


every debt.


Nehemiah 13:16 There dwelt men

Jerusalem.



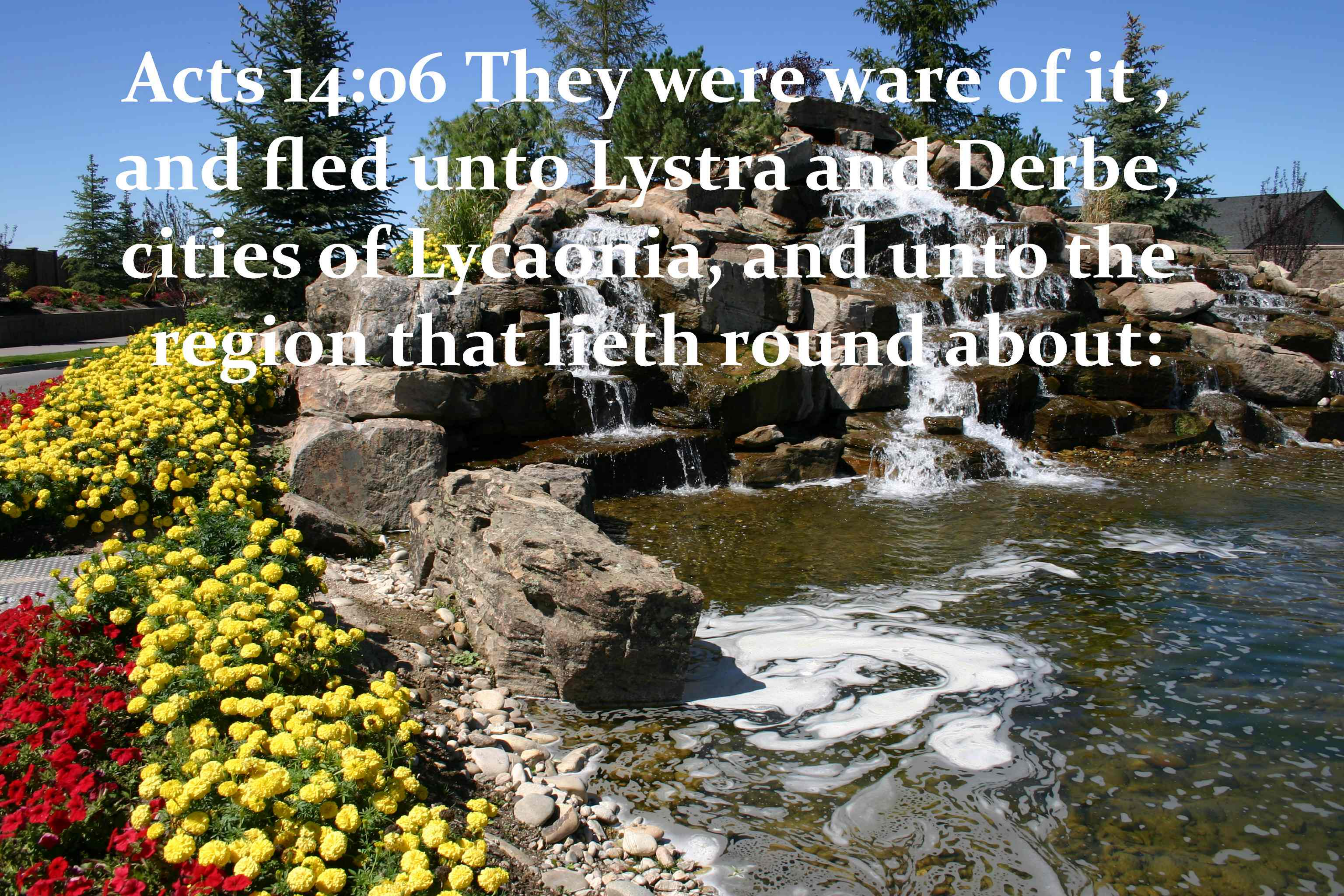
**Nehemiah 13:20 So the merchants
