


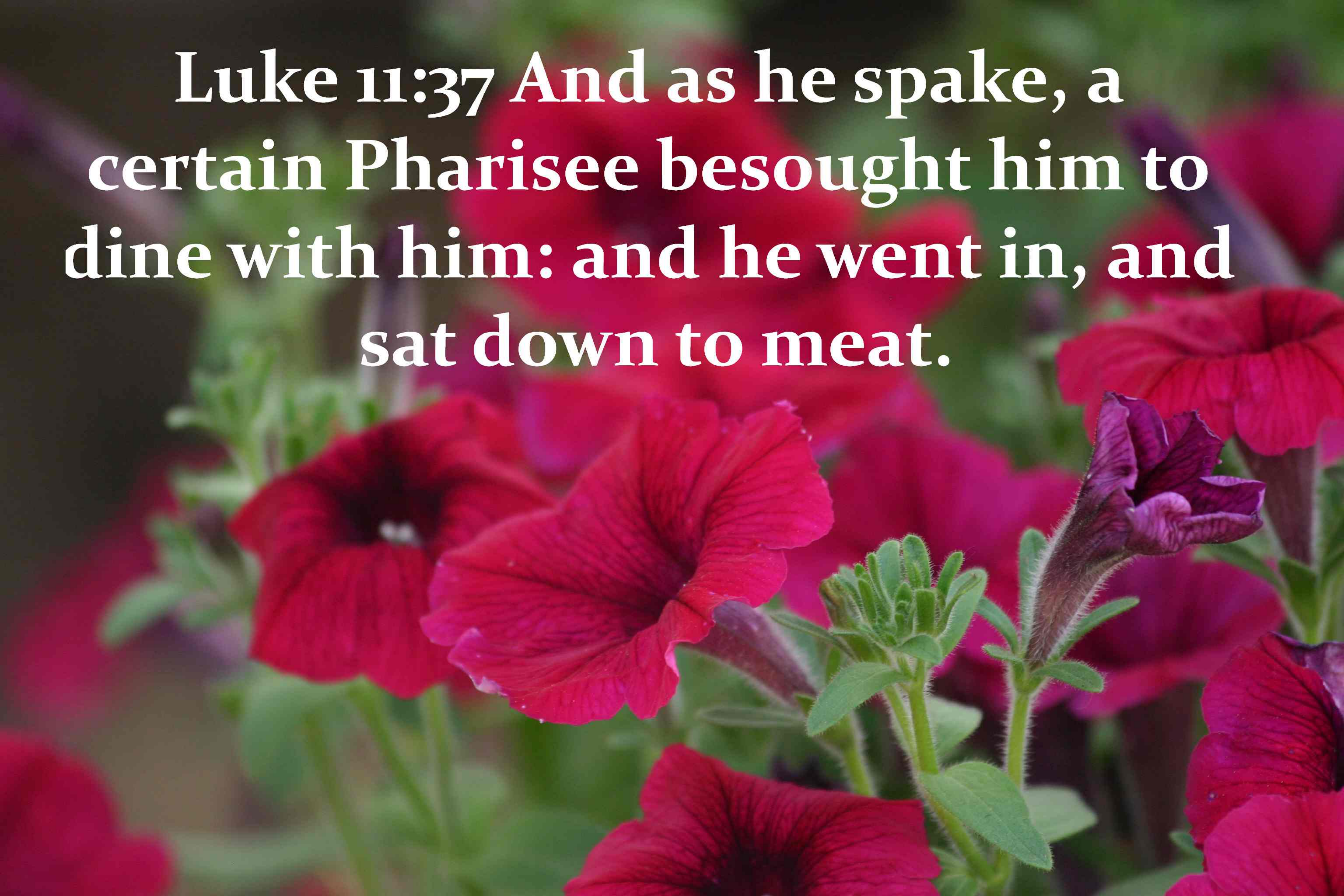

**Luke 11:37** And as he spake, a certain Pharisee besought him to dine with him: and he went in, and sat down to meat.




**Luke 11:38 And when the Pharisee

not first washed before dinner.**




**Luke 18:10 Two men went up into

Pharisee, and the other a publican.**




**Luke 18:11 The Pharisee stood and
