




Genesis 29:28 And Jacob did so,

also.




**Daniel 09:27 And he shall confirm

Matthew 28:01 In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first day of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre.

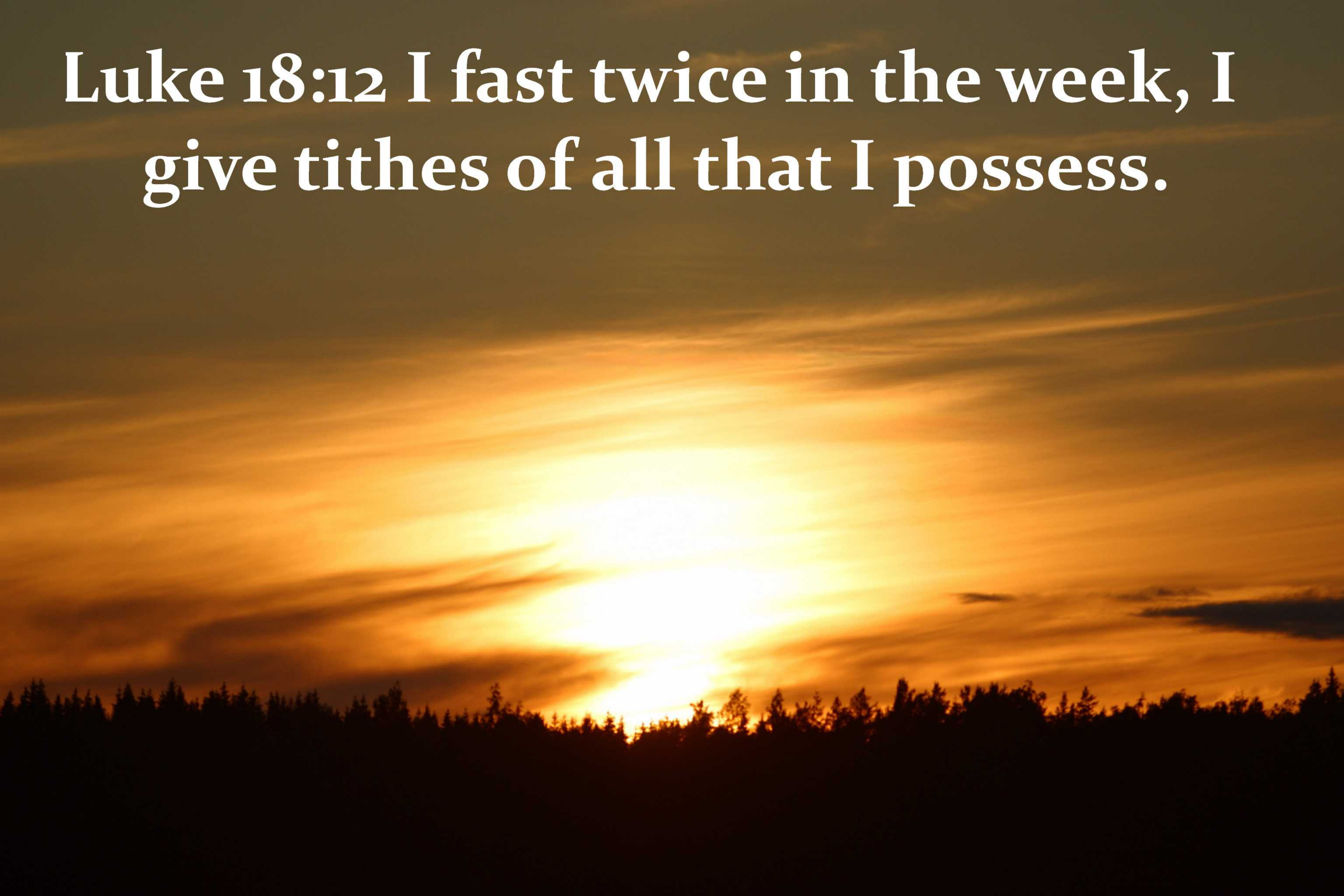
Mark 16:02 And very early in the morning the first day of the week, they came unto the sepulchre at the rising of the sun.





