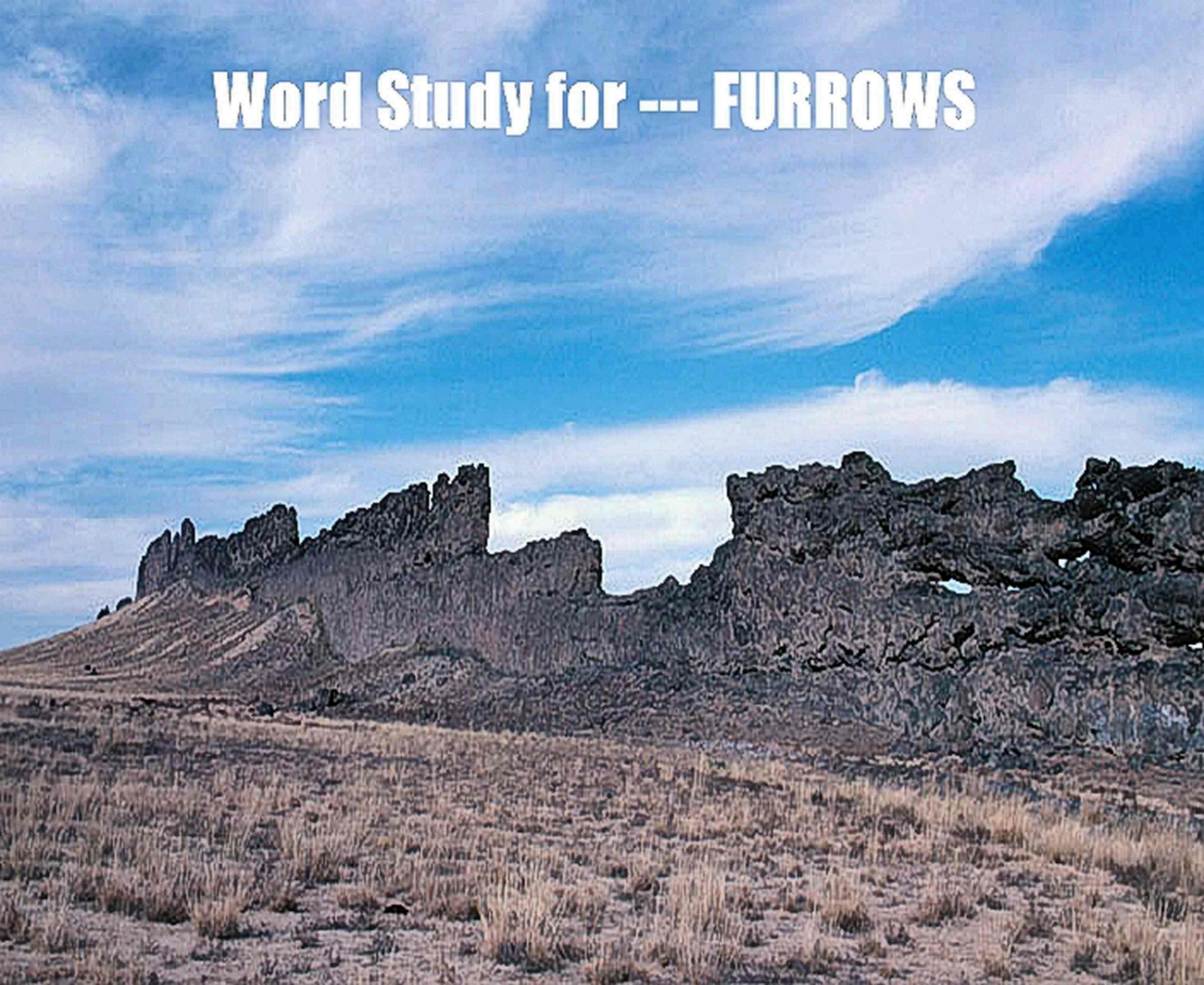




**Job 31:38 If my land cry against me,

thereof complain;**




Psalm 129:3 The plowers plowed

their furrows.




A photograph of a forest in autumn. The trees have yellow, orange, and red leaves. In the foreground, there is a field of tall, dry grasses. The sky is blue.




**Ezekiel 17:10 Yea, behold, being
