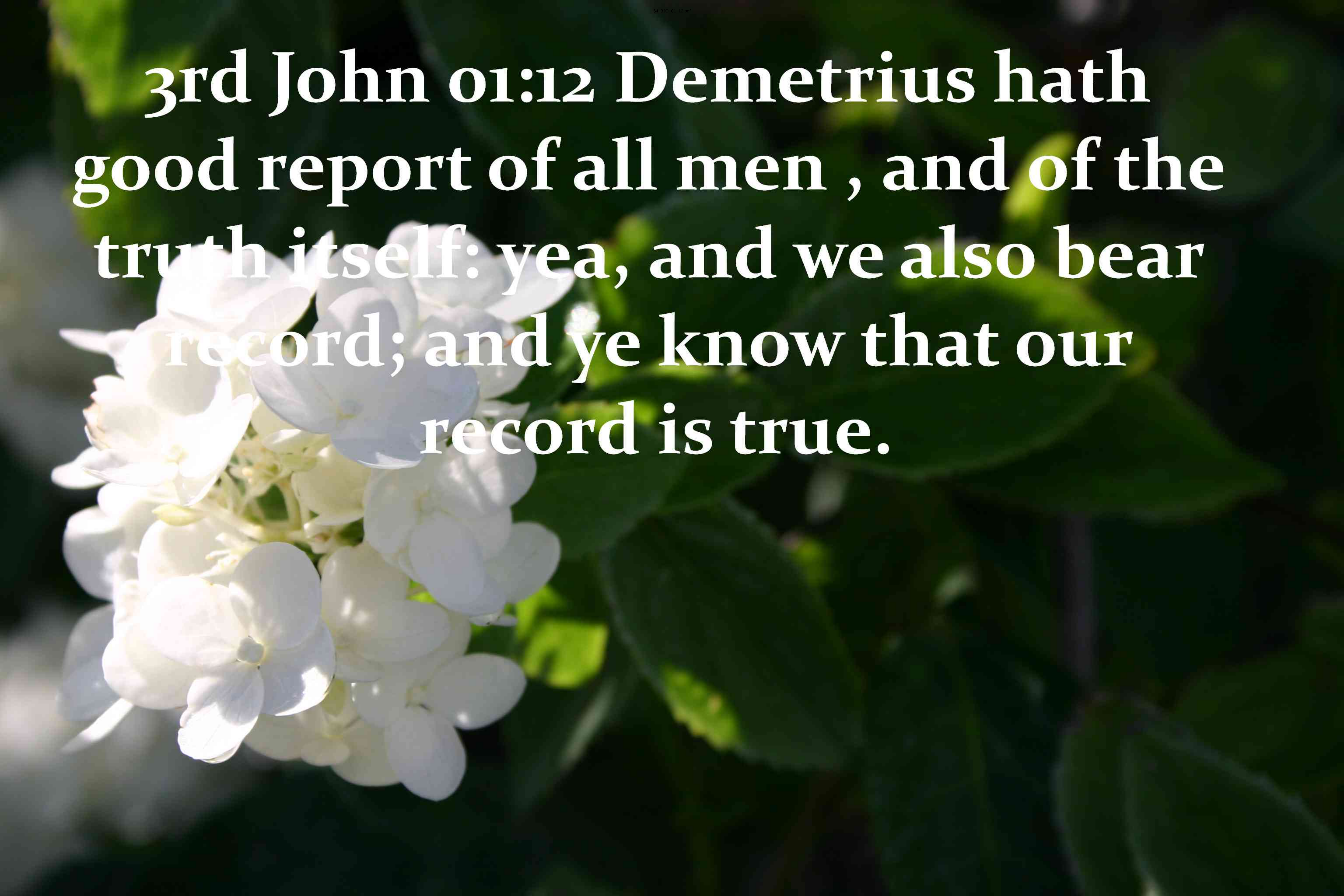


3rd John 01:10 Wherefore, if I come,

casteth them out of the church.