Mark 16:09 Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.

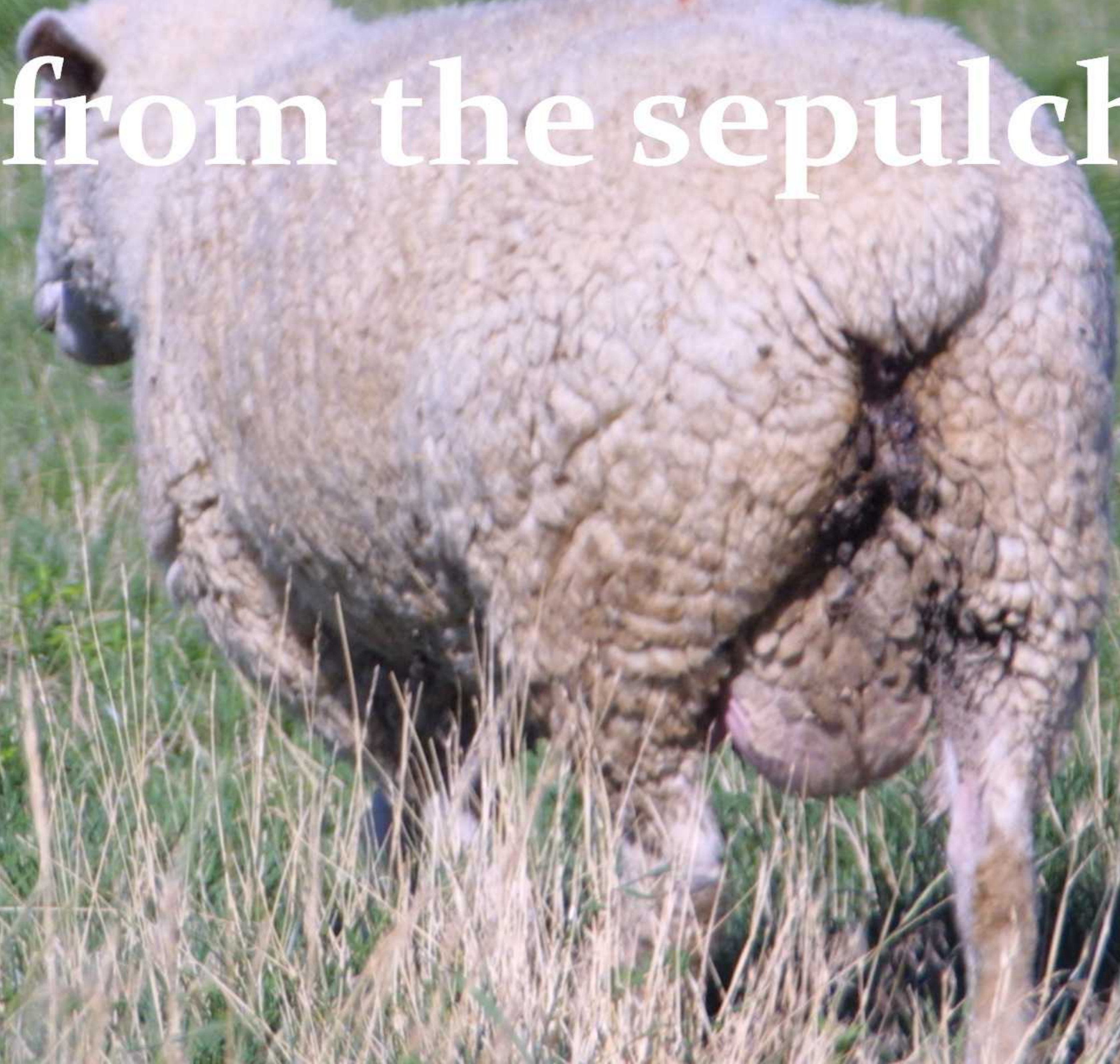




Luke 24:01 Now upon the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared, and certain others with them.


