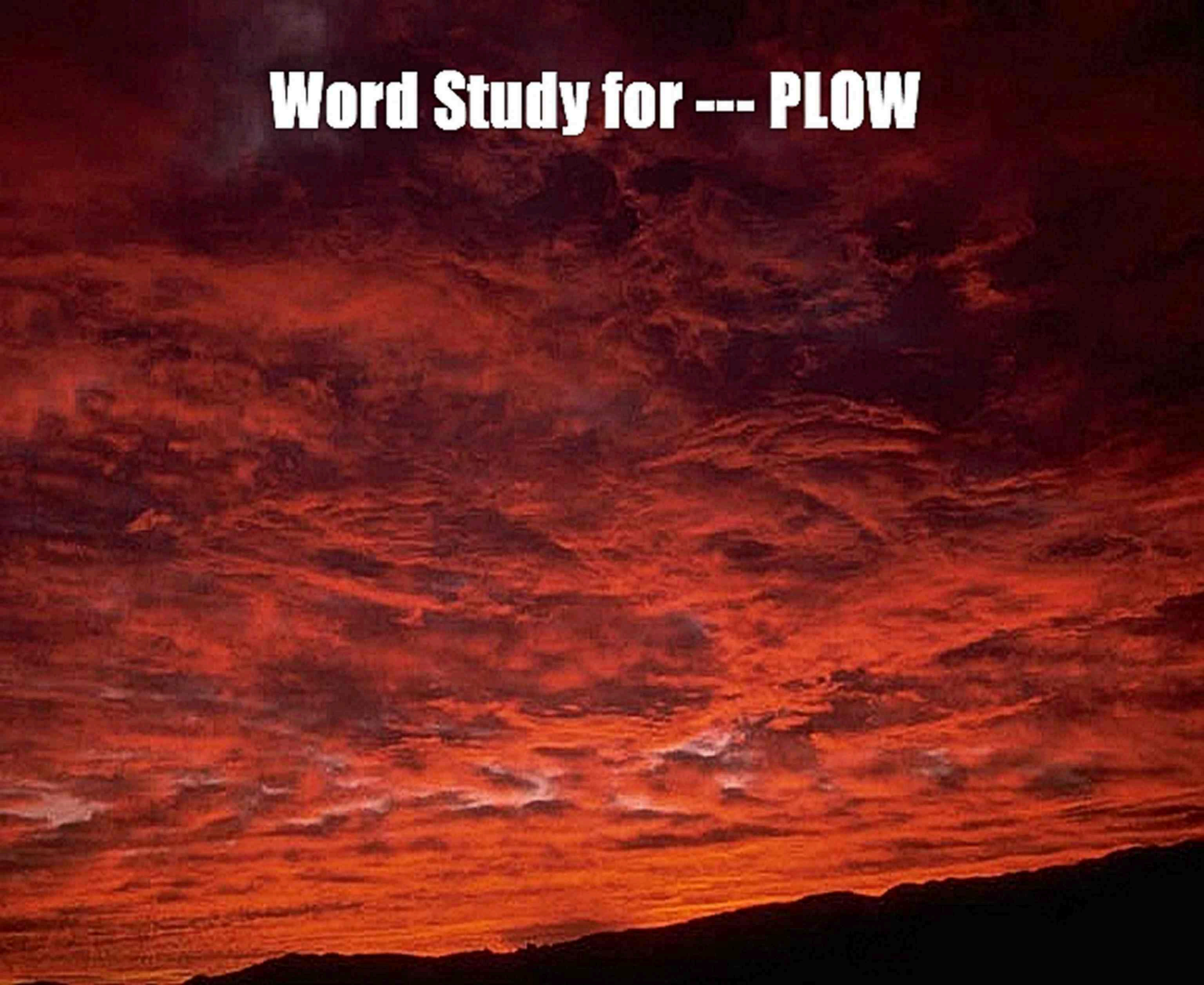


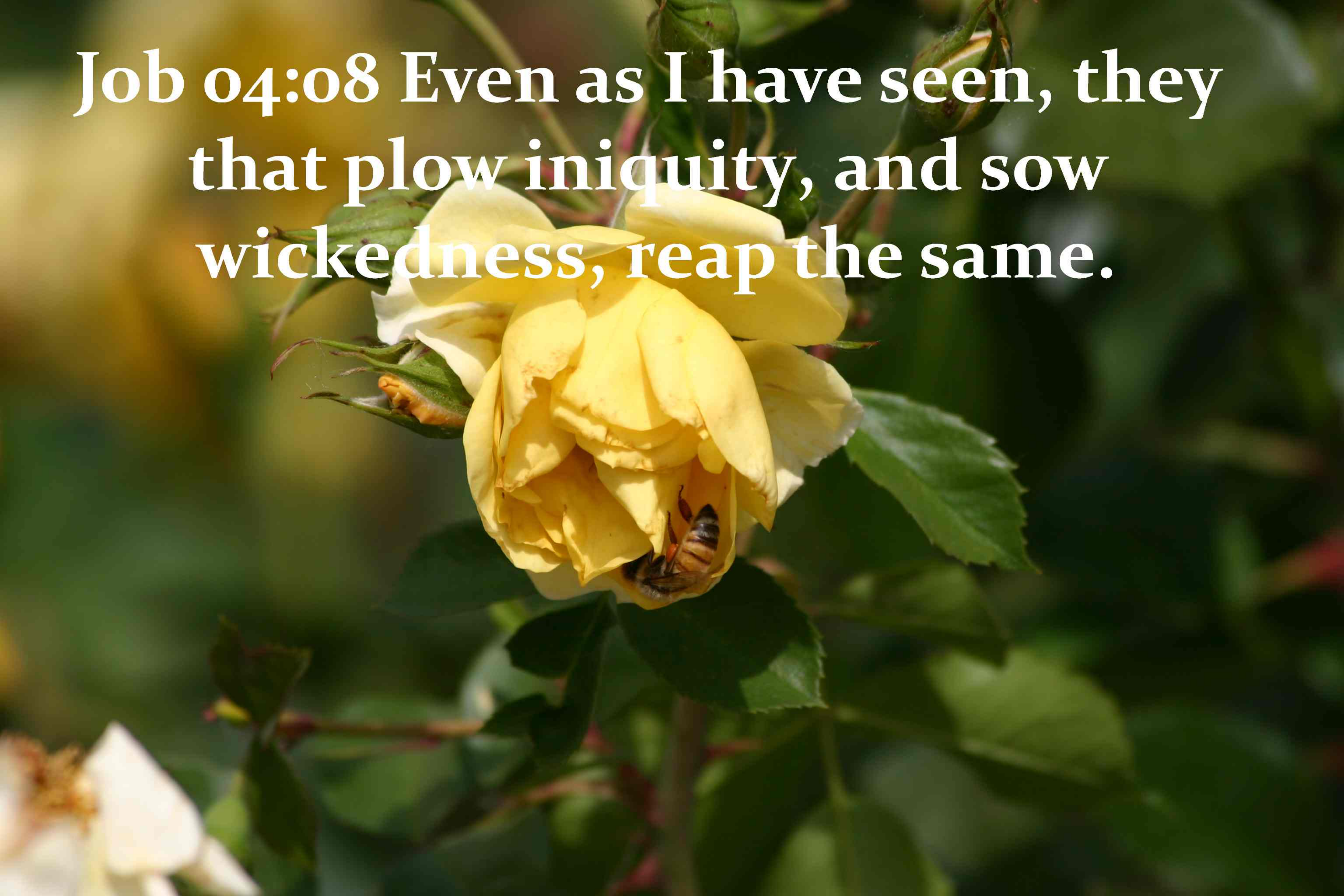
**Deuteronomy 22:10 Thou shalt not

together.**



