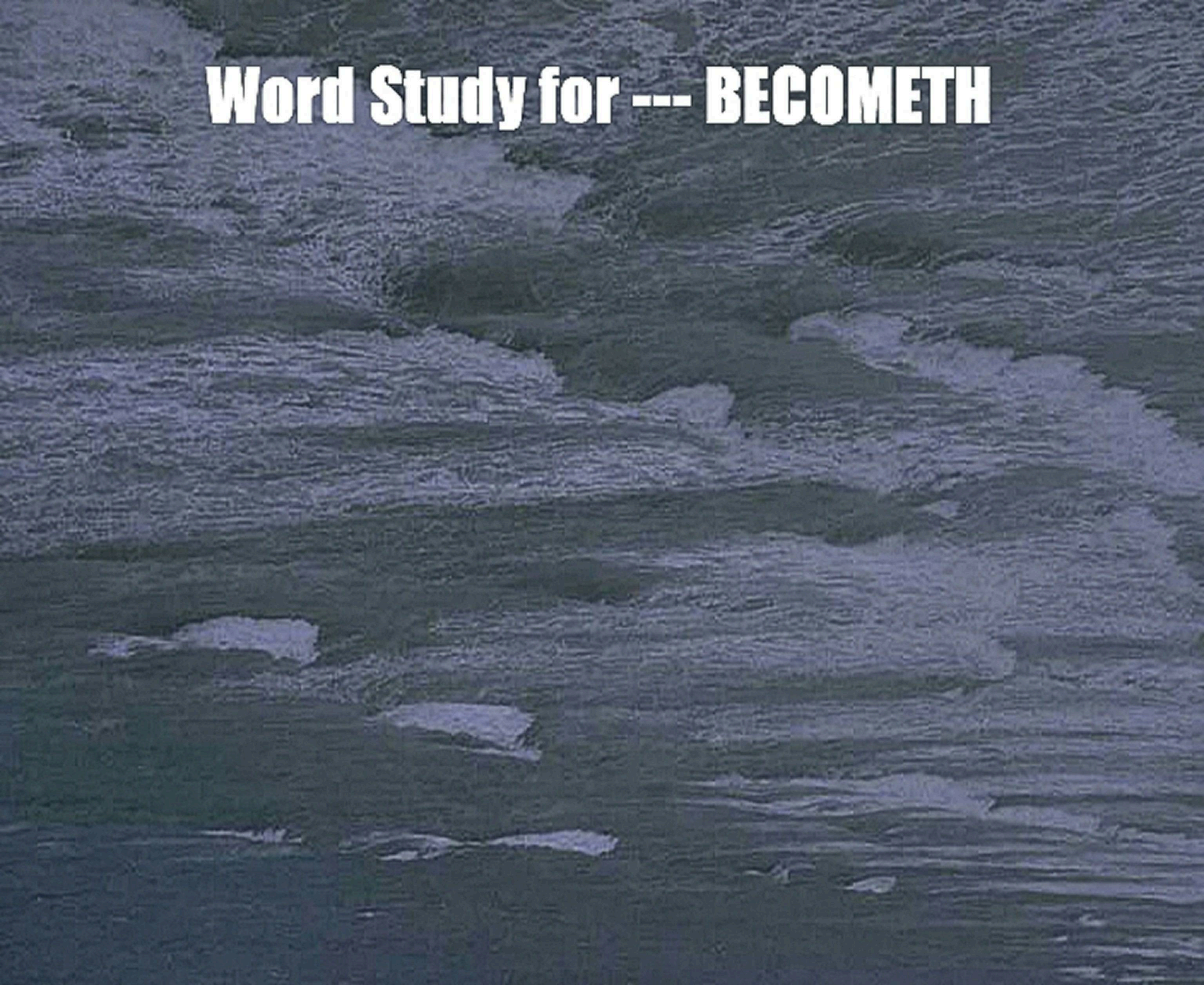



rich.**










