
Genesis 43:25 And they made ready

should eat bread there.




**2nd Samuel 04:05 And the sons of

noon.**





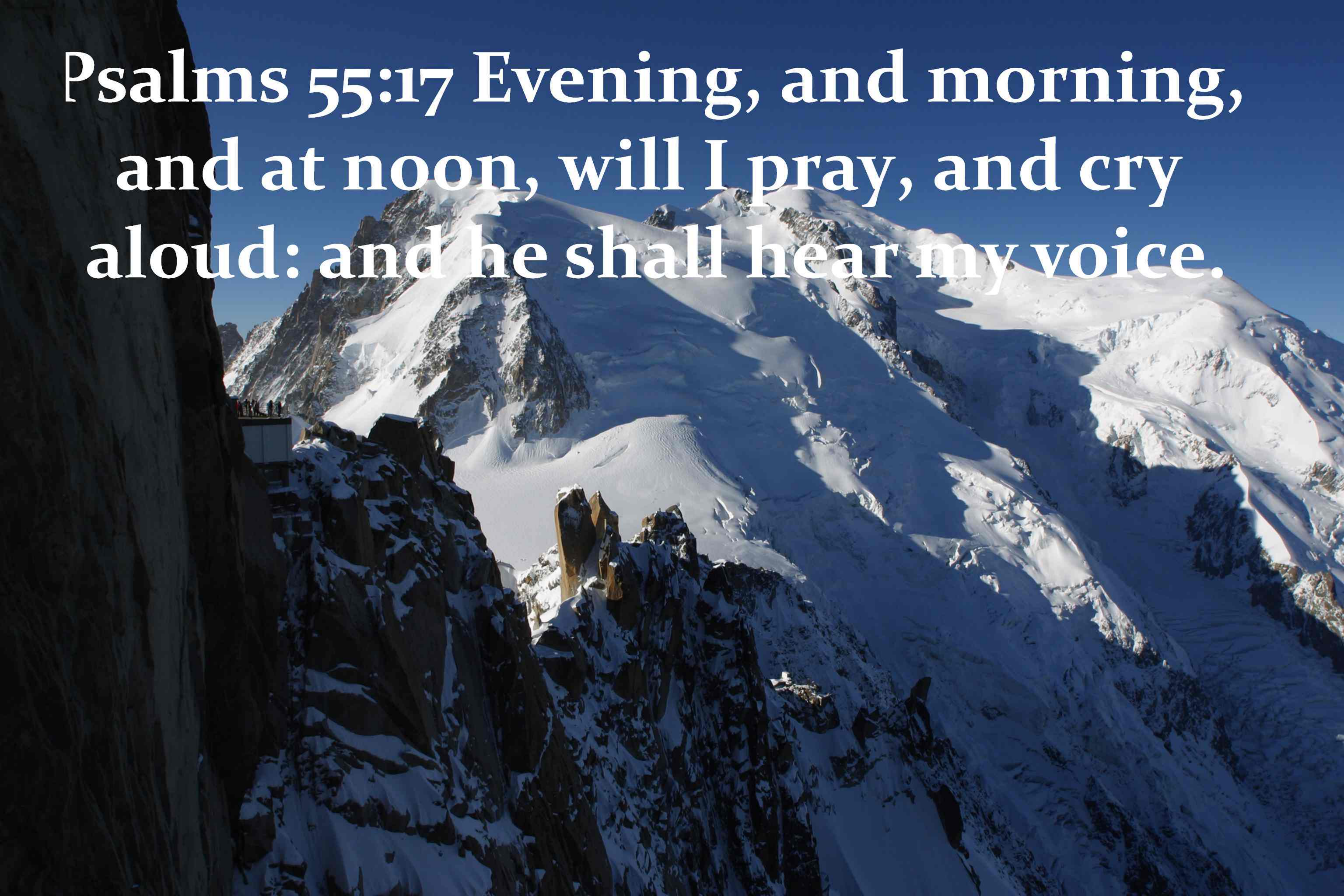


**1st Kings 20:16 And they went out

noon, and then died.


**Psalm 55:17 Evening, and morning,

aloud: and he shall hear my voice.**






**Song of Solomon 01:07 Tell me, O

companions?**


**Isaiah 58:10 And if thou draw out

darkness be as the noon day:**




Isaiah 59:10 We grope for the wall

desolate places as dead men .




Jeremiah 06:04 Prepare ye war
