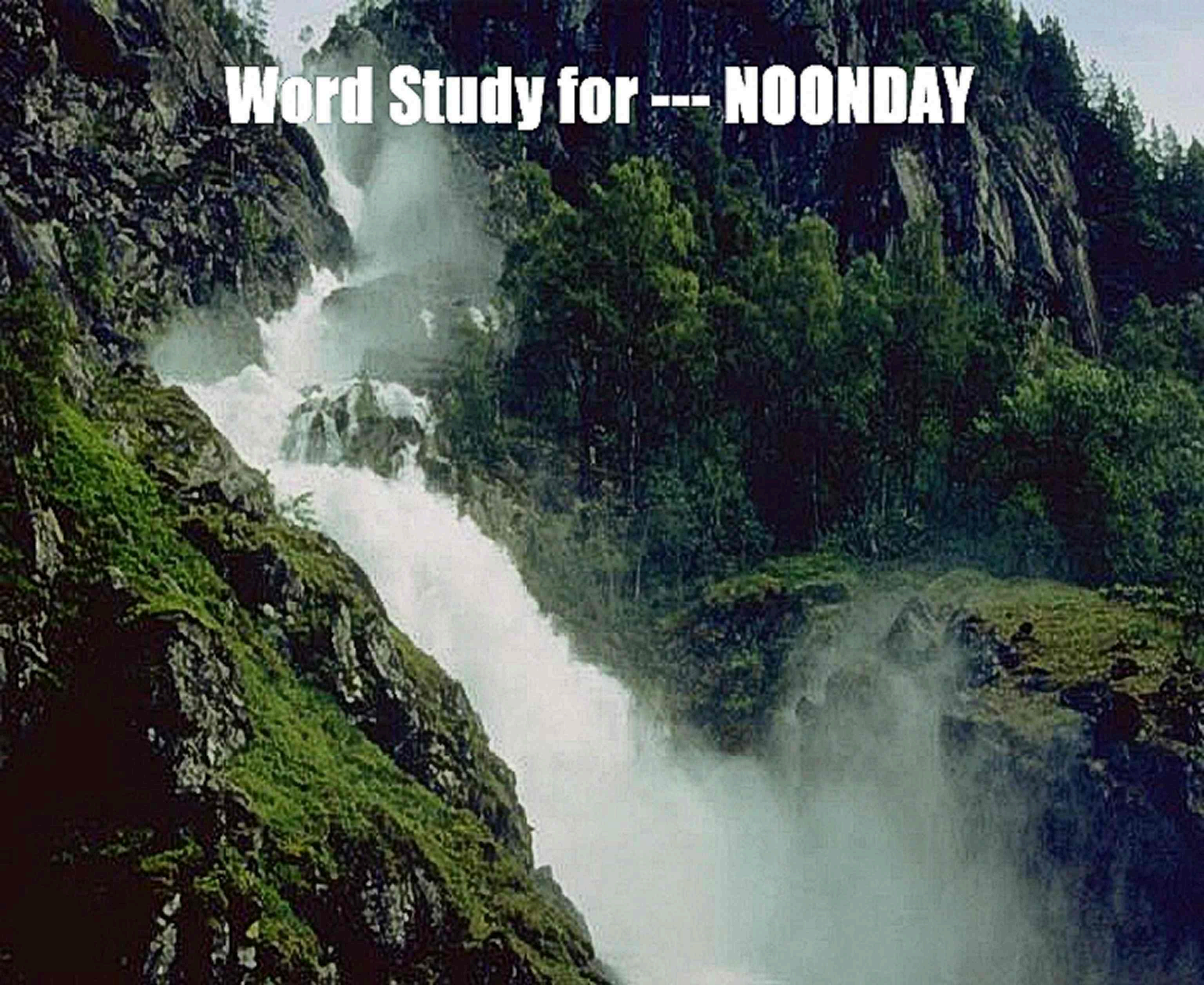







Deutronomy 28:29 And thou shalt

shall save thee .


**Job 05:14 They meet with darkness

noonday as in the night.**