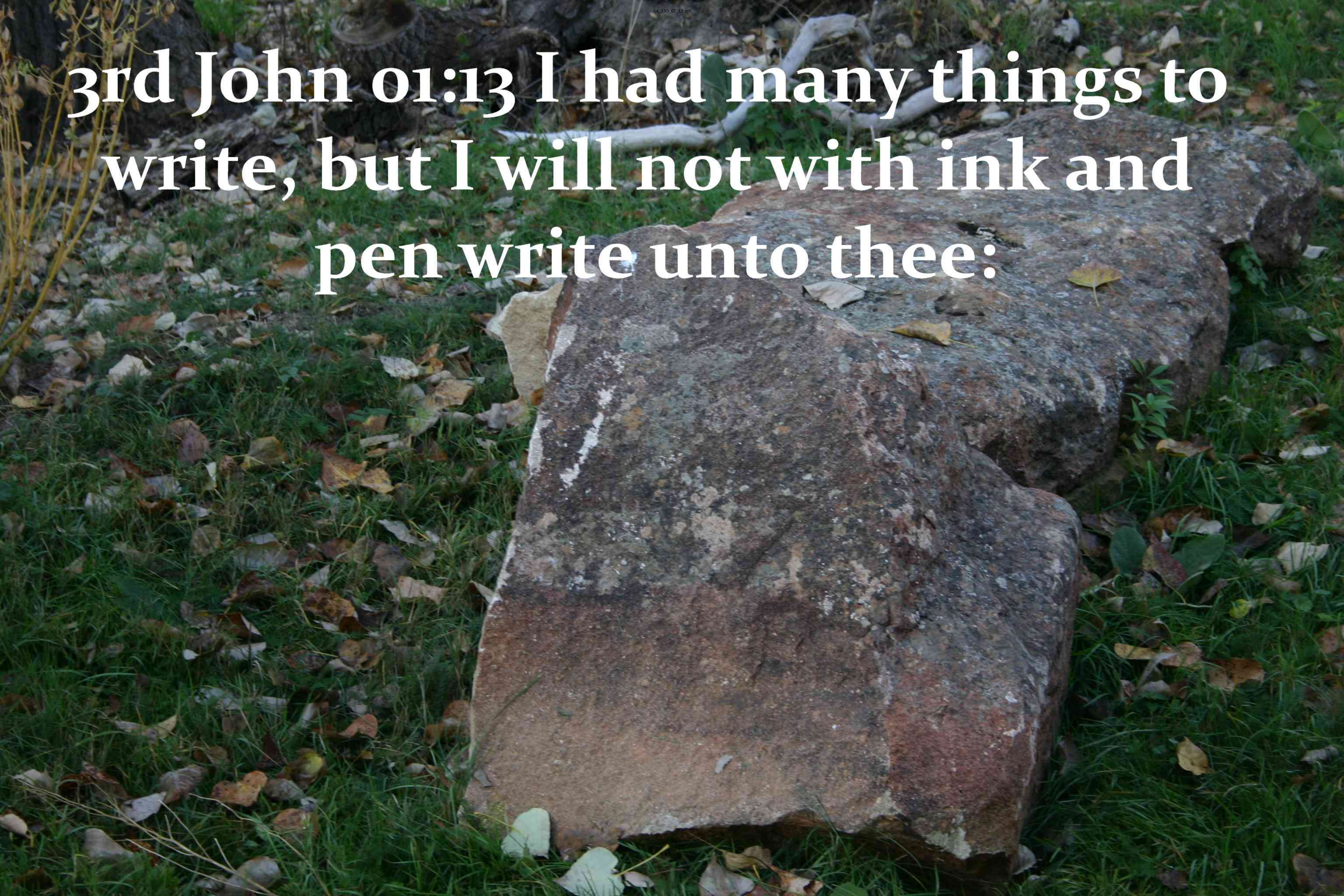
3rd John 01:11 Beloved, follow not
