







**Joshua 12:21 The king of Taanach,  
one; the king of Megiddo, one;**








**Judges 05:19 The kings came and fought, then fought the kings of Canaan in Taanach by the waters of Megiddo; they took no gain of money.**








2nd Kings 09:27 But when Ahaziah


2nd Kings 23:29 In his days
