

2nd Kings 23:29 In his days  
Pharaohnechoh king of Egypt  
went up against the king of Assyria  
to the river Euphrates: and king  
Josiah went against him; and he  
slew him at Megiddo, when he had  
seen him.



2nd Kings 23:33 And  
Pharaohnechoh put him in bands  
at Riblah in the land of Hamath,  
that he might not reign in  
Jerusalem; and put the land to a  
tribute of an hundred talents of  
silver, and a talent of gold.



**2nd Kings 23:34 And  
Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the  
son of Josiah king in the room of  
Josiah his father, and turned his  
name to Jehoiakim, and took  
Jehoahaz away: and he came to  
Egypt, and died there.**

2nd Kings 23:35 And Jehoiakim gave the silver and the gold to Pharaoh; but he taxed the land to give the money according to the commandment of Pharaoh: he exacted the silver and the gold of the people of the land, of every one according to his taxation, to give it unto Pharaohnechoh.
