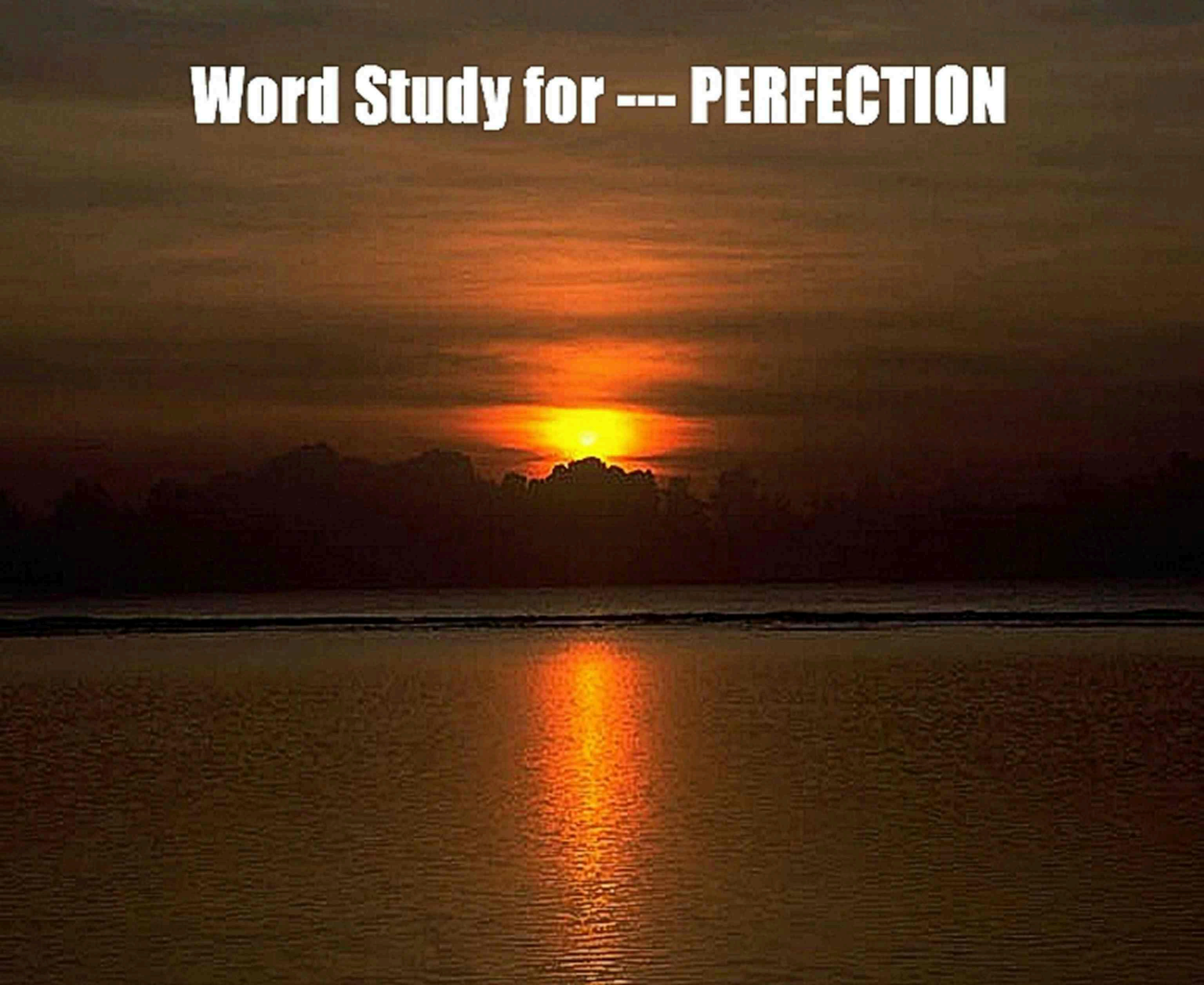


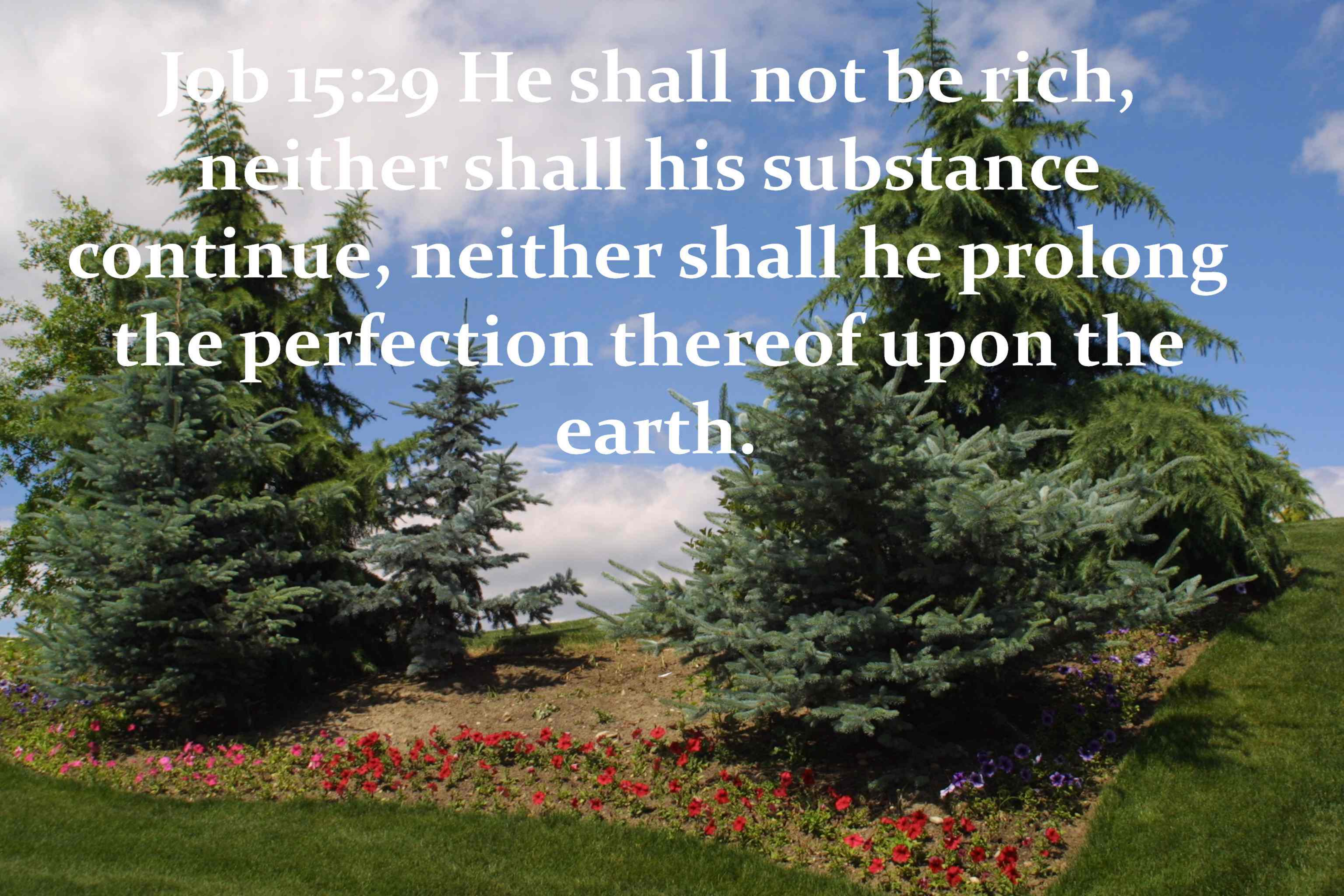






**Job 11:07 Canst thou by searching

earth.







**Job 28:03 He setteth an end to

commandment is exceeding broad.**




**Lamentations 02:15 All that pass by

earth?**