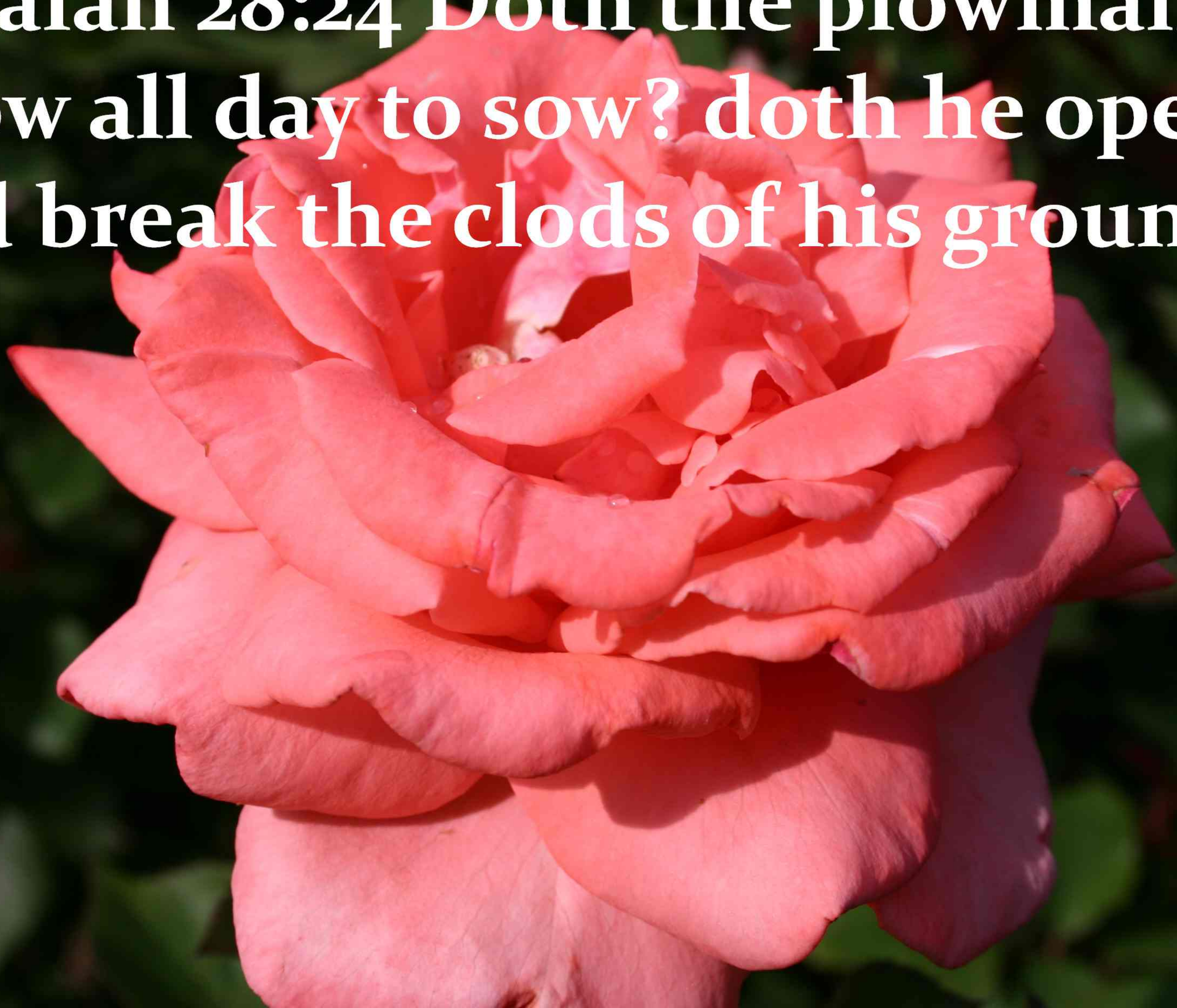
**Job 04:08 Even as I have seen, they

wickedness, reap the same.**







**Proverbs 20:04 The sluggard will

and break the clods of his ground?**






Hosea 10:11 And Ephraim is as an
