speckled, and spotted.







Genesis 30:41 And it came to pass,

Exodus 07:12 For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods.

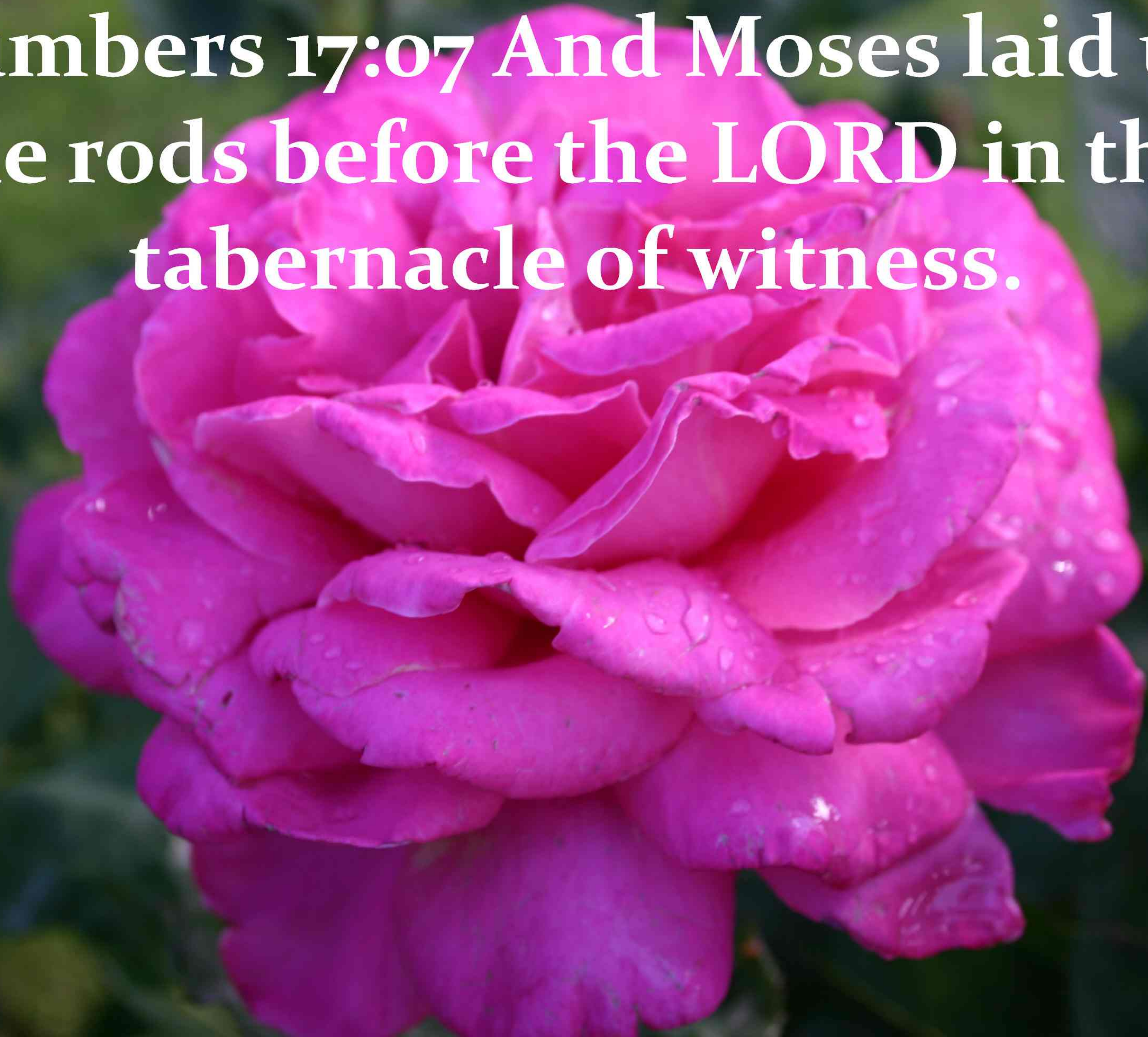





**Numbers 17:06 And Moses spake

tabernacle of witness.**







**Numbers 17:09 And Moses brought
