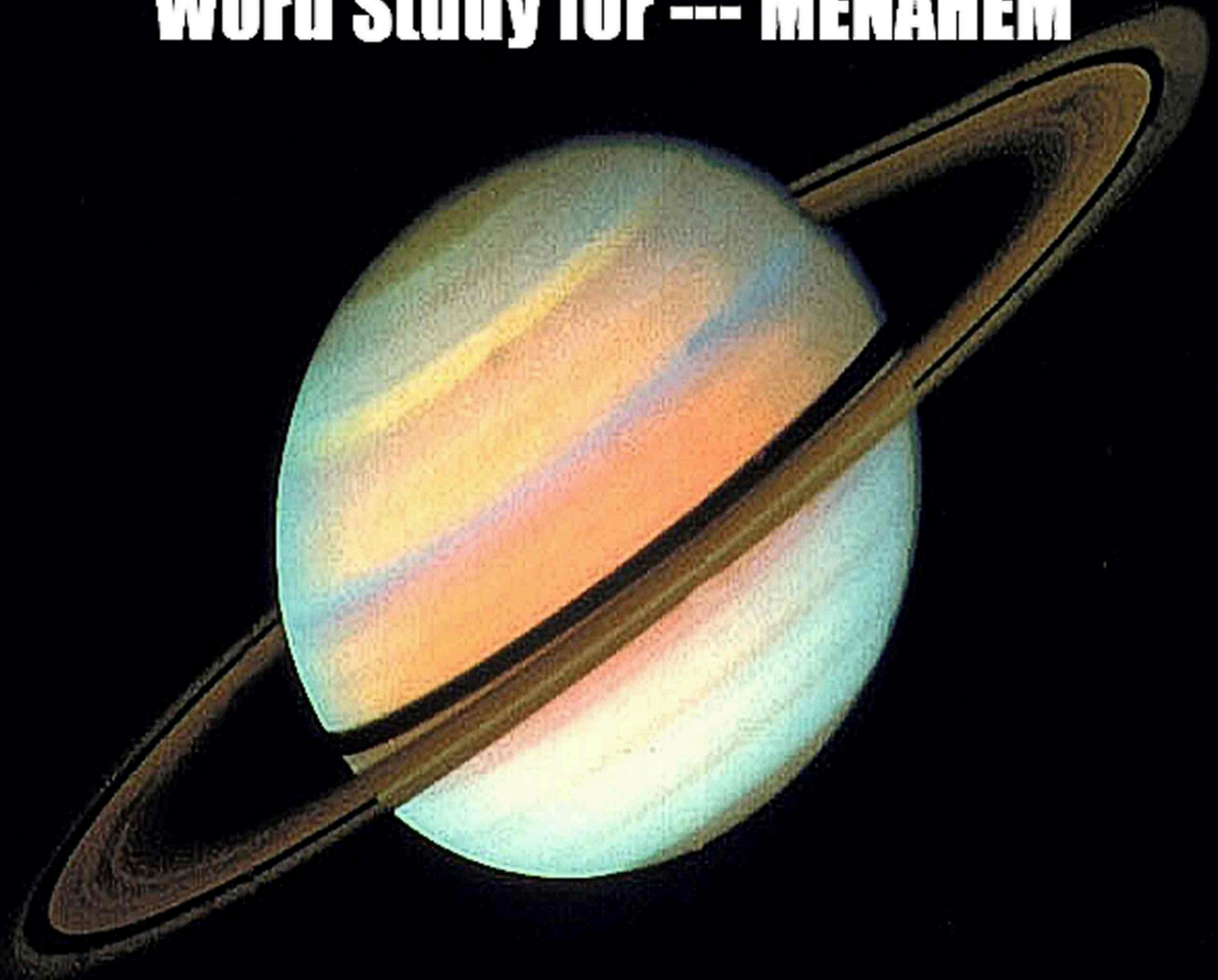



Word Study for --- MENAHEM








